Getting Started

System Requirements

Any Symbian S60 3rd edition running device.

Installation and Un-installation

Installation

1. Download the SIS or SISX file for a selected travel guide on your desktop PC. The file contains the main Travel Guide application and a database file for a selected travel location.

Bluetooth installation

- 2.1. Enable the Bluetooth transfer on both the desktop PC and SmartPhone and use a Bluetooth connection to install the SIS files on your mobile device.
- 2.2. The newly transferred SIS/SISX file will appear as new messages in the inbox of your phone. Open the Inbox and start it to install the program on your mobile phone.
- 2.3. Follow the instructions on the screen to install the software.

Data Cable Connection

- 2.1. Connect your phone to your desktop PC and make sure that the Nokia PC Suite software is installed and enabled on your PC.

The Nokia PC Suite is free of charge and comes with your mobile phone. You can also obtain the software from <http://www.nokia.com>.

- 2.2. Double click the installation SIS or SISX file. Nokia PC Suite will upload the travel guide files onto your phone and notify you that you should continue the installation on your mobile device.
- 2.3. Follow the on-screen instructions on your phone to complete the installation.

Once the installation is complete you may be asked to restart your phone. After you do this the QuickWrite icon will appear in the default install directory on your phone.



Installing from the Mobile Phone

If you download QuickWrite from a mobile web site through the web browser on your phone or through an on-device software catalog as Nokia Downloads! or Handango InHand:

1. Click on the download link provided. The download will be initiated showing the progress.
2. When the download is complete you will be asked if you want to install the software on your phone. Select “Install” and follow the instructions that appear on the screen of your phone.

Un-installation

To delete the QuickWrite program from your mobile device:

1. Go to the Application Manager in the Menu on your phone and select QuickWrite that you wish to uninstall.
2. With the left soft key select **Options>Remove**.
3. A message notifying you of the deletion will appear. Press **Yes** to confirm.

Registration

QuickWrite is a downloadable shareware products available for limited free evaluation period. A license key for the software may be purchased from Mobile Systems web site or from most online mobile software stores.

Once you purchase QuickWrite, the license key based on your device IMEI will be sent to the e-mail address specified during your order. The *license key* is a numeric combination of 2x5 symbols (for example: **32454-11562**).

To register QuickWrite:

1. Start the software from the applications launcher.
2. Select **Options** and then **Register** in the form that will appear.
3. Type in your *license key* in the provided space.
4. Select **OK** to confirm or **Cancel** to abort the entry.

How to use

Overview

QuickWrite is a FEP system extension handling the text input on S60 devices. The default phone FEP is the AknFEP (that you can see when you start the QuickWrite from the application launcher) and you can activate it to restore your phone default text input behavior. QuickWrite enhances the text entry on your phone by adding some new features as – popup list of suggested words while typing, ability to add words to the spelling database, and ability to work with several different spelling databases.

Activation and deactivation

To activate QuickWrite, go to your installed applications and select the QuickWrite icon.

The QuickWrite setup tool will appear and you will see a list of all currently installed FEP plugins (text engines) on your phone, including the default one (AknFEP).

To activate QuickWrite, select the corresponding item from the list and press the central button of the 5-way navigation tool.

To deactivate QuickWrite, select AknFEP (the default phone text input engine).

After phone restart QuickWrite is automatically deactivated and to be able to use it, you should activate it again.

How it Works

Once you have enabled QuickWrite, it will take control of the entire text input on your phone. It duplicates the main functions of the AknFEP (so the phone can be used the same way) and adds some new functions in the same time. Instead of T9 mode QuickWrite offers text prediction in the form of a list of suggested words. In this mode you will see three dashes to the left of the text mode indicator (“abc”, "Abc" or "ABC"). The suggested words are dynamically filtered on each new character that you enter. When the desired word appears in the pop-up list you can select it and it will be automatically added to the text

Depending on the phone model, currently there are 3 types of S60 phones. For each different text input type QuickWrite follows the functionality of the default FEP.

Writing Mode

To change the writing mode:

- Press the ‘#’ button on non- QWERTY phones with available “pencil” button such as E60, E70 (when closed), 5500 and E50.
- Press the “shift” button on QWERTY devices as E61, E61i, E70 (when open) and E90 (when open).
- Press the “#” button on non- QWERTY phones without “pencil” button such as E90 (when closed) and 6110

The FEP Menu

Through the application main menu you are able to:

- Add words to the spelling database.
- Change the dictionary. (Here you can change the language of the suggested words. Supported languages are English, French, German, Dutch, Italian and Spanish.)
- Show the QuickWrite preferences dialog.
- Switch between numeric or alpha writing modes.
- Copy, Paste or Cut selected text
- Show the special character table.

To pop up the FEP menu:

- Press the “pencil” button on non- QWERTY phones with available “pencil” button (E60, E70 (when closed), 5500 and E50).
- Press the “chr” button on QWERTY devices as E61, E61i, E70 (when open) and E90 (when open).
- Press the “*” button on non-QWERTY phones without “pencil” button such as E90 (when closed) and 6110.

Special Symbols

To popup the special symbols table:

- Press the “*” button on non-QWERTY phones with available “pencil” button such as E60, E70 (when closed), 5500 and E50.
- Pop up the FEP menu and select “Special character” on QWERTY devices as E61, E61i, E70 (when open) and E90 (when open).
- Press and hold the “*” button on none QWERTY phone without “pencil” button such as E90 (when closed) and 6110.

Settings

When you choose “Preferences” from the FEP menu, the QuickWrite settings dialog will appear. Here you can configure when the suggestions pop-up screen should appear, the size of suggested word pop-up and number of words to be shown, as well as the word list sorting.

- **Sort** - By default words are sorted by frequency so most used words appear first in the list. You also have the opportunity to sort words alphabetically.
- **Number of words** - select how many words should be shown in the pop-up suggestion screen. You are allowed to select from 2 up to 6 words.
- **Maximum list size** - here you can configure the pop-up word suggestion screen size. The possible sizes are 2 up to 6 lines. Each word appears on a new line. If the suggested words are more than the list size, a scroll bar will appear in the list.
- **Show list after** - here you can configure on which letter the word suggestions pop-up window will appear. The possible options are 1st letter up to 3rd letter.

Backup and Restore

QuickWrite does not support backup and restore. Please use the installation file to restore the software to its original state if needed.
