Introduction

When you first launch Bookman, a bookshelf called “My Library” appears. You can start adding eBooks to your bookshelf by downloading them from the internet or transferring them from your computer.

Downloading eBooks from the Internet

The built-in web browser allows you to download eBooks easily from the internet. Here is a good place to start. You can download some free eBooks on our website:

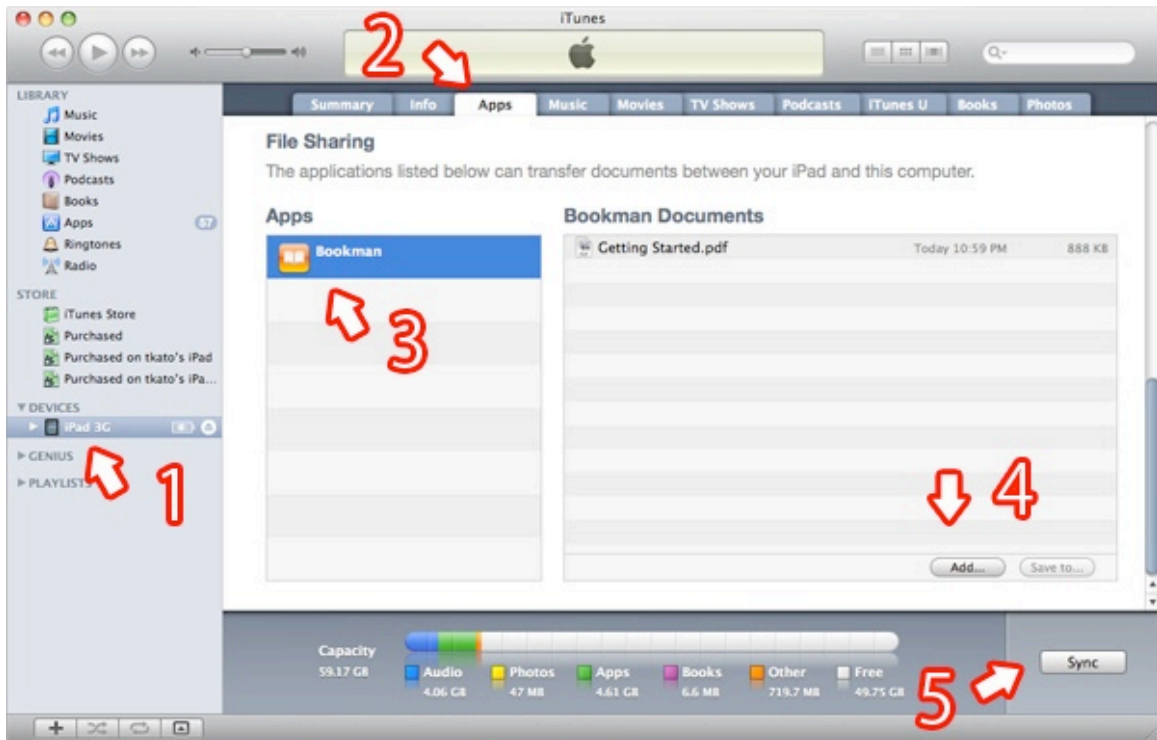
When you tapped the link above, the built-in web browser appears. You can download eBooks to “My Library” with the web browser.

You can also download eBooks you like using eBook publish service such as [Feedbooks](#).

(For now, Bookman can download PDF and Comic Archive files.)

Copying your files to the application

To transfer your files using iTunes:



1. Open iTunes and select your device.
2. Click on the **Apps** tab.
3. **Scroll it to the bottom** and click on **Bookman** in the **Apps**.
4. Click on “**Add...**” to choose files. Or Drag & Drop files into **Bookman Documents**.
5. Click on the **Sync** button. The file will be displayed automatically on a bookshelf after completed syncing.

FTP File Transfer via Wi-Fi network

You can transfer files via Wi-Fi network by using FTP client software from other computer.

To be enabled FTP function, tap the settings icon in the lower right of the bookshelf screen, and tap on “**FTP**” in the section of “**File Transfer**”. You will see as screen below:



Select ON “**FTP server**” to enable FTP server function.

Account and **Network** settings will be used when it is connected from FTP client software.

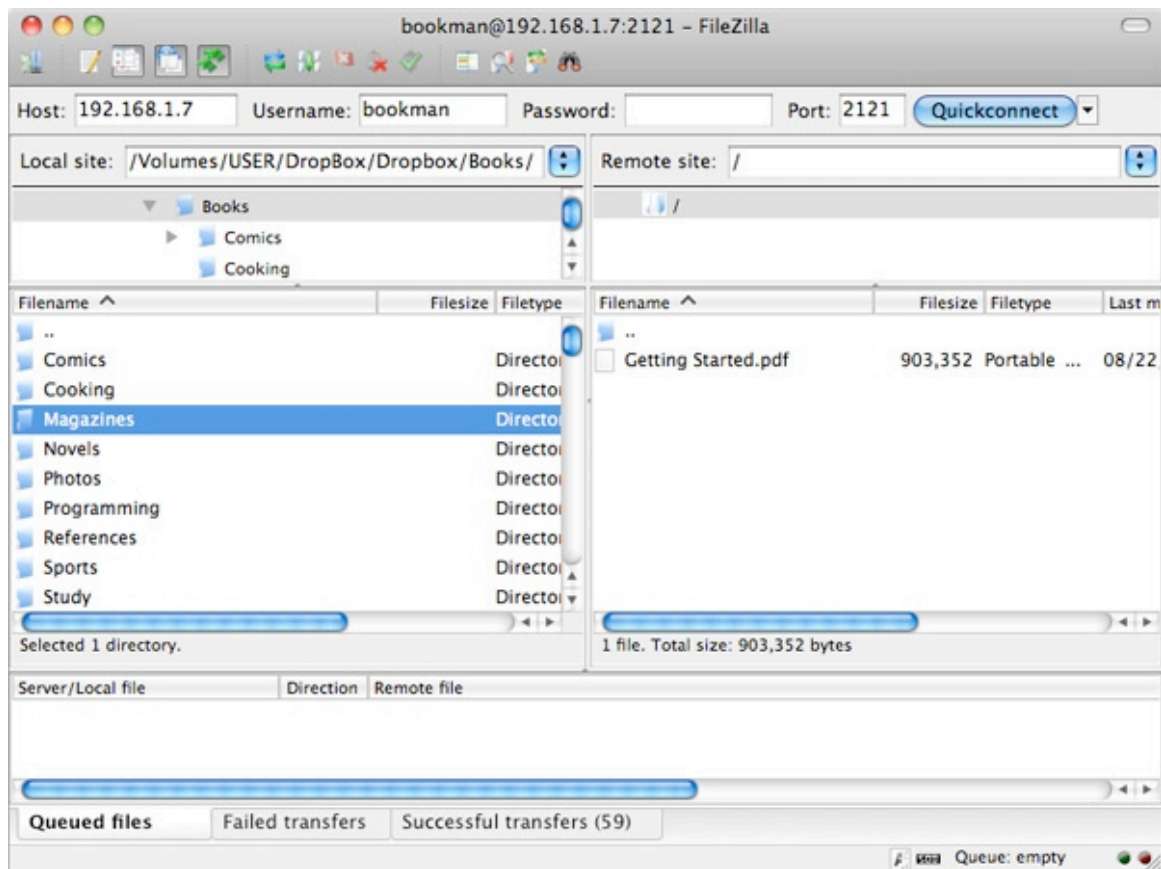
The default **Username** is “**bookman**”. The default **Password** has not been set. We

recommend you change the **Username** and **Password** for your security.

If you change any setting, restart the “**FTP server**” to reflect them.

How to setup FTP client software

There are many kinds of free software released on the internet. Here is the instruction to setup FTP client software using one of the free software “[FileZilla](#)”, which can be used on both Windows and Mac.



1. Open FileZilla, and input same parameter as FTP setup of Bookman in the 4 text boxes (**Host**, **Username**, **Password**, **Port**) as shown in the upper part of the window.
2. Click “**Quickconnect**” in the upper right of the window.

3. The file list of Bookman will be displayed in the right column when the connection is succeeded. The file list of the computer will be displayed in the left. At the first time of startup Bookman, only this document file “Getting Started.pdf” will be shown in the right column.
4. Select the file you want to copy in the left column. Drag & Drop it to the right column.
5. The red light is on in the lower right of the window while copying files, and the light is off when it is completed. The file will be displayed in the right column.
6. Restart Bookman after completed file copy. The file will be displayed automatically on Bookman’s bookshelf.
