CHERRY GOBBLER

"Cherries, cinnamon, the vanilla of the Galliano, and, of course, a nice bourbon are flavors that come together and embody the spirit of the season," says Fairweather. "Even if you don't have a turkey spread in front of you, this drink will transport you to that state of mind."

- 1¾ oz. bourbon
- ¾ oz. cherry-cinnamon syrup*
- ¾ oz. lemon juice
- ¼ oz. Galliano L'Autentico liqueur

Shake all ingredients together with ice and strain into a cocktail glass. Garnish with a cherry and a sprinkle of cinnamon dust.



Cherry-Cinnamon Syrup

In a saucepan, combine two cups sugar, two cups water, and six cinnamon sticks. Bring to a boil until sugar is dissolved; remove from heat. Let steep for 20 minutes, then remove cinnamon. Add 15 pitted cherries, blend in a blender, fine-strain, and store.

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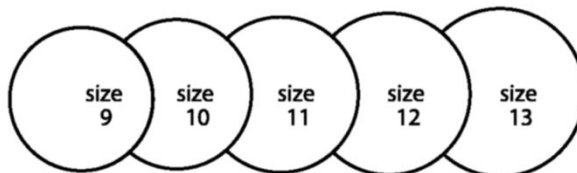

1. Turkey
2. Turkey sausage mixture
3. Prosciutto
4. Chicken
5. Chicken sausage mixture
6. Prosciutto
7. Duck
8. Bratwurst
9. Pancetta

INGREDIENTS

- 1 Tbs. each sage and rosemary, chopped
- 25 sage leaves
- 1 bunch parsley
- 1 tsp. garlic, chopped
- 1 cup olive oil
- Salt and pepper
- 1 (25 lb.) turkey, partially deboned and open-faced
- 2 lbs. turkey sausage, casings removed
- 2 lbs. prosciutto
- di Parma, sliced thin
- 1 (4 lb.) chicken, deboned and open-faced
- 2 lbs. chicken sausage, casings removed
- (9 oz.) smoked duck breast
- 2 lbs. uncooked bratwurst, casings removed
- 5 lbs. pancetta, sliced thin
- 5 garlic cloves
- Carrots, celery, and onion

1 Combine rosemary, sage, and parsley in a blender. Add the garlic and blend with olive oil until smooth.

2 Open turkey cavity and season the inside with salt and pepper. Brush in herb-garlic mixture.

3 Spread turkey sausage inside to form a thin layer, then cover entire area with layers of prosciutto.

4 Place chicken inside the turkey and brush

it with the herb-garlic mixture.

5 Spread chicken sausage on top in a thin layer, then cover the area with more prosciutto.

6 Cover duck breast with a thick layer of the bratwurst, then place it on top of chicken.

7 Carefully begin to

close the turkey by pulling each side up, basically making the bird whole again. Then tie it shut with kitchen twine, almost as if you were sewing clothing.

8 Wrap entire bird with pancetta and put in a large roasting pan with peeled garlic cloves and chopped carrots, celery, and onion.

9 Roast your turducken at 350°F until it reaches an internal temperature of 160°F (about four hours covered). Let it rest for about 20 minutes, then slice into your delicious meat monster!

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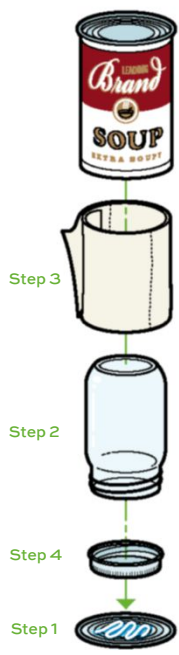

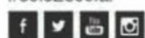

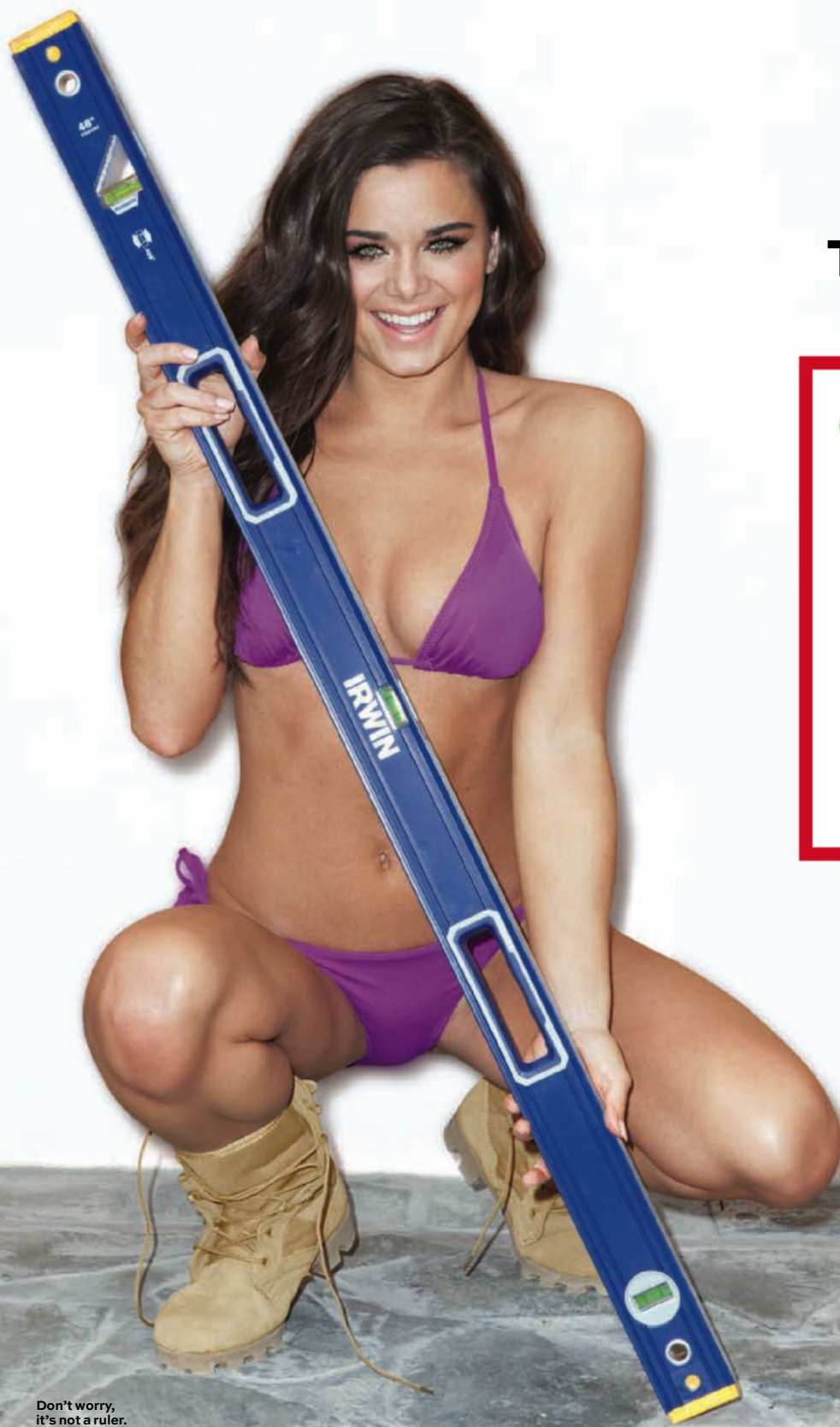

How was the shoot?

It went great! We shot at the Ace Hotel in New York, and I brought in my guitars. It had a rock'n'roll vibe, which is a bit different for *Maxim*.

Do you have a lot of input in your photo shoots and music videos?

I'm very involved in anything to do with creative, and I actually co-directed the video for "My Medicine." I like to blend music with image, and at my age sexuality is a big part of that, so it seems fitting to me.

You started the Pretty Reckless while you were on *Gossip Girl*. Were you worried you wouldn't be taken seriously as a musician?

Given his casting choices, we bet that could happen. 🐻



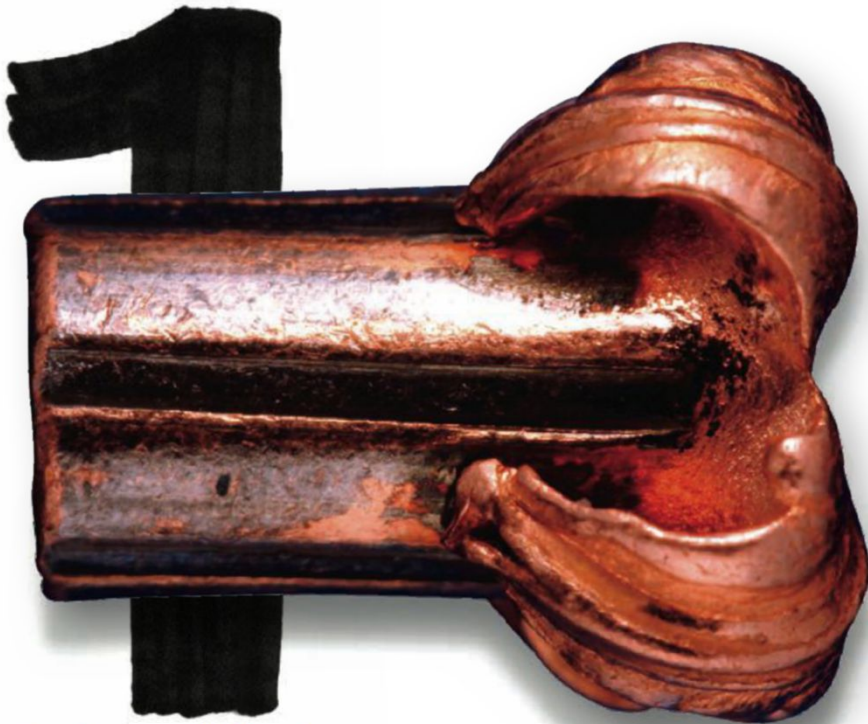

The star of *Jackass' Bad Grandpa* talks pranks, penises, and smoking weed with Willie Nelson. By David Swanson



You're a youngish dude from the South, but in *Bad Grandpa*

you play an old Jewish man. Where the hell did your character, Irving Zisman, come from?

The name comes from two guys who used to come to a restaurant I worked at. But the character is like a mixture of Mel Brooks, Walter Matthau, a more perverted version of myself, and my father. There were a lot of lines in the movie that come straight from him. He's probably my biggest influence.

He was a big prankster, right?

Oh, yeah. When I was 17 or 18, I'd be passed out, and he'd take a hot dog and put it in the microwave for 20 seconds to get it lukewarm, then run it through my mouth. When I woke up, he would act like he was zipping up his pants.

This new movie is all pranks. How was filming *Bad Grandpa* compared with the other *Jackass* movies?

Well, the makeup took three hours every morning, so that sucked. And if I did a scene with my shirt off, it took another two hours, so after we did that once or twice, I wrote those scenes out. I don't want to be a whiny actor, but after 12 hours you want to rip your face off.

Was it hard to stay in character?

To do a whole movie where you're pranking the public, at first it was terrifying, but once we started getting good stuff, the fear washed away. And Jackson Nicoll, who plays my grandson,

he was just heaven-sent. He's got no fear, he's cute, he has charisma, he's smart, and he loves fucking with people.

Sounds like a *Jackass*-in-training.

He's a lot smarter than I was as a kid. On our set, though, around me and the crew, well, let's just say you'd better cover up because Jackson is gonna hit you in the zipper at any time.

What's the worst injury you've had?

Hmm. A rocket blew up on me at the end of *Jackass Number Two*, and a long metal rod flew past my ribs and nearly decapitated two of our art department guys. So that was pretty hairy. I almost broke my neck in the first one. There have been a number of times I could have died, I guess.

And you broke your penis. How's that going for you?

Right now it's harder than a turnbuckle. Tiny but mean. I had to use a catheter for three and a half years, twice a day. An 18-inch tube about the size of a number two pencil. But not anymore. Everything's in working order.

Do you regret any of the stuff you've done? We know you recently had your Leon Spinks tattoo removed.

I don't really sit around going, "Aw, why did I do that?" What happened with the tattoo was, I was in Austin and I woke up hung over one morning, and on my left forearm was a note that said, "Get a tattoo of Leon Spinks on your left biceps," in my handwriting, so I knew it

was a message my drunk self wrote to my sober self. I woke up, and I'm like, "That guy's a genius! I'm gonna go do that right now!" And I went and did it and had it for many years.

You bought Johnny Cash's cabin, partied with Hunter S. Thompson, and starred in a movie with Willie Nelson. What's all that been like?

I never met Johnny Cash, but I did have a couple of evenings with Hunter that are pretty foggy. When I started writing for magazines, I was just doing cheap Hunter-esque knockoffs, so he was a big influence on me. And to be able to call Willie a friend is pretty mind-blowing. Smoking with him was tough, though, because I'm not a weed guy. I love the idea of weed, I love the smell, but I think I'm allergic to it. It makes me super dizzy, and I lose my hearing for five or six hours. And with Willie's weed, forget five or six hours. I'm done for eight or nine.

You seem to have a pretty high threshold for pain.

I don't know that that's true. I just think my give-a-shit threshold is really low. But people have been doing dumb stunts since the beginning of time. With *Jackass* we were fortunate in our timing. I didn't think it was gonna get on TV, and when it did, I didn't think it was gonna stay on TV. And when they brought up the idea of a movie, I was like, "Well, I don't see a movie." But I love when people film themselves doing stupid shit, and I'm glad they're doing it. I just don't think we invented dumb shit. 🐢

THE RACE TO GROW THE MOST INSANELY HOT PEPPER IS ON. BUT THE ROAD TO FIERY FAME AND FORTUNE IS PAVED WITH TRASH TALK, DECEPTION, EVEN PERFORMANCE ENHANCERS! WE SENT OUR MAN INSIDE THE SUPERHEATED BATTLE FOR THE CHILIHEAD CROWN.

All hell just broke loose inside my mouth. My tongue is burning. My upper lip is stinging. My eyes are bloodshot.

It's like being face-fucked by Satan himself. "There's no shame in throwing up, brother," says Ed Currie, a soft-spoken 50-year-old who fed me a new variety of superhot chili pepper he's developed called the Carolina Reaper.

Three minutes ago I popped the bright-red, gumball-size pepper into my mouth, chewed thoroughly, and swallowed. Without warning a numbness shoots through my right pinkie, then up into my biceps. Strangely, a mellow head rush sets in. My pupils dilate as a tear trickles down my cheek.

"It looks like you blew a blood vessel in your eye!" says Currie.

We're at ZestFest Midwest, a fiery-foods show in Columbus, Ohio, where Currie is selling sauces and snacks made by his PuckerButt Pepper Company. Outside the 5,000-capacity Ohio Expo Center, the parking lot is dotted with vanity plates: 2SPICEE, HABANERO, and SAUCY RV. Inside, an eclectic crowd of frat brothers, beer-bellied dads, and silver-haired grannies walk the floor among die-hard "chiliheads" sporting pepper-patterned Hawaiian shirts and chili-themed tattoos.

Each year tens of thousands of chiliheads buy tickets to expos like this all across the U.S. to experience a plethora of sauces, glazes, jams, candies, and beef jerky with punishing heat levels and names like Instant Regret, Sudan Death, Edible Lava, Colon Blow, and Satan's Flaming Hemorrhoids. During ZestFest there will be a jalapeño-eating contest, a spicy-wing-eating contest, and an impromptu battle between Steve "the Machine" Smallwood and Chuck "the Biz" Cook, two thirtysomething pro pepper eaters who each finish 10 superhots in under two minutes.

Like connoisseurs of craft beer, fine wine, and "medicinal" marijuana, pepper people talk shop with a geeky enthusiasm and specificity: There are flavor profiles, experimental strains, and body highs like the one I'm getting from that furious little Reaper.

"I've had about 25 today. I'm high as a kite, brother!" laughs Currie. "More dopamine receptors get filled than using morphine or heroin. It's mean stuff."

Today at ZestFest, 19 showgoers will attempt to eat an entire Carolina Reaper; 17 will vomit. After 20 minutes, I too exorcise my demon. I'm told the next probable side effects include ring sting, "fire-rhea," and capsaicin cramps, named for the chemical compound that produces a pepper's heat. (Capsaicin is used to manufacture everything from pepper spray and arthritis cream to anti-barnacle nautical paint.) The higher a pepper's capsaicin concentration, the higher its

heat rating on the Scoville scale. Jalapeños peak at 10,000 Scoville heat units (SHU); the hottest habaneros hit 350,000; anything classified as superhot, like the Carolina Reaper, must register above one million.

To date only six superhots have been discovered. The first was the Ghost Pepper (a.k.a. the Bhut Jolokia), which didn't become widely known until 2007, when its 1.001 million SHU rating landed it in *Guinness World Records*. From 2007 to 2012, Guinness fielded 25 different claims of "world's hottest."

Since 2012 several new contenders have cropped up, including hybrids like the Jigsaw, Infinity X, and the Carolina Reaper. The most hyped of these is the Trinidad Moruga Scorpion, which became the first pepper to break the two million SHU mark last year, shattering the record of 1.4637 million set by the Butch T. Scorpion pepper in 2011. Nevertheless, Guinness has not changed its record book.

The race to grow the next "world's hottest pepper" has ignited a heated debate among chiliheads, one that raises deep questions about science, ethics,

and honor. Economics aren't the only incentive, but that's a big part of it. Hot sauce is one of the 10 fastest-growing industries in the U.S.—worth an estimated \$1 billion. Claiming the record can make or break a new product. After the Naga Viper took the title in 2010, its grower says he made \$40,000 in one month selling sauces and seeds.

"It's critical for Ed to get that record," says John "CaJohn" Hard, the CEO of CaJohns Fiery Foods. "But there are educated chiliheads who doubt his pepper is different from anything else out there."

Which is to say, I didn't travel to Columbus just to burn my face off. I came here to meet the men vying for the throne.

SO TELL ME about this stash," says Guns n' Roses guitarist Ron "Bumblefoot" Thal. It's 11 P.M. on Saturday, and Thal has just walked into Currie's hotel room with Brimstone, the professional wrestler. They're in town to promote their branded sauces at ZestFest.

Currie is holding a gallon-size Ziploc filled with red, yellow, orange, and dark purple superhots you can't buy anywhere. Most of them don't even have names, just cryptic labels like HP26.

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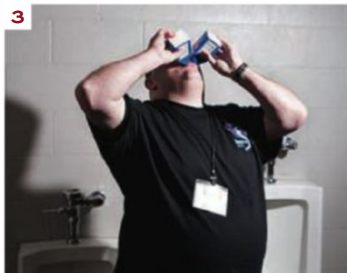

Currie says many of his “unstable strains” are testing way hotter than the current Guinness record. Nevertheless, he won’t release numbers until the crossbreeds reach stability, meaning that their seeds will reliably grow matching offspring. (Stability takes seven generations, a minimum of three and a half years.)

Currie does have one tentative name for his HP48 strain: Death. In his YouTube review, Ted “the Fire-Breathing Idiot,” a bald 39-year-old with an uncanny tolerance for pepper pain, simply said, “Never again.”

As Thal takes teeny bites of the franken-peppers, Currie turns to me and grins. “When in your life did you think you were gonna be sitting with a wrestling star, a rock star, and a mad scientist?” A similar question could be asked of him.

Growing up in Michigan, Currie was a

bit of a prodigy. In elementary school, he took high school classes, and by 14 he’d taught himself how to cook LSD in the school chemistry lab. “That was the ’70s, brother,” laughs Currie. “There were the freaks and the jocks. I was a freak, man!”

By the 1990s he’d settled down with a wife, a job in finance, and a condo in Rochester Hills, Michigan, where he kept a modest backyard pepper garden. On paper life was good, but in reality Currie was in trouble: He weighed 360 pounds, drank heavily, and frequently cut work. His marriage imploded.

Then one night during a blizzard, Currie was alone at home, naked, when the door blew open and an angel appeared. “You need to go to Brighton Hospital,” the angel said. “Where’s Brighton Hospital?” Currie murmured in shock as the angel turned around and left.

When Currie looked it up, he discovered Brighton is a rehab facility. He checked in, cleaned up, and focused on his health. As he dropped down to 160 pounds, he pondered his family history of heart disease and cancer. He’d read that indigenous cultures along the equator have far lower rates of both conditions, and Currie had a hunch this might be the result of their pepper-heavy diet. Through the years he’d collected notes but never pursued his theory seriously until 2002, when he crossed a Pakistani Naga with a red habanero.

“God gave me a gift,” says Currie, who developed a special capsaicin-boosting nutrient regimen for his plants. “I can take a jalapeño and make it one million Scoville. But I can’t make it repeat.”

That wasn’t the case for a new hybrid, the HP22B. After three years, Currie says, the seeds were growing hotter peppers without chemical assistance. He’d permanently altered their DNA.

In 2005 Currie began selecting seeds to stabilize the strain. But he wasn’t posting in online forums, where hobbyists typically show off new hybrids, so when news of the HP22B first appeared in late 2011, the chillihead community went nuts. Just a few months earlier, the Butch T. had taken the Guinness record. Now here was an unknown grower with some mysterious new strain—and a claim of 1.5 million Scoville?!

Currie had no idea what was coming.

“Jim Duffy called me a liar on every Facebook forum out there and told me I’m not taking his crown,” says Currie. “I’m doing it for the science. The only reason we’re going after the record is because he pissed me off!”

JIM DUFFY STEPS onto the field at San Diego’s Petco Park and points to left field. The Padres are taking batting practice before tonight’s game against the Phillies. Duffy’s here to do some coaching. “I’m a little worried about them,” confesses Luke Yoder, director of field operations, leading us through a door in the outfield. In the bullpen is an 18’x6’ garden with 18 pepper varieties.

Yoder started growing exotic peppers at Petco Park in August 2012. Soon thereafter a few relief pitchers ended a dismal losing streak after eating some of

the Black Cobras (50,000 SHU). Last May, when the team renovated its bullpen, the pitchers campaigned for more peppers. That's where Duffy came in.

Duffy, whose day job is as a welder, runs an online side business selling exotic pepper plants and seeds. He fantasizes that one Padre will try his hottest pepper, the Moruga Scorpion, and kick off a league-wide craze: "It'll frickin' light his ass up! And then they'll go on the road and they'll be telling that story," quips the fast-talking 53-year-old in his New York accent.

In 2008 Duffy supplied some of the seeds used by the Chile Pepper Institute (CPI) at New Mexico State University to conduct a study on superhots. The results rocked the chilihead world: One Moruga Scorpion hit 2.009231 million SHU.

In February 2012 the CPI issued a press release declaring it the "hottest pepper on the planet." The news got picked up by the Associated Press, *USA Today*, and CBS.

Duffy made \$10,000 in two days selling Moruga seeds to frenzied chiliheads. The CPI submitted its results to Guinness, which asked for more data verified by an impartial third party. It didn't matter. Record or not, Duffy's business kept booming. "Only thing that makes more money than selling seeds is illicit narcotics and fireworks," says Duffy, who's also peddled time shares, vitamins, and exotic reptiles.

By the end of 2012, Duffy had grossed \$220,000—four times his annual welder's salary. But just as he was posting record profits, hype for Currie's Carolina Reaper began building. Duffy went on the defensive.

"Is it truly a new variety?" Duffy asked in a 1,094-word takedown of the Reaper, citing Currie's techniques to chemically "juice" his peppers. "The answer is no."

Currie hopped online to introduce himself and emphasize his goal of furthering cancer research. He and Duffy agreed to bury the hatchet. Still, Currie didn't take too kindly to being called a liar. Since he'd already committed thousands of dollars to nabbing the record, he vowed to go on.


Duffy stands by his point: The playing field isn't level. To some the Carolina Reaper is nothing more than a Barry Bonds. "Steroids in baseball is a perfect example. Is it fair?" says Hard, who manufactures CaJohns sauces with Carolina Reapers and Moruga Scorpions. "No, it's not. It's just not natural."

MEASURING CAPSAICIN is a simple, exact science. The pepper is dehydrated, ground down, mixed into a solvent, and then run through a four-foot-tall machine that measures the number of capsaicinoids per million. Plugging that total into a formula determines a Scoville rating.


What's less simple is agreeing on what constitutes the hottest pepper.

Peppers are the result of nature and nurture. The amounts of sunshine, humidity, moisture, and, yes, nutrients all contribute. But pick two jalapeños off the exact same plant at the exact same time and there's little chance they've got the same amount of capsaicin.

Duffy's Moruga Scorpion that registered above two million SHU? It was an outlier—

one superhot pepper out of 100 Moruga Scorpions that averaged 1.207764 million.


"Anybody can get a peak," says Currie. "That's whose swinging dick is bigger. Good science doesn't report anomalies."

Currie says he has Reaper data showing an average of 1.52 million but that Guinness keeps moving the goalposts.

"As we receive more and more applications and more records are verified, our guidelines must be adjusted to accommodate new information and technology," says Sara Wilcox, a PR and marketing executive with Guinness.

Nothing better encapsulates the complicated friendship between Currie and Duffy than an old adage: "The enemy of my enemy is my friend." Feeling dicked over by Guinness has helped them bond. At ZestFest I watch these two onetime

rivals hug and cheerily dine together in the restaurant of our hotel. They're even doing business: Duffy signed a deal to become one of Currie's four licensed growers of the Carolina Reaper.



IT'S THE FINAL hours of ZestFest, and I'm holding a Moruga Scorpion the size of a golf ball. Yesterday, after barfing up the Reaper, I promised Duffy I'd try one of his peppers.

At the time it seemed only fair.

But late last night Currie told me a dark secret: Some growers use hypodermic needles to inject liquid capsaicin into peppers before giving them to reviewers, using a flavorless extract called Pure Evil that tests at 1.56 million SHU.

"Jim will tell you he doesn't want the record," I remembered Currie telling me. "He wants the record so bad, it's unbelievable."

Does that mean he'd also burn my face off with a doctored pepper? When I confront him, Duffy denies ever having laced peppers. As I sit down across from him and Currie, they each pull out cameras and begin filming. I bite into the Moruga and begin chewing. It's sweet. Perhaps sweeter than the Reaper. I can't decide, mainly because of the gnarly burning in my throat. It's ruthless. Worse than the Reaper? Kind of. Mostly, it's just...different. Every time I breathe, it hurts.

Ten minutes in and there's no numbing in my hand. Zero tingling. And I don't feel any urge to vomit. I do get a head rush, but it's not as intense as what I felt with the Reaper.

Aha! The Reaper wins!

Not necessarily. Duffy and Currie remind me that one species of pepper grown in San Diego versus South Carolina isn't a fair comparison. Ultimately, the CPI will settle the debate. Last summer it planted Reaper seeds alongside the same five superhots from its 2012 study, including the Moruga Scorpion. In January 2014, the CPI will have results.

For now the question lingers. Will the Reaper seize the Guinness record? Or at least trump the Moruga? "Some people live in a fantasy world," Duffy says of Currie. "Is that the case? I guess we'll find out."

For now my gut tells me that the Reaper had more capsaicin. But that's totally subjective. I'm not a machine. I'm just another dude with indigestion, and an escalating case of ring-sting. 🍌

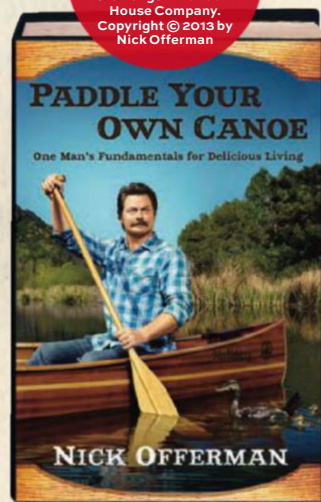


Chicharrón, Cracklins, Pork Rinds

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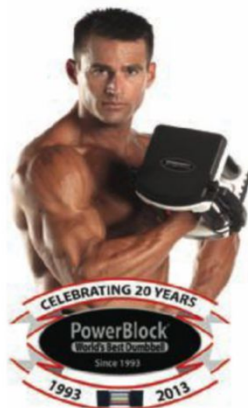
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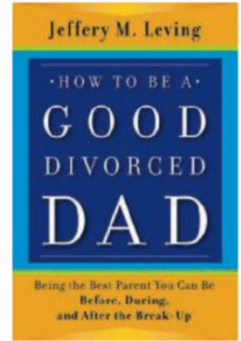
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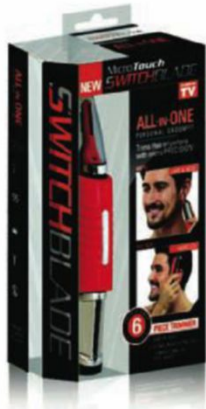

"I've been deployed to several war zones, and sometimes I miss being in those shit holes," says Raj Chowdhuri, a veteran of the U.S. Marine Corps Forces and Special Operations Command and current instructor at TIG, an elite tactical training facility hidden down a dusty road in Crawfordsville, Arkansas. "You'll come through a mountain pass and the landscape can just be fucking gorgeous. But mostly I miss being in those places because you're with your pals and making a difference—"

Raj is cut off by the sound of a loud explosion, followed by the sight of an off-road vehicle doing an end-over-end cartwheel 10 feet away from us. Without missing a beat, Raj darts into action to make sure the people inside aren't as mangled as the vehicle's outside.

The driver, a Marine, pops up from the wreckage with a bloodied face and calmly asks, "Can I get another vehicle? Or just fucking run the rest?"

Welcome to Maximum Warrior.

This is the fourth installment of *Maxim's* competition that pits members of America's Special Ops branches against one another in 10 challenges of strength, tactics, and insanity. The winner will walk away with \$10,000 in cash and a truckload of high-performance gear. We're at the Rally Biathlon Challenge, where Warriors have been tasked with completing two loops of an off-road track while engaging targets with their rifles, getting harassed by a chase vehicle, weaving through a simulated minefield, and dealing with not-so-simulated explosions.

"It's typical of training," says Rob French, a Marine Force Recon vet and TIG instructor, of the crash. "The only way to get better is to know your limit. How do you know your limit if you never actually find it? That's what that guy did."

Pushing the limits and dealing with the unexpected is what these Warriors live for. Representing Army Special Forces, Navy SEALs, Marine Force Recon and MARSOC, and USAF Pararescue, this year's contestants have all been in situations that go from bad to really fucking bad in a heartbeat.

Explains Jamie (MARSOC), "In the Marines we always talk about Murphy's Law. You can have the best plan, but you always have to be ready, because Murphy is going to show up at some point and just fuck things up, and you'll have to think of something else on the fly."

Derek (Marine Force Recon) echoes that. "Special Ops guys just have a tough mind-set, and we're not willing to give up. You don't have to be the strongest or the fastest; you just have to be able to think on your toes and not quit."

"Every op I've been on—I don't know how many countless American lives we've saved by taking a bad guy off the street," says Eagle (Navy SEAL). "We're capable of doing it, and I love doing it."

It's the equivalent of having a football team: Do the players want to sit on the sideline, or do they want to play in the Super Bowl? And every day out there is the Super Bowl."

You may think that rooming 10 combat specialists competing against one another in the same barracks would lend itself to some, let's say, *impolite* interactions, but, in fact, it's the opposite. Donnie (Army Special Forces), whose hand-to-hand and edged-weapons expertise earned him the nickname Bruce Leroy, explains what many of these guys echo over the course of the week. "Yes, we're competing, but we're all brothers. In the military, out on missions, it's all about the guys to your left and right. It's camaraderie and a brotherhood few can really understand."

Rob (USAF Pararescue) tells me, "In my line of work, I get great satisfaction when we're able to take guys off the battlefield, and all my brothers here are fantastic. I would hate to have to pick them up, but if need be, I would do everything in my power to get them home."

Among this year's competitors is Dakota Meyer, a returning vet from Maximum Warrior 1 and a Medal of Honor recipient. Ret. Special Forces Sgt. Maj. Karl Erickson, the inaugural winner of Maximum Warrior and the twisted bastard who now designs the challenges, says, "The guys have all been friendly and helping each other out with the gear, but make no mistake: They're all fierce competitors—they all want to win."

And true enough, when word comes to the barracks for the Warriors to head to the Afghan village for a hostage extraction, the warm, fuzzy feeling in the room vanishes. Rifles are grabbed, body armor is affixed, game faces are put on: In a flash these Warriors are ready for anything. 🇺🇸

GUNS FOR HIRE

Unemployment is a real issue for vets, but Medal of Honor recipient **DAKOTA MEYER** is working to change that.

→ Say you are a Marine sharpshooter just back in the States after serving in Afghanistan and you're looking for a job. Chances are slim that the HR lady where you're applying to work will ask, "So...do you have any experience taking out Taliban from long distances?" Medal of Honor recipient Dakota Meyer, a former Marine sniper himself, knows all too well the difficulties vets from all branches of the Armed Services face trying to break back into the civilian workforce: "A lot of people, when they get out of the military, have a hard time translating to an employer what they did." That's why he, along with the U.S. Chamber of Commerce's Hiring Our Heroes program and Toyota, recently launched the Personal Branding Resume Engine, which converts military experience to

working-world skill sets. "Take being a sniper," Dakota tells us. "There are a lot of skills involved that an employer probably doesn't know about, such as communication, teamwork, leadership, personnel management, risk management, promptness, and discipline. These are all things an employer can use." So how does this Personal Branding Resume Engine work, exactly?

It's as easy as hitting up resumeengine.org, clicking on your branch of service, and listing everything you did while serving your country. The site does all the rest. It was launched only a few months ago, but Dakota is already hearing an incredibly positive response. "People are talking about it like it's the best thing they've seen," he says proudly. "And that's exactly what we were shooting for." Spoken like a true sniper! 🎯

ROPE AND CHANGE

A covert Special Operations soldier keeps strong and healthy.

PHYSICAL EXERCISE: RUNS AND ROPES

"I'll run half a mile and then climb up and down a 20- to 25-foot rope, continuing to alternate between the two for three to four miles' worth. Once you've mastered this, add a 20-pound vest to your runs and climbs."



"Rope climbing is not just for your arms. It's a full-body workout, and you really need to use your legs as you go up to lock in the rope; otherwise your upper body will tire too fast. To start off, grab the rope high and let it fall on the outside of your left leg. Kick your right foot underneath and let the rope drape over it. This creates a kind of rope ledge you can stand on with your left foot. It's easier than it sounds. Even just wrapping the rope around your leg will create friction, reducing the effort you have to put in with your arms."

BEGINNER'S ADJUSTMENT

"If you can't climb the rope at first, just lie down on the ground on your back and lift your arms up to hold on to it. Use your arms to climb

the rope, pulling yourself up until you're in a full standing position. This is a great way to develop that strength, and it's safe because you never leave the ground. You can also find a gym with a rock-climbing wall, preferably a rotating one you can control the angle on, which is easier on your muscles but still a fun challenge."

MENTAL MANEUVER: MATH

"I'm not talking two plus two here; I'm talking sniper math. When I'm running or bored, I'll calculate how big a target would appear at different distances or how much wind would affect my bullet at that distance. I try to keep the formulas fresh in my mind. That's the real trick, whatever you're doing, no matter how many times: Think it through over and over to keep sharp."

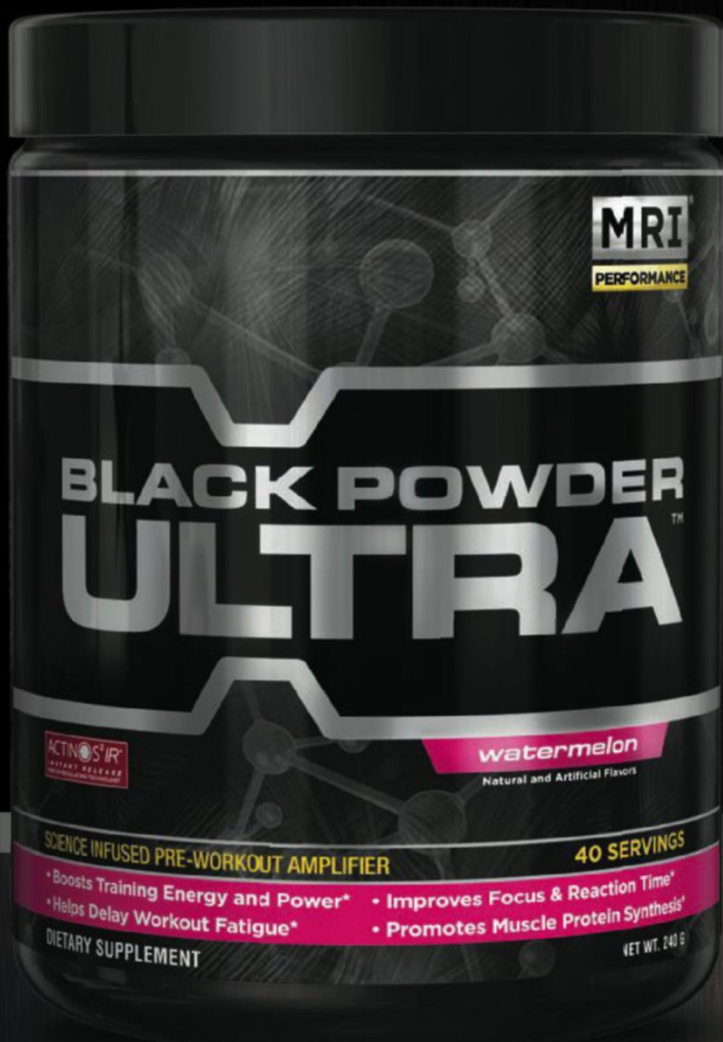


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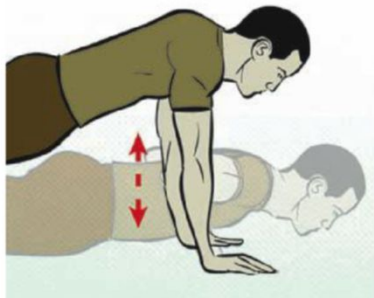

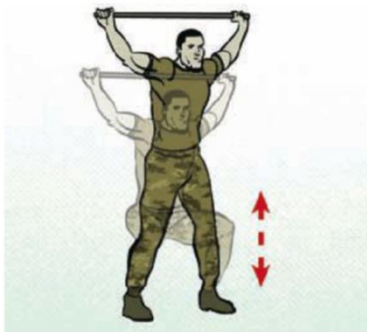
PHYSICAL EXERCISE: PULL-UPS AS PART OF A 60-MINUTE ROUTINE

"I work out for my job. It's essential to have a full body of functionality, and for a Navy SEAL pull-ups are a particularly crucial aspect to achieving that."

- 1 Ten pull-ups and 25 push-ups for 10 sets



- 2 Twenty squats with a PVC bar, 10 lunges (bar optional); 10 sets each



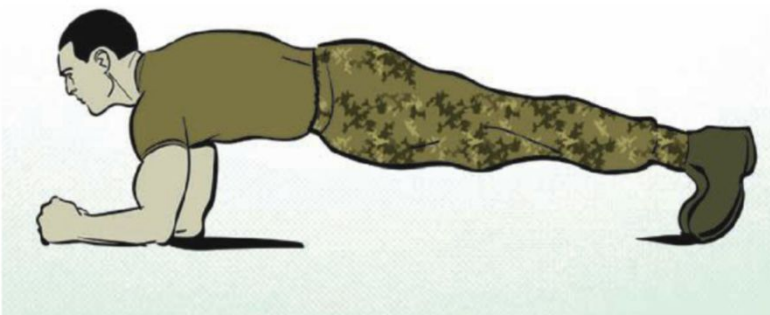
- 3 Five sets of 30 dips on a dip bar



- 4 A 5,000-meter row or a three-mile timed run



- 5 Ten minutes of core exercises, such as planks or just extending your legs six inches off the ground



MENTAL MANEUVER: MAKE IT A LIFESTYLE

"For me the psychological aspect goes directly back to the physical exercise. We push ourselves to the max. We do that one extra rep and then we do another one and then we do another one on top of that to build mental strength. Pushing yourself physically also works as a motivator so that when you're beat down you know you can persevere. Before you go into combat and you're stressing out, you can also clear your mind with a solid workout—and knowing that you're prepared to deal with things physically helps you out mentally. By maintaining a high level of fitness, I am confident that if something were to suddenly go wrong, I already have the experience to deal with it. I'm prepared for it because I've adopted this as a lifestyle. I train for years, months, and weeks, all the way down to the last minute. Every day I'm physically strong, and every day I am mentally strong."

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MARINES

PROUD AND EXTREME

GYSGT L. POPE says stop whining and do your burpees.

PHYSICAL EXERCISE: EXTREME BURPEES

“As part of Marine training, burpees are incorporated with high-intensity swimming. It’s a full-body workout that is good for mobility and can also be turned into a solid cardio routine.”



WHAT YOU’LL NEED

“Have a watch or clock nearby. The first minute you do one burpee, the second you do two, the next one you do three. You continue this at the top of every minute and go on until you can’t sustain the prescribed amount of burpees within those 60 seconds. A lot of our guys will start failing around the 15th minute, but one guy got to 28. That was over 400 burpees.”

BURPEES AND SWIMMING

“We’ll start in the deep end of the pool, swim 100 meters, hop out, and do 10 burpees, then get right back in the pool for another lap. To make this more intense, you can implement a jump onto a 24-inch box before the burpee. Instead

of swimming laps, you can do sprints between the burpees. There are just so many variations that can make your life miserable.”

MENTAL MANEUVER: AN EXTREME SOLO CHALLENGE

“Before I deploy I will come up with something insane that is going to take a complete day, like a combination of a 2,000-meter swim, a 40-mile hike, a 12-mile run, and a 25-mile bike ride. I’m trying to do something that’s outside the norm of what I do and what anybody else would do. Pushing myself through whatever hurts and finishing gives me the mental confidence to know what I am capable of in the field.”



AIR FORCE

GET RUCKED UP

Combat controller “GANTT” makes you fit for flight.

PHYSICAL EXERCISE: RUCKING

“For combat controllers, rucking [carrying heavy loads over rough terrain] is a crucial part of our training. On top of our battle gear, we also have to carry large radios to communicate with fighters and air support.”

WHAT YOU’LL NEED

“We carry between 65 and 85 pounds, but I recommend that your backpack weigh 25 to 30 pounds to start. Make sure to have a substantial amount of food and water with you.”

WHERE TO GO

“We try to ruck on varied terrain where we’ll hit a lot of hills and have to navigate through water, because that’s what we see in Iraq and Afghanistan. Those terrains aren’t always accessible, so you can head to a park or run up steep roads or climb hills just to build your physical stamina.”

AND HOW FAR

“We do a ruck two to four times a month as a team, and then guys ruck on their

own outside that. It’s too strenuous to do every day, and particularly hard on the knees. Start off with about three to five miles, especially on your own. Rucking is also a great team-building exercise, so feel free to invite a buddy along.”

MENTAL MANEUVER: GET ORGANIZED

“Each guy usually has his own shelf—all your gear is sitting there ready to go at a moment’s notice. When I get back from a mission, I put all my stuff back exactly as it was before. Then I start off by cleaning my weapon and go through the rest of the items in the same order. It goes all the way down to putting a Clif Bar in a specific pocket; it basically creates muscle memory.”



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MAXIMUM WARRIOR 3 WINNER

How did **JEFF “BIGGS” WOBIG** triumph at our last Warrior challenge? A decade serving in the Navy SEALs may have had something to do with it.

Congratulations on your MW3 victory. What did you make of the competition?

I'd seen the first two, and a friend of mine did it two years ago and assured me it was legit. It's a tough competition, and a tough group of guys to go up against. My respect for all of them is extremely high.

Are you a pretty competitive guy?

Extremely competitive. At BUD/S [Basic Underwater Demolition/SEAL] training, I realized I am more competitive than your average bear. I'm not a sore loser, but I definitely don't *like* losing. I strive to be the best I can be at all times. It keeps me on my toes, and that helps keep my friends and myself alive.

How did you decide to join the SEALs?

Well, I was what they call a “spirited” kid. Authority and I never mixed too well, so I guess I joined the military to get some discipline. Some people were born to be protectors, and I wanted to protect my family. Ultimately, I decided that the best route was to protect the country that we live in.

What did your family think?

My parents didn't want me to enlist. I think it's a little scary for any mother or father to send their child into the mili-

tary, especially during a time of war. But I was dedicated, and they were behind me 100 percent. When I was going through hell week during BUD/S training, I got injured, and when you get injured they roll you, and you have to go back and do it all over again. I called my mom, and she said, “What are you doing calling me? You're supposed to be in hell week!” I played a prank on her and said, “No, I quit.” She said, “Bullshit. You didn't quit. What the hell happened? My son would never quit!” She believed in me 100 percent and knew I would make it no matter what they threw at me, and I graduated.

How did BUD/S help prepare you for Maximum Warrior?

I think it's probably the hardest military training in the world, although some of the other guys in the competition from other branches of the military might not want to admit it. The one area where I felt like I had a leg up was shooting. I'm a sniper, and I was the only one to clear all my plates on the sniper rack. Long-distance shooting is my specialty, and I take a lot of pride in being a good sniper. I grew up shooting my whole life. I got my first .22 when I was 10. We had a big problem with prairie dogs on our farm. The horses would step in the prairie dog holes and break their legs, so it was my job to

take care of the rodents. I owe a lot of the success I had shooting in the military to the way I grew up.

How do you think the 18-year-old you would have done on the course?

I could have handled the physical stuff, but the experience you get as an operator in the field, that's something you can't be taught. I have a little saying: You can't go to 7-Eleven and buy a six-pack of experience. But in 10 years of serving in Special Ops, there's a plethora of missions that helped me—just thinking of the best way or the quickest way to do something. It's not cheating; it's just thinking outside the box and thinking strategically. As an 18-year-old, I wouldn't have had that.

How do you apply that experience when you're operating in the field?

There's a different way of thinking in unconventional warfare. You don't necessarily want to hit someone head-on. This isn't the Civil War, and we're not marching face-to-face shooting at each other. I respect that kind of fighting, but I'd rather hit you from a mile away. I want to fight an *unfair* fight. I damn sure don't want to go in and fight an equal opponent. I want it to be completely mismatched in my favor. Luckily, it's hard to find opponents who can compare to U.S. troops. ■

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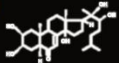
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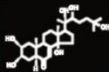
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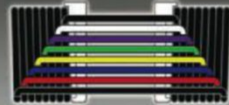
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
