





So, what would you do if you suddenly obtained abilities beyond comprehension? Would you don a special suit, fly off, and battle evildoers? If you were a teenager, the likely response would be: hell, no. You'd have a blast with them, pull elaborate pranks, and maybe exact revenge on those who've wronged you. Maybe those powers would amplify your less noble qualities. Or worse.

The title itself speaks to our obsession with self-documentation, through social networking or even by just carrying around a camera and recording our lives, simply because we have the means to do so. "We live in a world where you can film anything you want to, at any time," says Trank. "There is an emerging aesthetic from this generation. Kids in high school today are the most self-photographed people in history. Almost everyone has a camera in some form, and are uploading images every few seconds to social networking sites..."

Most of the film is told through the point of view of a troubled but creative young manwith a keen visual eye and a high-quality HD camera. "So, CHROICLE is not really a conventional 'found footage' feature," says Trank, referring to the often grainy-looking "shaky-cam" movies. "Instead, we wanted a very controlled, thoughtful looking movie, seen through the eyes of a talented young man. There's an

intelligence behind the way Andrew operates his camera and captures increasingly incredible events."

Andrew's newfound telekinetic abilities add an unexpected dimension to his camera operating skills, which give CHRONICLE a one-of-a-kind look and texture. "Andrew begins operating his camera

telekinetically, which opens up his entire world," Trank explains. "His camera is, in a way, attached to his brain, and he's able to make it float, fly and capture action in a unique way. Halfway through the film, you realize you're something you've never watching seen before. and then in the last 15 minutes, it just becomes insane. It's constantly evolving, from the intimate and grounded to the epic and unexpected."

Andrew evolves from teenage insecurity to full-blown narcissism in a way that could happen to anyone facing his extraordinary circumstanes. Says Dane DeHaan, who portrays Andrew: "When you're given the ultimate power, and if you're experiencing something that nobody has ever experienced, there's a certain God complex that comes of that."

FIRST TAKE

First, any film starring Oscar® winner Denzel Washington is worth the price of admission. So, immediately with his name attached to SAFE HOUSE we recommend dropping the coin to see this film. His co-star is Ryan Reynolds who, even though starred in films such as GREEN HORNET and VAN WILDER, we cannot seem to picture as a character other than the sappy guy in chick flicks such as JUST FRIENDS. To us, he is a reincarnation of Ben Affleck, they even look eerily similar.

THE PITCH

As far as the SAFE HOUSE is concerned, Denzel plays the CIA's most dangerous traitor, who stuns the intelligence community when he surfaces in South Africa. When the safe house to which he's remanded is attacked by brutal mercenaries, a rookie (Reynolds) is forced to help him escape. As the masterful manipulator toys with his reluctant protégé, the young operative finds his morality tested and idealism shaken. Now, they must stay alive long enough to uncover who wants them dead.

THE PLOT

Legendary spy Tobin Frost (Washington) has eluded capture for almost a decade. One of the best ops men that the CIA's ever trained, the brilliant ex-intelligence officer has betrayed assets and sold military codes to enemies of the state since he turned. From aiding splinter cells to trading incendiary secrets to the highest bidder, the damage he's done to the U.S. is immeasurable. Now, Frost is back on the grid with the most explosive intel he's ever gotten his hands on.

For the past year, Matt Weston (Reynolds) has been frustrated by his inactive, backwater post in Cape Town. A "housekeeper" who aspires to be a full-fledged case officer, the loyal company man has been waiting for an opportunity to prove himself. When the first and only occupant he's had proves to be the most dangerous operative he will ever cross. Weston readies for duty.

As soon as Frost is brought in for debriefing, mercenaries in brutal pursuit of Frost come and level Weston's safe house. Barely escaping, the veteran spy and untested captor must discover whether their attackers were sent by terrorists or by someone on the inside. With only hours left to get Frost to the next safe house, Weston must figure out who he can trust before he and the world's most skillful assassin are both eliminated.

FINAL RECOMMENDATION

We told you in the first line. Any film with Denzel Washington is worth the price of admission. Drop the coin to go see this film. It is one of those rare action films that you probably could get your girl to go along to without too much of a fight as it co-stars Ryan Reynolds.

IN THE SECOND PART OF OUR SPECIAL REPORT ON CONCUSSIONS IN PROFESSIONAL SPORTS WE TAKE A LOOK AT THE RISE OF CONCUSSIONS IN THE NHL AND OFFER SOLUTIONS TO RE-DUCE THEM AND INCREASE THE POPULARITY OF THE SPORT IN THE USA.

fter the NHL lock-out of 2004-2005 (which wiped out the entire season), a set of rule changes were implemented to make the games more appealing to television. Hockey has been, and will always be, the greatest sport to watch live in person. However, the speed of the game and the intensity of the games has never transcended very well to television. Two rule changes that were implemented after the lockout led to a faster game and increased scoring. First, the league eliminated the center-ice line, also called the red line. on two line passes out of the offensive zone. This rule change led to faster charges for teams with the puck and higher velocity collisions between offensive and defensive players.

The second rule change was stricter interpretation of holding, clutching, and hooking penalties. Such techniques were commonly used in the pre-lockout NHL to slow the offensive pace of the game and a lot of the talking heads in the media felt this negatively impacted the game, often taking to the airwaves to vent their gripes. The avid hockey fan barely noticed and accepted it as part of the game, the same as a pitcher stepping off the mound or a batter stepping out of the batters' box in baseball.

None of the rule changes implemented by the NHL has led to significant television ratings improvement. Hockey still ranks behind the NFL, MLB, NCAABB, NCAAFB, NBA, and NASCAR in ratings. NBC's 2011 broadcast of Game 7 of the Stanley Cup drew a 5.7 rating and 8.5 million viewers as compared to Game 7 of the 2011 World Series which drew a 14.7 rating and 25.4 million viewers. The NBA's Game 6 of the 2011 Finals drew a 13.3 rating and was watched by 23.88 million viewers. There is no need to cite the Super Bowl ratings as we all know it is year in, year out the most watched sporting event in the US. However, the fact

that hockey falls behind NASCAR and its' 8.7 rating and 15.6 million viewers for the 2011 Daytona 500 race tells you that the American public finds cars circling a track for hours on end more exciting than a two hour sporting event on ice.

Hockey was at its' peak in popularity when it had a superstar and super team on the ice, Wayne Gretzky and the Edmonton Oilers teams of the mid to late 80's who won 5 Stanley Cups. For hockey to regain its' seat as one of the four major sports in the USA it needs to protect its star players such as Crosby and engage policies that do not penalize successful franchises. While the hard salary cap they have implemented led to financial stabilization of the league it has prevented a super power team to emerge such as the Edmonton Oilers of the 80's. Without payroll flexibility teams that have done a good job of drafting young talent are eventually forced to choose who to keep and who to let go via free agency. A hard salary cap has worked well for the NFL but the popularity of the NFL has more to do with fantasy football than the product on the field.

If the NHL wants to regain its spot as one of the 4 major sports in the USA we recommend the following changes on and off the ice. First, implement a soft salary cap. such as the NBA, allowing teams flexibility to exceed the salary cap to re-sign their own players. The lone exception when teams sign free agents from other teams, teams lose their right to exceed the salary cap to re-sign their own players. The second change the NHL should make is to reinstall the red line. This will slow offensive charges and reduce the frequency of concussions. The final change should be to loosen the interpretation of hooking, holding and interference penalties. We believe that these three steps would be a good start to protecting players, increasing fan support and the maintaining excitement of the game without jeopardizing the health of the players.
