TAILGATING MENU ITEMS

Football season wouldn't be the same without the great food. Tailgating just wouldn't be tailgating without delicious distractions to pass the time before the game, regardless the size of your gathering. Here are some foolproof menu items to keep stomachs full and heads in the game.





CHILI

Not only a classic game day food, it's also easy to make and actually tastes better when it's had time to brew in its juices, shall we say. If you have mixed tastes in the crowd, you can keep it vegetarian or throw in browned turkey meat for the weight conscious. Crock-pot enthusiasts have it easy... combine the ingredients, let it cook, and transport the crock-pot on game day. If you make it in a pot, seal it up in Tupperware once it is done cooking. The basic ingredients in any chili are beans,

diced tomatoes, tomato paste, and onions. Add different kinds of seasonings, bell peppers, and cheese, as you please, to appeal to various taste buds. Tabasco and cayenne pepper are popular choices for the heat seekers, while beef bouillon cubes and bacon bits are perfect for the salt cravers.

JELLO SHOTS

You know those small to-go containers you get salad dressing in at restaurants? They also double as Jello shot containers on their

weekend shift. Creating Jello shots is as simple as mixing the Jello mix with some vodka and then pouring the mix into the containers to set in the refrigerator. Quadruple points for your fellow tailgaters for making them in team colors. Just another tailgate that can be prepared ahead of time and thrown into the cooler in a plastic bag alongside the beer.

GUACAMOLE

Any self respecting tailgate party includes guacamole.

Whip up a batch of home-made guacamole and bring some Dixie cups for guests to dip from with the store bought tortilla chips. Guacamole is automatically less likely to brown than solo avocado because of the lime mixed in, but to reduce browning further cover the surface of the guacamole with an extra lime spritz or with a thin layer of salsa. The acid keeps the green avocado flesh looking green and appetizing. Guacamole requires only a few ingredients – mash up a batch of ripe avocados, add chopped garlic, lime juice, chopped tomatoes, chopped onions, and chopped jalapenos. You can also get

creative by mixing in hummus or Greek yogurt, to switch up the flavor a bit.

HOT DOGS

Hot dogs are foolproof tailgating options and they are significantly easier to cook than burgers or chicken. To cover all your bases try veggie dogs, turkey dogs, or beef dogs for your non pork-eating friends. All you have to do is plopping them on the grill and providing the buns and condiments. Put a Food Network chef spin on the dogs and grill up onions and bell peppers as toppings, in addition to the classic sauerkraut option.

CHOCOLATE COVERED STRAWBERRIES

Oh, hey there fancy tailgater! Chocolate covered strawberries are easier to make than a cupcake and pleasing to eye, as well as your female guests' appetite. Melt chocolate chips, add in one tablespoon of oil, and start dipping away with the biggest strawberries you can find. Chill them for an hour on parchment paper for the perfect pastry chef look. Cover the dipped strawberries with chopped walnuts or even some whole chocolate chips and your guests will be asking where you hid Sandra Lee.

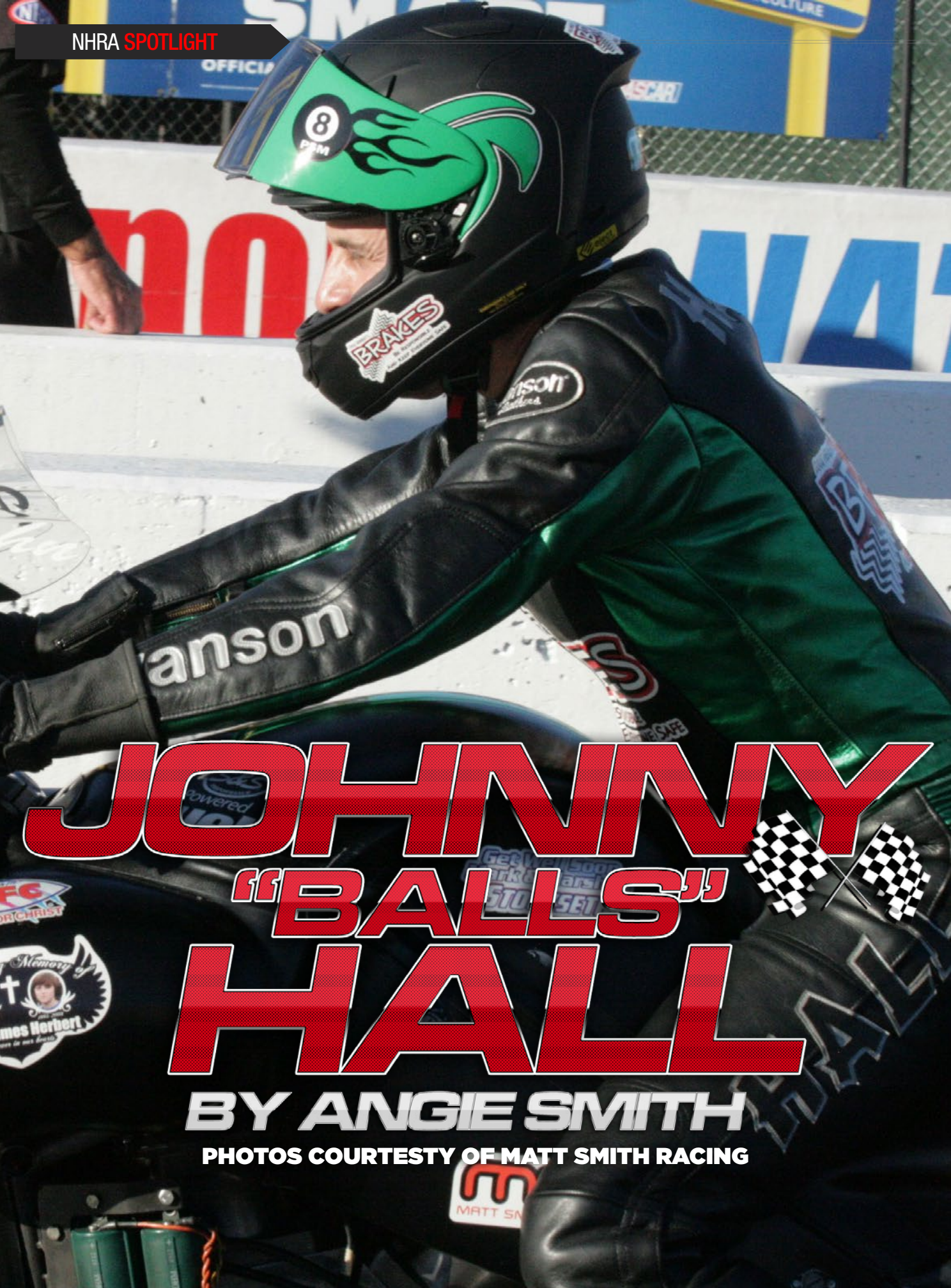

When you are not racing, what occupies your time?

I buy and sell houses. Flip houses. I also enjoy snowboarding with my family in the winter. Living in CT it snows a lot so our family started snowboarding and I really enjoy it.

Share with us the experience of winning the US Nationals!

I didn't qualify well. I struggled every round of qualifying and I honestly didn't think I was going to qualify. I knew we had a great bike but we just had to get it from the starting line to the finish line under full power and we would be good. Eddie Krawiec was the #2 qualifier and I ran Eddie in the last qualifying round. I ran faster than Eddie in qualifying so I knew I at least had a chance against him in the 1st round. I just took it all in stride and the win lights were flashing in my lane round by round. I really didn't think about it being the U.S. Nationals. I was just focused on racing. In the final round, I had to race my teammate Matt Smith who is

also my crew chief and team owner. I wasn't nervous going up to race Matt in the final. It was just another race to me. When I won, it really didn't set in until the next few days had passed. It was really special for several reasons. The first was, of course, it's the U.S. Nationals which is the biggest NHRA race of the season. It is comparable to the Daytona 500 in NASCAR. It was my father's 93rd birthday. I got to take my father a Wally home. His reaction was priceless. He said, “Wow! That's nice... how do you get one of these?” I said you have to win it. He said, “Geez, you got to win it... That's real wood.” He said that's nice and put it down



and moved on. He was in World War II so it's hard to impress him because he has lots of metals to show off. The only thing I regret is my wife and kids were unable to make it to the race that weekend because of their school schedules. I would have loved to share the win with them but we celebrated when I got home.

What's been the biggest challenge for you this season so far?

I think my biggest challenge of the season thus far is... I am more comfortable on the bike and I think my reaction times have suffered because of that. Last year my reaction times were better but I had other challenges as far as

riding the bike down the track. I would say last year my adrenaline was flowing and I was really focused on the things I needed to do on making a pass. This year I am more comfortable on the bike and more relaxed because Matt Smith has made me a better rider since last year. Maybe I am too relaxed on the bike. I have lost my reaction times and hopefully I find them. If anyone has seen them please let me know. Haha. I think I lost my reaction times in Indy last year so maybe when I go back this year I will find them there.

I think we should start calling you Johnny Cool. Do you ever get upset?

I absolutely do get upset. With

me it's ALL or NOTHING. Either I am really mad or I am not. When it comes to racing I try to stay as calm as possible. Freaking out never really helps anything so I try to stay cool, calm and collect for the most part. Freaking out kind of throws everything off. At the races, it's all about having a great time and turning on win lights.

Any suggestions on bringing greater fan awareness to our race class, NHRA Pro Stock Motorcycle?

I think NHRA PSM needs to target a younger crowd. For example, if you watch motorcross, they have young beautiful girls doing interviews. I think they need to maybe change the demographics of the media personnel. I am not saying it's going to bring a ton of fans but I do think it will bring a new generation to watch our sport. It's all about what's appealing in my opinion. I am not saying anything about the people that do our interviews now. All I am saying is we just need to spice it up a little with new beautiful faces maybe.

Social media obviously is larger... than it ever has been... Social media is perfect at getting the word out at a rapid
