FORZA: HORIZON 2

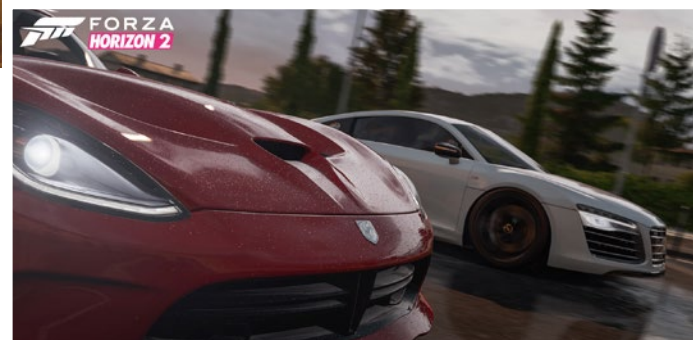

W

hen it comes to racing, few names are as respected as Forza. The core Forza franchise, which is exclusive to Microsoft's Xbox consoles, is considered one of the most accurately realized racing simulators in all of gaming. So when news broke that a new studio was developing an open-world Forza game separate from the main franchise reactions were mixed. On the one hand, more Forza would surely be a good thing for fans. On the other, Turn 10 is trusted for its commitment to realism and detail, while Playground Games was essentially an unknown.

Of course, the final outcome is now something we can readily check. Forza Horizon launched in late 2012 to high review scores, maintaining an 85 average on Metacritic and silencing most of the big concerns coming from the hardcore Forza crowd. The game wasn't necessarily a massive step forward for Forza as



a franchise, but it gave fans something to play in between primary Forza titles and acts as a sort of side-option for racing fans in general. The big question about Forza Horizon 2, then, isn't whether it's a good Forza game, but whether it lives up to the advances of its predecessor.

Forza Horizon 2 abandons the mountains of Colorado for the hills and vistas of

Southern Europe. Its map is roughly three times the size of the map from the first Horizon game and features recognizable real-life locations. Put simply, there is no shortage of road (and off-road) to explore in Forza Horizon 2. The game features both day and night events and includes the Forza franchise's first attempt at race-changing weather conditions. All of these things combine to make one Forza Horizon 2 just different enough to warrant consideration.

It's important to note that unlike other cross-generation releases, Forza Horizon 2 on Xbox One is not the same game as Forza Horizon 2 on Xbox 360. Two separate studios were tasked with developing individual versions of the game; the two versions run on different engines, include different features, and offer different experiences. The Xbox One version of the game has more in common with Forza 5 than the original Forza Horizon, while the Xbox 360 version runs on the same engine that powered the

first entry in the Horizon series. Driveatars and dynamic weather will not be available to Xbox 360 players. Notably, the token microtransaction system from the Forza 5 will not be included in Horizon 2; Playground Games decided to drop it based on player complaints.

In this particular case, the next-gen version of the game is the clear winner. Forza Horizon 2 looks incredible on the Xbox One, and the improvements from Forza 5's engine make it more fun to play. Additionally, weather events help shake up the driving experience and are well worth the price of entry on the next-gen system. If you have both consoles and you're on the fence about which version to buy, the Xbox One version is the way to go.

As for the game itself, your final decision should be informed by your enjoyment of the first Horizon game. If you liked the less serious iteration of the Forza franchise, Forza Horizon 2 is a great pick up. If not, you may want to wait for a price drop or Forza 6.

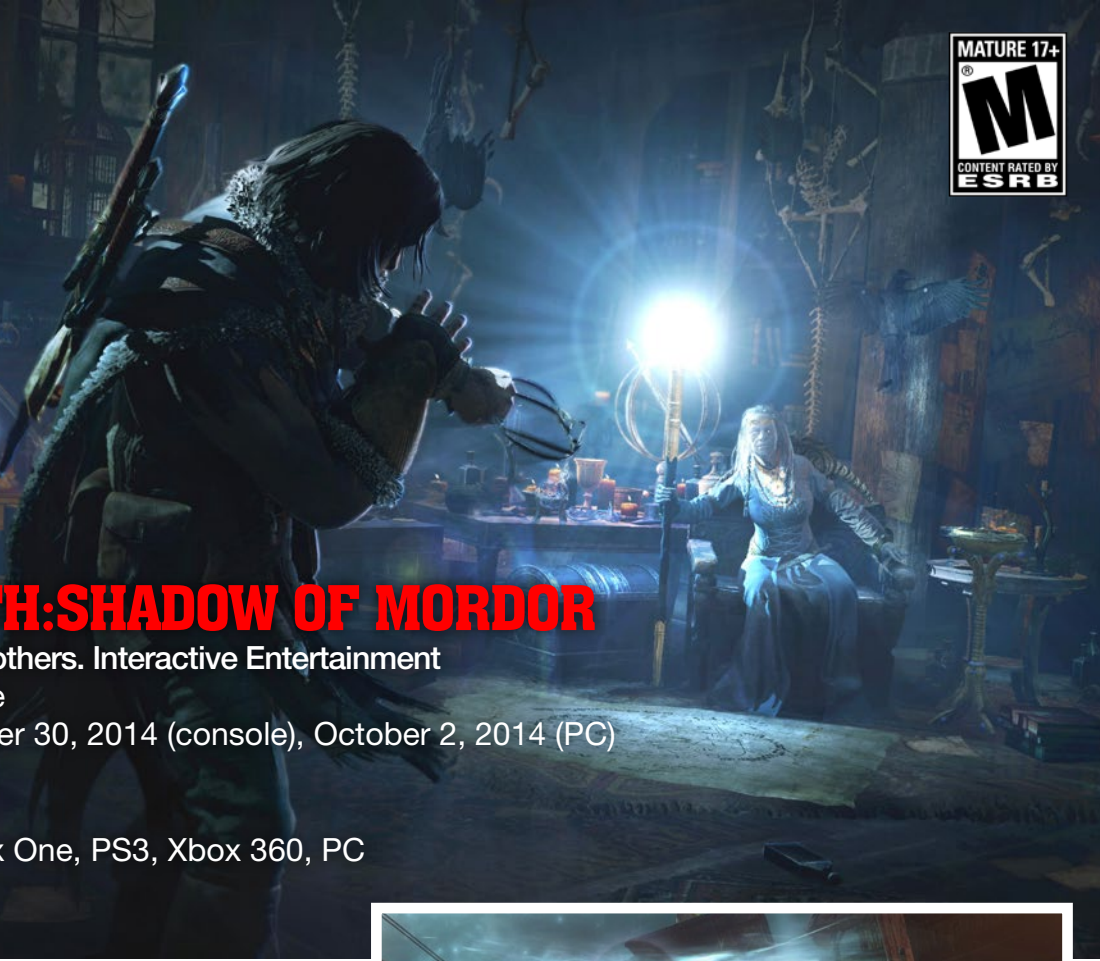

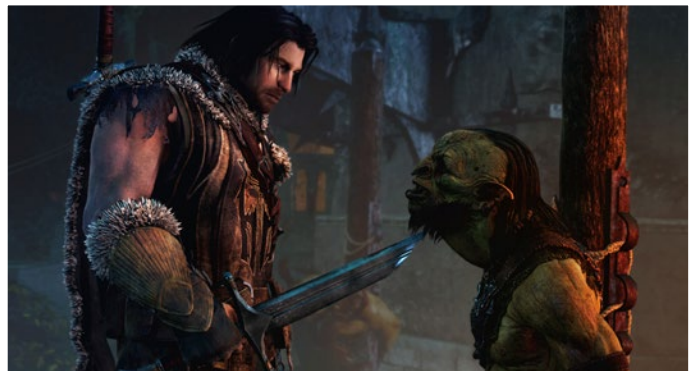

he Lord of the Rings franchise offers a rich narrative tapestry from which game designers can make almost any type of game. We've seen MMOs (Lord of the Rings Online), movie tie-ins (The Lord of the Rings: The Return of the King), kids games (LEGO Lord of the Rings), and LOTR versions of pretty much every other genre. In fact, since 1982 there have been roughly 35 games developed under the Lord of the Rings license -- and that's just the official ones.

Middle-Earth: Shadow of Mordor is something of an anomaly when it comes to Lord of the Rings games. It's not targeted at a broad audience (the M rating insures this), it doesn't center on any of LOTR's iconic characters, and the events in the game may or may not tie in with major events in the LOTR trilogy (no spoilers here!). The hero is a completely new character crafted by Monolith Productions and Behaviour Interactive, and the gameplay is like nothing you've ever seen in a LOTR game.



Middle-Earth: Shadow of Mordor drops the player in Middle-Earth just before the events of Fellowship of the Ring. Sauron hasn't yet become the world-ending threat he eventually becomes, and Mordor isn't a place one simply cannot walk into. In fact, the hero of Middle-Earth: Shadow of Mordor does

indeed adventure into Mordor as he seeks to exact revenge on the no-good dirty orcs of Sauron's ever-growing army. The setting is refreshing and engaging, even for those players who aren't deeply vested in LOTR lore. Talion, the main character, is interesting enough in his own right to not require story assistance or fan-service cameos (though a couple do occur).

Gameplay in Middle-Earth: Shadow of Mordor will feel familiar to anyone who's played an action-adventure game. The title borrows elements from games like Assassin's Creed, Dishonored, and Skyrim. Players have the option of advancing Talion's skills as a ranger or a wraith, with each path opening up unique options for interacting with the world's items and characters. What is most interesting, however, is the game's Nemesis system, which causes enemies to evolve and grow based on the way in which you play the game. According to the marketing hype, in Middle-Earth: Shadow of Mordor every



enemy you encounter is an individual character with behaviors informed by your own actions. In action, however, it's harder to detect. There are certainly some instances in which you'll see your actions manifest in enemy behavior, but there's no shortage of forgettable bad guys who are dispatched without a second thought.

The generation split between old and next-gen systems is apparent in Middle-Earth: Shadow of Mordor. The next-gen version looks and feels leaps beyond the old-gen version, and some of the fancy Nemesis A.I. has been cut down to make the game playable on the PS3 and Xbox 360. If you have a next-gen system, this is a game that benefits immensely from the new systems' increased processing power.

Middle-Earth: Shadow of Mordor is an interesting experiment in making a grown-up game that speaks to both hardcore action-adventure players and Lord of the Rings fans. It is likely that the great majority of players who pick the game up will consider that experiment a success. Above all else, it's fun to see developers finally feeling free to explore the world of Middle-Earth without hanging the whole thing on Legolas' quiver.

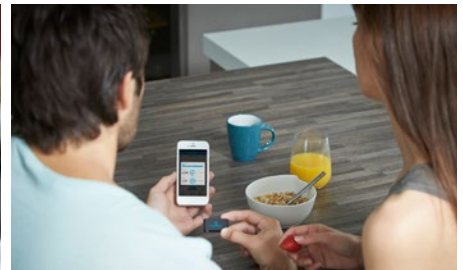
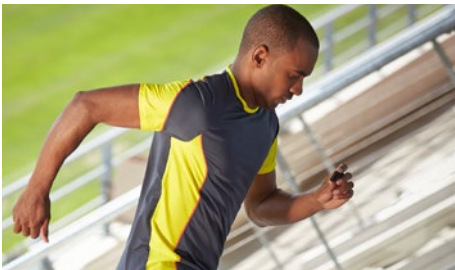
GoPro

CAN'T WE ALL JUST GET ALONG?



“Hey brother, do you still believe in one another?”

F Those of us who have siblings know we would do anything for them or those sons of those famous fathers of NFL lore, getting ready to embark on your own career as a professional football player can be daunting and overwhelming on its own. Hence, being the son of a Pro Football Hall of Famer and one of the most recognized faces in the television business just adds to the pressure.

Now throw in the fact that you are a first-round draft choice, something your father was not. The expectations have now been set even higher; you are expected to be one of the top rookies at your position and make an immediate impact.

Next, double that scenario. There are now two of you looking to measure up to the standards set by your father enshrined in Canton, Ohio. For one of you, it's made even more difficult by the fact that you play the same position as the man who gave you your name and so much.

Finally, add in the fact that the two of you will meet on the football field in a regular-season game in the National Football League. And we don't mean just meet, but meet. That's because one of these brothers is a defensive end and the other an offensive lineman.

We have gone a long way here to keep you in suspense. Perhaps that's only fitting considering we are talking about Hall of Fame defensive end Howie Long, who enjoyed a spectacular career with the Raiders, and his sons Chris and Kyle Long.

The former was the second overall pick in the 2008 NFL Draft via the University of Virginia. In six seasons with the St. Louis

Rams, the aggressive defensive end has yet to miss a game and totaled 50.5 sacks. The latter was the 20th selection in 2013 from the University of Oregon and comes off a rookie season in which he started all 16 games and wound up in Hawaii as a Pro Bowl replacement for San Francisco 49ers' guard Mike Iupati.

Brothers facing each other in the NFL or in professional sports in general are far from uncommon. We know the accomplishments of quarterbacks Peyton and Eli Manning. Since 2006, there has been one of these sons of Archie in the five of the last eight Super Bowls.

No, we are talking about a close encounter of the sibling kind. Like during the days of the NFL's old AFC Central division when Houston Oilers and later Tennessee Titans offensive linemen Bruce Matthews having to deal with the likes of his brother linebacker Clay Matthews who roamed the field for nearly two decades with the Cleveland Browns and later the Atlanta Falcons. The Oilers and Browns clashed a combined 23 times from 1983-93, including a playoff game in 1988, while the Matthews brothers were busily excelling at their crafts and making regular trips to the Pro Bowl.

How often do you think the Barber brothers butted helmets not only in practice at the University of Virginia in the mid-1990s but when running back Tiki and cornerback Ronde were members of the New York Giants and Tampa Bay Buccaneers, respectively? The former was a second-round draft choice and the latter was a third-round selection in 1997 and each of the twins enjoyed standout careers.

So let us fast forward to November of 2013 and Week 12 of the league's 94th season. The Bears are visiting the Edward Jones Dome, meaning there could be an occasion that right guard Kyle and left defensive end Chris could butt helmets.

"We play on the same side of the line on opposite sides of the ball," said Kyle to Larry Mayer of ChicagoBears.com last November prior to the game. "So the chances of us running into one another and getting physical with one another are pretty high."

For Kyle, that would mean a chance for him to show the man he has admired for years just what he has accomplished to date. But for those expecting a tribute to the 13-year NFL veteran and eight-time Pro Bowler who has a bust in Canton, Ohio. Kyle's words were for someone else this day.

"People would usually think that my dad would be my idol, but my older brother is somebody that I've idolized. I've looked up to (Chris) my entire life. I try to emulate the things that he does on and off the field. I try to play with the same passion and (motivation) that he does, which is really tough to do because he goes hard for a very long time."

When it was all said and done. Chris' Rams would pummel Kyle's Bears, 42-21. Less than four minutes into the game, St. Louis had jumped out to a 14-0 lead and never trailed throughout the contest. Chicago would be limited to just 80 yards rushing on 26 carries. Chris would total two tackles and knock down a pass.

"That was a hell of a week..." said Chris to Brad Biggs of the Chicago Tribune. "I don't find it fun to have to compete against your brother in a game where it is so violent. But luckily we barely touched each other, so that was good."

That wasn't entirely true. That's because Chris' biggest stop of the afternoon came may have come in the second quarter of the game. And it had nothing to do with tackling a Bears' player with the football.

"Oh, if the sky comes falling down for you, There's nothing in this world I wouldn't do."

Roughly nine minutes before halftime, Kyle and Rams' defensive end William Hayes nearly came to blows. A little pandemonium ensued and just before the younger Long could do something he may regret, his older brother came off the bench to rescue him. It didn't prevent Kyle from getting a 15-yard unnecessary roughness penalty, but it may have saved him further discipline.

Oh brother, indeed. And lesson learned as well.

So what can we expect next from Howie and his sons? The teams don't meet during the preseason or regular season in 2014. For those who find family fare in the NFL quite fascinating, keep in mind that outside linebacker Clay Matthews of the Green Bay Packers and tackle Jake Matthews of the Atlanta Falcons, the sons of Clay and Bruce, respectively and the latter the team's first-round pick in May, may be getting to know each other up close and personal at Lambeau Field on Monday night, December 8.

Then again, is it possible that the Bears and Rams could both reach the playoffs and we could see Kyle and Chris clash this January? Chicago hasn't been to the playoffs since reaching the NFC title game in 2010 while St. Louis' last postseason appearance came in 2004.

Now that's a Long time.

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
