

HOW TO COOK THE PERFECT THE PE



There is a single foolproof way to cook the perfect Turkey. It is so easy to do that there are only a few ways to screw up:

- 1. You forgot to turn on the oven.
- 2. You sat the wrong oven temperature.
- 3. You bought a frozen turkey and forgot to let it defrost.

- 5. You stuffed the turkey and did not allow extra time for the stuffing.

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




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A QUICK Q & A WITH ABIGAIL

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NHRA SPOTLIGHT

MATT SMITH aka THE CHAMP

Honey, I can't believe that here we are in November and people are still talking about our race in Epping. Once and for all, please tell everyone what happened, beside the fact that I beat your butt.

I was excited to be racing you in the final. It was your first ever final. Basically, what happened was I had a better reaction time than you. I put my bike in fifth gear and the motor went to one cylinder. When that happened, I looked over and didn't see

you but could hear you. I stayed in the throttle a bit longer and I put it in sixth gear and you passed me. I got out of the throttle. I had to save parts because we were on a three race swing so it wasn't worth blowing the motor completely up just to win. We broke a push rod on that run so it was simply a parts failure.

It has been a tough season for you. Do you think you bit off more than you can chew with four bikes?

I don't think my season has

been that bad. I'm trying to look at the positives in this. We have three bikes in our class that have leapfroaged the whole class because of NHRA rules. The two Harleys got new rules ... no one else is allowed to run these bikes. So, with that happening, we automatically got pushed to third place. Not only did that happen, but Vance and Hines put fuel injection on Jerry Savoie's bike and made it really fast as well. So, that put us down to fourth place. I don't really think I have bit off



more than I can chew because I am sitting in fifth place right now. I can get to third place by the season end. The most satisfying of this is that we got all four bikes in the Countdown to the Championship this year and that's a huge accomplishment. Considering the rules that the NHRA gave our class, I am happy with my results

I'm sure everyone wants to know your plans for 2015. Are you going to field four bikes again?

I don't know what MSR plans are for the 2015 season yet. I have a desire to drive a Pro Mod car or a Nitro car. I am not sure how many bikes I am going to run yet. I am still in negotiations with riders and sponsors trying to figure it out at this time. When we know we will put press releases out at that time letting them know the team's status. If I don't drive a car, I will definitely be riding a bike. That's what I do and how I run my business.

Would you sit out and be a crew chief?

For the right amount of money I would sit out and be a crew chief. It would take a certain amount of money for me to do that and not get the pleasure of competing. If someone threw the money there and wanted that, then yes I would do it.

Michael Ray leasing one of your engines started a ton of rumors. Is he coming back to MSR in 2015?

We haven't talked anything about him coming back to race for us in 2015. There have been a couple of people talk to me about doing the motor leasing program and up to this point I have declined all offers. Michael and I sat down and

came up with a plan and decided to do this on a trial basis. I will see if it works. If we have a good plan, then it might be something I will have available for other people that have their own bike and want to do an engine program with me. I have to do what's best for MSR and give people a chance of winning races.



Those Harleys were tough this year. Is there a plan in place to knock them off the top perch in 2015?

That's really up to NHRA's tech department. We can't get back to the top unless NHRA decides that we need some parity in our class. The class was very equal in 2013. I think we had seven different winners in 2013 and that's when it is fun to go to the racetrack. If you look at all four of my bikes, the Star bikes, and the Lucas bikes we are pretty much evenly matched. So, hopefully NHRA will look over it during the winter and make some changes to the rule package for the Harley Davidson bikes so it is more evenly matched. The only other way we could get back on top, with the same rules package, is if someone brought about \$500,000 to do a lot of research and development with some new parts.

Let's talk about one of the most controversial moments of 2014, the first race in the Countdown to the Championship in Charlotte. After V. Gaines crashed, the PSM teams got together for a meeting to discuss racing if the NHRA declared the track safe. Things got very heated between the different PSM teams. Why?

I am going to be blunt with my answer. There was one idiot in the meeting that said his bikes could race down a dirt road. I said more power to you. Your bikes can be the first down the track then and they didn't want to do that. The rest of the group had decided that the track wasn't safe and agreed not to race. That's when it got heated. Safety should be a priority with all these teams and NHRA definitely made it a priority when they decided to cancel the race. Not only is safety my top priority but I also have several hundreds of thousands of dollars invested into my program and I didn't want any of my equipment riders and jeopardy.

Enough of the serious questions! How did the Kandy girls do in their first season as cheerleaders?

I think the Kandy girls did a fabulous job promoting this year. I really like Laurie. She brings so much positive energy and excitement to the team. I really like her being at the races. You don't have any idea how many times I was asked where the Kandy girls were at the races they did not attend. The fans LOVE the Kandy girls. I can't tell you one guy that come by our pit and didn't want a pic' with the Kandy girls. I think it's great and I think the Kandy girls need to be at every race. It is great for our team to get that coverage and publicity

with the Kandy girls.

What do you think if I talk Laurie into letting me borrow one of their outfits one night?

That's fine. I wouldn't care a bit. Ang' can wear whatever she wants. Their outfits are very classy and I like them so whenever Laurie lets her borrow one then that's good for me. Haha.

Last question, besides our home track in Charlotte, where is your favorite track to race? Why?

I think I would have to say St. Louis. I have always liked St. Louis. It got off our schedule for awhile because they changed management. I was happy to see it come back. I have always done well there. It's a fast track and safe. It has a long shutdown area. To top it off, it has a go-kart track beside the track so if we want to get away from drag racing then we can jump over to the other side and race go-karts. It's good to unwind after a long day of racing or qualifying at the racetrack. I also get to race the guys that work for me and some of the other guys on the other teams. I am a very competitive person and I like to win at everything I do. I would challenge anyone in the NHRA series to a go-kart match any day of the week.

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
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
