Aircraft-inspired supercar!

Spyker's latest is a 180mph beauty based on First World War fighter planes!

- The latest launch from prickly, eccentric car-maker
 Spyker is the total opposite of mass-produced. Its latest £100k B6 Venator is aimed squarely at people who find Porsches too predictable.
- Thankfully, the B6 Venator looks absolutely showstopping. It claims to draw inspiration from historical aeroplanes because before going under in 1925, Spyker built First World War fighter planes. Even the name Venator (Latin for hunter)

Or rather, cockpit. Keeping it aviator-obsessed, the Venator keeps the cabin airy thanks to glass roof panels. Look beyond and it comes decked out with its hallmark-exposed gearshift linkage (inspired by early aircraft controls from Spyker's aviation heritage) and machine-turned aluminium panel fascias.

What becomes impressive is the dotty detailing of the B6. Within the machine-turned dash are not switches and gauges nicked out of existing And that's before you caress the supremely soft Litano Royal Hulshof Dutch Tanneries' finest leather.

- An entry-level Porsche 911 may be as light at 1,400kg, but the Venator's chassis comes created out of aluminium, with an entirely carbon-fibre bodyshell on top. It's 74mm wider but 144mm shorter than the Porsche, with a 50mmlonger wheelbase.
- We've got "3D LED" modern jet afterburner-inspired lights at the back, and wheels
- Those long circular vents tunnel into each rear shoulder point to where the 375bhp V6 engine will live. It's not masses these days, but the B6 will be about as quick as a base model 911 (0 to 62mph in around 4.6 seconds, 180mph top speed), but that's academic when it has been machined and built with as much precision as this.
- There aren't many cars we could say we'd buy purely for its gearshift linkage and intake vents. But this is a car

is a nod back to their Spyker Hunter fighters.
Let's start with the B6's finest asset - the interior. cars, but hand-machined custom bezels and dial faces, with everything machined from solid billet aluminium. which are a mere 19in but mirror-polished and called "Turbofan", because they ape jet engine intakes. for those who don't just say they want to be different. And who have around £100k budget for their motor.

The big facts that show Wigan don't stand a chance... or do they?



THE FA Cup final is imminent and Wigan vs Man City is very much going to be a David vs Goliath-style showdown, as these astonishing facts and figures make clear. Let Nuts shock and amaze you with a few simple stat comparisons...

Wigan's record signing is Charles N'Zogbia (now at Villa), who cost £7m from Newcastle. An incredible 17 of Man City's 27-man first-team squad (including two players, Wayne Bridge and Roque Santa Cruz, who have been farmed out on loan) cost more than N'Zogbia.



Eleven of Wigan's 18-man squad cost the club just £1m or less. None of Man City's squad did. The only free-transfer player in Man City's entire first-team squad is current third-choice goalkeeper Richard Wright, himself a Premier League and FA Cup winner and full England international. Wigan's third choice keeper, Mike Pollitt, is 41.

The FA Cup final, ESPN/ HD and ITV/HD, 5.15pm on Saturday 11 May.

Over the last five seasons, Wigan have paid out **£47.1m** in disclosed transfer fees. City, on the other hand, have paid out a whopping £537.4m.

The combined total cost of Wigan's starting 11 for their semi-final against Millwall was £14.45m. Not that impressive when you consider that there were five players on the Man City substitutes' bench - Edin Dzeko, Kolo Toure, Aleksandar Kolarov, Javi Garcia and Joleon Lescott - who cost more than Wigan's entire starting 11 put together. Combined cost of Man City's semi-final substitutes' bench: £106.3m. Combined cost of Wigan's semi-final substitutes' bench: £5m. Gulp!

Wigan's entire 18-man squad for the Cup semi-final cost £19.45m. Eight current Man City players cost more than that on their own!

City's semi-final **starting 11** between them have 12 Community Shield winners' medals, 12 Premier League titles, seven FA Cup wins, two Champions Leagues, two Champions Leagues, two UEFA Super Cups, two FIFA World Club Cup titles, one League Cup and one Europa League title. Darts lessons from The Power!

Nuts picks up some tips on arrow-chucking from the greatest darts player of all time!

Hi Phil! So what basic advice would you could give the novice darts player?

First, make sure the board you are playing on is the right height and the oche is the right length. Most importantly, get the right set of darts. Find some that you feel comfortable using. I must have tried over 40 sets when I first started!

What's the secret of your extraordinary success?

Practice and dedication. These days, I don't practise as much as I used to, but I still do two-and-a-half hours a day.



Have you ever experienced "dartitis", that weird condition that means you can't release the dart at the right time? Yes, when I was younger. Someone told me to overcome it, I should throw a house brick in the garden. And it worked!

What methods do you have of shutting out the crowd?

I don't have any! Some guys wear earplugs, but I feed off the crowd. They inspire me.

What techniques do you have for keeping up the pressure on your opponents?

You just have to keep scoring heavily when you get the chance. Keep turning the screw.

You've spoken at various points about considering retirement. What's your current situation? I've just signed a new five-year

deal with Barry Hearn. That will take me to 58. I want to give it everything in this five years, and be more professional than I've ever been before. If it was suddenly decided that darts was to be included in the 2020 Olympics, would you be willing to stick it out until then? Ha-ha! No, no, no. I don't want to be the oldest person ever to compete in the Olympics!

Do you ever stop to think about how remarkable it actually is to get a nine-dart finish?

Yes, all the time. The first one I did on telly was worth £100,000. So that one felt pretty incredible. That was the best one, for some reason!

Is the prospect of a nine-darter lurking in the back of your mind every time you start a set?

Not unless you hit a couple of 180s. Then the crowd gets on to you...

Which tournament means the most to you?

The World Championship is the one everybody wants. Of course, the league is the hardest, because it lasts for five months. To stay focused and injury-free for that long takes some doing.

Who's best placed to be the next major force in darts?

Michael van Gerwen. He's an exciting player. You never know what he's going to do next, and he never knows when he's beaten! Off the pitch, he's a great lad.

What is it about the Midlands that produces so many good darts players?

There are a lot of dart leagues in that area, it's a popular sport. Plus, there's not much else to do!

Thanks, Phil. Finally, what did you think of *Nuts* Man's performance today?

Bloody awful! But the good thing about being awful is that you can only get better!
