When it comes

 This is the latest BMW Art Car, with graphics designed by US artist Jeff Koons.

• The BMW M3 GT2 is the 17th BMW Art Car, a project that started in 1975 when French racing driver and auctioneer Hervé Poulain invited an artist to create a canvas on a car.

 According to Koons, the design is "evocative of power, motion and bursting energy".

 And the M3 GT2 has energy, alright - this stripped-down, racing version of the M3 GTS road car is powered by a 4.0litre V8 engine that produces a pretty hefty 500bhp.

- It can sprint from 0-60mph in under 3.2 seconds, while top speed is around 200mph!
- This awesome performance is largely down to the fact that carbon-reinforced plastic (CRP)

has been used to replace the original bodywork, delivering substantial weight reductions.

- Lightweight magnesium wheels are also fitted.
- This car has just taken part in the 24 Hours of Le Mans sports-car race in France.

- It was given the number 79 in tribute to the 1979 BMW Art Car, which was painted by artist Andy Warhol.
- Want to get your hands on this work of art? Forget it – the car isn't for sale at any price and is destined to become a museum exhibit later this year.
- However, you can snap up a BMW M3 GT2 race car. But you'll need roughly £350,000 in your bank account!



Meet the road car-the BMW M3 GTS!

- This is the BMW M3 GTS the road version of the M3 GT2 Art Car.
- Costing around £100,000, it's the most expensive BMW M3 road car ever built!
- The 4.4-litre V8 engine produces around 450bhp.
- Removing the air-con, radio, satnav and back seats has made the car nice and light.
- This gives it a 0-60mph time of 4.4 seconds. Add an incredible 190mph top speed and Porsche should be losing sleep.
- Using the GT2's suspension technology, the subframe is adjustable, allowing you to lower the GTS by 16mm at the front and 12mm at the back.
- The BMW M3 GTS will be available in any colour – as long as it's orange!

Shuttle leaves F-15 in its wake!

o, this isn't the latest errant shot from Emile Heskey. It is, in fact, the Atlantis Space Shuttle blasting into space at a whopping 1,000 miles per hour!

It's not often you see an F-15E Strike Eagle (pictured in the foreground) look like a slovenly slowcoach, but that's just what happened as Atlantis completed its final ascent at nearly two-andhalf times the speed of sound!

This shot was taken by pilots above the Kennedy Space Centre as they captured the shuttle's last journey to the International Space Station. Upon its return, Atlantis will be retired, along with the rest of the fleet.




"I didn't know I'd done it until I got up and felt a torrent of blood running off the end of my finger.
