MERCEDES SLS AMG E-CELL This all-electric version of Merc's SLS AMG is only two tenths of a second slower than its petrol-drinking twin, and achieves 0-62mph in 4.0 secs.



BMW 1 SERIES M COUPE The baby Beemer coupé finally gets an M medallion. There's an overboost mode, spiking torque from 332lb-ft to 369lb-ft, and it'll do 0-62mph in 4.9 secs. Sweet.



MINI PACEMAN COUPE CONCEPT With a Cooper Works 212bhp turbo petrol motor, linked to Mini's new ALL4 fourwheel-drive system, it'll hit 62mph in 6.5 secs and top 150mph.



CADILLAC CTS-V COUPE The CTS-V is one badass race car. It'll compete in the Sports Car Club of America (SCCA) World Challenge, where its sub-four-second 0-62mph will be handy.



AUDI E-TRON SPYDER CONCEPT The Boxster-sized hybrid sports drop-top has been fettled even further. It's now dieselpowered for the rear wheels and electric for the front wheels.

THE SEVEN SNIPER SKILLS SNIPER KNOWLEDGE Snipers are instructed on the tasks they may be asked to carry out on the battlefield. As well as this, they're also instructed on the L115A3 weapon system and the history of a sniper.


2 NAVIGATION All snipers are expert navigators. On the sniper course, candidates hone their map-reading skills and are taught to navigate from aerial photography. This is to ensure that a sniper can plan his task accurately.



3 OBSERVATION Snipers are taught how to observe and log enemy movements. This ensures they can detect the slightest detail that may give away an enemy. Snipers have been known to stay in one location for days on end.

4 STALKING Stalking's an art form. A sniper must be able to approach an enemy position undetected, then get into position, calculate wind and distance to the target. take his final shot and extract from the location undetected.






6 SHOOTING Snipers must be able to calculate wind 5 CONCEALMENT Snipers are experts in camouflage values, distance and elevation. and concealment. They're Snipers are also taught firing taught to conceal themselves from all positions - standing, using natural vegetation to lying down, kneeling, sitting enable them to lie undetected and crouching. This improves when observing enemy the chance of a first-round kill. movements or when moving.

7 JUDGING DISTANCE Snipers are taught a number of methods to help them judge the distance to a target, ranging from methods using the naked eye to using optics on the rifle. Again, this improves the sniper's chances.









During the Second World War, Soviet marksman Vasily Zaytsev killed 225 Nazis in he Battle of Stalingrad, one of whom was a sniper he 'duelled" with for three days. His story was told in 2001 movie Enemy At The Gates.

n 2010, a British sniper from The Rifles shot dead five Taliban gunmen in an astonishing 28 seconds, ust moments before his comrades walked into their ambush. The sniper, who can't be named for security reasons, was setting up an observation point with his spotter when they noticed the group of Taliban rebels. Immediately, the gunman snapped into action. Hiding in an old fort, he pulled his L115A3 into position. As soon as he was given the command to fire, he engaged. Less than

half a minute later, the five Taliban were down. "My job" about taking care of the boys," the hero said. "It's not about how many you kill!"

Former Finnish soldier Simo Häyhä, nicknamed "White Death," holds the record for the most kills in any recorded war, with a mind-blowing 505 confirmed in the 1939 conflict between Finland and the Soviet Union, What makes Häyhä's achievement even more spectacular is the fact that the majority of his kills came from the barrel of an iron-sighted M28 Pystylorva rifle - a far cry from the technologically advanced weapons at the disposal of snipers today. In fact, he chose not to use a telescopic sight because a sniper must lift his head slightly higher to use it, making him that little bit more detectable.



to believe it will happen soon!




