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

225mph Brit Meet the brilliant new Noble M600

- No ABS, no airbags and lighter than a Ford Focus, Noble's M600 is the race car with a road tax disc. And boasting 650bhp, this means 0-62mph in three seconds and 0-120mph in 8.9secs.
- The prototype was unveiled in 2009 and now the production version of British supercarmaker Noble's latest jewel has rolled out from their factory.





- In order to break 200mph, you need decent stability and a hearty dose of power. The latter comes from a midmounted V8 engine.
- It's had a pair of turbos added and the backside tuned off it by superbike gods Yamaha to give it 650bhp.
- With a space-frame chassis, stainless steel tub and full carbon-fibre bodywork, it weighs less than 1,200kg.
- Compared to the Veyron's hardly tatty 521bhp-per-tonne power-to-weight ratio, the M600 packs 550bhp/tonne.
- You can even choose the level of punishment on the 335/30/20 rear tyres, as the Noble features a threestage turbo-boost function.
- It has traction control which is tweaked by lifting a lid on a fighter plane missile switch.
- Fussy is something it isn't on the inside. There may be plush carpets, but the M600 is still as raw as fresh steak.
- The £200k price tag is fruity but Noble claims its inspiration for the M600 was the Ferrari F40 and McLaren F1!

One of our cleverer staff tried to explain this phenomenon to us, but we just repeated, "Ooh! Lightning!" until he slunk away to fix the printer.


