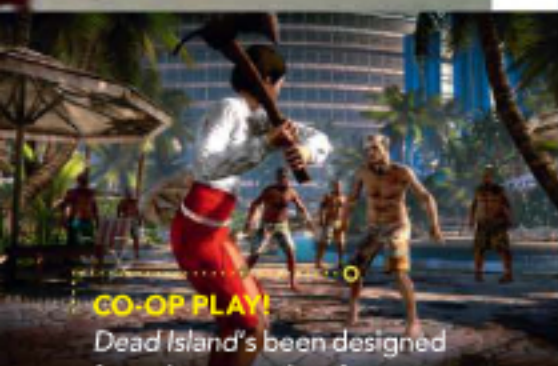

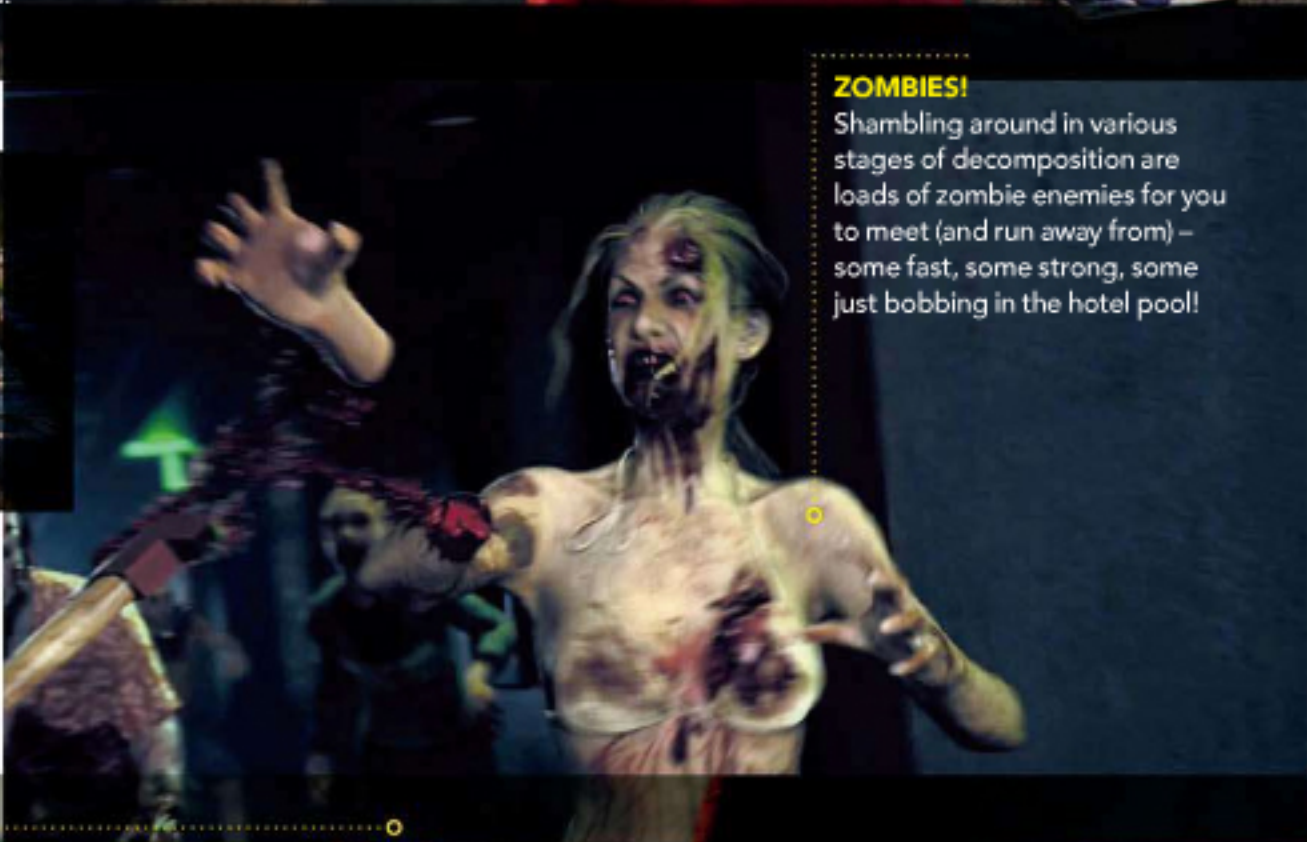

# Carbon fibre-clad Cayenne!

**Swiss car-fiddlers turn Porsche 958 Turbo into the "Wide Body"**

- Despite being Porsche's best-selling car, the Cayenne has never been handsome. And even though it's had a facelift, it was never going to win any beauty contests.
- So Swiss car-fiddlers Mansory decided to spice the Cayenne up a bit, by developing a body kit to make the SUV 60mm wider up front and with 80mm broader arches at the rear.
- Created out of flawless carbon-fibre (Mansory's signature dish), the Cayenne has a revised front valance, wider wings, side skirts, mirrors, roof spoiler and the most complicated rear diffuser we've seen.
- The bodykit also features multiple front air intakes (to help the 4.8-litre V8 breathe harder) plus new LED daytime running lights. Moving the

location of the radar for the adaptive cruise-control system to higher up the grille (it's now in the centre) is a neat trick.

- Although Mansory offer 21in and 23in rims, the 958 Wide Body comes standard on 10 by 22in turbine-design forged wheels. To make the hoops fill out the arches, the air suspension system has been modified to allow a further 45mm drop.
- Not satisfied with the interior of a standard Turbo, Mansory has torn out and replaced the headliner and restitched the steering wheel, door cards, seats and arm rests with real carbon-fibre and carbon weave fabric. Basically, if you're not a fan of carbon-fibre, you'd best move right along.
- Mansory's men in coats have also been at work beneath that ultra-light carbon bonnet. The result is the carbon fibre-decorated 4.8-litre V8 engine with

a brainwashed Electronic Control Unit, a pair of larger turbochargers and stainless-steel quad-exit exhaust system, which all provides 680bhp and 590lb-ft of torque.

- And being all-wheel drive, the Mansory Cayenne can lay that power straight to tarmac without smoke, doing

0-62mph in 4.4 seconds. Not bad for something that weighs over two tonnes!

- We've no idea if the custom carbon tailgate and roof spoilers help, but top speed has been stretched from 173mph to 186mph.
- And the cost? Add £18,320 on top of your £85k for a standard Cayenne Turbo (pushing it past the £100k to £103,320). But what price beauty, eh?

# Charlie Sheen: Hollywood's Biggest Loon!

## Cocaine, prison, car crashes and porn stars - a look at the most colourful man in showbiz...

For over 20 years, Charlie Sheen, 45, has enjoyed a sketchy relationship with the real world, living a surreal existence full of illegal substances, women of relaxed morals, barely averted calamities and amazing success in acting, which he occasionally gets around to doing, too. But over the last two years, Sheen - who earns about £775,000 per episode of *Two And A Half Men* - has appeared to enter a self-destructive pattern of excess, burnout and rehab. Our story begins, like many classics, on Christmas Day!

If one moment can be said to have started Sheen's two-year blizzard of drugs and porn-star sex, it came on 25 December 2009. The festive season that year ended with Sheen in jail

after wife Brooke Mueller called the police because Sheen was drunk and acting bizarrely. "It's happened before," Mueller told police. Even so, less than a week later, the couple were putting on a show of affection to the media. "They're very much in love," said a lawyer for Sheen's wife. The marriage lasted another 11 months.

### STOLEN CARS AND PORN STARS

In February 2010, a four-door Mercedes Benz saloon vanished from Sheen's home in Sherman Oaks, California, and was driven over the edge of a cliff in the Hollywood Hills. At 4am, around the time the car's automatic security system was informing police of a crash, Sheen was at home reporting the car as missing.

"It was nice to have police come to my house and for once I didn't have to leave with them," Sheen quipped. A little over a fortnight later, though, Sheen checked himself into rehab to begin his third stint in recovery.

One car falling down a ravine can be seen as unfortunate, but when another of your fleet of Mercs ends up over the side of a cliff four months later, at the same time in the morning, the police get suspicious. Just before 3am on 15 June, an officer saw another Mercedes saloon, crashed off a cliff on Mulholland Drive about a mile from the site of the February crash.

Once again, it belonged to Sheen and once again, he was baffled by its absence. On both occasions, the keys had been left in the ignition of his car, and it was this aspect of the thefts that police noted as "suspicious".

By August, Sheen was back in

the hotel's famous Eloise Suite with Capri, Sheen discovered that his wallet and mobile - or, according to other sources, his Rolex - had gone missing, and he flew into a rage, hurling stuff around the room, while Anderson hid in a wardrobe.

Finally, Sheen passed out and Anderson made a panicked phone call from inside a wardrobe. Police arrived to find the pair naked, with Sheen screaming "incoherent slurs" at officers on the scene.

A police spokesman later reported Sheen wasn't expected to face any criminal charges - the hotel-trashing incident, according to Sheen's people, was "an allergic reaction to medication". By the time 2011 came, Sheen was divorced again and ready to go into overdrive.

The Adult Video News Awards is an annual ceremony held by the US porn industry, where porn stars descend on Las Vegas to be honoured in categories like Best MILF Series and Best All-Girl Sex Scene. On Saturday 8 January, Sheen headed to the Palms Hotel And Casino in Vegas to join the fun. He rented the hotel's Hugh Hefner Sky Villa (at around £25k a night) and was soon downing shots with another famous porn star, Bree Olson, in the hotel bar.

When Wednesday 12 January came around, and Sheen was due to report for filming on his hit sitcom *Two And A Half Men*, he was nowhere to be found. The reason? An "ear infection".

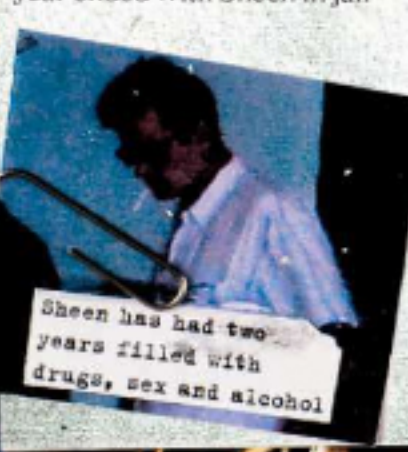
rehab at the order of the courts. He underwent counselling and was given probation. Apart from the mysterious double car theft, the Hollywood star had been relatively quiet for months. But that was about to change.

In the early hours of 26 October 2010, police escorted a cocaine-crazed Sheen from the New York Plaza hotel after the actor had caused over £4,000 of damage in his suite.

Sheen had been "partying" on the town, snorting cocaine and drinking with porn star Capri Anderson. Upon returning to

#### DRUGS AND SEX

But all good things must come to an end, and for Charlie Sheen, it came in the early hours of 27 January, when he was again hospitalised with abdominal pain, before checking himself into rehab on 28 January. The exact cause of the hospitalisation wasn't clear, but Sheen had just spent two days taking cocaine and having sex with several women - all porn actresses - at least one of whom was 22-year-old porn star Kacey Jordan.

The full extent of Sheen's strange desires became clear in the days that followed. He'd reportedly paid Jordan £3,000 to turn up at his LA mansion, telling her he'd been "searching for her for a year", and after having sex and indulging in drinking games with her, Sheen gave Jordan an £18,000 cheque to buy herself a Bentley.

Other stories included the rumour Sheen was planning on creating a "porn family home", where his favourite stars could come to live at his expense, and that Sheen was thinking about starring in a series of adult movies called *Charlie's Devils*.

Two weeks ago, Sheen's porn contacts received texts from the troubled star, saying things like "we're closed" and "please drive through". The party, it seems, may be over.

But with Sheen vowing to return to work within a month, and a porn remake of his greatest drugs-and-sex binge in the pipeline, there are many who have their doubts. ■

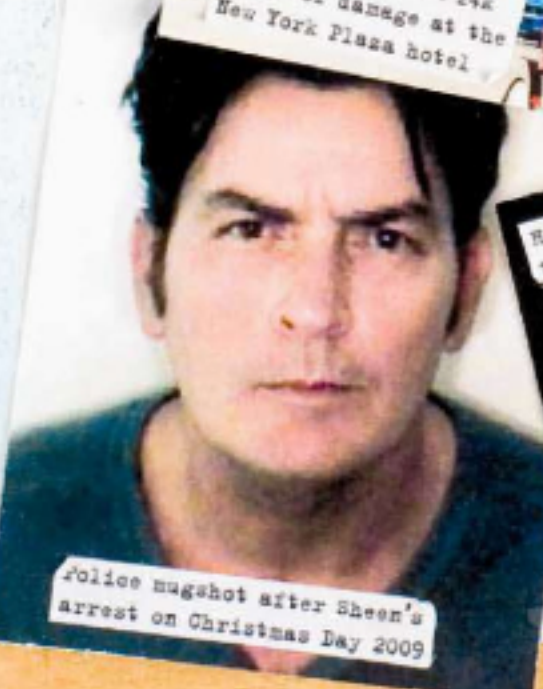

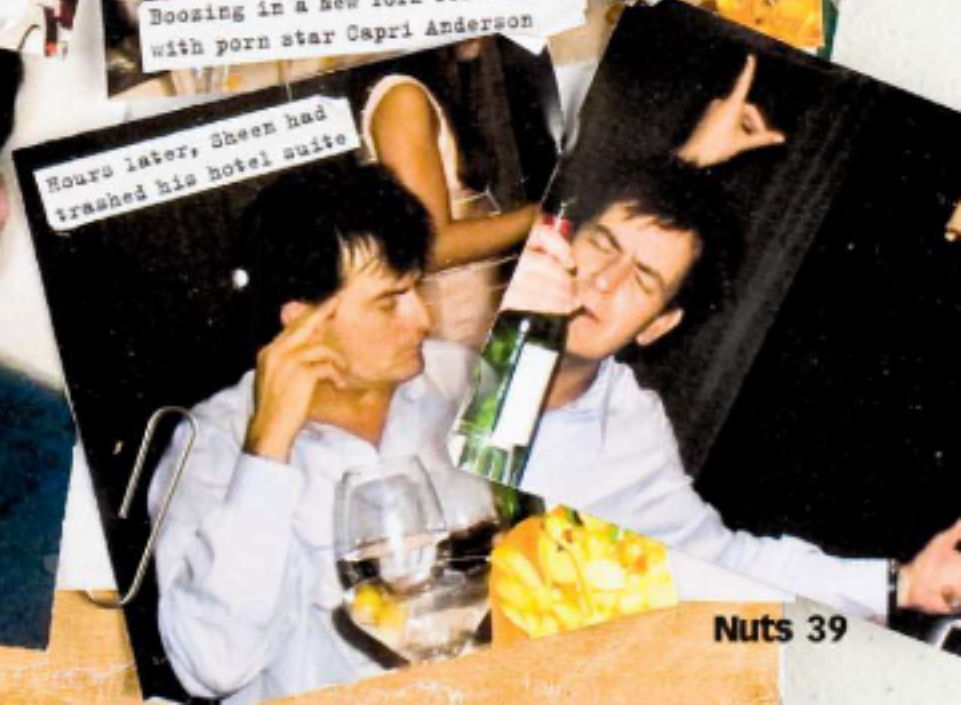
