

The Aventador LP 700-4 - Lambo's first new model for eight years!

- The Reventón and Sesto Elemento concept cars aside, this is Lamborghini's first new model since the Gallardo in 2003.
- And boy, this is some replacement. The numbers next to the name signify the car's horsepower (a ludicrous 700bhp) and power train (their now standard fourwheel-drive powerplant).
- The important stuff:
 The engine's a naturally-aspirated, 6.5-litre, 700bhp,
 V12 thumper. It grunts the
 Aventador to a 0-62mph click of 2.9 seconds edging into hypercar territory and on to a top whack of 217mph.
- The main reason for these blistering figures is a superlight, all carbon-fibre, singlepiece monocoque, which
- weighs 148kg in its entirety. Because of this, the whole car weighs just 1,575kg.
- The power's channelled through special "ISR" (independent shifting rods) transmission, making for a faster, lighter gearbox and what Lamborghini call "the world's most emotional gear shift". It's quick, that's for sure, at a 50 millisecond blip.
- The cool stuff: like its predecessor, the Murciélago, the Aventador has verticalopening "Lamborghini doors". And you start it by popping up a missile-like starter button cover.
- The Premier League price for this Premier League car?
 On the road for £242,280 for late summer delivery. In time for close season, Mr Rooney!



f you're into first-person shooters, you'll know Dice's work – they're the Swedish clever-clogs behind the super-popular Battlefield series.

We caught up with Dice head honcho Patrick Bach, who told us how they're bringing Battlefield 3 to consoles, and which weapons are the best for destroying houses!

The game's not out till autumn, but that gives us plenty of time to save our pennies!

Hi Patrick! First up, can you tell us where Battlefield 3 is set?

Well, the images you can see are set in Sulaymaniyah, a city on the border between Iran and Iraq. We can't really go into the details of the story too much at the moment, but this scene's quite early in the game, right at the start of the campaign.

We can see a cool-looking helicopter. How do they fit in?

The vehicles are a big part of the gaming experience, and that's true of BF3. In single player, we give you certain vehicles at certain times to ride in, but also to control – that's what makes it different from most shooters. You take control of tanks, helicopters and planes, as well as the infantry.

We can also see a chap blowing up a building with a rocket launcher - how destructible are the environments? We want to create a totally destructible environment, rather than an environment that can just be "affected". But this image is actually showing an event that will be a specific objective there's a guy hiding in this building. So, depending on the situation, you'll get objectives, or in multiplayer you can more or less take down any building to reveal the men behind it. How we put it is, "If you have a big gun, you can make a big hole!" How big a part does teamwork play in BF3? Teamwork's always the thing in all BF games, and even more so in BF3. When you play, you'll be playing both as a team and alone in single player. But, the same thing applies in multiplayer, where you can choose to be part of a squad or play lone wolf and go wherever you want and not be responsible for anyone.

What are the biggest and coolest new weapons?

If you want a big, dangerous weapon, I'd pick one of the jet fighters, where you can fly around and cause havoc over big parts of the map. But there are counter-measures for each weapon, so no one should feel safe. We read that you've even recorded guns being fired at different distances to make the audio super-realistic. Yeah, we recorded loads of weapons in open fields

and compared them to

ones fired in doorways



to make sure you get the right reflections of sounds. That adds to the immersion of using the guns - it just feels right. Going online, how much can you customize the game? Well, we underestimated the amount of time people put into our games. We have players for Battlefield 2 who've spent more than 1,000 hours in the game. So, of course, those people want to unlock more stuff and get more rewards further into the game. You don't want to "rank out". I can tell you we've definitely learned a lesson! How many players will be able to play online at once? We're capping the console at 24 players, compared to 64 on the PC.



and our goal's to make sure that experience will be intense enough for the console audience. What cool stuff can you do with the new graphics engine? One thing I think will make a big impression is the whole movement and animation system, making characters look more realistic when moving around on the battlefield. We actually looked around to find the best animation system and we found it within EA, in Fifa!

Finally, are you lot obsessed with war and video games?

Us, or the Swedes in general?
We have a lot of hobbies other
than war! Ha-ha! Our country's
probably the most pacifist in
the world as we haven't been
to war in more than 120 years,
so I think there might be an
urge to get it out of our system!
