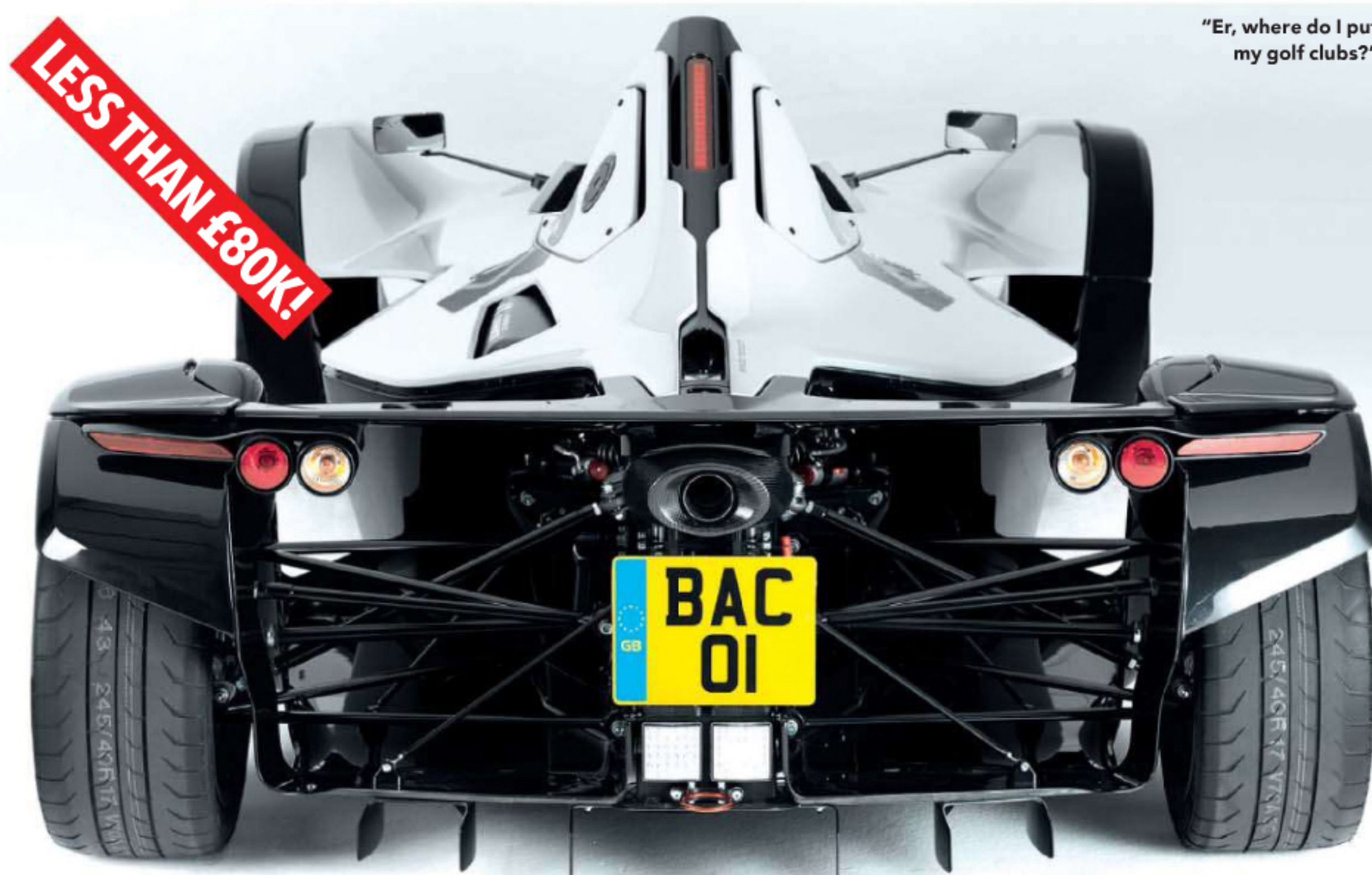

- Weight (or lack of it) plays a big part in that blinding stat. The Mono clocks in at just 540kg due to copious amounts of carbon fibre. Oh, and no roof. Or doors. Or stereo.

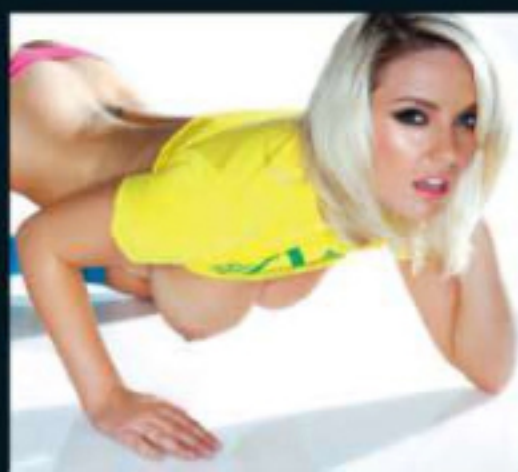
I found out that my girlfriend of two years has slept with 30 men. It's changed how I think about her and I've turned into a bit of a mess. How can I get everything back on track?

The Dragon on his new show, ladies' knickers and football!

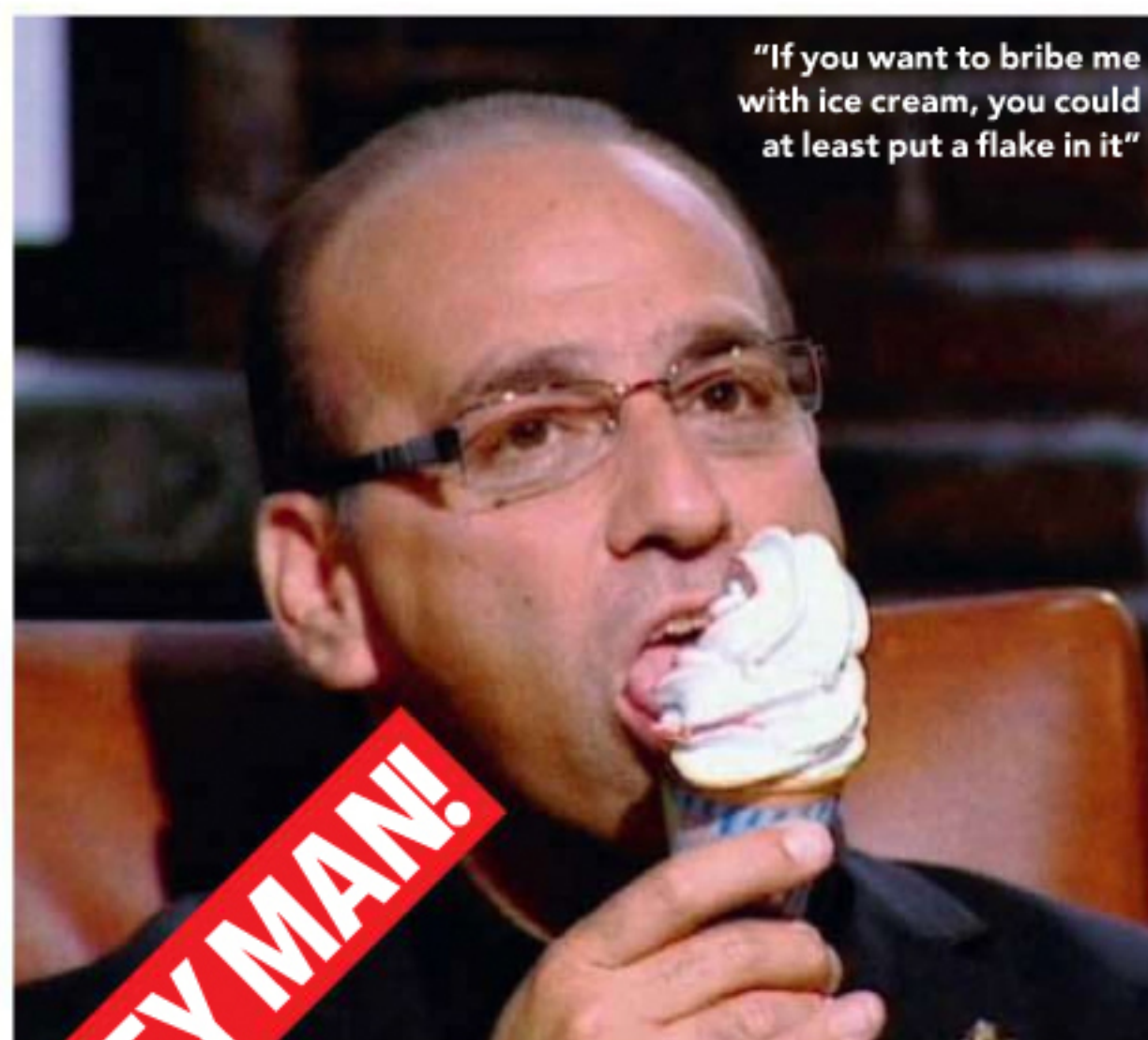

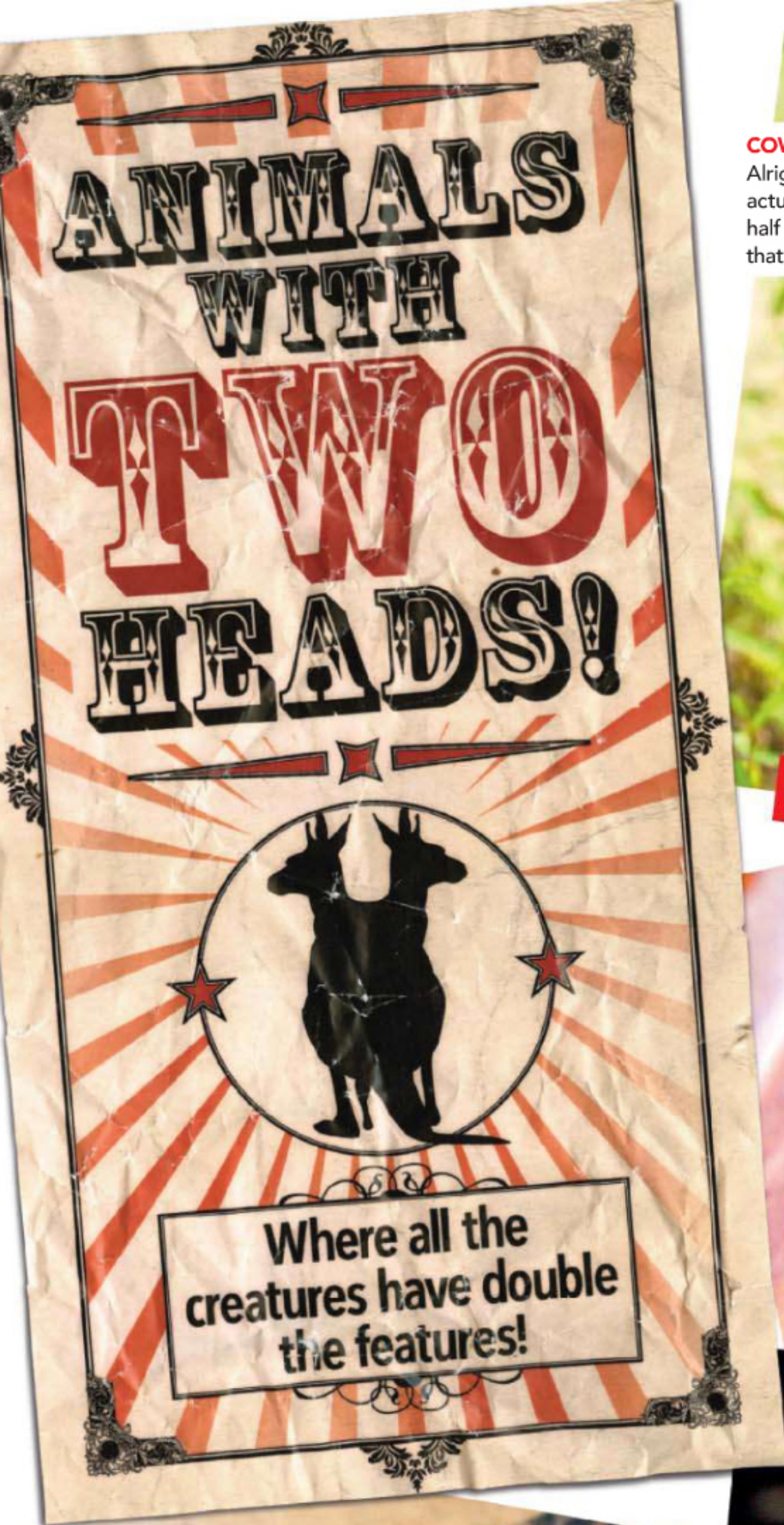
Apparently, you own a fleet of top cars. What's next on your automobile shopping list?

Colombia's cocaine submarines!

Home-made craft trafficking drugs beneath the sea!

Imagine you're a Colombian drug smuggler, wanting to flood the streets of countries like the United States and Mexico with cocaine. How do you move your product?

You can use human mules, but this means small loads being transported in an arduous process. You can fly drugs in, but the risk of being intercepted and shot down is high. You can ship it in on speedboats and hope the US Coast Guard doesn't catch you. Or you can take your drugs underwater.

Up until a few years ago, the tactic of smuggling drugs out of

Colombia in submarines was seen by law enforcement agencies as an intriguing oddity, with about four cases a year between 2002 and 2007. But then the practice seemed to erupt, almost overnight. There were more cases of cocaine-smuggling subs being stopped in the first three months of 2008 than in the previous six years. The tactic, it seemed, had started to catch on.

And catch on it did. American law-enforcement authorities estimate that in 2011, 480 tonnes of cocaine will be smuggled out of Colombia in submarines and that only 15 per cent of that huge amount will be intercepted by the US Coast Guard – finding the craft, after all, is “like looking for a floating log in the middle of the ocean”, according to one US anti-drugs official.

Such descriptions perhaps explain why Colombian drug

smugglers are prepared to go to all that trouble.

“All that trouble” is a long and remarkable construction process deep in the Colombian jungles to evade detection. Cartels will bring together a team of 15 to 20 workers and have them set up a jungle camp, and then effectively set up a submarine construction plant and go to work.

Dodging the authorities

Using equipment powered by generators, they build the submarines by hand, making them large enough to carry several tonnes of cocaine and a handful of human traffickers, but small enough that they're almost impossible to detect. Most of the craft cannot fully submerge in the manner of regular submarines, but they can get far enough under the surface of the water to become almost undetectable. The cost of building one of these subs runs to about £300,000.

However, in recent times, more sophisticated craft have been discovered under construction, boasting satellite guidance systems, 300hp engines that can power the craft at 10mph, dive to depths of up to 30 feet and can be operated by remote control, and even super drug-subs costing up to around £1.25million to assemble.

Sometimes, the submarines never even make it to the sea. In February this year, the

Colombian Navy seized a 100ft fibre-glass vessel in the jungles of the southwest of the country, and it was the largest and most sophisticated craft of its kind captured to date. However, even those submarines that do make it out are designed to be eminently disposable.

Most of the submarines may be slipping through the US Coast Guard's net, but the ones that are spotted have a unique way of avoiding smuggling charges – they simply destroy

the craft by flooding them with seawater and sending them, cocaine cargo and all, to the bottom of the ocean to rest and rust. The crew, meanwhile, don life jackets and bob on the surface of the water, waiting to be rescued, safe in the knowledge that their incriminating evidence is plunging to a depth where it will never be recovered.

Occasionally, as in the case of a recent seizure of seven tonnes of cocaine by US Coast Guard officials off the coast of Guatemala, the crew may fight back, or throw their craft into high-speed reverse in an attempt to throw boarding law officials into the sea. If the sub

evades the authorities, then once the cocaine is unloaded, it's again sent to the bottom of the ocean, its work done.

The subs are so effective that authorities in both the US and Colombia have been forced to invent new laws to combat them. In 2009, Colombia's congress passed a law that made simply building a submersible craft illegal and punishable by up to 12 years in prison, because such craft have one use and one use only – the trafficking of cocaine.

Snaring the smugglers

At the US end, you can now earn up to 20 years in prison just by being on an "unflagged" vessel (one that's not registered to a specific government), whether that vessel is being used for drug smuggling or not – again, an unflagged makeshift submarine in US waters can only be being used for one thing.

Even if the crew decide to take the option of sinking the craft

before their illicit cargo can be captured, the new law would make them as punishable as if they were caught with a whole submarine full of cocaine. All of this should give a clear idea as to how seriously the submarine problem is being taken.

As a symbol of the US Coast Guard's recent successes in stopping these underwater smugglers, a submarine named Bigfoot sits outside the Naval Air Station Key West in Florida, soaking up the sun and being scrutinised by passers-by.

Forty-nine feet long, made of steel and remarkably high-tech, Bigfoot arrived in Florida via the ocean off Costa Rica, where it was snared in 2006 carrying four traffickers with AK-47s and three tonnes of cocaine.

It now serves as a physical reminder of what the US Coast Guard is up against – a new breed of smugglers' vessel, running silent and invisible in the vast ocean. ■

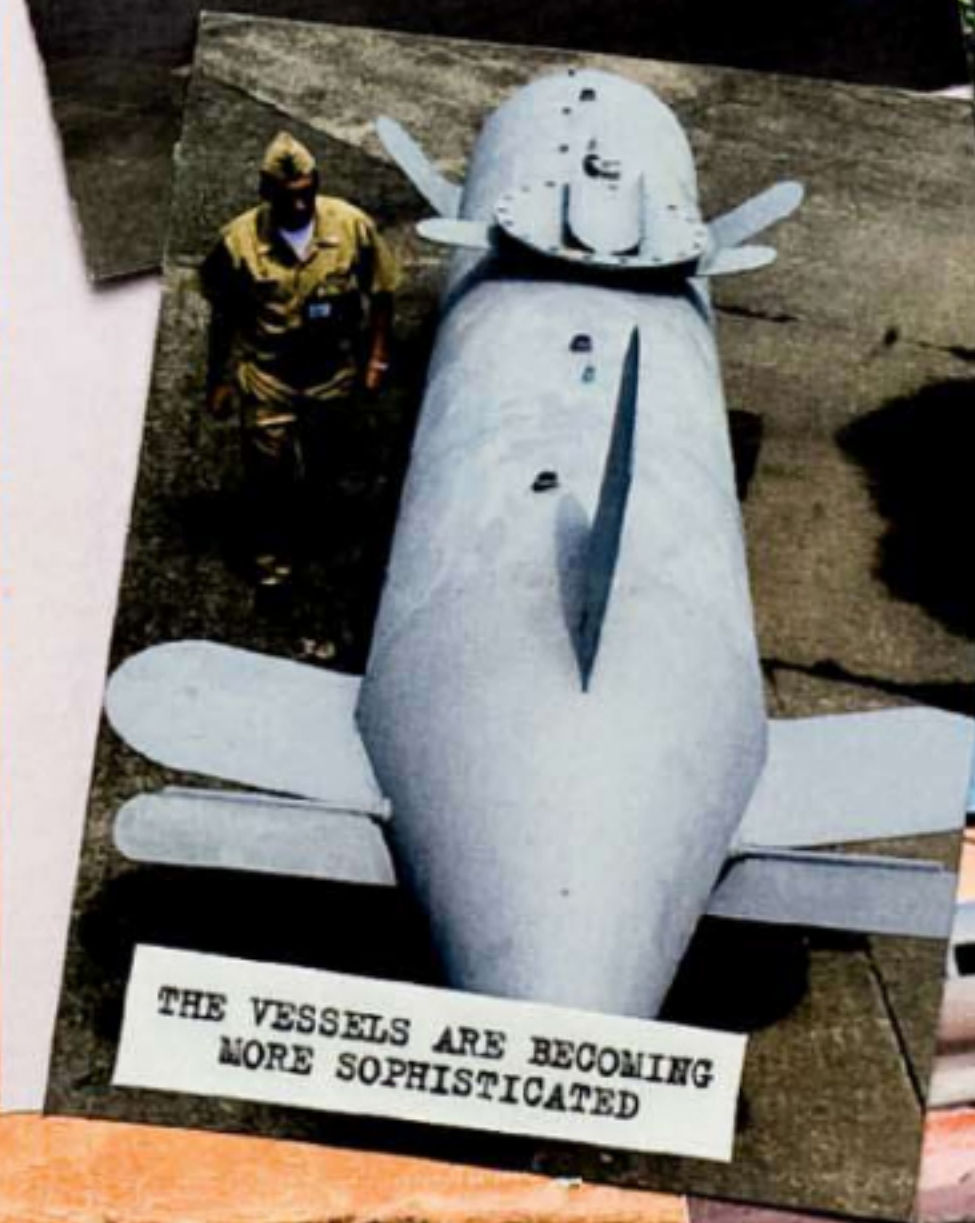
