Magnificent 2732bhp Merc!

Brilliant Bavarian tuner Mansory gives the SLS AMG a not-so-subtle nip and tuck!

- You might think there's nothing much wrong with a brand-new Mercedes SLS AMG. It's not exactly a Fiat Tipo, after all. But if you did think that, it would mean you're not one of the boffins at ace German tuning company Mansory, who clearly took one look at the car and thought, "Pah! We can make that oodles better! Oodles!"
- Besides having horny aullwing doors, the SLS was always fast. Bloody fast, actually. 0-62mph in 3.8 seconds and a top speed of 197mph, anyone? Mansory obviously don't find this impressive enough, though. No performance figures have been released into the wild but Mansory mechanics have bolted a supercharger, a sports air filter and new stainless exhaust onto the already snorting 563bhp to increase the lunacy to 732bhp. But it's the hike in torque from 480lb-ft to 609lb-ft that'll really give the driver and passenger a whack to the back like a sledgehammer in the spine.
- Being white, the Mansory SLS disguises its revised carbon fibre body-styling. Mansory's in-house carbon fibre gurus have given the Merc a new bare-weave, vented chin spoiler, front wing intakes, a heavily louvred bonnet and a debadged grille. Cool!

- At the other end, the rear spoiler, rear diffuser and exhaust outlet have all been given carbon detail. The bodyshell sits 20mm closer to the tarmac thanks to tweaked suspension. Each corner now has special forged, seven-spoke alloy rims - 9.5 x 20in up front and 11.5 x 21in at the back. Besides looking downright menacing, this also brings the Merc's kerb weight down below its original 1,620kg.
- The innards of the Mansory Merc are where things start to go a tad wrong. Lift the gullwing doors on this demo car and you're greeted by a fairly grim shade of blue leather with white piping throughout, which screams cruise liner rather than race car to us. Nevertheless, you can't fail to be impressed with the carbon fibre centre console, sculpted sports bucket seats and huge infotainment screen.
- To Mansory's credit, they've refrained from fitting some rear spoiler the size of a bungalow and wheels that look like they belong on a Vegas roulette table.
 We like. We like a lot.
 Until Merc bring out their £300k-plus 210mph hardcore special "Black Series" version later next year (which they will), this could well be the favourite flavour of glorious Germanic gullwing.







Two thumbs up for the surgeons, then! Well, one-and-a-half, in any case.



Wow, that's impressive singing! Thanks, Danica. Finally, then, what advice would you give to our readers if they wanted to impress you?

Money and flash cars really don't impress me at all. Just treat me really nice and with respect! A lot of people say you've got to treat them mean to keep them keen, but I don't play games!

When you
first went out "in the
field" as a sniper, how
did you feel?

Confident. The training's tougher than standard Army training. You have to run faster and shoot better. Only two or three people from about an initial 30 make it.

What did you feel after your first kill? Nothing, except that I'd done my job well. Certain thoughts can occur when you realise the man you've shot is someone's son and maybe someone's father, but if I lost my concentration

someone's son and maybe someone's father, but if I lost my concentration and a member of my team got killed, that's when real guilt would kick in.

How do you cope knowing you're the last person who'll see your target alive? It's not something that you can think about. If you think like that, you might lose your concentration and endanger the lives of your fellow men.

Is there psychological pressure?

Yes. When I left the Army I was a van driver for a while. About a year on,

a stone bounced against my

windscreen and it brought it all back. I started seeing silhouettes out of the corner of my eyes, I couldn't sleep and had flashbacks. I was diagnosed with post-traumatic stress disorder.

Do you ever build up any sort of relationship with your target?

No. In Afghanistan, you're never tracking somebody for days. You see the man and take him out. When we were training, though, we'd have to spend 48 hours just waiting it out.

Can you describe an actual mission? In Helmand in 2007, I was supporting

In Helmand in 2007, I was supporting a rifle company. We were in some bushes, looking onto some poppy



fields, where it looked like five guys were tending crops. They suddenly rolled over a pile of poppies to reveal AK-47s and RPGs and began a rear ambush. On the count of five, our team fired and all five men went down.

Do you get a call about a target and go to the location or hunt the target down?

If we were in a defensive role, our job was to go to where the enemy's engaged. The Taliban are very good at knowing where you are, so often we were being reactive rather than proactive. The situation can change quickly. Often our mission would change because of a Taliban ambush.

How do you guys move around?

We're trained to travel at night, but in Afghanistan, the situation changes so frequently that we often travelled during the day. Often, we were embedded with a platoon, though, which made us harder to identify. It was simply considered too unsafe for snipers to travel independently.

Do you work in pairs with a "spotter" and how close do you become?

We're always in pairs with a spotter. With the 1st Battalion Royal Anglian there were two snipers and two spotters. You become extremely close.


Are you left on your own to do your job then make your way back alone?

There's always a plan – you'd never leave somebody completely on their own if the situation got out of hand.

What's the hardest shot you've made?

I shot a Taliban from a kilometre once. I was in a village in Helmand with my L-96 rifle and there were two or three of them near a building. I couldn't believe it when I got the man from 1,000 metres. That felt good.






It's been a great year. I've done two series of *The Real Hustle*, my own beauty show on BBC3, got two little puppies and done loads of sexy shoots!


What's the most ridiculous thing you've heard about yourself this year?
