In this month's Music File, I have the distinct honour of profiling, Mark Pickerel, an artist with a quite extensive and somewhat unusual career path and a musician for whom I have a great respect.

ark was the original drummer and founding member of the band Screaming Trees who formed in the mid-eighties in the small eastern Washington town of Ellensburg. They were a heavy yet psychedelic band very reminiscent of that esoteric underground 60's sound with a more modern edge. Screaming Trees were responsible for their fair share of what became known to outsiders as, the "Seattle Sound" (and that other word) which became a prevalent influence in many non-Seattle bands throughout the '90s.

After six album tenure with the Trees, Mark teamed up with Soundgarden original bassist, Hiro Yamamoto and Rob Roth in '91 to form Truly who put out a few critically acclaimed releases between '91 and '97. Such as, the 'Heart and Lungs' EP and 'Fast Stories...of Kid Coma' which recently came in #3 on Alternative Nation's 'Most Underrated Alternative Albums of the 90s'. My band in '91 Unearth has the pleasure of sharing a mutual friend's living room as a rehearsal space. Sometimes we'd be breaking down as they were setting up and me and my mates would be outside having a smoke and listening to hammer out this tasteful blend of heavy and lush sounds and wonder "Why haven't these guys blown up yet?"

Pickerel has recorded tracks with such prominent musicians as, Nirvana's Krist Novoselic and Kurt Co-







bain and former Trees bandmate, Mark Lanegan on the Lead Belly cover 'Where Did You Sleep Last Night?' which was featured on Lanegan's first solo album. He has also done session work with notables like, Neko Case, Steve Fisk, Jim Carroll and Pigeonhead

Mark is a multi-talented musician and in 1999 he stepped out from behind the drums to exercise those other facets with his first solo endeavor The Dark Fantastic where he took on guitar, vocal and percussion duties for a '99 self-titled release and 2001's 'Goodbye Crooked Scar'. In 2004 he began collaboration on his most recent musical love-child with the namesake, Mark Pickerel & His Pray-

ing Hands with their 2006 debut release of 'Snake In The Radio'. This is dark horse Amercana alt-rock at its finest. It's like listening to a David Lynch film in many ways, as a matter of fact, a Lynch directed video would be the perfect audio/ visual cocktail. With two more additional releases - 'Cody's Dream' (2009) and most recently 'Tess' 92013) I'm positive we have not heard the last of Mr. Pickerel's sonic offerings. If you have not pleasured your ear holes with any of the aforementioned, I highly suggest you indulge yourself in any or all of these audio delights. Be sure to catch Mark Pickerell & His Praying Hands performing on Dave Grohl's new HBO series Sonic Highways.

# **On The Record**

I recently had the opportunity for some e-Q&A with Mark and ask some hard-hitting, fact probing...thought provoking....okay, they're just casual yet interesting questions. Here are the results.

#### How old were you when you realised you absolutely had to do music and what major influence(s) jump-started that drive?

Well the first artists that I remember having a real emotional response or reaction to were Creedence Clearwater, The Beatles and Elton John. Now I was only around 4 or 5 years old so at the time I had no concept of how any of this music was created, it was probably a couple of years later when I discovered Kiss, who's visual dimension and who's televised performances had the kind of impact on my young and impressionable mind that launched an all out obsession with music and inspired a devotion to become associated with music in any way, shape or form. Around the age of nine or ten I was at a friends house who's older brother who was in the high school marching band had a snare drum set up in the living room, after gaining permission to give it a few whacks, I was hooked. I signed up for school band the next year and picked drums as my instrument, partly due to my experience with the snare drum but also because it was the only instrument listed as an option that I'd ever known to be associated with rock and roll besides the sax, but there was no sax in KISS so the choice was obvious!

#### So, you're mostly known for being a solid but fluid drummer; when did you venture into singing, song writing and guitar?

In my mid twenties, I was growing frustrated with the "profession" of drumming, I still had love for the craft but it became clear to me that as a drummer, you are almost always in a submissive or supportive position to someone else's goals, work ethic, schedule, changing vision etc. The lack of control over my own career path was becoming really frustrating and I was also saddened and discouraged by the amount of drug use that I was witnessing all around me and the destruction and in some cases, death that it was causing, this was hitting me on a couple of different levels. On one hand, I was so sad and angry to see the creative people who I loved around me falling victim to addiction and I could also see that as a drummer who was dependent on these same individuals to keep me active and working, I was going to have to become self sufficient and that meant learning to play guitar and to sing out of necessity. I quickly discovered that I loved the process and how it allowed for so much more growth and self discovery than playing the drums did. I now depend on the creative process the same way some depend on meditation, yoga, prayer or DRUGS!

I'm almost positive there has to be quite the list but, spanning your entire music career, what's on a short list of most memorable moments and/or performances?

Here's a couple of memories from various tours.

Having to clean what seemed like a gallon of fake blood off my drums after the Screaming Trees shared a stage with Gwar on Halloween in NYC back in the late 80's

I remember having to pull Peter Buck off of a pile of guys who were all beating up on ONE quy in Toronto after I'd opened up for Robyn Hitchcock and The Venus 3, Peter jumped in to try and protect someone who got jumped by a bunch of hoods, Peter kept yelling "It's not a fair fight!" I remember thinking how none of these guys will ever even know that the guitar player from R.E.M. just broke up their fight! I remember how Van Conner of The Screaming Trees used to love to torment his older brother Gary Lee during long drives by constantly lighting single hairs of his on fire from the seat behind him, just to keep things interesting and entertaining for the rest of us.

I remember working on Truly recordings when the last big earthquake rocked Seattle.

And of course I'm proud and honored just to have shared the stage with so many amaz-

ing bands, Nirvana, Soundgarden, Neko Case, Meat Puppets, X, Dinosaur Jr, Ray Davies, The Sonics, Mudhoney, The Yeah Yeah Yeah's, Alex Chilton, Brandi Carlile, Robyn Hitchcock, Stan Ridgeway as well as countless others.

#### Growing up we all had one, who was your first TV star crush?

Catwoman, and I wish I could say that it was Eartha Kitt as Catwoman that dominated my dreams because now that I'm much older, I recognize how beautiful and talented she was on so many different levels but I'm afraid it was Julie Newmar who also starred in the original Batman series of the 1960's who stole my heart at such a young age.

FGM: Mine were Elizabeth Montgomery (Samantha from Bewitched) and Dawn Wells (Marianne from Gilligan's Island) and Muareen McCormick (Marcia from The Brady Bunch)

#### Being a man of many talents, have you ever considered doing the crossover thing into some film roles?

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# THE COWARDICE of Climate Change Denialism

ore than 300,000 people turned out the People's Climate March on September 20, aimed at mobilizing people to demand action on climate change. The march was the largest event ever raising awareness and calling for serious policy changes in order to prevent the worst effects of manmade climate change. People from all over the country attended, demonstrating that there is a genuine and passionate concern about the issue.

In some corners, anyway.

I endeavored to avoid the commentary from the denialists that I knew would accompany the march would engender. Climate change denialists are a deranged bunch. It doesn't suffice for them to deny that the planet has warmed, and continues to warm, considerably since the Industrial Revolution, thanks to our burning of fossil fuels and our pumping of greenhouse gases into the atmosphere. Theirs is not a casual denialism. It's not merely that they're shrugging their shoulders and denying the problem then going about their lives. No, they are apoplectically angry at the very idea of anthropogenic climate change and the people who acknowledge that it's a reality. I have frequently seen comparisons to the scene in "Eric the Viking" where Hy-Brasil is sinking, and Eric and others are

trying to warn people of the dangers. The denizens in Hy-Brasil deny that anything is amiss, even as they descend below the waves.

It's not a very good analogy. In contrast to the citizens of Hy-Brasil, who chuckle and dismiss the notion of any danger, denialists become enraged when anyone talks about climate change. For the analogy to work, the denizens of Hy-Brasil would have had to scream that the people warning them of the danger are "hippy faggots" or "social justice warriors" (a term popular among deranged fuckwits for people who aren't as sociopathic as themselves). That is their M.O. They shrilly attack not just the reality of climate change, but the people who have committed their lives to studying it and drawing attention to it. Mark Steyn, a completely warped degenerate who libelled climate scientist Michael E. Mann, is a perfect example. Steyn compared Mann to Jerry Sandusky and (more relevant to the Mann's libel suit) called his work in developing the famous "hockey-stick graph" fraudulent. (It was actually a comparatively tame posting for Steyn, who is known for conducting himself like a rabid animal a vast majority of the time).

So it goes with run-of-the-mill denialists as well. Raw Story's David Edwards wrote an article back in July about "coal rollers," who,

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in "protest" of proposed EPA regulations of carbon emissions, modify their trucks to spew large clouds of smoke through stacks installed on the trucks' beds. An anonymous seller of the smoke stacks exemplified the pathology and derangement of climate change denialists when he said, "You want clean air and a tiny carbon footprint? Well, screw you."

It requires some serious psychological damage to behave this way. I've often wondered how it is that people become so unhinged as to not only deny a scientific reality, but to become violently angry at those who acknowledge that reality. As I mentioned earlier, I had attempted to avoid any commentary from denialist circles about the People's Climate March, but I wound up catching Jon Stewart's coverage both of that event and of a Congressional hearing on climate change. There were the usually cringe-inducing clips of Congressmen (and they were all men at this hearing) wondering how it could be that, if our glasses don't overflow when the ice in them melts, the melting of the ice caps will raise sea levels.

The most telling one, though, and the thing to which I trace denialists' derangement, came at the end, when one Congressman accused climate scientists of employing "fear tactics" by highlighting the dangers of climate change. Stewart latched onto this, saying that this position boils down to, "It's unfair to talk to us about the scientific or medical consequences of our actions because they're scary."

Stewart is right on the mark, and this is what I've long felt is at the root of denialists' lunacy. It is, in fact, scary to look at the impact that our pumping greenhouse gases into the atmosphere is having. It's scary to contemplate what the future holds if we do not slow our burning of fossil fuels. It's painful to acknowledge that our lifestyles and consumption habits contribute to this, and to realize that we have to sacrifice some of our luxuries in order to deal with this urgent problem. It's tempting to turn away from the problem, to pretend that it's not as severe as climatologists are telling us it is, and to listen to the soothing lies from denialist organizations like The Heart-







land Institute and American Enterprise Institute. But you know what? It's the fucking reality, and denying it makes you a coward.

This, I think, is the basis of climate change denialism: Cowardice. Denialists are afraid. Profoundly afraid. But rather than deal with their fears like human beings, they run away and deny that there's even a problem. And more than that, they become angry at people who discuss it, because they're such god damned pussies about facing reality that any reminder of it turns them into howling animals. They become enraged when faced with scientific reality. Climate change denialism isn't merely ignorance or a political position, it's a mental illness. Denialists are so afraid of reality that they behave irrationally, not only supporting policies that ensure the continued burning of fossil fuels (a problem from which it's easier to distance one's self), but poisoning the immediate air that they and their friends and families breathe, as the "coal rollers" do.

It's alternately pitiable and contemptible. People with mental illnesses are suffering and deserve help. But, unlike someone with a physiological disorder that results in mental illness, denialists elected to walk down that path by running away from reality. And, unlike most mentally-ill people who pose no threat to their communities and humanity at large, denialists are dragging the rest of us toward a global ecological meltdown, just because they're too cowardly to acknowledge reality. They represent an immediate danger to the rest of us, and need to be confronted as one.
