





The American Pie star talks ice-hockey fights, meeting AC Milan and his Oscar chances!



Hi Seann! You're in Goon, a comedy about ice hockey.

Is that going to appeal to British audiences?

I play Doug "The Thug" Glatt, a dumb but loveable guy who quits his job as a nightclub bouncer to become the enforcer on his local hockey team. The only thing he's good at is fighting. It's like he's been touched by the fist of God!

How much training was involved before you could get physical on the ice?

I had a month to learn how to skate... badly. But we just got out there, started shooting and kicked some ass! On my first day, the stunt dude was like, "You guys are gonna throw five right crosses, he's gonna throw four to you, you're gonna give him an uppercut, head-butt him and crash him against the boards before knocking him out. You good to go?" I'm like, "F**k!"

Did anyone get hit for real?

It was as violent as you could get filming a fight for a movie. Normally, it's two punches and then you cut for another angle, but this was way more intense! The guys I was facing off with were all ex-hockey players. Most of them wanted to get hit for real!

Which sport could be improved by a good ruck?

I like baseball, but the games can last forever so it would be nice to see both teams beat the sh*t out of each other!

What can we expect from the American Pie sequel American Reunion?



1,088bhp electric supercar!

It's the Concept_One, a Croatian corker!

- The Rimac Concept_One is the latest contender in the ever-serious world of electric hypercars. We like it a lot.
- Just looking at the spec of this thing is enough to make doubters think twice about 'leccy performance cars having an exciting future. Veyron pilots have every reason to go a bit pale.
- The Concept_One is a fully electric hypercar made by Croatian company Rimac. It not only looks pretty damned chiselled but it promises to chase down its internal combustion-engined rivals.
- The Concept_One's looks were inspired by a tie.
 There, we said it. The design of the huge intake ducts

down each side draw their shapes from the sort of neckwear your dad would have worn in the '70s. By leaving them bare carbon fibre, the motor gets a twotone look that sprawls the full length of each side. The ugly charging socket has been cleverly disguised next to a front-wing vent.

- Things are as tasteful inside as out, with Rimac resisting the temptation to go mental with shiny trinkets. The Concept_One's cockpit is minimalist, with a large centre console touchscreen doing away with much of the usual clumsy switchgear.
- The car's swooping twotone leather interior was



a special commission by upholstery experts Vilner, who trim everything from beds to yachts. The stitched hide is broken up by a carbon-fibre gauge binnacle and centre console surface.

- The Rimac gets its grunt from ten battery modules, which are arranged in three different locations – two up
- front, six in front of the rear axle, two behind the rear axle for weight distribution.
- The result is the electro equivalent of more than 1,000bhp, with maximum torque from zero right up to 12,000rpm. Despite weighing 1.6 tonnes, it's apparently still capable of a 373-mile range on one charge.
- Electric cars don't really require gearboxes and, in the case of this Rimac, you'll find one motor driving each wheel hub - which makes it a true four-wheel drive. As a result, traction is like stepping on a licked lollipop, with 62mph reached in just 2.8 seconds, while top speed is a seriously impressive 189mph.
- Although Rimac tells us the performance figures are provisional, we're not going to let this stifle the slackness of our jaws. This thing just looks stunning, as is the price – around £200k. Croatia now has more to boast than being the 18th most popular tourist destination in the world!






Stuart was rushed straight to hospital, where docs found








How long from the Scottish Highlands to South Wales? Five minutes'

BAE's chief test pilot Mark Bowman on an incredible life spent ripping up the skies!



NE OF Britain's most experienced fighter pilots is 50-year-old Mark Bowman. Since joining the RAF at 17, he's flown some of the world's most awesome fighter jets

in war zones including Afghanistan and Bosnia. He tells *Nuts* what it's like...

Hi Mark! What does it take to become an RAF fighter pilot?

You have to have incredible tenacity, a lot of ambition, great logic and control and excellent hand-to-eye co-ordination.

What's been your most incredible battle?

I can't tell you about specific incidents, but if you look at what the Typhoon [the fighter jet Mark flies] can do – going from 0 to 30,000 feet in a minute and being able to fly from the Scottish Highlands to South Wales in five minutes – it means just doing flights in the UK is incredible.

Surely you can tell us something?

I was test-flying a Harrier in the UK. I was firing air-to-air missiles against targets. They have a timer so that when they go off they don't pose a risk of damaging the aircraft I'm flying. I had one that went off the rails at 1,000 feet and just went bang. With bits of engine flying all over the place, I had to control the situation.

Have you ever found yourself in a situation you thought you'd never get out of?

Yes. Even just a couple of days ago on a training exercise there were moments when my jet and others came far too close for comfort, at incredible speeds! The Typhoon takes 5 mins to fly 700 miles - a 747 would need 90 mins!

How much training and how long does it take to become a fighter pilot?

You'd need five or six years in the UK to become combat ready, and then you have to have notched a few missions. You join up at 17 or 18 and the minimum commitment you can give is 12 years.

How cool is it to say you're a fighter pilot?

It's a dream come true! A tip to know if anybody you meet ever claims to be a fighter pilot is to look at their forearms. If they're marked with burst blood vessels from being up in the air at such speeds you know the person isn't bullsh*tting!



Is it a difficult or glamorous life?

There's a lot of travel and a lot of hours involved, and you have to really keep on top of yourself physically. I'm 50 and I still do an hour in the gym each day.

Have you ever been in a dogfight?

The technology's so advanced now that those kind of battles don't take place in modern warfare. It doesn't matter whereabouts on your radar the enemy plane is, you can still destroy it without any kind of chase sequence in a Typhoon.

How much is being a good fighter pilot down to talent and how much technology?

You do need talent, but the truth is that with the technology you have today it's easy to fly a fighter plane. You do still need somebody who can think and has good hand-to-stick coordination though.

Will we get helmets that read thoughts?

I'm not sure if that would be such a good idea! You need a human there so that in combat the right decisions are made.

Is there a physical sensation when you go through the sound barrier?

It depends on what you're flying.

In a Typhoon, you'll feel nothing –
it's just a read out on a screen. You're
going supersonic but you have so much
incredible equipment. The older planes,
like a Harrier, are different – you'll feel it.

Have you ever had to eject from a plane?

I've never had to yet, though I know pilots who've had to do it three times!




