185mph British supercar!

Classic British marque AC is back with the 378 GT Zagato!

- You may have heard the older blokes in your family get dewy-eyed when the words AC and Cobra are mentioned. And so they should. AC is one of the world's oldest car brands, and has been bolted to some of the best sports cars in history.
- Now the AC name has been revived by enthusiasts and the 378 GT uses a bodyshell from Italian coach builder Zagato – known for building quirky bodies for Aston Martin, Bentley, Alfa Romeo and even Ferrari.
- As the name subtly suggests, the Zag is a GT - a long-bonneted, sleek, two-door coupé with a slightly Ferrari-ish face and
- Aston side profile. It's a lot cheaper than either of the above, though. A third of the price of the new Aston V12 Zagato, and yet it shares similarities such as the "double bubble" roof.
- Beneath those several pairs of gill vents along the front wings lives something big, simple and capable of forcing wee out of you against your will. It's the identical 6.2-litre V8 used in the current Corvette C6, punching out an identical 434 horses.
- AC hasn't unveiled what the slick Italian body is made from, but with weight coming in at less than 1,500kg, 0-60







I know a couple of the guys, but without sounding snobby, we look at *The Only Way Is Essex* as sort of the Champions League, and the other shows aren't in the same league.


Do you think TOWIE will eventually get boring?


We introduce new characters every series.

Hi Jenson! How well have your preparations for

the new F1 season gone?

They've been excellent – the drivers and team have worked incredibly hard and I think it's all paid off. We have a car we believe will be more competitive than last season.

Is McLaren's new MP4-27 as good as people say?

We'll soon see, won't we? All I can say is that I think we're in a good place – better than last season. I think I did a decent job with that car but we just weren't good enough. Now, with the progress we've made, we should have a package to challenge for the World Championship. There's no aspect of the car I'm unhappy with.

What's different about it?

Without going into details, we've just looked at every aspect. I'm lower in the car, for a start, which I enjoy. It feels more a part of me.

So you fancy yourself for the Championship?

I have to. If you don't have a positive mental attitude you may as well go home. I want to experience that utter exhilaration of finishing number one again. In F1 it's all about the team, so to see all the guys you work with so closely go nuts when you win is something I can't wait to feel again. I want to do it for myself, my team, my friends and family.

You sound very determined! I'm hungry, yes. Winning is addictive.

Does the fact that McLaren have a strong car stoke up the rivalry between you and team-mate Lewis Hamilton?

Of course there's rivalry – we wouldn't be proper racers without it – but we're also team-mates and get on really well. On the track, we've had some fine battles and shown some great skills against one another, yet it never spills over into something stupid or dangerous. There's always respect for one another as drivers and human beings.

Any predictions for how the season will go?


You can't predict anything in F1, but one thing I do know is that it's going to be tremendously exciting. There are six world champions on the grid, all desperate to win again, all determined to fight for every single point. Last season had lots of fantastic racing and overtaking – this one could be even better, and if I end up as champion, I'll be one very happy boy.
