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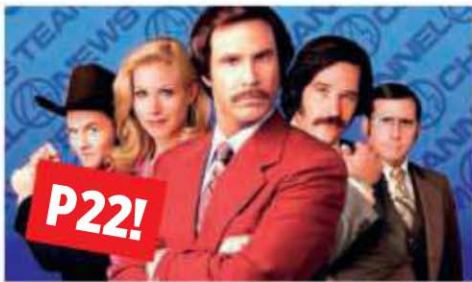
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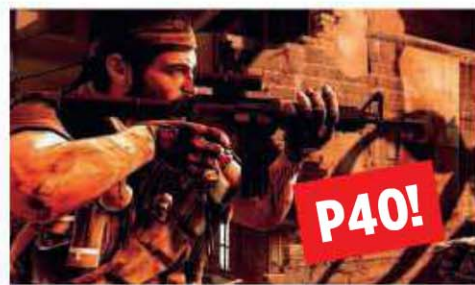
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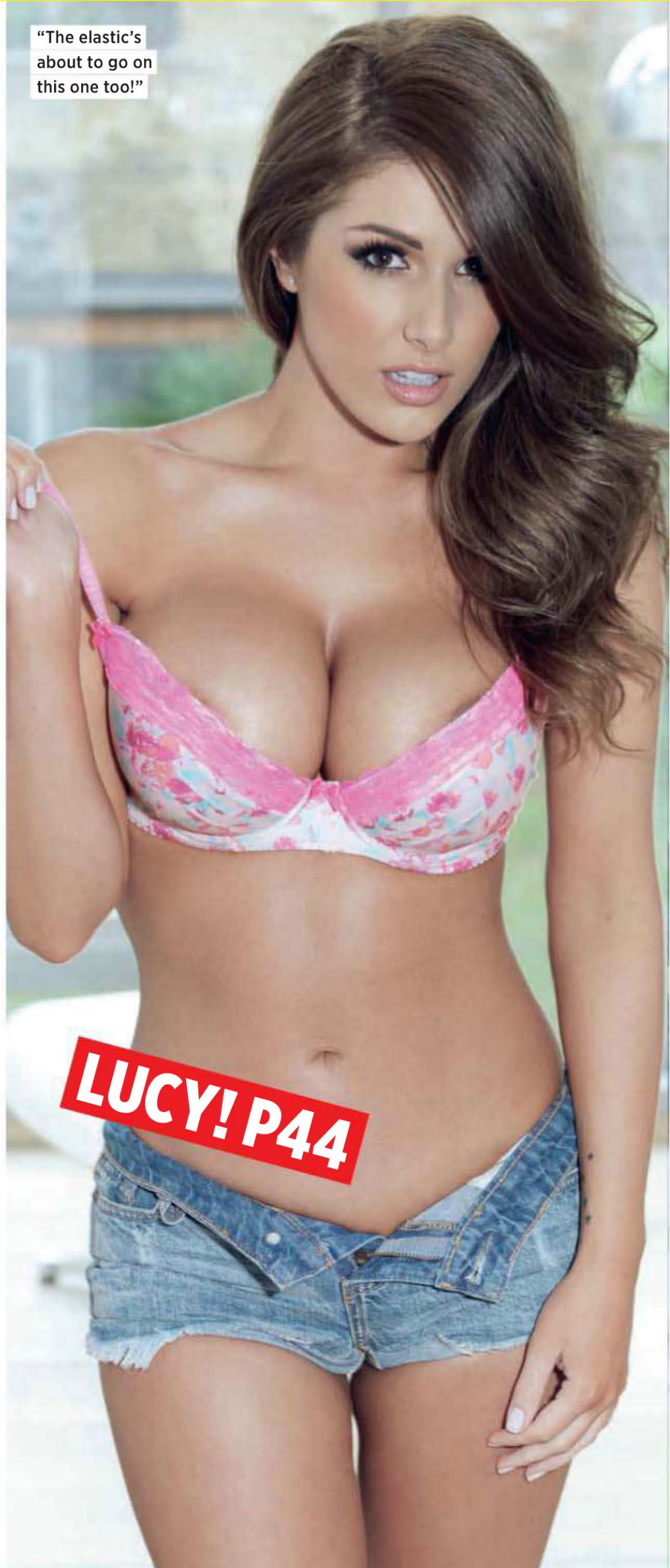

A quick word with Ricky Gervais

Ricky on his penis, Karl, Karl's penis, God, God's penis and his new TV show!



Hi Ricky! At one point in your new show *Derek*, you run

through a room stark naked with your bits pixelated out. Did you actually film this, ahem, "tackle out"?

No. I was wearing little pink pants. If I was naked, it would be difficult to pixelate because I'd be swinging like a kangaroo. It's all trickery. "Art is the lie that helps us understand the truth," said Picasso. And he was known for his massive knob!

Your character Derek isn't very bright. Are you worried about the backlash of portraying a character with learning difficulties?

Yeah. I'd be confused if there wasn't a backlash. Every week has been the end of my career, for 20 years. It started with a backlash! But I've never thought of Derek as disabled. He's cleverer than Baldrick [from *Blackadder*]. He's cleverer than Father

Dougal [from *Father Ted*]. He hasn't got a big a problem as Mr f**king Bean. Derek is a sweet character. He's selfless and unpretentious. He has to be to work in an old people's home. No one cares about old people in this country. There's an arrogance of youth. "Ha-ha, you're old." How can anyone say that? That's one thing that's definitely going to happen to you. He's protected in the safe haven of an old people's home; it's a fortress against an uncaring world.

Did you find it hard playing a sensitive character like Derek rather than a complete berk like David Brent in *The Office*?

There's nothing more fun than playing a deluded character. Everyone knows someone like David Brent. There are still three David Brents in every series of *The Apprentice*. Derek is a comedy drama but life is a comedy drama. You try to have a laugh then you find a lump. It's how you deal with it. I've snuck in drama before.

David Brent cried in *The Office*. Andy Millman cried in *Extras*. I've never been scared of emotions. The difference with Derek is that there's no irony. Derek is honest and kind. He's better than most of us.

Would you like to do more serious acting then?

Imagine me playing a hard-drinking cop who loses his badge and now he's got to get his wife back. "Look! It's the bloke from *The Office*." I've often said to directors who've cast me, "You can find someone better than me." They've looked at me like I'm mad. I think I could play demented and weird. I'd like to play a psychotic serial killer. *Dexter* would be good. Shakespeare would terrify me!

How did you persuade your chum Karl Pilkington to take on his first acting role in *Derek*?

I try lots of things, I see what he reacts to, then I work on that. This time I said, "Surely it's a challenge?" I knew if he did what I said, it'd be great. His part was written for him and some of the things I've written for him to say, he could well say. Not that you could predict anything he'd say. In an interview he famously said he'd donate his organs, but not his eyes because he'd hate to be a blind ghost. This came up. I said, "Would you donate your penis?" He said, "No." I said, "Why not?" He said, "I don't want anyone fiddling with that." Turns out he'd donate his testicles now! He said, "I don't need them. They get in the way. I'm not going to have kids. Someone else may as well use them." So I said, "You'd

lose the testicles?" He said, "I'd still have the knob."

Would you ever write Karl into a lead role of his own?

I don't know. If it was about a little bald Manc tw*t who said stupid f**king things, I think he'd stand a hell of a chance. He's finally signed the contract for *A Short Way Round* which is him cycling around the world with a dwarf in a basket. When I told him the idea, he didn't say, "That's ridiculous." He said, "So I'm doing all the f**king pedalling?" He signed the contract this week so he can't back out now – he's in too deep!

So after *Derek*, what's next?

I'm trying to get a new tour together, and I'm working on a new show about an atheist who goes to heaven. He's not so smug. Originally, I was going to create the show and take a step back from it. Now I've got a part in it and I've bigged my part up. I play God. It's a stretch.

You made God's part bigger?

Is that an innuendo? He must have a huge one. Ha!

Do you think Derek would believe in God?

I think he does. He likes Jesus. He thinks Jesus is cool because Jesus is kind. He doesn't see any problems. [Does impression] "My favourite is Jesus and Robbie Williams, because they're both kind to beggars." I'm riffing.

IT SURE IS PRETTY!

Borderlands 2 boasts a "cel-shaded" art style, so it looks like an animated cartoon. The visuals are genuinely incredible.



USE YOUR SKILLS!

Now there are role-playing game-style skill trees where you can upgrade and specialise your character.



FRANTIC ACTION!

Four-player online co-op is the best way to play. The enemies are toughened up and firefights become zingy pandemonium.



CHOOSE YOUR CLASS!

We played two of the four classes – a huge jock called “Gunzerker” and psychic “Siren”. There’s also a ninja assassin and a commando.

SPECIAL POWERS!

The Siren’s special power is levitating helpless enemies before filling them with lead. The Gunzerker can dual-wield.



AWESOME FIREFIGHTS!

Early on, we hit gun-totin’ robots. Tricky enough to take out alone, they then call in floating drones that recharge their health.

It's a Slovenian supercar!

And it's faster than an Audi R8!

● **Slovenia.** Famous for thermal springs, folk music, bear-inhabited forestry and... um... the oldest vine in the world (400 years old, fact fans). It isn't exactly supercar central. But there's a bloke called Aljosa Tushek who intends to change that.

● Because before your eyes is the awesome-looking Tushek Renovatio T500. Depending which angle you look at it from, there appears to be inspiration from many existing supercars. However, the Tushek has a chopped off-roof of a pick-up truck and a huge rear wing

that stands away from the body. But it really works.

● **Slovenia isn't known for being world-class at engine-building** so Tushek wisely paid a visit to Germany. The 4.2-litre V8 borrowed from Audi's forthcoming supercar-killing estate (the

RS4) punches out 444bhp. But when sitting in the Tushek's chrome-tube chassis and wrapped in a carbon fibre body, it's significantly quicker than even Audi's flagship R8.

● If you compare its vital stats to those of the V8 R8, the

Tushek is more powerful, a second faster to 62mph at 3.7 seconds, and boasting a top speed of 193mph, is 10mph faster at the top end. At 1,133kg it's a lot lighter than a 1,600kg R8 too, helped by everything being made from carbon-fibre composites.

- **The Renovatio's huge gaping mouth, slashed open bonnet, front arches and massive raked rear diffuser do more than hint that this is a track-focused motor.**

- Roll hoops stick out from the back of the passenger compartment, while the rear

lights are tunnelled right into the back panel. The 4.2 V8 breathes out through a pair of exhaust nostrils in the sculpted back bumper.

- **But don't dismiss this as a race toy. Beyond the scissor doors you're greeted with satnav, air-con, keyless**

entry, rear view camera and Bluetooth connectivity.

- In the words of Tushek, the T500 experience will be like "an exquisite night with a wonderful lover". Hmm! While waiting for a confirmed price tag, we'll just enjoy viewing the impressive styling.

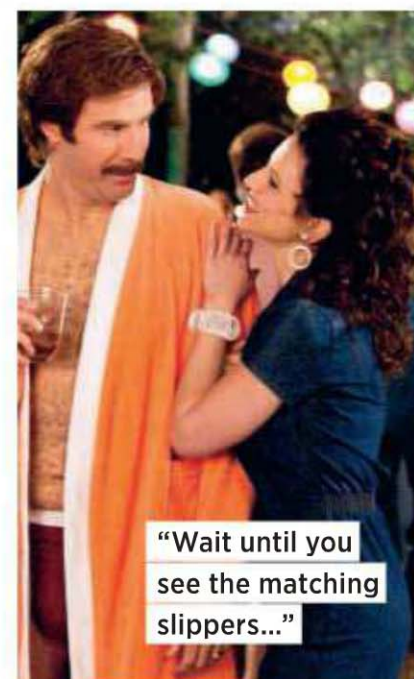

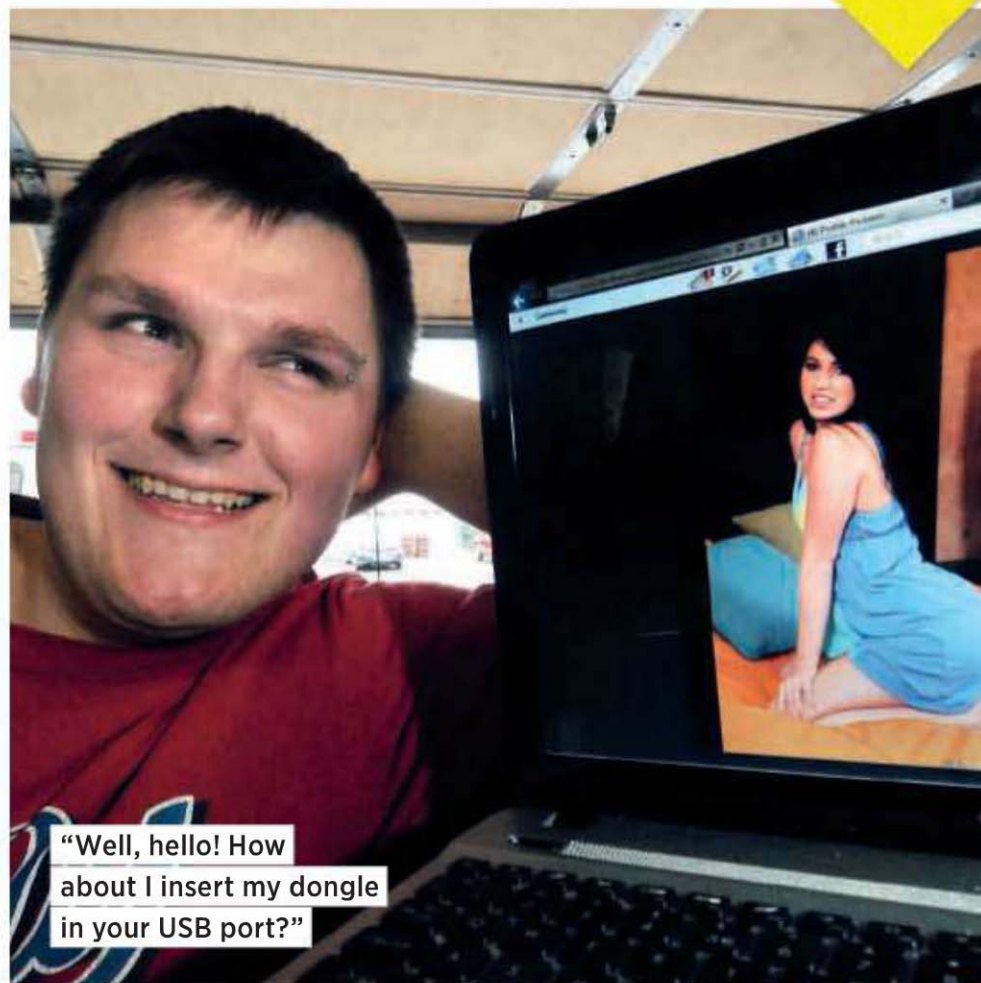


HE'S RUDE, RANTY AND RIOTOUS!

➔ **Hi Rory! How confident are you heading into this year's US Masters?**

I'm great, thanks! This should be one of the most exciting tournaments ever. I'm looking forward to it, without putting too much pressure on myself.

Do you have a point to prove after the trauma of last year?

No. I know I can play and compete at the highest level. But yeah, what happened was embarrassing and I admit to feeling bruised and upset. However, I knew I had to pick myself up and get on with things. I learnt a lot from the experience.

What did you learn from throwing away that massive lead on the last day?
