The beardy *Star Trek* actor on yoga, his goolies and sitting around in his pants!



Hi Simon! In your new film, you play a crime novelist so spooked

by the serial killers he's writing about that he spends most of the film sitting at home, utterly paranoid, in his pants.

Yes. It's an adaptation of a short story called Paranoid In The Launderette. I loved the way it was written and, as an actor, the character was a gift because I got to spend a lot of time in my pants. Who wouldn't want to come to work in their underwear and sit there all day? That was the biggest draw for me. Pardon the pun. Draws! Geddit?

Umm. Yes. Didn't the other

What's your favourite Simon Pegg film to date?

They're all my babies so I couldn't possibly choose. Paul was a huge one, as my daughter was born in the middle of it. Shaun Of The Dead was a huge one, as it was our first film and I've just done Star Trek 2, which was the most fun ever. I guess I'll say Shaun Of The Dead as it was the beginning of everything and I owe that film a lot. It was tough. We were making a film without much money. We didn't know if it was going to get released in the UK, let alone America. So I'll say Paul!

actors mind you sitting around in your pants between takes?

I don't think so. I sat in my special chair, which I take to jobs. It's a deck chair that reclines. I just sat in my pants and a cashmere sweater and relaxed. It was delightful. The first time, people were like, "Weird!" After that, nobody batted an eyelid.

Pants aside, your character, Jack, looks rather dishevelled. How did you prepare?

I tried to get inside the mind of a guy who's not left his house for three weeks. We wanted Jack to have that rakish, dishevelled look of a smart person down on his luck. I was instructed not to shave or cut my nails. My nails were like talons. They used to jam dirt under them every day. And I lost a lot of weight.

Blimey. How much?

Forty pounds. Oh, I don't know. I'd come off the back of Mission: Impossible - Ghost Your character is obsessed with people trying to murder him. What are you most obsessed with in real life? Carrie Fisher's arse [Princess Leia from the original Star Wars films - Nuts' Film Ed]. It's hard to beat.

There's a chance. We start shooting next year. Alright?

Industry of the secret of the

Pathfinder Captain David Blakeley talks to *Nuts* about the secretive elite unit of the British Army he served with

40 Nuts

BEHIND ENEMY LINES



ello David. The 16 Air Assault Brigade Pathfinder Platoon is shrouded in mystery. What can you tell us about it?

The motto of the unit is "First in" because often we go into hostile environments before anyone else. Our origins go back to the Second World War, when military commanders realised you need to have someone on the ground to recce enemy targets before you send in thousands of soldiers. In the '80s, some SAS guys decided they needed a special reconnaissance unit to go in before them, like during the Second World War. Some SAS guys and the best guys in the Parachute Regiment basically got together, pulled the top people in and formed the selection process.

What's it like parachuting into enemy territory from high altitude?

It's f**king awesome! We use the Halo technique. You stand at the back of an aircraft, a ramp comes down, there's a big screeching noise and then it's like an amphitheatre and you can see out into the desert. You have your oxygen mask on and your rifle strapped to your side, along with your pistol.

Were you expecting trouble?

The intelligence was that there shouldn't be any enemy forces in the area, but it was wrong. There were Iraqi forces there in their thousands, and only nine of us. There were Republican Guard, the Fedayeen – the fanatical paramilitary-type fighters – and they had secret police there, too.

How did you avoid detection?

We looked a bit like Iraqi forces because we don't wear uniform and we drive similar vehicles. We were just trying to look inconspicuous, but a secret police guy spotted us. He called in for fire on his radio. Mortars started coming in, which were getting closer and closer to our convoy. We hid in the undergrowth and waited with our machine guns. We couldn't go west because the undergrowth was too thick for the vehicles. We couldn't go north because we'd spotted about 200





you can feel the vehicle getting hit. We had to carry on, all guns blazing. One bullet came right through the car and ripped through my trousers! Jason in the lead vehicle was throwing smoke bombs to mask us. So we got through the first ambush, only to then drive through a further three. We got ambushed by three minibuses full of Fedayeen soldiers, which we just had to open fire on and move past. There were bodies hanging out of them everywhere. At one point, a rocketpropelled grenade went right over the vehicle in front. And then one skimmed over our bonnet! A few centimetres difference and our Land Rovers would have been blown up.

Tell us about the mission you were on that went wrong in 2003.

In the first few days of the Iraq War, the US Marines were pushing through into Baghdad, as were the British. The mission was to send me and my team of eight Pathfinders to recce Qalat Sikar Airfield and mark a dropzone for the paras. I wanted to do the Halo drop in but senior military didn't want us parachuting, so we had to drive in through the Nazaria area. I guess the advantages were speed and firepower.



Fedayeen fighters who were looking for us. We couldn't go south because there were thousands of enemy fighters. The only other way out was blocked by a canal. We're totally f**ked. We looked to abandon the vehicles and carry on to the airfield on foot. But we decided that if we were to continue on foot, we'd get captured. And if you get captured, you get tortured and executed. So we decided to keep the vehicles and fight our way back to the front line. It was an insane plan, but we hoped the Iraqis weren't expecting it.

What about air support?

I radioed to higher command. Straight away, I'm told there's no air support available. I was f**king gutted.

Weren't you worried about ambushes?

Well, after about three miles driving, we spotted an abandoned taxi and all of a sudden, its hazard lights came on. We knew this meant the first ambush was coming – it's a signal. Next thing, a barrage of enemy fire opens up. It's at night so all you can see are bullets with tracers flying everywhere, and

Miraculously, your unit all made it back alive. What did your mission achieve?

When we got back to the front line, we knew where all these Iraqi positions were. We passed this incredible intelligence to the Americans, who were able to launch a massive air strike. I believe that because of our mission, we saved many American

lives and helped change the course of the war.
