4 Mills' star has risen



5 It's set in Istanbul



It's got over 1,000bhp and a body to shame a Ferrari!

- Well, it certainly makes a change from waxed lady gardens, rainforestry, football and the odd drug cartel. This is Brazil's first stab at a supercar, called the AmoritzGT DoniRosset.
- The "challenging" name? Well, entrepreneur William Denis Rosset approached the car's designer/ company owner Fernando Morita, as he wanted to create a unique supercar as a birthday present for his dad Donino "Doni" Rosset. This is the result. Socks weren't going to cut it, it seems.
- The Brazilian-designed motor looks nothing short of intergalactic. The

front has a whiff of Ferrari 458, and there are many Lamborghini related aspects, especially in profile. The back end is dominated by two giant diffusers and, between the LED rear light clusters, five exhaust pipes mounted way higher than the rear numberplate. It's not a fussy design, just a jolly confident one.

The entire bodyshell is carbon fibre, covering a tubular aluminium spaceframe, while the 8.4-litre V10 engine lives under a glass panel. Said engine once spent time under the front of a Dodge Viper SRT10, but in a car this exotic, it was wisely mounted in front of the rear wheels.

CRAIG SUMMERS IS A MEDIA **BODYGUARD, HIS WORK TAKES HIM TO SOME OF** THE WORLD'S **MOST VOLATILE PLACES. HERE HE TELLS NUTS** HIS STORY...

> ello Craig. Can you explain to us what your role as a bodyguard involves?

I have to be a jack of all trades. I look after media personalities and camera crews when they visit dangerous places. I have to do everything from logistics to making sure the crews are safe.

How did you get into this work?

I left the military in 2000 and was looking for the next thing to do. I got a phone call one day asking if I fancied working on the May Day protests, looking after a news crew who were covering it. I had to pull my cameraman out of a few scuffles and that's when I got a taster for working in the media and seeing what it could be like.

How did you end up working in various war zones?

I got a call just before Christmas 2000 from the BBC asking me to join their foreign planning desk. Once I established myself there, I knew that was where I wanted to be. I got into the habit of banging on desks, asking when they next needed me. There was a bit of hassle going on in Iraq, so we got sent out there.

Are you armed when you get sent to these places?

We were armed in Baghdad but around the rest of the world we weren't. You're working on your own skill set. It's a double-edged sword. If you carry a weapon, can you really say you're a journalist? We've been in situations where we've come to check points and having a weapon will drop you in it. But in 2004, at the height of the kidnappings in

Iraq, we were armed and trained to deal with kidnap situations.

Can you tell us more about the work you did protecting the legendary war reporter John Simpson?

After 9/11, I found myself working more and more in places like Afghanistan, Pakistan and Iraq. It was the turning point. In 2003 I got a call from a senior producer at the BBC who asked me to leave with them at short notice to work on a documentary for Panorama about the situation in Iraq. I was to escort John Simpson and a crew to Baghdad.

Is this when your crew was almost blown up?

Yes, this was the now quite famous "friendly fire" incident in which the Americans dropped a bomb on us. I recall a plane came around everyone was looking up and then we all saw this huge bomb coming towards us in that split second. My cameraman was about 20 yards away from the bomb and the impact knocked me to the floor. I thought

I was dead. I knew what had happened but I just couldn't get my orientation. The man to my right was dead because he took the blast coming our way.

Was your team accounted for?

Well, I got up, ran to the front of the car and got everyone behind the bank, as I could see that the plane was coming around. I then ran through the burning

scene, looking for my cameramen and our producer, Cameron. The cameramen were OK but we couldn't find Cameron. When we eventually did, we found his leg had been blown off. I called an American medic who told us the blast had caused some internal injuries. Sadly, he died on the way to the hospital.

Of all the places you've been sent to, where has been the worst?

The 2004 Indian Ocean tsunami was one of the most horrific experiences. I was there in more of a logistics capacity rather than being a bodyguard, and the challenge was to keep a team of 20 BBC reporters

safe in among the worst conditions. There were dead bodies piled everywhere in the streets.

You infiltrated some football hooligans at Euro 2000 in Belgium. What was that like?

I was doing an undercover programme for Panorama. We found ourselves right in the middle of an infamous incident in an Irish bar. We were in the pub when the police tear-gassed it. I found a way out but that really kept us on our toes for the rest of the trip. It's not the first time I've found myself adopting a disguise in the line of work. I did one job that involved spending a weekend with the Hell's Angels in Boston.

Thanks, Craig. Finally, has there ever been a point on a job where your cover has been blown?

No. One reason is the amount you drink. You're drinking, they're drinking, you're buying each other drinks. They become more p*ssed, you try to stretch the pints out by chucking bits when they're not

looking. You can end up looking like you've had ten pints, but really vou've only had five.


Redknapp should be at the Euros, but now he's out of a job!
