i Tom. What's an average day for you like? I usually train for six hours a day. I'll have a morning session, head home for lunch and then I'll be back at the pool. We do dry-land training as well as work in the pool so it's always varied. Then in the evenings, I'll chill out with my friends.

How's it feel to be so young with so much expectation heaped on you? I'm my toughest critic and I don't tend to read what's in the papers I just concentrate on training hard. At the end of the day, I have to go out there and dive to the best of my ability. I can't control anything else, but I can make sure that I'm in the best shape possible.

London must feel completely different to Beijing - now you're expected to challenge for gold, is it tough to deal with that pressure? I was 14 in Beijing so I've grown up a lot. I've got four more years of diving under my belt. I'm older now so my strength has increased - I can perform harder dives and have the opportunity to get higher scores. The support of the crowd in London is incredible!

The crowd were really behind you and Pete Waterfield last week in the synchronised 10m dive. Do you think that puts you under more pressure for the individual event? We've experienced what the crowd's like now so it's not going to be overwhelming.


I love diving, it's my passion. To be an athlete in any sport. I think you have to really enjoy it. Diving can take its toll on your body, so your career length quite often depends on how long vou can stav injurv free. Realistically early 30s is the oldest vou'd probably want to be diving competitively.

Are there any footballers who could move into diving?

Ha! I always know when there's been a lot of diving in a football game because I get lots of mentions on Twitter. I think it'd be funny to see some footballers dive off the boards.

If you weren't a diver. what would you be doing right now?

I'd have just finished my A-levels and might



have been looking to go to university. I've finished school for the year, but still have a couple of maths modules to finish off so I'm going back in September. I'm a bit of a perfectionist so if I'm going to do something, I try to do it properly. I used to be a bit naughty when I was younger, too, but most people go through that phase at school.

Have you seen that clip of Greg Louganis where he smashes his head on the board?

Yes and I've done it myself. twice! British diver Monique Gladding hit her head in Russia last year and knocked herself out. Seeing that was terrifying.

What does it feel like when you're standing there waiting to dive? Do you ever feel sick?

When I'm stood at the edge of the board I'm thinking about nothing else but the dive I'm about to complete. I get scared every time I go up on the 10m board - I have to check that there's water in the pool before I jump! Throwing yourself off a 10m board is a pretty unnatural thing to do.

What kind of reception do you get when people recognise you?

People are really friendly. They usually just come up to me and say good luck or shout, "Hi". It's quite strange, though, when girls just come up to you and scream in your face. I never really know what to do.

a balanced diet. For breakfast I might have a bowl of cereal or eggs on toast, for lunch some chicken salad or maybe in a wrap, and for dinner a bit of anything really as long as it is balanced.

Who are your all-time sporting heroes?

In diving, it's Alexandre Despatie, three-time World Champion and Olympic medallist, I also think Steve Redgrave's achievements are incredible, having won five gold medals in five different Games.

What do you do when vou're not diving?

I'm usually with my friends and family. I enjoy cooking. When it comes to music, a bit of everything is on my iPod, but I tend to listen to more upbeat stuff when I'm competing.

Are you a prankster? What's the funniest prank vou can share?

I don't take myself too seriously. I once covered a friend's car with cling film, which was quite funny.

Eight years ago, smuggler Nick Brewer was banged up in a tough Argentinian prison. Now reformed and back home, he tells Nuts his story... Nick is now a

i Nick. Tell us a bit about your life before smuggling.

I was a natural at skiing. By the

age of 15 I was in the England junior development ski team. I got sponsorships and lived in the French Alps. But at 18 I broke my back and lost my place in the team. I headed to the south of France, lived like a bum for six months and got into drugs.

How did you get involved in smuggling?

It started when I was 21. I was serving a prison sentence in London for smuggling 100kg of cannabis. While there, I was educated by crooks on how to smuggle properly. Ten days after my release I was back smuggling cannabis, and at the end of the '90s, I was smuggling cocaine.

How were you doing it?

I based myself in Argentina where I got into the logistics of container shipping. Cocaine was shipped by container to Europe where it was sold wholesale in London and Amsterdam.

What sort of money was involved?

I was dealing in quantities of £10million a time. I was working independently but I had a big gang behind me.

What was the lifestyle like?

reformed character

I owned a nightclub, restaurants, cars, boats, houses, flats, cash and jewellery. I was a crazy sportsman, a parachutist and into adrenaline sports.

But then it all came crashing down...

Yes. In 2002. I fell out with a colleague. They did the dirty on me and informed the drug squad in the UK. They then sent MI6 to spy on me. Ten of us were arrested in Buenos Aires in 2004. I spent threeand-a-half years on remand in Devoto prison.

And what was the outcome?

Me and my colleague were sentenced to ten years each, which is very low considering we had 200kg of cocaine.

Can you describe Devoto prison?

It was like hell. The prisoners were suffering from malnutrition. They had machetes, knives. You'd be lucky if you got a bed and the food was appalling.

What was the day-to-day routine like?

There's no routine. There are no cells it's open wings. Everything's done in gangs. If you get food, you share it. Every gang fought against each other.

Did you get involved in the gang fights?

You don't get a choice! You might be eating your food and someone will just come and take the food off your plate. You might be on the telephone and they come and start a fight with you.

Did vou see anvone die in prison?

God yeah. In a bad fight six, seven, eight people would go at the same time. four months it was not a nice experience. Just the howls and screams were awful.

Gladiatorial. Beds were taken to pieces. Prisoners would get spikes and strap them to broom handles to use as spears.

And the prison guards?

After the fighting, the riot squad would come in and beat the sh*t out of everyone with poles. If that didn't stop you, they'd come in with pump-action shotguns. The classic Devoto scar involved piercing you in the stomach with a spike.

How did you manage to get out?

In 2010, the Home Office and Argentine courts arranged to have me expelled. I was in Devoto for just under six years. I went into prison a multimillionaire and arrived in London with little over £300.

Did you consider getting back into smuggling after you were released?

No. All the fame and fortune I desired as a smuggler went. It doesn't interest me. I'm enjoying a very humble life now.


How do you feel about the drugs trade?


Drug abuse was rife. Witnessing the physical and mental effects on people changes you. People buying a bit of whatever for a night out have no idea of the misery they're funding.

Sylvester Stallone rallies a megamuscled cast as Jason Statham, Jet Li, Terry Crews, Randy Couture, Bruce Willis and Dolph Lundgren return, joined by Arnold Schwarzenegger (getting his fight on this time!), Jean-Claude Van Damme and Chuck Norris. That's a lot of testosterone!



The Rocky and Rambo star was inspired to create The Expendables by classic films like The Dirty Dozen and The Wild Bunch... "Back then our heroes were flesh and blood," says Stallone. "The Expendables put their lives on the line for a cause. They're not cartoon superheroes with superpowers..."

The film's title comes from Sly's line in Rambo 2, "You're expendable!" So what's the story this time round? Barney Ross and his team of mercenaries for hire lose one of their crew when a routine assignment goes Pete Tong. The film follows their quest for revenge. Get some!

The "Muscles from Brussels" Jean-Claude Van Damme plays the aptly named Vilain. Stallone explains: "He's hell-bent on destroying us. Eventually when Vilain and Barney meet one-on-one, it'll end up being a hellacious battle until the very end... like a heavyweight championship fight that you never thought would happen!"

Smoking Chinese actress Yu Nan (star of the *Matrix*-making Wachowski brothers' *Speed Racer*) plays the character Maggie and becomes the first female Expendable.

Jet Li is a practitioner of Tibetan Buddhism but on screen the mental calm gives way to carnage as the star of flicks like *Hero* unleashes his aerial wushu skills!

Liam Hemsworth (brother of *Thor* actor Chris Hemsworth) joins the cast as dead-eyed sniper Billy the Kid. Taylor Lautner from *Twilight* was considered for the role but we reckon Stallone made the right choice!

Sly and Arnie received treatment in the same hospital for their shoulder surgeries towards the end of shooting and Stallone still carries a metal plate after breaking his neck fighting Steve Austin on the first film!

They've put their bodies on the line for this!



Half a million dollars was spent building a real 114-metre railway bridge over the river Osam in Bulgaria and remains as part of their railway network.

Legendary martial artist and six-time undefeated World Karate Champion Chuck Norris answered Stallone's call coming out of retirement for the film. His character Booker is a nod to Chuck's 1978 action flick Good Guys Wear Black about a war vet on a mission to rescue his old comrades.



Shot in Bulgaria, Hong Kong and New Orleans with a budget of \$100m expect some awesome scenes, promises Sly: "Some of the caves in Bulgaria are so big you could fly a plane through them... and we do!"

British director Simon West knows his action onions bringing his behind-the-camera skills from action classics like Con Air, Lara Croft: Tomb Raider, Jason Statham's The Mechanic and Black Hawk Down.

EASONS WHY!

Their films have taken a combined total of £8bn at the box office, but it's the first time Schwarzenegger and Stallone have kicked ass together on screen. We can't wait!

While filming in Bulgaria, Arnie, in Governator mode, met with the Prime Minister awarding him the sword of Conan the Barbarian. We want one of those!

Terry Crews is reunited with his character Hale Caesar's weapon of choice – the AA-12 auto assault 12-gauge shotgun. Designed in 1972, it's one of the most powerful weapons in the world capable of delivering 300 rounds per minute!

Randy Couture (who plays Toll Road) came out of retirement to regain his title as UFC Heavyweight World Champion and fought on until he was 47. More proof that the stars of this film are hard as nails!

The film is full of deadpan oneliners. "I'm back!" bellows Arnie before complaining, "My shoe is bigger than this car!" Boom!

sly reckons it's the biggest action movie he's ever done.
"I thought if we get together all of these characters, present and past, and try to bring back a little of that hard-core action, that old time rock'n'roll, it would give audiences something that they haven't seen for a while..." With no muscle suits, prosthetics or CGI body enhancements, these guys are the real deal!

The film features some serious military tech! THE FA are


wasting time and effort policing what footballers say on Twitter, Emmanuel Frimpong and Rio Ferdinand being the latest to fall foul of the association over tweets.
