



- was a guest judge on the first episode of this series and, boy, was she scary! Did you think she went too far? Tulisa: I loved her. She tells the truth, so you can't knock her for it. There were points where I was thinking, "Did you have to be so honest?" But she's telling the truth. I think you'll either love her or hate her on the show. Louis: We all loved her. She's just saving what everyone else is thinking. That's why she's Scary Spice.

In one audition, a girl looked like she was going to climb down and deck you all. Do you ever fear for your safety?

Tulisa: I didn't fear for my safety. I feared for Louis! **Louis:** [Looking miffed] Why?

Tulisa: She looked like she had it in for you.

Louis: I tried to help her. We gave her two songs. She came out looking like Pink. Even [her dad who looked like] Tom Jones couldn't help her. She was a Pink look-alike. She looked like Pink. Will all the judges be falling out with each other this series?

Tulisa: I can't speak for the other guys but I'm always 100 per cent myself when I'm on the show. Anything I say is exactly what I'm thinking. I don't premeditate situations. Louis: We're very emotionally involved with our acts. That's why we fall out.

If it came down to fisticuffs between the judges, who'd win? Louis: I'm going to say Tulisa. Nicole: Tulisa has a big heart. I think Gary [Barlow] can be pretty tough sometimes, too. Dermot: Let's say Gary because he's not here.

There's always a lot of blubbing among contestants on *The X Factor*. Do you ever worry that someone might come on the show and have a fully blown mental breakdown just because you haven't put them through to the next round?

Tulisa: Thousands of people audition every year and there's always going to be one person who has a hissy fit. You can't go, "We need to think of the emotional stability of these people." That's one person with their own issues.

Are there any hotties we should look out for this series?

Tulisa: There are definitely some hot solo males!

Er, that's not exactly what we had in mind.

Louis: And I can think of at least two boy bands that you haven't seen yet.

Oh, well, we'll just have to keep our eyes peeled. Nicole, will you be doing anything different over here to what you did on The X Factor USA?

Nicole: I don't really know. Obviously, there's a different energy on the panel over here. And different contestants. And the judges are much nicer in the UK than in the US. Dermot: Where are you going with this? Oh, wait, Simon [Cowell] is in America, isn't he!

Louis, there were some pictures in the paper recently of Simon Cowell and Sinitta in a speedboat together. Does that mean the judges will be using Sinitta's house this year? Louis: I can't tell you that. I can't tell you anything, in fact. But I know whose houses we'll be using. You'll just have to watch the show!

Dermot: Which is the right answer, Louis.

Nicole, in the first show of the series, you described yourself as a "scary bitch underneath". How scary are you?

Nicole: I think what I meant was that I know what I'm looking for. There are never any excuses. Ultimately, I try to let people down gently and bring out the best in them. But at the end of the day, I know who has it and who doesn't.

This year's contestants are allowed to have managers. Isn't that cheating?

Tulisa: I don't know how many of them do because it's not a general question we ask them. But there has to be a change. Just because someone has a manager or experience in the music business doesn't mean that they're any less deserving to be on the show than a normal person who hasn't any experience. I had a manager for seven years before I got anywhere at all.

What do you say to people who say that *The X Factor* is turning into a soap opera? Louis: Soap opera? It's a talent show!

Tulisa: It's always going to be about the music but there will always be

but there will always be drama and fun. It's not just about the talent, it's about the connection with the audience, so you need to see every side of the person as they go though the competition. There's going to be drama, there's going to be tears and there's going to be laughs. That doesn't make the show any less credible. It's still about the music.

Finally, do you ever worry that people will get bored of watching the show?

Louis: Last year was still the second biggest series of *The X Factor*.

Tulisa: Last year, it was the second biggest show after the Royal Wedding. I'm not worried about it at all!


- Even though we're about to see the 500th episode here in the UK, 508 episodes have been aired in the US.
- The 500th episode is the 14th episode of the 23rd season and is called *At Long*
- At the beginning of the 499th episode, Springfield residents run into the Simpsons' living room to congratulate them on 500 episodes, but Lisa points out that they're an episode early.
- Special guests in the 500th episode include Kelsey Grammer as Sideshow Bob, Jackie Mason as Rabbi Krustofski and Julian Assange, the founder of WikiLeaks.

- To celebrate 500 episodes of the show in the US, Fox set out to break the Guinness World Record for the longest continuous television watching. A hundred fans of the show were invited to watch nothing but The Simpsons for as long as possible and two fans lasted for 86 hours and 37 minutes, breaking the record.
- Actors who provide the voices on the show are currently paid £400,000 per episode.

Lighter, more eco-friendly and the first model to surpass the £100k mark – we want one!

- The Range Rover may be 42 years old this year but it's still the go-to car for everyone from Premier League footballers to catwalk models, gangsters to royalty. The original luxury off-roader, it defined the "SUV" (sports-utility vehicle) genre. Everything else is just a copy of what the Range Rover created back in 1970.
- Well, after more than 18 months of rigorous testing, Land Rover has launched this brand-new version of its high-and-mighty 4x4. The big news is that it's shed 420kg of blubber, is much quieter than previous models and has become more eco-friendly.
- The huge diet (it's 39 per cent lighter than its predecessor) has been achieved by switching from a steel chassis to state-of-the-art aluminium-monocoque tech. This

- means a huge improvement in the Range Rover's miles-per-gallon ratio.
- There are several engines to choose from.
 Most Brits will likely opt for a diesel –
 either the 3.0-litre TDV6 or the 4.4-litre
 TDV8 but there will also be a 503bhp
 supercharged petrol V8 on the options
 menu. Great if you happen to work for
 BP, Shell or Texaco, or live in Saudi Arabia.
- The reduced weight means the car is happier going around corners. The new model gets revised air suspension all round and promises a less wallowy ride.
- It'll also be the quietest Range Rover ever. Thanks to upgraded soundproofing, special laminated glass and cleverly structured body panels, the new Range Rover's innards will be quieter than a closed library. But it's still boxy, which means a 0-60mph punt of 6.5 seconds and a top end of around 140mph.

- Inside, expect a new selection of leather hide, wood veneer and brushed aluminium, plus a Meridian audio system.
- Just like the baby Range Rover the Evoque - this model has had its roof height lowered and boasts slimmer headlights and wrap-around taillights. It wears very Evoque-esque 22in rims and, as with the Evoque, a contrasting coloured roof is an option.
- The front end is more raked back and less likely to inhale flies on the motorway, while the vertical side vents have moved from the front wings to the front doors.
- So what's the price for luxury? The base model will start at around £70k, but start ticking the options boxes and the showroom price will (for the first time) sail past £100,000. But that's still quite a bargain for what promises to be the must-have car of 2013.

She's butch!




What's next up for you? **Fancy running for Parliament?**

Hi Scott! Tell us how a Brummie goes on to have a crack at Hollywood stardom?

It's all I've ever wanted to do. Everyone around me would tell me to choose another profession, but there wasn't anything else I wanted to do!

What can you tell us about your role in The Expendables 2?

I play Hector, Jean-Claude Van Damme's right-hand man. We have our own army somewhere in Eastern Europe. We're not mercenaries, we're more like ex-army guys who've moved into organised crime. We get tangled up with The Expendables, who are there to hunt us down, and we're more than willing to take them on!

So it's just you and Jean-Claude kicking ass?

Absolutely! Me and Van Damme are the ass-kicking bad guys, and the rest of our army are these faceless goons!

Amazing! Did you have to bone up on your gun-toting skills? No, we've all done so much of it before that we just know what we're doing. It's a film with all the action stars, so we come on set and know exactly what we're doing with the guns and the fights and stuff.

So you do all the stunts yourselves?

Pretty much, but sometimes you just can't do all your own stunts – you might be off shooting something else whilst the other unit is picking up some of the fight stuff with other people. It's inevitable that stunt doubles will be used,

but we do most of it ourselves.

Was there any point during filming that any stunt scared you? What I

found really unnerving was a scene we had to shoot where a helicopter lands right behind our heads and the blades are insanely close to us. They're real blades, and the power is blowing me and Jean-Claude off our feet!

What was it like working with Van Damme?

He was an idol

of mine growing up, but I've worked on a film with him before. I think that helped with the chemistry of our characters in this film. But to be on set with all these action icons there was just amazing.

There must have been so many action heroes on set – who was the joker of the pack?

Arnold Schwarzenegger's a really funny guy! He doesn't take himself too seriously, you know. He's gone off and done his politics and you get the feeling that he's really enjoying being back into movies. It just

goes to show how popular he still is.

Has there ever been a point shooting a stunt where you've thought, "What am I playing at?" I did a film called El Gringo where I have to blow up a car. I'm standing right next to it. sticking a rag into the petrol tank and setting fire to it, then I have to walk away without looking back. But there's an uneasy feeling knowing that

the car is



stuffed with explosives! You start to think, "Hang on, who's pressing the button? Do I trust this guy?" But it's an action film, you're there and you just get on with it – even knowing a car could land on your head.

What's the key to a really great fight scene?

Good choreography is a must. If you don't film it right then no matter how good a fighter you are, it will look rubbish on screen. I see it time and time again in movies, and it can be the most disappointing thing ever if you're doing a fight but know it's not being filmed well. It's an art, and they do it best in Hong Kong.

Ever fancied using your MMA skills to have a pop at UFC? I never really fancied it as I knew that films were for me. If that was the road I wanted

If that was the road I wanted to take, I could've been good at it, but I won't sit here and tell you that I can do what the pro fighters do. It's a tough game! Also, you've not got to mind being punched in the face, and I'm far too vain for that!

Finally then, did any of The Expendables struggle with your proud Brummie accent?

It's still there, isn't it? It was much stronger when I was younger and I've had to change it a bit to avoid any confusion. But, let's be honest, the accent doesn't do you many favours – even in England. I remember a poll they once did that said the Birmingham accent was voted the most stupid sounding. Ha-ha!


The England legend picks his top transfer deals in the Prem
