




# **Deft leopard!**

# Insane Audi convertible!

The wind in hair, heart in your gob... This is the new convertible Audi RS5 – a 444bhp hairdryer!



- Audi convertibles have long been kind on the eyes, so it's no surprise the soft-top version of the flagship RS5 is a real head-turner.
- In 17 seconds, the RS5 goes from cosy, quiet hood-up status to topless audio studio with a screaming 4.2-litre hand-built V8 delivering 444bhp to all four wheels.
- Like the hardtop coupé, the RS5 cabriolet can call on the legendary Quattro system for a 40:60 power split. In fact, up to 70 per cent of the grunt can be dished out to the front axle, and 85 per cent to the rear.
- Earlier this year, the hardtop RS5 had a facelift, with

- sharper bonnet contours, tweaked bumpers, new tenspoke 19in rims, "solid band" wraparound LED running lights and LED rears. The RS5 cabriolet has all of the above, plus a roof that drops in 17 seconds at up to 31mph.
- If it rains, you could clog the V8 and savour the three-stage head-level and front seat heating, or put the roof up in 15 seconds.
- To stop this cabrio feeling as floppy as a four-week old cucumber, it sits 20mm lower and has had chubbier anti-roll bars and stiffer suspension mounts bolted up underneath. This adds 200kg to the weight, so



0-62mph happens in 4.9 seconds – 0.4 seconds slower than the coupé.

- To compensate, the RS5's front wings are made from aluminium. Peer through the wheels and you'll see radical flower-shaped mountain bike-style disc brakes. This reportedly shaves off 3kg, although carbon ceramic brakes do appear on the options list.
- With almost identical performance to the Porsche 911 Carrera cabriolet, the RS5 rag top costs over £8k less. And the sound of that V8 at 8,250rpm through the Hatfield Tunnel? Absobloody-lutely priceless!



### Thinner, lighter, faster and, well, just better

APPLE HAS finally lifted the lid on its iPhone 5 and Nuts was the first magazine to play with the most anticipated smartphone

It's thinner, lighter, has a taller 4in screen and packs the new A6 chip - twice as powerful as the A5 of the iPhone 4S. The new iOS 6 operating system includes Apple's own Maps app with free satnay gubbins.

since phones got smart.

You'll get upgraded "Ear Pods", and the usual iPhone connector has been ditched for a tiny one, but our fave feature is the "panorama" photo function and Shared Photo Streams, a kind of private Facebook that lets you "Like" those pics which aren't safe for work.

Apple is taking online pre-orders now before it drops into shops on 21 September - we're going to camp out to get ours, though. We like camping.

### **Verdict:**

A dream of a smartphone with a processor that will worry your games machine. It might cost £529 on Pay As You Go, but it makes rivals look ugly and weak when placed side by side.

Challenge me to a dance-off. I'd love that! Nothing too professional, though. I want to see some ridiculous dance moves. Bust out "the worm"!


### What's your sexiest outfit?

### London 2012 four-time Paralympic gold medallist on winning, fame and Ibiza...

i David! Was it always your ambition to race in front of millions of people? Yeah, you just dream about things like that. The Paralympics have been something special - to win in front of 80,000 people – but I wasn't scared by it. It was the home crowd that made it a privilege. Paralympic sport has grown so much this year and I felt we weren't getting as much recognition as other sports. People were going to see quality sport, they weren't thinking about disability. People weren't thinking, "Let's go and see these people in wheelchairs!" They were thinking, "Let's go and see some great action tonight!" You only get that in Britain because we're sport mad and want to see any kind of sport. That inspires me.

> When did you realise this was what you wanted to do with your life?

I didn't get many qualifications in school and I just felt sport was the way forward, really. Then I saw how great the 2000 Games in Sydney looked on TV and I was in floods of tears, wishing I was there. I didn't look back after that.

#### Tell us a bit about yourself and your background.

I'm 33, I've been racing since I was eight and I live on a South London council estate. Everyone has always known me on the estate and I don't feel any different - I've always felt like one of the boys and just done what they've done. I lived a normal life.

### Do athletes such as yourself enjoy the perks, money and lifestyle that able-bodied athletes do?

I can't say I've got a lot of money because I'm Lottery funded. I've got a few sponsors but I'm not going around in a big Rolls-Royce. I was never there for the money, I was there to do a job - win gold medals. I was waiting for that day for seven years.

### Do you feel that athletes such as yourself don't enjoy the same level of recognition as other athletes?

These Games have changed people's minds and made people realise these Paralympians are proper athletes, like the Olympians, like everyone else. They train as hard as everyone else and the media have got better as well. By the end, the press were 30-people deep on the track.

### Tell us about the technology behind vour wheelchair?

It's custom built and it costs £3,500 to build. It's not like a bike, where vou can adjust it. It's got carbon fibre wheels and it's about seven kilos - the chair has to feel like part of your body so I don't have any padding – I'm sitting on a carbon seat. I have a spare one in case I have a big crash, too.

### You have incredible upper body strength - do you

I never want to lift too much because vou get too bulky. We did one bench session with ten reps at 55kg, ten reps at 65kg, ten reps at 80kg and then I'd have a couple of minutes rest, then I'd start doing reps at 60kg

bench press a lot?

again. Then I'd do 20 chin-ups and I thought, "Jesus, this is killing me!"

### What did you make of Oscar Pistorius' comments about his some of his rivals' blade lengths?

I thought it was a bit sour at first -I think he was a little bit wrong and it made him look like he was a sore loser. He hasn't lost for nine years, so he probably didn't know how to react. He'll learn from that and try even harder now. He's apologised and I've got a lot of respect for him saying that.

### Personally, what was the greatest moment of the Games for you?

Winning four gold medals and seeing family and friends at the end of it was a great achievement - I made history. My family were supporting me all week and I've never had that before because I've always been on the end of the phone. I feel like I'm dreaming - I feel like I haven't done it yet then I wake up and I think it isn't real.

### What has the public's reaction been like?

The crowds were superb - we felt like we were on a level par with the Olympics for the first time ever. It was bloody awesome every day. I couldn't even hear my name against the cheers.

### Where do you go from here? The Paralympics in Rio 2016?

I haven't had time to think about that yet -I'm just going to enjoy my time off. I'm on a high still after what I've achieved, I didn't think it was possible. I'm off to Ibiza to spend some time with my mates - I keep saving to Emily [Weir's



girlfriend], can't we buy a villa out there?

### Any other events you fancy having a crack at?

I'd probably have a go at wheelchair basketball but I've so much experience at racing, I just want to get the next generation racing and put wheelchair racing on the map.

### Finally, David, where did vour "Weir Wolf" nickname come from?

Rick Edwards and the Channel 4 guys! After my first couple of finals. someone came up to me and showed me the masks people wear, then the media got hold of it and it went wild. Everyone howls at me - even in the street!



MAJOR RUSSELL LEWIS TELLS NUTS ABOUT HIS SIX-MONTH TOUR OF HELMAND



VER THE six months he led a company of Paratroopers on a tour of Helmand, Afghanistan, Major

Russell Lewis was shot at and and nearly blown up countless times. On his return in 2009, he was awarded the Military Cross for his leadership. Here he tells *Nuts* about leading 200 troops into that firestorm...

### Hi Major Lewis. What were conditions like in Helmand?

Hot, dirty and messy – freezing in winter and scorching hot in summer. You live in an enclosed space shared by hundreds of people. The toilets were just a trench with a shed above it. You can't imagine the smell.

### How difficult are the Taliban to face?

We're a well-trained, well-armed beast but a slow-moving one – we carry around 70-90lb each. This makes it challenging to fight a light, agile foe who has local knowledge. Our main advantage is they're looking to attack us, not the other way round. Therefore, we can draw them to a ground of our choosing, making it the worst possible place for their attack.

#### What's an average day like in Helmand?

Typically, we'd rise at 2-3am to beat the heat, then head out on patrol. I'd pick an area I'd want to search before first light. We'd reach that target then wait for dawn. Shortly after that, we'd expect to be attacked. Knowing it's coming takes a lot of pressure off. You never want to be in a position where you're ambushed – if I know they're coming, I know that my men are prepared, giving us a huge advantage.

#### What is it like being under enemy fire?

One time, I was under fire in open ground. As my pace sped up, so did the enemy's bullets, which meant he was firing directly at me. Bullets have a different noise the closer they get – once they're really close, say 50cm, they start to make a zipping sound. So close were they, it's like your body braces itself to be hit – your nerves almost reach out for the impact.

# Your company lost three men to a suicide attack. You rejected airlifting them out for treatment for fear of the helicopter being shot down. How hard was that decision to make?

You need to draw a line between what you want to do and what you need to do. I wanted to get my injured men out of there as quickly as possible, but a voice in my head said, "If a helicopter comes here and gets shot down in the middle of all your men, you've made the situation ten times worse." We had to return the next day to clear up any forensics. You don't want any enemy taking snaps of bandages or bloody ground and using it to show they had hurt us.

### How did you lift morale after that?

You tune in to what individuals need. Some need to be left alone others need a personal touch – an extra phone card to call home.

### What part does luck play in battle?

Well, one corporal was stood in the middle of the men who were killed during that suicide attack but he survived. He was stood on a log, meaning the force of the blast projected him straight into a ditch rather than going through him. He must've escaped death by millimetres.

### What was your own nearest miss?

An RPG clipped a wall about three feet above my head and exploded in the next field. If it had detonated at the wall, it would've killed me. No chance of survival.

## Who has the most dangerous job in your command?

We have a position we call "point man" – the first man out as we file out on patrol. He's the first person attacked in an ambush and needs to be the first to spot a threat. If he misses one himself, his comrades might die. It's a supreme test of nerve.

### How difficult is it to go home again after being in combat?

It's surreal. You fly from Bastion and on to 24 hours of decompression in Cyprus, which helps you start to readjust. From there you can be back in your own home with hot running water within a few days. That's a big adjustment to make.





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

Shinii Kagawa also looks like a fantastic signing. Last year United slipped up in a couple of group games and were unable to recover. They need Nemanja Vidic and Rio Ferdinand back."

**CHELSEA** 

ARSENAL

"Santi Cazorla looks like a really exciting signing. I think the only reason he was quite an unheralded arrival was

that ahead of him in the Spain team were Alonso, Iniesta and Xavi! Arsenal are set up to play European football they keep the ball better than anyone

in the Premier League and their midfield looks strong. It's a question of whether they'll get enough goals."

"Fernando Torres is the main man. He has to fill the role that Didier Drogba played and there's no back-up if he's injured or out of form. Daniel Sturridge could play that role but most of his effective games have seen him coming in from out wide. Chelsea will get goals from midfield, through Mata, Hazard and Lampard, but they need Torres to be getting goals this year."





#### **MANCHESTER CITY**

"Yaya Toure is the big player for City – I'm a fan of Aguero and Tevez but in all the big matches last season, Yaya was the game-changer. He's started this season as a holding player but once Gareth Barry's fit, I'd expect them to move him up the pitch. When he arrived at City, we were scratching our heads as to what Mancini was doing, but the gamble's been repaid tenfold."

#### **BAYERN MUNICH**

"People like Bastian Schweinsteiger are outstanding players, and they've bought well, taking Javi Martinez from Bilbao and the Croatian centre-forward Mario Mandzukic. They've strengthened considerably. They had three or four suspended for the final against eventual winners Chelsea last season and they were the better team in that match."



#### **PARIS SAINT-GERMAIN**

"Last season's Ligue 1 runners-up haven't started the season well, which can happen when you throw players together, but Thiago Silva and **Zlatan Ibrahimovic** are super signings. It won't be, realistically, their year this year, but once the players get used to playing together in Europe, they'll emerge over the next couple of years."



#### BARCELONA

"It'll be interesting to see if either of the Spanish big two come up trumps. Barcelona obviously have the unsettling factor of Guardiola leaving. **David Villa** is a big player for them – Barca missed him last season. If Messi is playing as a central striker then they need someone who gets goals from wide and Villa contributes enormously in that respect."



#### **REAL MADRID**

"They haven't started the season very well and **Ronaldo** – bless him, having to pay his tax – is clearly an issue, too. The dressing room will know that Ronaldo can win them matches – players are willing to put up with high-maintenance players if they deliver on the pitch, but if they don't, then all of a sudden you have a real issue."

Roy Hodgson has made England organised and hard to beat – now they just need to make that switch from "hard to beat" to "good to watch", and making and taking chances.





# What on Earth has happened to Wales?
