

N: People probably think we're all really dull and stupid. **L:** People probably think that we just live in farms and shag sheep, but we're so glam!


Do you think the show will be as big as other reality shows?

Mad new McLaren unveiled!

It's called the P1

– and it's not far off being fit for F1!

- McLaren's F1 was, and still is, a radical, rapid, unbelievably practical car. And with the Paris Motor Show about to get under way, the British company has whipped the sheets off its latest creation, the P1. McLaren's MD Antony Sheriff has said the goal of the P1 is to be "the most exciting, most capable, most technologically advanced and most dynamically accomplished supercar ever made". So, quite good then.
- The P1 is currently classed as a design study, but we're almost certain it will look virtually identical when it becomes reality next year.
- Like all super/hyper/ stratospheric cars, the engine lives in the middle of the chassis – right behind the occupants' ears.
- At the back, the near invisible LED striplights outline a menacing black honeycomb rear panel which is broken up by a central exhaust of factory chimney proportions.
- Below that is the mother of rear diffusers, which has no doubt been shaped in the F1 wind tunnel. The same can be said of the subtle doublebubble roof with F1-style roof scoop. There's also a Veyronstyle airbrake that deploys when you're "on it".
- Up front there's a pair of nostrils tunnelled into the bonnet panel, with intakes underneath the headlights that mimic the McLaren logo.
- The P1 reportedly uses a modded version of the MP4-12C's carbon-tub chassis. The whole car is said to weigh less

than 1,300kg, using radically redesigned aluminium front and rear subframes. It will also feature even more advanced active suspension than the 12C.

- Details on what will give the P1 its punch are secret, but many experts are saying it will be a re-tuned version of the MP4-12C's 3.8 twin-turbo V8, together with an F1-style Kers system. The result? Between 800 and 960bhp.
- The P1 probably won't outrun a Bugatti Veyron, but it promises to be the most rewarding to drive. It's also said to have completely shattered the best lap time for a road-legal car at the Silverstone circuit. Blimey!
- To see if McLaren decides to tweak its P1 masterpiece, we'll have to wait until 2013. That's when the order book opens to let up to 500 lucky gits put down their cash.

And they can be deadly. In 1923, during an earthquake in Honshu, Japan, a fire swirl emerged that killed 38,000 people in 15 minutes. To put it another way – fire swirls are badass!

Canadian journalist Jay Bahadur has spent years tracking

Somalian pirates. Here, he gives an insight into some of

the deadliest gangs on Earth...



i Jay. How did you first become involved with Somalian pirates?

I was working in market research in Toronto but it was my plan to break into journalism by going somewhere crazy. I wanted to go to Somaliland. I was caught up in the whole romanticism of this idea of pirates. I wanted to go and see what the real story was.

Who exactly are they?

The guys I met were fishermen from a small town on the northern coast of Somalia. Originally, it was just fisherman focused on the harvesting of lobsters. The local people received huge amounts of money for exporting them to Dubai.

When did they branch out into kidnapping?

Around 2005, these gangs essentially invented the modern model of piracy, which was kidnapping crews at sea. They went up and down the coast, training new recruits. Over time, the ransoms starting going up from £200,000 to £300,000 to millions and eventually tens of millions. It created a whole new incentive which attracted a new breed of pirate – people who had never stepped foot in a fishing boat in their lives but were attracted by the money. In fact, none of them really operating now are fishermen.

Does this new class of pirates come from a military background?

If you're a young man in Somalia, one of your only options if you own an AK-47 is to be hired by private security firms. They would protect certain property or, in some cases, provide security for the UN. But the government basically ran out of money in 2008. The state created an army, and once the state ran out of money, you had a lot of young men with guns with not much else to do, and one of the only criteria to become a pirate is to own your own gun.

How well armed are the pirates?

Each individual has to have his own small arm and then the financier will get the money for everything else, like the boat, fuel and weapons. They go out with Russian sea guns and a couple of grenade launchers, although those are generally used to frighten. I think those heavy weapons are more for show.

Who's funding all this?

Local businessmen or pirate leaders. You can fund a mission for £15,000. They do





tend to be local businessmen. They come back to their hometown and they see a chance to make money.

Were you going out to sea with them?

No, I would have had a moral issue with that. I did try to get on board just

to interview a crew once. They called back to their leader to ask if it was OK, but he consulted his sidekick, who was also a psychic. Apparently, he said, "Don't let this spy on board." This gives you an idea of how paranoid they were. They have a very limited idea of what's going on in the outside world. It's not helped by the fact that they were high on drugs.

What were they high on?

Khat [leaves that create feelings of euphoria when chewed]. It started as a mild

curiosity [for the pirates] and turned into a fascination, because if you chew it for hours, it gets you quite jacked up.

Why did they let you get close to them?

The ones who thought I was a spy had connections to the family that was hosting me. There were some scary encounters, though. We once arrived in another town where a rival pirate gang were holed up. I tried to ask questions and get on the ship to witness the negotiations, but the local soldiers said it was a good idea to leave.

How do they target ships?

They generally acquire a mother ship – a lot look for fishing ships to hijack. They tow two skips so they have four or five men to each skip. They open fire

to keep the crew from interfering with the boarding, and then use ladders to climb onto the ship.

What are some of the misconceptions about the Somalian pirates?

One is that it's internationally funded. It's not. Another is that their intelligence allows them to target the rich ships. Generally,

they don't have that much navigational experience. Another is that pirate money is being used to fund different empires and other countries – claims that have

and other countries been made with no evidence. My experience was that most of the lower down guys had never left Somalia and wouldn't know what to do with a bank.
