Yes! I'll have to give Emma a quick call later and say, "Oi, Glover! Where's my place in this Glamily of yours?" Ha-ha!





I THOUGHT THEY'D DROPPED A BODY ONTO OUR CAR!"

The gang-botherer's back in a world more extreme than ever!

i Ross! Tell us about your latest series of *Extreme World*...

Well, this is the second series that I've worked on. We've been to Karachi, Venezuela, Glasgow, Marseille and New Orleans. It's been more intense. The last show is having to go out later because we have some footage of people who've been beaten and set on fire after being accused of witchcraft.

Has there been a running theme for this series?

We've done 28 gang shows now and 15 in Afghanistan. My team and I have seen things that you would class as extreme but don't necessarily fit under gangs or war. "Extreme" is a wide enough umbrella to cover a whole gambit of current affairs.

How do you choose where to go in the world?

What we try to do is pick out individual stories that have a certain amount of interest. People have accused us of being voyeuristic, but I think you have to show what you see. We're not seeking out these horrible bits of footage. If you come to the shows and you're shocked by what you see, you should be!

You seem to get very close to some dangerous people...

This time around one of the hairiest moments was being fired on in Karachi. Being shot at by snipers isn't good for you! There are always moments when you're scared, and I get a buzz from that, but there's only a certain amount of time I'll be young enough to travel around the world and meet these incredible people, so it's worth it. I'm given the budget and the time to spend with these people, and that's how we get the access.

Do you ever pay them?

We can't pay these people, no. We have to win their trust. These people are good at sussing out who's genuine, and who's not. Hopefully, they get quite quickly that I'm not there to bend their story – I want to hear the truth. Generally, the truth is shocking enough without having to tart it up.

What's been the scariest moment filming this series?

In Marseille, they have estates – like in London, like in Manchester – that are pretty much no-go zones for the police. We tried to get in there, to this estate that's been built like a fortress. As we drove in, we got stuck in a dead-end. Then bang! A 2.5-litre bottle of frozen water was dropped on our car from the tenth floor. If you want to see Ross Kemp jump, that's the time. I thought it was a body!

What about the thing that shocked you the most?

Because it was so close to home, it was probably what I saw in Glasgow. I've been ignorant to the extent of it. I met this prostitute who was injected with heroin at the age of nine. She took me where she sleeps under a bridge, where she'd recently been ill, and there were needles and excrement



on the floor. Yet there were luxury apartments 200 yards away! I felt embarrassed.

Is it true that you got some stick for including Glasgow in the series?

People say we're kicking Glasgow, but we went there for the statistics. But to say that these problems go on in that city alone is completely incorrect. I feel that the money we spend on welfare is probably being used in the wrong way. Maybe it's time we re-address how we deal with people who've slipped through the net.

Well, thanks for the chat! Finally, where is Ross Kemp taking us next?

It's been such a full-on year. It's been so intense. But I'm doing a show about people who are mentally wounded by war. I don't think the government have put enough money in the coffers to deal with mental health. The film looks into that, and will be out just after Remembrance Sunday in November.

You didn't seem to be featured all that regularly in the last series. Why was that?



Thanks, Billie! Finally, then, bearing in mind Arg did the London Marathon, do you think you could have a go? I'm crap at running – it would


