Delicious Lexus concept

500bhp hybrid is a curvy superstar!

- The eventual existence of this liplicking Lexus concept depends entirely on you. Toyota (who own Lexus) say they are seriously considering building the LF-LC concept – their most powerful ever hybrid car – if there's enough public interest.
- Yes, it's a hybrid, but don't let that ozone-friendly swearword wither your trouser tent. The LF-LC promises
 500bhp, which will be divided between an electric motor driving the front wheels, and petrol power to the rear.
- There is no official word on what exact motor(s) the LF-LC concept is packing, but Nuts would bet it will borrow the

same guts as their fat cat LS600h hybrid saloon. If true, that means a 4,969cc V8 under the bonnet driving the rear wheels, together with a little 'leccy motor turning the front tyres. So 0-62mph will be around 4.5 seconds to a needle pushing 180mph. Expect a similar price tag, £180k.

- The electric part is called Advanced Lexus Hybrid Drive, but that's not important. What is important is that the car will have four-wheel drive and tons of grip.
- Using all of the in-house carbon fibre wizardry developed for the 552bhp LFA supercar, the LF-LC coupé will be completely handmade from trick

alloys, CFRP (carbon fibre reinforced plastic) and the sacred weave itself.

- These special methods of moulding also mean the Lex can wear body panels shaped in a way that would be impossible with conventional materials like steel. Like that raked front end, with amazing sculpted gills and a grille that looks like a lot like the Birmingham Bullring building.
- You have to hand it to Lexus when it comes to subtle jewel-like detailing. This thing makes a Transformer look like a Tesco's trolley. If this is the future of Lexus, then we're all eyes and ears. Bring it on.

Hi Lionel! You're always so smiley on the pitch – what

I'm having fun! All I ever wanted to do was play football for a living and it's what I'm doing. I have the same passion for the game now that I did when I was 12. If I ever stopped enjoying playing football, I think it would be time to retire.

A lot of other players have very flash cars, yet you seem quite grounded. Are you? What do you drive?

I think it's just my dedication to football that makes me lead a quiet life. Even when I was a kid and friends wanted to go out, all I wanted to do was go to football practice, and the same is still true now. I do really like cars – but for training, I'll normally drive an Audi Q7 because it's practical.

What's the best thing a fan has ever done for you?

When we arrived in Calcutta, it was the middle of the night and we didn't really expect anybody to be waiting, but there were thousands of fans outside the airport. They were shouting my name and had Argentina and Barcelona shirts on. It was crazy!

Football is not restricted by anything, it is connecting people all over the world and that's one of the great things about it.

Of course there's pressure – almost every year I've been here it has been Madrid we've been competing with for the title. Last year was their year, but we're all very determined to do all we can to bring the title back to Barcelona.

Would you ever go to Real? Or any other team?

My heart's in Barcelona, I think everybody knows that by now.

Who do you think is England's best player?

One English player I really like is Wayne Rooney. He's a nice guy who has said great things about me – it's always great when players of that class say good things about you. Also Kun Aguero is a great friend and a great player who's doing a fantastic job in England. His performance to win Manchester City the title was very special. tried to sign you? Not that I'm aware of!

Is Mourinho a bad loser?

When you're at a club like Real Madrid, you're expected to win. It's the same at all top clubs, the owners and the fans have this expectation. When you're used to winning, it's what you expect, but it doesn't always happen.

What about Ronaldo?

I really like Ronaldo – in my experience he's a good person. Of course he won't like to lose, but nobody likes to lose. He's a special player who can change a game in a second.

Many people say you're better than Maradona. Do you agree?

There have been comparisons between me and Maradona – and while that makes me feel proud, I don't think you can compare any player with Maradona. He's the best player who has ever lived. Probably the best player there'll ever be.

He became Barcelona's top scorer in history at the age of 24.

What the Scottish team can teach us about survival in Europe



IT WAS a bad week for England in the Champions League but Celtic nearly came home covered in glory. The difference? Simple: tactics.
