Hi Martin! The Hobbit's an epic action movie. Was this a very physical role for you?

Well, obviously, Bilbo's not a superhero, so I wasn't benchpressing 200lb, but as an actor you have to be healthy and you have to be ready, just because it's a war of attrition. When you're doing a film for 18 months, you don't want to get ill and vou don't want to get a sprained back. So you want to be fit and strong, but fit and strong for a hobbit.

Are you a person who jumps into adventure?

Yeah, depending on the adventure. I wouldn't go into life and death easily. but nor would anyone, unless vou're a f**king moron. But I'm an actor, I've chosen a job where there's no security, where there are no wages, where there's no pension, so for a start that's braver than most people who got to work at the bank.

If I live to be 100, I won't do many things that are written better than Sherlock. The same with The Office. The Office was a perfect half-hour comedy for me, and it was my taste and as a fan, I would like it.

Tell us about the famous, huge hobbit feet. Do you miss the feet?

No, ha-ha! I don't miss the feet. I mean. I like them -I think they're really brilliantly designed and fantastically clever, but I don't miss them, no.

How did you actually manage to put them on?

Well, they're like tights. They come up to your mid-thigh it's a two-person job. I shaved

my legs and put talcum powder on them and then they'd put an inner sole on my foot like those trainers where you just put your toes into. There's a hard sole, in case vou stand on something sharp so it won't come through and stab vou, as it did to Sean Astin in Lord Of The Rings. And then they put this latex foot and leg over you. £179k track special 911!

Porsche reveals its first track version of the seventh-gen 911!

- People have been racing Porsche 911s as long as they've been racing horses. Pretty much. And the GT3 Cup version is the world's most successful race car in terms of sales – since its 1998 launch, 2,395 of these track attackers have been sold.
- And this is the GT3 Cup race version of the latest "991" shape Porsche, born to race in the one-make series. As with previous Cup cars, it also hints at how the forthcoming road-going GT3 model will look and feel.
- Compared to the old Cup car, this motor has grown 10bhp, even though the 3.8-litre normally

aspirated (no turbos, just raw horses) engine beneath the back window remains about the same. This relates to 62mph in around 3.9 seconds, and a maximum speed of about 190mph, depending on your gearing.

- What definitely has changed is the gearbox, as for the first time the Cup car does away with a sequential floor-shift gear selector and uses steering-wheel paddles. It does still have three floor pedals, however, as the clutch is required to pull away (on the start line, for instance, or at the pit stop).
- Surprisingly, braking's taken care of by slotted, vented steel disc brakes rather than the poncey ceramic discs

you might pay £6k for as a dealership optional extra. Fronts are 380mm, clamped by pasty-sized six-piston callipers. The rear end gets four-pot callipers.

 Cup car styling isn't exactly what you'd call subtle. The body panels are mutated almost beyond recognition, while the GT3's signature park-bench rear wing can now support 40 cans of cola as opposed to the old car's 33.

 The front splitter is deeper and wider because it means business, supplying huge dollops of downforce for race warfare. The bonnet now has a pair of special Naca vent nostrils grafted on, originally seen on jets and spacecraft. They're designed to let airflow into

the Porsche's brakes without upsetting the aerodynamics over the bodyshell. Clever.

The cream of motor sport has the most heavily bolstered head-hugging bucket seat you've seen, designed to keep the driver cocooned during high-speed barrel rolls. If this did happen, it boasts another clever safety feature – a roof rescue hatch. This allows the driver to bail out quickly, or for emergency services to get in.

 The 911 GT3 Cup costs £190k, is built on the same production line as road
 Porsches and is only available as left-hand drive with white paint. It arrives ready to race in the Mobil 1
 Supercup championship.

Alastair Cook's top records!

After a great tour of India, *Nuts* looks at some top facts about the England captain!

After hitting his 23rd century in his 86th Test, Cook became the man with more Test centuries than any English batsman. After the third Test in Kolkata, Cook's average as captain was 111.25 – the highest of any player to skipper five or more Tests.

Cook scored 7,103 Test runs between his debut in March 2006 and the third Test. Only Kevin Pietersen is within 1,000 of that total.

Cook is the youngest ever batsman to score 7,000 Test runs, achieving the feat at the age of 27 years 347 days.

5 He had accumulated 3,536 Test runs and nine centuries before his 25th birthday – again, these are both records.

6 He scored his first Test century on his debut against India in 2006, in the second innings. He scored 60 in the first innings.



Cook scored a century in each of his first five Tests as captain, including two as a stand-in against Bangladesh in 2010.

> Prior to the final Test in India, Cook had made 29 Test 50s. He'd converted an impressive 44 per cent of 50s to centuries.

9 He took the catches for the last two wickets of the 2009 Ashes, including Michael Hussey's to clinch the series.
