Oh yeah, I've scored far better goals in training. Ask any of my team-mates or my former team-mates and they'll tell you that goals like that are pretty normal for me. If you were to watch me for one or two weeks in training, you'd probably see at least one better goal.

A good lady, like the one I have, and kids will change most men for the better and make them a calmer person. I only really get annoyed when I think somebody doesn't care about something as much as I do. You can take the boy out the ghetto but you can never take the ghetto out of the boy.

Your former Inter Milan teammate Mario Balotelli gets a lot of headlines. Can you see why?

Of course! There's never a dull moment when Mario is around. He's my friend and I like to be around him because he makes me laugh. Of course, he probably regrets some of the things he does, but that's Mario.
