# A quick word with... Arnie!

#### Mr S on his new movie and catchphrases!

Hi Arnie! What were you looking for in a comeback movie?

I was looking for a typical Arnold action movie and *The Last Stand* has great chase scenes, believable fights, crazy set-pieces, shoot outs and it's funny, too. The character I play [a Mexican border town sheriff who faces off against a murderous cartel] was more vulnerable than ones I've played in the past and I liked that. It was exciting to get Johnny Knoxville involved – my kids are big fans.

#### Knoxville was a just a teenager when you were making *Terminator*...

You have to mention my age! To put it into perspective, Jaimie Alexander [Sif from *Thor*, who plays Arnie's deputy] wasn't even born when I made *Conan The Barbarian*. And *Predator...* And *True Lies...* 

#### You're most notably famous for your catchphrase "I'll be back!" Did you always intend to return?

I always saw my movie career as ongoing. I stepped out for seven years to be Governor of California but



I was never trying to be a career politician who runs for Congress and the Senate. I just felt since America has given me every opportunity to achieve in life. I should take time out to serve the people regardless of the lack of pay. I gave the money back, as a matter of fact. It was around \$187,000 [£120,000] a year, which is petty cash... for me! I lost out on earning tens of millions of dollars and it also cost me - political campaigns are expensive but none of that mattered. I wanted to help the people. It was the most educational thing I've ever done.

#### Working with Johnny Knoxville, were you ever tempted to do a *Jackass*style stunt?

In his movies, the stunts work really well - when they fail! People laugh when he crawls away with broken bones and gets hospitalised. I wasn't about to try that! In my movies, it's all about how you can do a stunt and not get hurt. I tried to explain this to Johnny. You know, let's make things work so we don't have to close down the set. But of course he didn't listen. He crashed into a truck on a falling telegraph pole. We thought he was dead. He just said, "What a fun ride. Yay!"

Out of all the characters you've played, if they were fighting it out, who would be the last man standing? I think they would all join forces to fight the bad guys.



Most of my characters work in law enforcement or have some kind of authority. Whether they are CIA, FBI, sheriffs, policemen, spies. They're pretty much the same type of characters who bring law and order. But then there's the Terminator... I'm a machine and the complete opposite.

#### What can you tell us about *Terminator 5*?

We're seriously looking at that. We'll see what happens. We're writing the script now, along with a new *Conan* movie and the sequel to *Twins*, which is called *Triplets*. I'll be working with Eddie Murphy so you figure that one out!

#### What advice have you got for people on following their dreams?

You must always have a goal. You need a vision. Without it and a goal to strive for, you have nothing. I was absolutely convinced I would get there. My whole life, people said it can't be done. A boy from Austria becoming Mr Universe? You will fail. If you run for governor you'll lose because people don't take people from show business seriously when it comes to politics... blah, blah, blah. I've heard it all with the impossible thing but I didn't pay any attention because I believed. You need that fire in your belly to believe in yourself.



#### Thanks for the chat, Arnold. Finally, you're undoubtedly the king of the one-liner catchphrase. But do you have a favourite? There isn't just one, but

# New Fast And Furious car!

Ignore Vin Diesel and his spray-on vest, this awesome Nissan GT-R is the real movie star!

With its satin blue paint finish and severely combed bodykit, you don't need us to tell you this is no ordinary Nissan GT-R. In fact, by the end of 2013, it may well be the world's most famous R35 GT-R - it appears in the sixth in the street-race/beefcake/ bikini frenzy that is the Fast And Furious series.

- Chief tyre-kicker Paul Walker is a Skyline fan in real life – he owns a Skyline GT-R V-Spec, as well as a Corvette, a Porsche 911 GT3 and an Audi RS6, and races a BMW M3.
- Before talking about the oily bits beneath, it'd be rude to ignore the origami-inspired BenSopra aerodynamic kit imported from Japan.

- With a custom forwardopening bonnet, front splitter and rear wing that rises up from the rear bumper, the BenSopra panels are worth over £28k. And that's before you tot up the bill from the AMS Performance carbon roof, and carbon-fibre doors, door sills and trim supplied by Seibon Carbon in California.
- Let's hope the car doesn't play a crashy role in the film, eh? At least it brings the weight down from the standard car's 1,740kg.
- Straight out of the crate, a 2013 GT-R's twin-turbo 3.8 V6 develops 542bhp and shoves it to 62mph in 2.7 seconds, but this one had to go and take more 'roids.
- Thanks to tuning specialists Switzer, this GT-R now carries one of their P800 turbo kits, while R's Tuning redesigned the cooling system and SP Engineering filled it with 100 RON race fuel, tweaked its ECU and strapped it to the rolling road. The result? A rather conservative 685bhp and

603lb/ft at the wheels. So 0 to 62mph should pass in 2.6 seconds, while top speed is around 205mph.

 The GT-R will star alongside a Subaru BRZ, a Jensen Interceptor and a Dodge Daytona. *Fast Six* speeds into cinemas on 24 May. Ticket prices for the movie? Around £12. The G-TR? About £135k.



## Plus! Here's the new Rolls-Royce!

The luxury marque has released a teaser of its next car, rumoured to be unveiled in March. The Wraith is a sportier, £220k coupé, which, with the Ghost's 6.6-litre V12 engine should be the fastest Roller ever.

**i Sly! Your new movie looks totally bonkers!** Bullet To The Head is a back-to-basics action thriller. People think buddy movies are funloving romps. This isn't. Myself and Sung Kang are thrown together when the same psycho kills our partners. It's an anti-buddy movie. I'm a killer, he's a cop, so you can't get further apart!

Are there glimmers of yourself in these characters you play? No question about it. Even when I played Rocky, who appears to be one step behind everybody, and Rambo, who's a pessimistic man of few words... let's just say if Sylvester Stallone was a hitman, this is how he'd act. I bring a lot of baggage with me, so it's easy for the audience to believe in me and it's the first time in my career I'm using what I call my real voice. What you're getting is the way I really I am.

#### Blimey, Sly! Should we start to fear for our lives?

Don't worry, I like you guys. You gave me an award! Ha-ha! This is pretty biographical. You need life experience to make this kind of movie work. The audience is either too damn smart or too damn hungry to put up with fluff.



#### What was the toughest scene to shoot? When I filmed the

final showdown with Jason [Momoa], it got physical. He'd just come off *Conan* so this is a guy who knows how to swing a sword – and now he's swinging an axe! When a guy that big slams you into an iron wall, you feel it.

#### Do you ever think, "I don't need to put myself through this any more"?

I'm old-school, so I just suck it up and do it. This isn't a superhero movie. I always ask myself, does this look true? I want it to look like a man could actually pull this off.

#### Do you think these types of roles are keeping you young, then?

No doubt about it. I just love to compete. And I see a fella like Momoa, who's an unreal physical specimen but it inspires you to compete, so you do as many stunts as possible. I try not to use a double and I think audiences appreciate that. Some people think they're making films that will alter the universe, but I just want people to see mine and tell their friends it was fun and it gave them a chance to escape for a couple of hours.

#### There's a fair bit of tech used in this film. Are you a bit of a whizz with it all?

Are you kidding? I only just learned how to use the speaker on my iPhone! I used to tweet but it's an act of futility. You're not really making any impact and if you find yourself in a mood when you wanna be a bit controversial and you post something, you suddenly realise, "Oh my God!" because you've opened yourself up to a bunch of criticism from strangers. It might be a great promotional tool but just to make small talk, it's crazy.

#### When you talked to *Nuts* about *Rambo*, you said you'd put on **20kg of muscle. What was your regime like for this film?** This was quite different. Since then, I've had about four operations, making the *Expendables* movies – two on my back, a neck and an ankle fusion. So this time, I had to approach exercise in a more intelligent way, which means not lifting m a lot of dead weight. Ts. I have to be more

I have to be more athletic so I've lost muscle tone but gained flexibility, which is perfect for this film.

#### **SLY STALLONE**

Thanks for the chat, Sly. Finally, like Rocky, you've rolled with the punches throughout your movie career. What lessons have you learned along the way?

When you're on top, everything's fine. But I'll always cherish an athlete or anyone who's been to the top and got knocked out, beaten to the ground. That's when you're gonna see what they're made of. Do they get up or do they just lie there and become a broken human being? That's really what life is about. Taking the beating, getting up and keep going on. Few people who fall try to get back up again but they'd be surprised - if they tried they might just succeed. I'm always looking for a new challenge. There are a lot of mountains to climb out there. When I run out of mountains to climb I'll build a new one.

When I was a kid I was always in trouble. Today they'd probably call it ADHD, but they couldn't diagnose it at the time. It's hard to say whether that was a direct result of my dad being in prison or if I would have been like that anyway.

I was always in trouble and always fighting. I was an angry kid. I never had to go looking for trouble - it had a way of finding me!

### So what sparked your interest

I'd always had an interest in martial arts. I'd buy the magazines, try to copy the forms and teach myself in secret. My mum would never let me try it, so I hid the magazines under my bed.

#### How old were you when you first started in MMA?

Nineteen. My cousin, Mark Weir, who also fought in the UFC, had a gym in my home-town of Gloucester. I went there to train with him one day and just fell in love with it. It all started from there.

Do you think martial arts gave your life direction? Yes, definitely. Before I found MMA I lived day-today. I went from job to job, not really accomplishing much. I had no ambition.

#### Which techniques did you find suited your style best? None of them and all of them! But as I progressed, I found stand-up suited me better. It's more fun. You'll notice that I usually fight with a smile on my face. It's because I love what I do.

#### When did you first think that MMA was something you could excel at?

About six months ago! Until recently, I never really thought about it as a career. Then I started winning fights and thought... maybe.

You talked about being angry as a kid. When you get hit in the Octagon, do you see red? No, you can't afford to. I did make that mistake early in my career, but the more



experience you get, the more you learn to control your aggression. You have to keep your wits about you, listen to your coaches and not do things you're not supposed to do, otherwise it all goes out of the window and all the hours of training will be for nothing.

#### Your father's conviction was overturned just as your career was taking off. How did that come about?

There were always doubts over his guilt. There were various unsuccessful appeals over the years, then 14 years later, the evidence came to light and he was released.

#### How did it feel to see him again after so long?

Amazing. He came out just in time for my first UFC fight. He loved combat sports but just didn't enjoy seeing his son do it. He's not with us any more, and I like to think I made him proud.

#### We're sure you did. So, who are you going to dedicate your imminent victory over Matthew Riddle to?

Two people. My father and my son. My son was born around the same time as my dad died last year, so it'll be in honour of them both.

#### Thanks for the chat, Che. Finally, what's with the "Royalty" tattoo you've got on your neck?

A lot of people think it's down to arrogance, but they're wrong. I'm not saying I'm royalty. I'm no better than any other man. What it signifies is that everyone's royalty in their own way. Because of what I've been through, that's what I believe in the end.

## Evil genius or mad moaner? An expert reveals all!

WHEN SIR Alex Ferguson called Newcastle a "wee club" recently, Nuts' own Kammy reckoned it was the start of Sir Alex's famous "mind games" for the season, rating him "the best there is." But what exactly are Fergie's mind games for? Is he a cunning genius or just a bloke who likes getting people's backs up? We asked sports psychologist John McDermott to talk us through Fergie's tricks of the mind...

## **UNDERMINING** MATCH OFFICIALS

**CRITICISING RIVAL** 

MANAGERS

"He's establishing himself as a leader. Any manager who

is drawn into his 'mind games' should take it as a compliment. The trouble is, Sir Alex usually comes out on top, and when he does, the opposing manager feels less worthy, which can impact on their team's performance."

"Studies into 'home advantage' found that referees don't make decisions to seek approval, they do it to avoid disapproval - you try to mediate this but it's unavoidable. As humans, we strive to avoid mass disapproval. Sir Alex tries to create this advantage no matter where they play he's creating the fear of reprimand in officials, the fear that they'll have their decisions scrutinised."

## **INSTIGATING FEUDS**

'Again, this feeds into his cult of personality - he's seen to be even bigger than an organisation like the BBC when he withdraws his interviews. But it also creates what's called an 'in-group/out-group' mentality, which means that you separate yourself from a larger group in order to make your group stronger from within. 'This is us here - this is you over there.
