

Oithinate mustre car:

The Dodge Challenger R/T Redline – as American as the Super Bowl and obesity!

- It's been a few years since Dodge stepped back into the muscle-car ring to go against the equally retro-styled Ford Mustang and Chevy Camaro.
- This Challenger is a modern-day homage to its 1970 Challenger forebear – arguably one of the most iconic muscle cars to break out of Detroit. It still looks like a concept car, in a good way.
- Being a hulking great American muscle car means it's as brash and rear-wheel drive as you'd expect. The R/T refers to Rapid Transit, which translates to extra grunt and stickers. The new R/T Redline, however, goes a bit further.
- For starters, there's a grey and red stripe that runs the full length of each side, finishing up over its quarter panels. The Redline also lives up to its name with a

- set of simple, chunky square-profile 20in alloys, finished in black chrome. Around the outer lip is – yep, you've guessed it – a painted red line.
- Retro-styled cars don't suit body kits, so Dodge has kept the Coke-bottle shaped coupé as was, but added a body-coloured grille surround to the menu and four colours: Bright White, Pitch Black, Billet Silver and Granite Crystal.
- Under the hood is a 5.7-litre "Hemi" V8 breathing through the pair of bonnet nostrils. 375bhp and 410lb/ft is transferred to the tarmac either through a paddle-shift five-speed automatic or a six-speed "Tremec" manual box. This will result in 62mph zooming past in 5.1 seconds, and a top speed of 145mph.
- Interiors are where Yank tanks tend to feature acres of scratchy plastics and Lego Duplo-sized gauges. The R/T Redline is never going to compete with a Merc AMG, but it does get soft Nappa leather in Radar Red or Dark Slate. Tick the automatic option box and you'll get remote start, a Mopar T-handle shifter and a chrome pedal kit.
- A Super Track Pak drops the ride height, adds sticky Goodyear Eagle F1 tyres and uprated brake pads.
- Unbelievably, the basic R/T Challenger is only £18,000, with the R/T Redline package a mere £1,265 extra. But before you reach for the credit card, bear in mind it'll only be available in the UK as a private import and end up about £30k. Even so, storming value.







I spent my early days with my grandfather, who was a locksmith, so I fell in love with the idea of breaking into safes. Before I was 18, I'd stolen 150 cars, over £3.5m in jewellery and burgled over 90 properties. I upset a lot of people – though I gave away 80 per cent of the money I stole.

When did the Mafia cotton on to what you were doing?

I never knew exactly how they found out, but if I could have avoided racking up large gambling debts, maybe they would never have traced me. I never knew if it was a set-up or just an unfortunate series of events, but I ended up getting together with some small-time crooks and I was invited to a game of poker with them. I left the table 100 grand in debt. My brother was a victim of a vicious attack which left him handicapped for life. It was their way to say, "Pay your debt."

What were the repercussions of that night?

Up until a certain age, I thought I was safe, but because of this one gambling event it

was a doubt. My brother was a victim of an attack that left him handicapped and my parents stopped speaking to me, as they knew somehow I was responsible for it. Once you're in it, the underworld's impossible to get out of – it's like quicksand. I lost my family, my identity, my friends and the ability to go back to my home city.

From that point, did you immediately go into hiding?

I didn't actually, because if I'd suddenly gone missing it would have been noticed. Instead I hid in full view –

no matter how heavy the thing got, I tried to be the usual smiley teenager even when I had the weight of the world on my shoulders. I think that was the only thing that I did right.

Didn't your methods also damage the Mafia in the USA?

I came up with an idea – rather than doing what the FBI was doing at the time and getting people to go to court to testify, I got the criminals

to fight one another. Two senior guys from the FBI took me to see the number two of the organisation. They wanted to thank me for my "flash of genius". I gave them a whole new perspective on crime fighting and they took my ideas back to the USA.

What's the situation with the Camorra at the moment?

They're not as powerful as they were, which is worse. In my day, you were better having one person in charge than having a fragmented system. Even though I brought down the main guy, more people took his place and it became more chaotic.

We see a great deal of Mafia ferocity dramatised in film and TV. How realistic is that?

No movie can ever give a faint idea of what it's like. Living with the constant fear of being caught is a strain that pop-culture can't convey. The closest comparison is like living with a terminal disease, but the doctors can't say for sure when you'll die.

GOALKEEPERS

"Former Atletico keeper DAVID DE GEA will be fired up for a return to his home city. He'll become one of the world's top keepers. He's only 22 but won't peak until his late 20s. An excellent shot-stopper, he's becoming more consistent but is still capable of poor judgment calls. With Iker Casillas missing following hand surgery, experienced January signing from Seville DIEGO LOPEZ might be preferred to Antonio Adan, who has made frequent errors. Casillas has also fallen out with Mourinho. They need to find a new long-term keeper. This is a potential problem area for Real."

DEFENDERS

"Man United have kept just six clean sheets in their last 20 Champions League matches. They'll need to match the concentration levels of the quarter-final first leg at Chelsea in 2011, when Vidic and RIO FERDINAND were superb. They must protect De Gea better and deal with setpieces. "MICHAEL CARRICK has been outstanding for United but they struggled to create at home against Galatasaray and Cluj. Will they play wide men to counter Real's attacking full-backs or three narrow midfielders? If only Giggs and Scholes were five years younger. Real edge it with their variety. XABI ALONSO's the most astute defensive midfielder in Europe and Khedira can also hold or drive on with great effect. Di Maria can provide width. Ozil can make a real impact from the bench with Luka Modric set to start. United missed out on signing him. Could he return to haunt them?"

STRIKERS

"ROBIN VAN PERSIE should be European Footballer of the Year. He's been the difference between Man United and their Premier League title rivals. Wayne Rooney hasn't scored from open play in this season's Champions League. This could be his time, while waiting in the wings is Hernandez. United will score in both legs. They're not a one-man band. CRISTIANO RONALDO is a huge threat. United can't afford to concede silly free-kicks with him about. He's scored more than Benzema (who netted twice against Man City), Higuain and Di Maria put together, but they're over-reliant on him."






