



Amazing oneoff retro Merc!

Modern technology plus a cool '50s look equals guaranteed phwoar!

- As we're sure you're aware, Mercedes has an in-house department of horsepower junkies by the name of AMG. As we're also sure you're aware, Merc AMG makes a downright superb supercar called the SLS Roadster.
- The £177,000 SLS has the kind of handsome hardnut

looks you'd associate with Jason Statham. The SLS is a modern take on the classic '50s Merc SL. It's a bit retro, but clearly not retro enough for some. Take a certain Eastern European customer of GWA (Gullwing America) who wanted to buy a new SLS Roadster and bin the bodyshell. And wheels. It's






a given that said Eastern European customer's rich, but they were also frustrated. Why? Because there were no 1955 Mercedes 300 SC W-188 series on sale last year. Well, they did make just 92 of them.

 The solution? Build a one-off modern interpretation that goes faster than the original.
 Keeping that sensationally snorty 6,208cc V8 from the SLS was a wise idea, as 563bhp is enough to make noise and get to 62mph in 3.8 secs. The seven-speed paddleshift dual-clutch gearbox is also ideal.


 GWA then borrowed a poster of a '55 Merc SC and proceeded to hand-beat an aluminium bodyshell (as per the original) to sit on the SLS Roadster chassis. Although it shares the tall radiator grille, it's heavily raked, with vertical teardrop LED headlights set into wings either side.

 The SLS electric adaptive rear spoiler has been reused higher up above the boot lid, not far from where the hard top fixes down. There are 21in front and 22in rear rims, and the cabin is unchanged from the showroom-fresh SLS. The other 21st century nods are adjustable suspension and a custom exhaust with quad exits.

We like this thing. A lot. You sometimes have to applaud daft ideas – some folk will pay a lot to own a one-off.


Is my cousin crush wrong?

ello Kenny. Can you tell us a bit about the job of a point man?

Hello. The point man's the guy who stays ahead of everyone else during a mission, so is the first person to have to respond to an ambush, to notice an IED [improvised explosive device] or to respond to any danger. When I first went to Helmand in 2007, there weren't quite as many IEDs as there are now, so I didn't

bother with metal detectors. That would be an essential tool nowadays, but back then I'd be happy with my SA80 rifle. An ambush was something that happened on almost every mission and I found that to be the most effective way of dealing with the enemy.

What would a typical day be like?

It's not a nine-to-five job. Sometimes, you'd do two hours or so of patrolling. Other times, we were sent out for two days and didn't come back for three weeks. As the point man, you have to be incredibly aware of what's around you. I would be about ten yards ahead of the next man, who was usually my friend Sam Hix. He was my wingman and when we ambushed a shelter, he'd be on my shoulder.

How much did you rely on your gut feeling?

You develop a sixth sense after a while. By the end, I felt like a great white shark – able to sniff blood from five kilometres away. Sometimes there would be no sign of danger but I'd just have a hunch that a particular alleyway, for instance, wasn't safe to go down. It's all about watching people as well as bushes, trees and caves. If there were no children in an area, I'd be suspicious, as I'd consider that fair warning that contact with the enemy was about to happen.

What are the main misconceptions about facing an enemy such as the Taliban?

Technically, they don't have what British soldiers have, but in terms of bravery, they're very strong. They have the power to kill, so you have to respect them and it's important to remember that they too have wives and children who they want to go home to.

Do any operations stand out as being particularly tough?

The ones in which friends of mine died were obviously traumatic. I do remember being particularly terrified having a five-hour battle in a cornfield with Taliban, where the visibility was just zero, and I felt I could have been shot at close range at any second. It was an incredible day as it was real close-quarter fighting – I was prepared to use my bayonet, it was that close – but, despite the field being

full of the Taliban, we managed to either kill or flush them out without a single one of us getting seriously hurt or killed.

Some have labelled the role as the most dangerous in the armed forces. Do you agree?

Somebody said to me once, "You could get hit by a bus back at home," and he was right, but on the front line in Helmand Province, you wake up every day wondering if it's the last you're going to speak to your girlfriend or family, or if this is the last day you're going to be able to use your legs. That's the danger we faced and I think that's the difference people can't understand – I hope they never have to.

Were you aware of the Taliban's attempts to sabotage your job?

Our bases were being watched constantly by the Taliban. We'd often have to win hearts and minds of locals by fixing irrigation ditches and things like that. The Taliban didn't want us doing that as they knew we'd win the support of local villagers, so they would attempt to bomb any work we carried out. It never lets up in Helmand. The only time you have time off is when you're asleep.



How did undertaking a role such as this affect you when you returned to Britain?

When I left the Army, I went back to Colchester and got a job as a bus driver. I ended up in a rage so much of the time as I couldn't understand how people could whine and moan when they had a hot bath and a meal to go home to. So different from Helmand. I remember another bus driver moaning as he had to work ten minutes later than usual and I just let rip at him. It was moments like those that made me realise that I just wasn't coping with the reality of killing Taliban one month, and then going straight into taking fares on Civvy Street.

And you're using your experiences to raise awareness of Post Traumatic Stress Disorder?

Yes. My father was one of the first people to really push PTSD into the spotlight after his experiences in Northern Ireland as

a soldier. At that time, there was a huge denial on behalf of the government, as they knew that if they had to start treating soldiers with this illness, it was going to cost them millions. My father's still a fragile man and struggles with new people and in crowds. He went through a lot and I hope that a young soldier today would be better treated by the Army than he was.

Did it affect your relationships?

It just got to the point where I was resentful of how easy people had it. It wasn't their fault. I was the one being a d*ck. Every time I'd go to the pub, I'd end up having a drink and getting into an argument or a scrap. I just didn't understand what was happening to me.

What advice would you give to someone who maybe has a pal suffering PTSD?

The main advice I would give would be to get them to open up. There's no shame in PTSD at all. I've had some of the hardest men I've ever known fall to their knees crying in front of me once they're given the chance to talk about it. It's not something you should worry about unduly, but if you're at the point where you can't sleep, you're constantly stressed and you can't even cope with a quiet pint in the pub with your girlfriend then you really do need to talk to a friend and take it from there.

"There's no game plan, and if you're a coach you need a game plan. I don't know what the tactics are. Some teams play with a high line, some don't. I don't think Arsenal have structure in training – they seem to play completely off-the-cuff."

DEFENSIVELY, HE'S NAIVE

"Wenger doesn't recognise defensive qualities. Look at André Santos. I saw him for Brazil at the Copa America and he was terrible – then two weeks later, Arsenal bought him! The problem's not so much team selection but team recruitment."

HE ALIENATES PLAYERS

"In recent years, he's bought players who play behind the main striker, but they end up in wide areas. Cazorla will be next. The players deserve better. There was a damning quote from Cesc Fabregas when he left: 'Now I'm at Barça, I'm learning the game tactically.'"

HE'S BECOME POWER MAD


"Wenger's a dictator and he's very much part of the board. Look at him during a game and he's really petulant, trying to affect the decisions of the fourth official and the referee, but he doesn't instruct the players. He's like a fan watching the game. Powerless."

HE SHOULD GET HELP - OR GO!

"The best thing for Wenger would be to admit where he's going wrong and bring in a defensive coach. That won't happen. Sadly, then, he should be relieved of his duties. His supporters ask who could do a better job. Well, there are loads of people out there."


Just too close to call in the Championship!

Some people think he could go to Man United, but Fergie's not ready to step down yet and I don't think Mourinho's the steady pair of hands that will attract them.


