Meet Lamborghini's latest – a 31mph tractor!

- Quick history lesson. In 1916, Ferruccio Lamborghini was born in the Emilian lowlands, a rural Italian farming region. It was 28 April, making him the zodiac sign of Taurus the bull. In 1948, he built his farmer dad a tractor using parts from Second World War military vehicles. As his business grew, he started making heating systems and helicopter prototypes.
- The Italian government refused authorisation to sell his helicopters so, in the early '60s, Lamborghini set about building the world's first production

mid-engined supercar. Why? Because "the other sports cars weren't good enough". With sights set to out-Ferrari Ferrari, he employed several Ferrari workers and the rest, as they say, is history.

- But despite their farm vehicles living in the shadows of carbon-fibre Aventadors, Lamborghini tractors are still in fine shape – proved by the latest offering to wear the chromed bull bonnet badge, the Nitro.
- The Nitro has been designed by Gioretto Giugiaro – officially the car designer

of the century. He has designed over 160 cars, including such legends as the Mk1 VW Golf, BMW M1, Audi Quattro and Michael J Fox's DeLorean DMC-12.

- He's provided the Nitro with LED lighting, extended mudguards, a curvy striped bonnet with honeycomb grille and colour-coded side vents that look like high-end hi-fi speaker covers.
- The cab boasts panoramic convex windows giving a 360-degree view, climate control, a slick three-spoke steering wheel, a folddown seat for mates and

a fully damped driver's chair. All at just £78k less than an Aventador.

- It has a field-worthy 3.6-litre four-cylinder turbo diesel that has up to 120bhp and a top speed of 31mph. But it does have up to 60 forward and 60 reverse gears. And it can tow up to 6.5 tonnes.
- For tight corners, there's the option of an SDD – a Steering Double Displacement pump – which reduces the number of steering turns lock-tolock. Handy for track days and drifting. Now we want to own a small holding!

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Nitro Circus star Aaron Fotheringham talks to Nuts!

AS VEGAS-BORN 21-year old Nitro Circus star Aaron "Wheelz" Fotheringham talks to

Nuts about his life as the world's mightiest wheelchair stuntman...

Hi Aaron! First off, why are you in a wheelchair?

Hello! I was born with spina bifida, a congenital birth defect. I started out on crutches, and back when I was still coming to terms with it all I felt a little restricted because my friends were doing things I couldn't. But then I ditched the crutches, got on my wheelchair, and never looked back. The wheelchair is something that empowers me rather than holds me back.

Do you recall the first time you went to a skate park and tried a mad stunt? I started going to skate parks with my older brother at the age of eight. For my first stunt I tried to

hop a curb and fell off, so I tried it again and again until I got it right. Ha-ha!

When you started out doing stuff like this, did people try to stop you?

Yes, my teachers were a bit concerned for my welfare at times and yelled at me for doing tricks at school. They would tell me I was crazy. But nobody really tried to hold me back. If they knew me at all, they knew that wouldn't work!

In 2006, you did your first wheelchair back flip. How did that come about?

It was 13 July at 8.57pm exactly. I'd been working hard in the foam pit, then I finally did it and I came away thinking, "No way!" There were a load of BMXers and skaters there watching it. The thing was, nobody had ever done that

on a wheelchair before. You could say I made history. The back flip was only the beginning. A few years later I did a double back flip and last year I landed a 50ft jump off a megaramp.

What's the most insane thing you've done?

I've done some crazy stuff. Probably the most scared I've been was doing the loop. That didn't end very well for me. The proudest I've been was after my first double back flip.

What other tricks have you got cooking?

There's something in BMXing called the superman, where the rider completely lets go of the bike while in mid-air, then regains control of it and lands. To do that on a chair would be amazing.

Now you're working with the hell-raisers at Nitro Circus. How did that come about?

I had an email through my website saying they'd heard about my stunts and wanted to get me involved. I didn't need asking twice. Last time I came over to the UK. I knocked myself out in Manchester. I've been working on some new things since then. You'll just have to wait and see what happens.

What's the Nitro Circus lifestyle like? Does it involve parties galore?

Unlike some of the other guys, I'm not a total party animal. I prefer to sit back and watch everyone else party. After the guys are done risking their lives, they feel pretty good about still being alive, so it can get a little crazy!

Do you get groupies?

Ha-ha! Let's just say we have a lot of fans, some of whom are female.

We'll bet! Who's your idol?

Chad Kagy [American BMX rider]. He's always there behind me, at the top of the ramp before I go down, guiding and motivating me. He's a legend, for sure.

Do you think last year's awesome Paralympics dispelled some myths about disabled people?

I didn't watch it. I know that's bad, but I don't watch any TV at all. I spend all my time in skate parks. I consider myself an able-bodied person in a wheelchair. I can do anything anyone else can.

What's the biggest load of rubbish you've heard about people in wheelchairs?

What drives me nuts is people automatically judge me and think I'm helpless. For example, when I try to use an escalator people freak out. People's preconceptions are one thing I'd like to change.

You say that one day you want to design the world's most wicked wheelchair. What's it going to look like? The biggest adjustment we can make is to put mountain bike shocks on them and make it more durable without sacrificing any of the stability or manoeuvrability. We've actually been selling a lot of modified chairs.

How about one that has flames coming out of it? Ha-ha! That would be cool. But it could be a fire hazard at some venues.

Fair enough! What else do you have planned?

This year, I'm working on perfecting what I already have and landing some new stuff. I'd like to get more people doing this. maybe even the ablebodied. Hopefully, one day, we'll have a big movement of people shredding parks on wheelchairs!

Do you see yourself as an inspiration to others?

I hope I can show people, especially in wheelchairs, that it can be a good thing. I always say I'm not in a wheelchair, I'm on a wheelchair. It's awesome as you have wheels strapped to your ass. The only limitations are in your mind!
