astounding and outrageously inventive - every take is different. It's hard to figure out how his mind comes up with the things that it does.

Were there times when you just stood back and let him go off on one?

It would be ridiculous to have Jim Carrey in your movie and not let him run with it. That's what he does almost better than anyone. He had full licence to go wherever he wanted to go. His character goes to sleep on hot coals and drills a hole in his skull! And with actors like James Gandolfini from The Sopranos and Steve Buscemi from Boardwalk Empire - they might be known for dramatic roles, but they're funny because they don't play it for comedy.

In the film, you get a live dog put down your pants. Did that experience put you off working with animals?

The dog was actually very sweet. The biggest fear when working with a child or an animal is putting them in a comfort zone. A film set can be such a scary environment that you try your best to put them in a safe place so it doesn't seem so outrageously scary to them. I've been pretty lucky so far, but working with bears on Anchorman was a tiny bit scary for me because they seemed extremely grumpy and I wasn't into riding a bear. Who is?

E WAS the first person to walk the full length of the Amazon river, in 2010, and more recently, former British Army captain Ed Stafford took

on an even more formidable survival challenge. For 60 days, he was cast adrift on the tiny, uninhabited island of Olorua in a remote corner of the Pacific, about 400 miles east of Fiji. Temperatures on the island top 30°C during the day but plummet to below freezing at night. The surrounding waters are infested with sharks, and food sources are scarce. *Nuts* caught up with Ed to find out how he handled being a man marooned, and picked up a few useful man tips from him.

Hi Ed! Why did you take on such a bonkers challenge?

It was a concept we devised that sounded like an easy idea – I'd be shipped off to a desert island for 60 days – but eventually it hit home what a real challenge it would be. I wanted to do a TV programme where I could show this could be done. I had literally nothing to begin with. When they dropped me off and told me to take my shorts off, I was naked and felt like a right prat. I got over the embarrassment quickly because I was on my own, but it's amazing how vulnerable it makes you feel.

So you had nothing with you and were completely in the buff?

Yes, I had absolutely nothing. No tools. No clothes. I ended up wearing a grass skirt I'd made!

This was made for telly, so was there a temptation to stage elements in order to weave in a little more added drama? No, it was deliberately flying in the face of all that. I like the stuff Bear Grylls has done, but he's got a lot of flak over the fact that they're scripted. What

he did was brilliant, but there was a backlash, and I wanted mine to be an authentic experience from the start.

Did you ever need outside help at any point in your challenge?

On about day 47, I got quite seriously ill with a stomach parasite. In my box with the camera equipment I had an emergency satellite phone. I really didn't want to use it, but I ended up having to, and a local boat came in with antibiotics to knock it on the head. Otherwise I could have been in serious trouble.

Were you tempted to pretend that it didn't happen?

I thought the producers would brush it under the carpet, but it's been kept in, and that's what the programme's all about. It's not a set-up, it's completely authentic. It's not about making me into a he-man – there are just as many points where I've mucked stuff up as there are successes.

How come you didn't lose the plot?

That was the biggest challenge by far. I picked up a tip from the Australian Aborigines for dealing with stress. I was told to build a stone circle – a "safe" circle. Whenever I felt panicked or depressed I sat in there and smiled, realising everything was OK. That definitely stopped me from getting out of control and going madder.

Were you ever scared?

It wasn't like when I did the Amazon, where loads of things can kill you. The only life-threatening thing on the island were the sharks by the reef, and I stayed mainly on land. I was overwhelmed by the responsibility of being alone – not knowing if you've got water tomorrow can get pretty scary.

Did you make an imaginary friend? I found an old rugby ball, which I called Gilbert, but I didn't speak to it – I used it as my pillow. Of course, I had a video camera, so that felt like I was talking to someone because I was recording all my emotions. Talking to something might be a sign of going mad, but I had a good reason for it!

When were you at your lowest ebb? Early on, when I realised what I'd let myself in for. Even though it was for TV, it was real. If I didn't find enough water, I wouldn't last two days. Coming to terms with that made it easier. I made life better by making provisions, and by the end I was happy.

Can anyone do something like this?

I did it because although I'm an expedition leader, I'm not a bushcraft expert, so I wanted it to genuinely be a challenge. I had to learn to make fire, flints and bows and arrows before I went. I'd say anyone stubborn enough could do it with two weeks' training – but I wouldn't recommend it!

Ed's top tips for surviving in the wild!

Learn these island essentials and even if you never end up stranded, they could help with everyday life...

MAKE A FIRE FROM NOTHING

"I used the hand-drill method. Fashion a round spindle of wood and roll it between the palms of your hands, applying downward pressure on a harder bit of wood. You need a dry leaf under it to catch the embers."



CATCH YOUR DINNER

"I found things to eat like snails – I swallowed them whole. Loads of things can be foraged, like blackberries. I also found a feral goat caught in a tree, so I finished him off with a giant clam shell. It was pretty bruta!!"

FIND A SOURCE OF WATER

"There was a tiny seep of ground water from a rock, which I collected in a bottle washed up on the shore. It collected really slowly, but I mixed it with coconut to make my own coconut water."



WIPE YOUR BUM OUTDOORS

"I did everything in a stream, so I had my own natural bidet! I had slightly rough skin by the end, but you can't complain. My advice would be to find a stream or other running water. You'll never get clean with a leaf."

BUILD A RAFT FROM SCRATCH

"I collected big pieces of bamboo and tied them side by side, with a couple going across. Then I attached anything that floated – old drinks bottles or fishing floats. The key with rafts is don't get too complicated."



FEND OFF AN ANIMAL ATTACK "It's true what they say – stand your ground and make yourself as large as possible with your arms over your head. That's meant to make wild animals think you're just not worth trying to attack."

CALL FOR HELP

"If you were in a situation like mine, you'd get a pile of fine wood, then light it and put wet foliage on it to create smoke and get attention. Don't try to create stop-start signals with a blanket – that's a myth."

He's a big-occasion player, but there are others on the list who've shone more and an excessively physical approach may deter some voters."

32Re

"The bargain buy of the season at just £2m, Michu played a huge role in Swansea's Capital One Cup final success. He's had a third of Swansea's efforts on goal and has scored one in every five chances, though 11 of his first 15 league goals came against bottom-nine clubs. Lack of European football will count against him though."

JUAN MATA

CHELSEA

"In a fractious campaign, the little Spaniard has been Chelsea's most consistent performer with his clever passing, wriggling runs and possibly more than 20 goals. His understanding with Oscar and Hazard can produce thrilling football, but he can fade. Defensive duties need improving, but but he can light up a game and is a worthy contender."

LUIS SUAREZ

"If skill, work-rate and importance to the club's campaign were the only factors, the Uruguayan would win it for me. He never stops running, always tries to create chances off the shoulder of the last defender, and has kept an average Liverpool going. But he goes down far too easily and is often involved in controversy." The Dog and Duck's six-a-side team had a few ringers

He still loses his rag occasionally and his barren patch in late winter was worrying. Still the favourite though."

"It'll be very close between Van Persie and Bale. The late votes may favour Bale and I'd like him to win it as he may never have this sort of run again. But **Van Persie**'s work in the first half of the season will probably get him the nod."

David Coulthard: 'This season's going to be special!'

The top pundit on the new F1 season and why no one can predict the champion!

Hi David! How do drivers feel as a new season approaches? I'd go through a range of emotions - little things like reliability issues with the car - which wouldn't go into the public domain. But none of it matters when it comes to the first race. The quickest car doesn't always win the Grand Prix, and the quickest driver doesn't always win the race. We'll get a snapshot from the opening GP in Melbourne, that's it.

What have we got to look forward to this season? There'll be great battles like Button vs Hamilton, McLaren vs Mercedes and Red Bull vs Ferrari. On the last corner of the last race at Abu Dhabi they'll all be scurrying for the line with their tongues out like Lightning McQueen in *Cars*!

Is 2012 champion Sebastian Vettel unstoppable?

No one's unstoppable. The top guys at that level are all



exceptional drivers. You can't separate the talents of Hamilton, Vettel, Alonso, Button and Webber. They all have the experience and speed to triumph. It then comes down to opportunity.

What's the relationship like between Hamilton and Button now? Lewis and Jenson have built up a working respect. Now Hamilton's



gone to Mercedes, they have a more open relationship as men than as team-mates because they both drove for McLaren. If Lewis in the Mercedes beats Jenson, Jenson has the comfort that he's in a different car.

What's the relationship like between team-mates generally?

If we were drivers in the same team, I'd have to beat you – my success is your failure, and vice versa. But having said that, drivers are like boxers – after the event they have mutual respect for each other.

What are the big races to look for this season?

The best circuits to drive are Spa and Monaco, but the best tracks for viewers are Montreal and Singapore, because they've historically given us topsyturvy racing scenarios, often due to changing weather conditions. At other tracks, one

guy qualifies at the front, stays at the front and wins the Grand Prix.
