Pininfarina's Ferrari 458-based design concept goes into production

- This kind of thing happens occasionally in the motor industry, and when it does, it's wonderful. Italian coachbuilders and Ferrari chums Pininfarina hit up the **Geneva Motor Show with** this, the Sergio - a "design exercise" based on Ferrari's 458 Italia. And now they've decided to make it.
- So, five or six of these impossibly gorgeous convertibles will go to lucky buyers, minus the Ferrari badge, but plus a wee windscreen, so drivers won't have to wear crash helmets.
- When they were crayoning it, the designers took into account any homologation requirements - regulations

deceased former president of Pininfarina, the Sergio is a two-seater "barchetta" which takes design cues from many famous Pininfarina designs. The raking front and angled

Pesky moths had already gone to town headlight array are Ferrari Dino-esque, while in profile, the long lines and side strakes echo the futuristic 1968 Ferrari 250 P/5 concept. Small scissor doors have also been added, along with a gaping hole on the bonnet and a lightweight honeycomb engine cover.

It may be based on Ferrari's 458 Italia and have its 4.5-litre, 570bhp engine between the rear wheels, but this will be a very different beast. For starters, at 1,280kg, this will weigh 205kg less than the Ferrari so will shave a couple of miliseconds from the 458's 3.4 second 0-62mph blast and add a couple of miles to its 202mph top speed. But what price such exclusivity? Well, Pininfarina will push five or six Sergios out of its Cambiano factory, to the tune of at least £2.5million a pop. Don't bother picking up the phone, though – these will almost certainly already have been sold to "special clients". In an Emirate somewhere, most likely.

NTERVIEW: CHRIS SAUNDERS



OPERATIONS CERTAIN DEATH HOW 60 BRITISH TROOPS TOOK ON A 100,000-STRONG IRAQI ARMY



T'S BEEN ten years since the men of Britain's Special Boat Service took on an unimaginable task. Their challenge

was to take the surrender of the Iraqi V Corps – a 100,000-strong army that had control of northern Iraq. Now, *Nuts* speaks to a senior NCO, Sergeant Steve Grayling who was involved in the mission, and finds out how the troops overcame all odds to survive.

The mission, so MI6 led them to believe, would be straightforward: enter the desert, locate an army, who, having grown weary of Saddam's tyrannical rule, would simply hand over their weapons. The outcome, which led to a death-defying escape, was far different.

AMBUSHED

The Special Boat Service troops - a regiment made up largely of experienced ex-Royal Marines - were dropped into the desert in the dead of night and, with only a dozen lightweight Land Rovers and a fleet of quad bikes to carry them, made their way to their target. Halfway to the destination, they received news that a team of elite Iraqi troops were hunting them. They were massively overstretched. The desert was 50°C by day, freezing by night. The men had little water. limited ammo and now had the threat of ambush to deal with across a 1,000km stretch of open terrain.

Upon reaching where they believed the Iraqi V Corps were based, the troops came under heavy fire. Steve Grayling recalls: "When the first rounds came in, we got a sense of the kind of firepower we were up against. Getting slammed by a dozen 12.7mm machine guns was bad enough – one of those will rip your limbs clean from your body. When the huge tank shells started hammering into the lake bed where we were hidden, we knew we had to get out of there or we'd be finished."

OUTNUMBERED

It was at this point that things got worse. Steve and his comrades saw Iraqi tanks followed by lorries filled with infantry troops piling onto the sand, ready to finish them off. It wasn't just the attack that was terrifying – it was the realisation that such heavy fire could only have come from the V Corps – the very men they were to liberate from Saddam's grip.

Steve continues, "We were outnumbered and outgunned – there was no way out. We had F16s above us and they did their air recces but said they couldn't differentiate friend from foe clearly enough to do any drops. We knew that without top cover, V corps would be able to annihilate us with ease."

The 60 men – several of whom were by now wounded – then had to jump onto the remaining vehicles to escape. "We had so many men loaded onto the wagons – even blokes laying across the bonnet," remembers The men had no sleep, little water and many were injured

Steve. "Others hung off the back as tracer fire zipped all around us."

Because the wagons were so overloaded, the SBS boys' use of their mounted machine guns was now hampered. The enemy fire was so intense, Steve recalls how some vehicles became so badly shot up, they looked like sieves.

"I never had time to fear death, though it was everpresent during the entire night of the firefights. Getting me and my men out alive was the overriding factor for me."

INSPIRATION

Just as it looked like the force would be wiped out, there came a moment of inspiration. One of the commanders radioed the F16s and asked them to fly overhead again, upon which he ordered his troops to fire the one and only weapon

MISSION: IMPOSSIBLE

that could save them: a thermobaric rocket. At that time an untested weapon, it fired fuel into the air creating a huge explosion. As a very last resort, the commander hoped the Iraqis would think the F16 was firing at them and flee, giving them time to escape.

The bluff worked and the men were able to escape into the desert. Around 40 troops were picked up by RAF Chinook helicopters and two more had outrun the enemy on a quad bike. They were picked up by the Syrian Army and later released. All 60 eventually made it back alive.

Looking back on the mission, Steve believes that capture was never an option. "We knew we'd fight to the end – to the last man and the last round. We drove the wagons until some ran out of fuel. It was f**king desperate. Die heroes; die cowards – take your pick."
