
















Wolverine's

HE MAY be the angriest and hairiest superhero of all time, but Hugh Jackman and his amazing acting mutton chops make for a terrific Wolverine. So a first glimpse at flick

number two is as good a use of half a page as we can think of. This one involves old spiky hands having his powers of rejuvenation removed. Called The Wolverine, it's in cinemas on 26 July. And it looks smashing.







Electric French supercar!

Sacrebleu! It's a 4WD Porsche Cayman slayer!

- An extra S on their capital city's name certainly isn't the highlight of the French-designed and built new 2013 Pariss roadster. It's a rubbish name for what seems to be a brilliant new silent supercar.
- The Pariss promises to get to 62mph quicker than a 330bhp Porsche Cayman R (under five seconds, with a top speed of around 120mph) and cover 125 miles before needing a five-hour household recharge.
- A pair of electric motors drive all four wheels, with one up front and one at the rear, which means bags of traction and the immediate torque that electric motors are famed for.
- At 3.6 metres long, the Pariss is shorter than a Ford KA, but its shrunken dimensions help to reduce unnecessary bulk while keeping the design sleek and fresh. It looks like a Mazda MX-5 ought to these days.
- Over a tubular steel chassis, the two-seater Pariss is clothed in carbon fibre and Kevlar body panels. This brings weight down to

- a jaw-dropping 750kg almost exactly half of a Ferrari 458 Italia. Gulp.
- But the French design team is keen to point out that no luxuries have been disposed of. Inside the snug cabin, you'll first notice the removable Targa roof, for when it's not snowing or lashing the country with rain.
- Then you'll clock the huge portrait-mounted iPad type touchscreen in the centre console – which is an iPad and is removable. All the car's tech and controls are channelled through here, with displays of wattage, range, speed and satnay.
- Interior finish options include aluminium, carbon, Alcantara, leather and a selection of matt or gloss veneers. Although there's no mention of where luggage will go or battery packs will live, we suspect it'll have a front and rear boot like a Porsche Boxster. Batteries will most likely live under the floor.
- Although this is a pure electric car, Pariss has promised that a range extender model could also become available, with



a titchy petrol engine that acts as a generator to charge the batteries – like Vauxhall's Ampera.

 That will be able to raise the distance between pit stops from 125 miles to 435 miles. And that little engine only adds an extra 70kg to the car. It's some sweet package, and it'll be available at the end of the year for around £60k. Gary Neville, we've found your next motor!

His band got to number 72 in the charts and broke up. Peter's so ridden with jealously, he won't speak to me.




In the original edit of 21 Jump Street, the drama teacher talks about doing cocaine with Whitney Houston's niece. It was dubbed "Doing cocaine with Willie Nelson's horse," after the singer's death.

The scene in *Heat* where Robert De Niro's gang make their escape after the bank robbery has been shown to US Marines as an example of the proper way to retreat under fire.

Tron: Legacy took just 64 days to film, but it took more than a year to add all the additional special effects before it was ready for release.

In The Dark Knight Rises. in a scene set in a Gotham City airport, an EasyJet plane is clearly visible parked on the runway.





i Danny! Your new film, Trance, is a bit far out! Hello! Well, movies are like a trance. They're these weird things. We come to these dark spaces with strangers, there's a flickering light, you're shocked, repelled, you laugh, you cry, you fall in love, you start to believe. Then in this movie, you start to be unable to differentiate between illusion and reality, even though the whole thing's an illusion because it's a movie.

There's loads about hypnosis and the power of suggestion in the movie. Do you believe in all that?

You mean like Derren Brown? I love his work but I always thought, "They're probably actors." Then I thought, "It's strange you don't find some actor years later saving, 'Oh. it's all bollocks - I was paid £200 to pretend..." I think hypnosis only works on the five to ten per cent of people who are suggestible and who want to change and disappear inside somebody. They're called virtuosos and they're the people who Derren Brown picks. So although what you see in the film is ethically very dubious and morally indefensible, it's clinically possible. So there you go.

Did you always want James McAvoy to be your main man in this?

I originally thought he might be a bit young, but he auditioned and he was fantastic. It starts off like a classic McAvoy movie anyway – he's warm, he's trusting, he's got a Scottish accent. Then he turns into a psychotic and loses touch with reality. But he's still someone who makes you feel for him.

Did you have a go at being hypnotised on set?

I didn't have a go. I can't relax enough to do it so I never went in the chair. But we did have a go with Vincent [Cassel] and James in rehearsal and it all got a bit sleepy, but nothing exciting emerged.

Does that mean you tried to get the Trainspotting cast high, then?

Ha-ha! No. They did stay off the booze because they were all trying

to lose weight for the film, but as we got towards the end they went back on the booze. There's a scene in the park where they shoot a dog with an air rifle. We turned up at the park that morning and there were all these rumours that Ewan [McGregor] and Jonny [Lee Miller] were still in a club. They turned up absolutely hammered, but they're such wonderful actors, they made something of it. So if you watch that scene you can see that they're completely out of it. It suits the scene as they do their Sean Connery impersonations.

Amazing! *Trance* is awesome, but how can our readers persuade their girlfriends to watch it?

Actually, one theory is that women find psychological thrillers, where there's a mystery and a puzzle, easier to go with than men. Men are control freaks and we try to organise things. We go, "That wouldn't happen." Psychological thrillers appeal more to women if you can get them in the cinema. Of course, they don't go because there's violence or whatever. So all you have to do it to tell them that *Trance* is a lady's movie.

How did you balance making this at the same time as directing the Olympics opening ceremony?

Thursday and Friday, happy clappy. Saturday to Wednesday, the dark,



psychotic stuff! I think it helped both projects. The other job was a family-friendly, overwhelmingly positive national celebration. It was nice to do something with the darker side of people's imagination at the same time.

Were you tempted to use hypnosis to "persuade" anyone to take part in the Olympics who might otherwise have said no?

Ha! Well, you like to think you have a hypnotic effect on people but it's a bit of an illusion to think you can persuade people to do anything. You can't!

Did you pick up any acting tips from Her Maj, bring it on set the next day and go, "Oi, McAvoy, this is how the Queen does it?"

Ha! Not quite. It was weird, that. When we wrote to the Palace, we were imagining they'd either say OK to a double if we did someone really respectful like Helen Mirren, or they'd say no. We were originally going to bring her on the tube, which was the second idea, "Let's get her on the Central Line - that will be fun." They wrote back and said, "We're delighted about the idea and she'd like to play herself." It was 1 April, so we thought it was a joke. The only thing we insisted on was that it was a secret. She didn't tell anyone in her family so it was a surprise for them too.

Nice one, Danny! Finally then, do you reckon all your flicks have the same underlying theme?

The last three films I've done have all been about memories. In Slumdog Millionaire, memory was a good fortune to Dev Patel. In 127 Hours, where he cuts his arm off. memories save him. This is more about how memories can wreak havoc and destruction. But all the films I've made are the same film, I have to admit that. They're all about a character - usually a bloke - who faces insurmountable odds and overcomes them. If you think about it, Slumdog Millionaire, the guy in 127 Hours, they're the same film. Don't tell anyone!

Trance is in cinemas now.


What do you think of new manager Mauricio Pochettino?

The Brit who spent five years in a US hellhole...

HAUN ATTWOOD went from a small Cheshire town to being a key figure in Arizona's drug-fuelled rave scene. He ended up in America's hellish Maricopa County Jail for over five years. Now reformed, he tells

Hi Shaun. How did you get on the wrong side of the law?

Nuts about what life's like in

the infamous clink.

I moved to America from a small town in England. I got a job as a stockbroker in Arizona and was eventually making half a million dollars a year. It was then I got into organising rave parties and distributing drugs.

How involved with that scene did vou get?

There was a huge amount of drugs and a lot of very shady people involved in the scene. I'd occasionally get on the wrong side of them. One night, a Mafia hit squad was sent out to kidnap me in a club. Amazingly, my friend got into a fight that same evening, so we had to leave the club early. If that hadn't happened, there was a strong chance I'd have been held and tortured.

How did you get caught?

I didn't realise that narcotics officers had been watching me. They had witness statements and they'd been tapping my phone, so they had evidence linking me to the distribution of drugs. A Swat team charged into my house one morning and arrested me. That was it.

Were you treated differently by the authorities because vou were British?

They nicknamed me English Shaun, which I didn't like. I felt it was used against me. I felt the way I was portrayed in court made me sound like a cross between Tony Soprano and a vampire!

Were you ever caught up in any jail riots?

Yes. I was caught in one where it all kicked off and the guards came in letting off pepper spray. There were men toppling down stairwells and you could hear the impact of skulls being smashed against walls and toilet seats. But even when they had pepper spray in their eyes, these guys just kept on going at each other.

What was your worst encounter in there?

I got beaten up pretty badly once. It was done deliberately on visiting day so that I looked like sh*t when my family were there to see me. I'm not a fighter but I tried to punch this guy. It was like hitting a bag of cement.

I'm giving over 100 talks a year. I'm working a lot with schools. I want people to know what prison can do to a person and to make it clear that there's no such thing as an easy stretch.

Was it especially painful to lose the title to your neighbours?


It wasn't ideal but the reaction would have been the same if it was Chelsea or Arsenal.

Hi Mick! Can you describe what it's like in the weighing room before the race?

You could say we're similar to gladiators - it's a case of last man standing. We're

all looking out for each other, but it's every man for himself - a tough business.

What does it feel like when you're on the start line?

You want to get a good place, but more importantly you'll have identified horses you don't want to be anywhere near. If you fall it's one thing, but if you get brought down by a bad jumper it's your own fault.

You won the 1996 Grand National with Rough Quest. Tell us about it.

It was only my second ride in the race. It may have been naivety, but I just felt that I was going to do it.

Did you worry about the prospect of having to jump fences like Becher's Brook?

You give them the respect they deserve or they'll bite you. An unfortunate part of it is that horses lose their lives. That's a horrible part of the sport, because without them we're nothing. What emotions did you go through on the last straight? I had a remit to hit the front right at the end as the horse I rode didn't like being in front. Just to complete the

course is a feat in itself. At fence 28, I thought, "Wow, I'm going to finish this!" Then I realised I could win.

What did winning feel like?

It was absolute euphoria, but I didn't realise the scale of it until I won. When I'm introduced anywhere, it's as a Grand National winner.

You had a bad fall in the 2008 Grand National...

The horse fired me like a spear into the ground. I couldn't feel my arms or my legs. I said, "Please don't let this happen." Luckily, I soon started to get some feeling back and after some operations, I recovered.

How would you sum the **Grand National up?**

If I was trying to promote horse racing to young lads, I'd say get yourself over to Liverpool for the Grand National meeting. It's three days of brilliant racing.

Any tips on how to pick a Grand National winner?

Go for a horse that's been around the course before. Also, see how they've done at Cheltenham Festival that's a great indicator of recent form.

Channel 4 Racing's Grand National coverage runs from 4-6 April.


not got off to a great start as Scotland manager. The Serbia game was difficult as they're a settled side with good players, but the Wales match was the one he had to win.



When you fight guys you know personally, does a bit of you hold back?


