Meet the Italian/Chinese Icona Vulcano concept – it's a 937bhp, £700k mongrel!

- Ferrari's forthcoming LaFerrari promises to deliver 950bhp from a 6.3 V12 and an electric motor. Then comes the McLaren P1 with 903bhp, thanks to a 3.8 twin-turbo V8 and clever leccy muscle. Both cars claim a 0-62 time of under three seconds, and both will nudge 220mph.
- But what you're staring at here has 937bhp and will reportedly crack 62mph in under *two* seconds and also poke 220mph.
- This handsome car is the Vulcano, conceived by Icona – an Italian company based in Shanghai, who offer "the best of European design, engineering and

prototyping experience in the automotive sector for the benefit of customers in China". So, Italian and Chinese experts who know how to build sports cars.

 There are two versions of the Vulcano. The fastest – the H-Turismo (street) version
 – carries a V12 beneath the bonnet which works in tandem with an electric motor. 937bhp goes to the ground through the rear rims, just like the McLaren P1 and LaFerrari. The other is the H-Competizione (racing) version, which has half the number of cylinders, yet only 79bhp less snarl.

 Engineer Claudio Lombardi is responsible for the mechanicals in both models. He oversaw many of Lancia's World Rally Championship wins in the '80s, then got involved with Ferrari's F1 power-train developments of the '90s. Now, his focus is on evolving electric hybrid cars.

- The bodyshell is sculpted with side intakes, front wing cutouts and diamond shaped side windows. It's a real looker.
- The curves were drawn by French designer Samuel Chuffart, who previously designed cars for Nissan, Jaguar and Stile Bertone.
- If this £700k-odd car makes it into production and produces the performance figures being banded about, the Icona Vulcano will guarantee its name in the record books.

WE LOVE all the drama of a cup tie here at *Nuts*, but we always wonder what goes into making the coverage. So, we joined the ESPN guys as they prepped for the recent Millwall vs Wigan FA Cup semi-final. Here's how it panned out...

34 Nuts

13.00 We grab some time with expert John Barnes and ESPN host Ray Stubbs. "Ray has to bring everything together," says John. "I have to tell people what they're watching and give them a professional view of what's happened."



14.00 We run into co-commentator Craig Burley. "I work with our director during the match through a special button to discuss camera angles and topics. Sometimes it f**ks up so you have to be careful not to swear on live TV!" he explains.

15.59 We arrive at the tiny ESPN studio, which is crammed with busy technicians, camera people and make-up guys preparing everyone for the upcoming broadcast. Ray, meanwhile, is going through his script.



12.25 We go into an ESPN truck where tech bloke Stewart Scott explains what everything does. "We have cameras all around the stadium," he says. "The director chooses which pictures he wants, depending on what's happening."

12.35 We meet pretty pitchside host Rebecca Lowe, who grabs managers for interviews. "They're contractually obliged to talk to us," she says. "They're mostly fine, and today's pair – Roberto Martinez and Kenny Jackett – are really nice."

13.10 Ray, who arrived at the stadium at 8.30am, says: "I research the teams, do some scripting and rescripting. John and [fellow studio expert] Kevin Keegan look at the factors that will come into play when the teams kick off." **13.20** After a quick visit to the plush surroundings of the Royal Box, we meet up with some RAF airmen at pitchside, and also listen in on a security briefing. "There are about 1,000 Millwall who may cause bother," says the top steward.

14.55 Rain means ESPN can't host the game from pitchside. "It's a shame," says Ray. "It makes you feel part of the event." John Barnes agrees: "Although FC United fans chanted, 'You Scouse b*stard!' when we went there a couple of years back!" **15.45** While the studio is being prepared now the weather has made hosting outside impossible, we bump into 1966 World Cup winner Sir Geoff Hurst. "Photo for *Nuts*, please, Sir Geoff?" "No problem, lads." He's still a winner in our eyes!

Hi Leighton! Victory in the Merseyside derby will more or less ensure you finish above Liverpool this season. Is that

an extra incentive? Of course there are rivalries, but that doesn't motivate us. We look after ourselves. In recent seasons we've proved we're a good Premier League side, irrespective of where Liverpool finish. It's good for the city to have two teams in the mix near the top of the table, though.

Do you like your reputation as being the Premier League's biggest grafters?

We're a decent side who play football but we battle for the right to play. Every single lad in the dressing room has the same qualities. Sometimes, I'm even surprised myself by the amount of effort and determination our players are willing to put in, each and every game. I guess the attitude comes from the manager and the culture he's instilled at the club.

What is that culture?

There's an expectation we give everything, 100 per cent of the time, and it's shown again this season how far this can take you. Some of our lads have been playing through injuries, such is our desire as a group. It's inspirational to see those kinds of things. There's talent in the side too... We have real quality throughout the side, and maybe this has been underestimated in previous seasons. Sides don't like facing us for a variety of reasons, one of which is that we have talented footballers!

Some pundits say you're now the best left-back in England - better than Ashlev Cole! Ashley has been a brilliant footballer for as long as I can remember. For me, he's a player I look up to and still learn from. My job is to keep playing well for Everton and do my best if called upon by England. Those are the only things I can control.

Your love of music like Oasis and Arctic Monkeys earned you a profile in the NME. How come you're such a muso?

I think music's a little thing to escape into. Once I come away from training I can't be bothered watching football on the TV and the news. That said. I love playing it and wouldn't swap it for anything.

Hi Floyd! How's training going for the fight?

The training camp has been unbelievable. I'm in the gym every day during the week working for hours. I always put in the hard work and dedication. I have the extra drive and motivation to really put on a good show.

What sort of fight do you expect from your opponent Robert Guerrero?

I expect a hard fight. He's mentioned among the other great champions in boxing today because he's proven himself. He'll now have to prove himself against me, which is a whole other story. Guerrero's a tough fighter who has been calling me out for almost two years. He wouldn't be in the position to face me if he wasn't. The MGM has treated me well over the years and I'm happy to keep bringing the Mayweather money back there.

Your promotional company, Mayweather Promotions, seems to be going well.

It is. One of my fighters, Ishe Smith, recently won a championship. I told Ishe that I'd get him a championship fight, and I held up my end of the bargain by putting him in the ring with K9 Bundrage and he held up his end by winning. He's the first Las Vegas native to win a world championship and I couldn't be prouder that he's part of the Mayweather Promotions stable of fighters.

"You're alright, mate – I'll just punch myself"

Will you ever fight Amir Khan? If it makes sense for me to fight Khan in the future, I'll consider it, but right now I'm fighting Guerrero and that's it.

Did you happen to see Ricky Hatton's last fight?

Yes, I did. I was so happy that the crowd came out for him the way they did and it was sad to see him go down like that. I have a lot of respect for Ricky Hatton. Our fight was one of my biggest and I wish him all the best.

Would you want to fight in the UK before you retire?

I have so many fans there. I'd love to fill the O2 Arena and give the UK fans a great show and show them how much I appreciate their support.

Do you ever get nervous before any fights?

No. Do you get nervous before you go to work? This is what I do!

Thanks, Floyd! Finally, does a Manny Pacquaio fight still interest you?

It isn't on my radar. Manny Pacquiao was knocked out by Juan Manuel Marquez in his last fight. I wish him well but all I know is I'm fighting Robert Guerrero on 4 May and that's my focus.
