IN JANUARY, we showed you pics of the X-47B, the US military's newest unmanned drone. Now, the 62ft-wide craft has made its first take-off – catapulted from the deck of the USS George HW Bush aircraft carrier.

What makes the X-47B such a departure from other drones is its ability to fly to a pre-programmed target on its own, making course corrections when needed.

Lamborghini's 50th birthday present to itself - a monster that looks like an Apache 'copter! Sometimes, a candlecovered cake doesn't cut it. Half a century in the supercar business is something to be proud of, which is why Lamborghini has treated itself to this little gift.

CAUTION

This is the Egoista, a singleseater with a cockpit that mimics that of an Apache helicopter gunship. It doesn't have any doors, but a forwardhinging bubble roof. You have to step on the bodywork to climb inside, due to the central driving position.

Drop down into the seat (upholstered in orange, hexshaped quilting), pull down the canopy roof and you're in an orange-tinted world with carbon-fibre panels

instead of carpets, a bow tie-shaped steering wheel and floating gauge pod.

On top of the pod is a headsup display and a gun sight, presumably nicked from the same Apache that influenced the rest of the interior. But the Egoista doesn't feature any weaponry, unless you count a 5.2-litre V10 as a firearm. Taken from the Gallardo model, the mid-mounted engine has been poked to pump up its horsepower from 552bhp to 592bhp, with an estimated top speed of 210mph, while the car weighs around 1,000kg.

 The Egoista doesn't have any spoilers, but instead uses active flaps – the type you see on jet plane wings. And you know the flashing lights on the wing tips of airliners? The same tiny LED lights are used on the tail and front end.

It's covered in military-grade radar-absorbing paint, but no one will ever discover if it repels speed guns, as it will never be sold or leave Lambo's clutches.

Hi Carl! You're fighting Mikkel Kessler again, this

time in London rather than Denmark. Will that give you an advantage?

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I won my title back in my next fight, but I've not had the chance to avenge my defeat against Kessler, so now I've got that chance to cement my legacy by fighting him again. I've been working hard in the gym and I'm doing what I need to do to get the win this time.

Did you feel as though you won the last fight against Kessler? We know the fight was close last time and he beat me fair and square, but we were in Denmark then and so rounds tend to go the way of the home fighter and that's what happened. I've had some close fights at home before when you get close rounds, so there's no doubt I can beat him in London.

Was the fight always going to take place in London?

I heard that Kessler didn't want to fight me in my home town of Nottingham because ideally I would have wanted the fight at the City Ground, but it's not the case. I'm happy fighting in London and I think Mikkel is too.

You've considered it before, but if you lose this fight, are you thinking of retiring?

Well, it depends – if I can't win this fight where can I go in the sport of boxing? I said after the Bute fight I was going to retire if I lost that one, so who knows? It depends how the fight goes. The natural fight for the winner would be Andre Ward, but he doesn't make for good viewing– he's boring. He fights very close to you so it's hard to get any punches off. You've got to give him credit though, because he's very effective. It hurt losing to Ward because he ducked and dived and ruined the fight. I didn't really enjoy it. I think I can beat him if we get the rematch, but I'm not too interested in fighting him because he's boring. The only thing is, that's a loss I could avenge, so I wouldn't rule it out from happening.

Will the Kessler fight be one big tear-up?

If I take the fight to him early on, he's going to have to have an answer. People know what they're getting with us two

Have you had to watch your diet in preparation for the fight? I have to keep one eye on my diet, but I've got a fast metabolism so I've never really had to worry about it too much. And I don't drink much. I'm not a big drinker, so I don't have to worry about that either.

Thanks for the chat, Carl! Finally, this is a title unification – you're both current supermiddleweight World Champions. So, who's under the most pressure?

My fans are very passionate and so are his. Kessler's the David Beckham of Denmark, so the atmosphere's going to be electric. But that adds pressure to him – this fight is gigantic in Denmark and Mikkel has the weight of the country on his shoulders. We're both fighting for pride, honour and our legacies. The fact there's two world titles on the line just adds to it. I can't wait for it. I'm going to be going for the kill and I'm not looking to leave it for the judges.
