

Amazing face transplant!

Polish chap loses his face in a terrible accident. Gets a new one, weeks later!

IT WAS, incredibly, just three weeks between this unnamed 33-year-old Polish chap here having his face ripped off and both jaws smashed in an industrial accident, and him having a new face stitched on by docs in a pioneering operation. Usually it would take months to prep.

In a 27-hour operation, our man's face, jaws, palate and the bottom of his eye sockets were reconstructed, before the donor face was whipped off a dead chap in the room next door and attached. And just six days later, the patient was cracking thumbs ups for the camera and showing off his impressive arm tattoo.





Tr's QUITE A JOB

As well as losing most of the skin around his face, our man also lost his jaw, nose and eye socket.

Surgeons mark out then cleanly remove the area of the face and skin that they aim to replace.


Medics now adjust the old and new bones and muscles. A better fit means quicker recovery chances.

The last great Aston Vantage!

Aston Martin 'retire' their V12 Vantage with a Ferrari 458 and Lambo Gallardo-eater!

- With a maximum speed of 205mph, this new Aston V12 Vantage S sets its sights on outgunning Ferrari's fantastico 458 Italia and Lamborghini's Gallardo – which both run out of puff at 202mph.
- Continuing Aston Martin's quiet 100th birthday celebrations, the V12 S is
- the next model to receive a spruce-up, strict diet and hike in power. Now, with the exception of the £1.1m One-77, this is the fastest road-going Aston.
- The grille is now moody dark carbon fibre with titanium mesh, and the horizontal alloy bars have been binned for diagonal





slats, pilfered from the CC100 speedster concept.

- The bonnet vents, front chin splitter, boot-lid spoiler lip and rear diffuser are also hewn from carbon fibre.
- From the depths comes the signature V12 soundtrack, which gargles through a new exhaust system in wrinklefinish black. Borrowed from
- the One-77 hypercar, it's smaller and lighter, but most importantly, also bellows like a lion with laryngitis. It also gets a black roof and part-painted boot lid.
- For the interior, Aston has specified lashings of carbon fibre again. Alongside the trademark exposed handstitching, the V12 S cockpit
- gets optional lightweight carbon seats, two grades of leather to choose from and the chance to order the door pulls and dash fascia in fibre.
- By using the new Vanquish's 6.0-litre V12, the S now has 565bhp of meat to chew on.
 The gearbox is the latest version of Aston's hydraulic paddle-operated "Sportshift

III". Gone is the choice of manual, which is a shame (as it was just lush).

 No official 0-62 has been released, but the outgoing V12 Vantage did it in 4.1 seconds. With improved power and less flab, the S will be a sub-4 second car. And the price? Around £140k. Trust us, that represents value for money.

UNMADE MOVIES

E.T. II: Nocturnal Fears 1985 The gist: The lovable extra terrestrial is hunted by, er, notso-lovable extra terrestrials!

Within weeks of E.T.'s release in 1982, Steven Spielberg had put together a nine-page outline for a sequel, in which evil aliens come to Earth on the hunt for E.T., whose real name is revealed to be Zrek. These rampaging space b*stards terrorise Elliott for information on Zrek's whereabouts, and right at the end, Zrek turns up to kick space ass. On realising it might be the worst idea ever, Spielberg scrapped it.

Superman Lives 1998 The gist: Nicolas Cage sporting a cape and yet another hairdo!

With a script by Kevin "Clerks" Smith and oddball Tim Burton lined up as director, the late-'90s reboot of Superman looked like a surefire winner - even with the slightly crackers casting choice of madeyed, drawling-voiced, nostril-flaring Nicolas Cage in the Man Of Steel role. Endless rewrites and a whopping £30million later, however, Superman Lives was canned - a shame, as it would've at least been less of a snooze-fest than 2006's Superman Returns.

The Sandman 2004 The gist: The ruler-ofdreams comic-book character hits the big time!

One of the biggest comic book series of the '90s, The Sandman by Neil Gaiman, charted the weird, creepy adventures of the ruler of dreams. There have been several near-miss attempts at filming the story, most recently by Gaiman himself. He pitched his dark and thoughtful vision to studio execs, the studio execs pitched their brashly violent version back at him. Deadlock ensued and The Sandman remains in limbo.

Alien 3: The Lost Tale Of The Wooden Planet 1990 The gist: Space monks vs space monsters. On a planet made of wood!

There was, of course, a third Alien movie, but it was very nearly a different film entirely. Set on a manmade wooden planet populated entirely by monks, it was intended to inject a little medieval flavour into the sci-fi series. The movie was green-lit, Sigourney Weaver signed on, production began - but the studio panicked and writer/director Vincent Ward walked.



The gist: Much-anticipated Masters Of The Universe

The Masters Of The Universe reboot - designed to erase painful memories of the pretty rank 1987 outing starring Dolph Lundgren - has been on/off so many times, many hardcore He-Man fans (yes, such people exist) have lost all hope. First, John "Face/Off" Woo signed on to direct, then the director of Kung Fu Panda, then the guy who did G.I. Joe: Retaliation. But don't despair, retro superhero fans - at least there's Teenage Mutant Ninja Turtles next year.

24 2010 The gist: Kiefer Sutherland's chief terrorist stopper, Jack Bauer, has another rubbish day, on a much bigger screen!

When 24 wrapped up its run in 2010, a send-off movie was announced. But progress has since slowed to such a crawl, the film's director, Antoine Fuqua (Training Day, Olympus Has Fallen), declared in March, "I don't think it's going to happen - certainly not with me." Although, in April, Kiefer Sutherland announced he's still keen. Let it go, Kiefer!

Wonder Woman 2007 The gist: The hotpantswearing lass with the lasso makes it big!

DC Comics' battling goddess looked all set for a bigscreen outing, with king of the geeks Joss "Avengers Assemble" Whedon behind the camera, and hotties from Katie Holmes to Mischa Barton lining up to pull on the hotpants - until Warner Bros rejected Whedon's script. Still, Drive director Nicolas Winding Refn recently expressed an interest in squeezing Christina Hendricks into the WW suit. We bet he did.

UNMADE MOVIES

Ghostbusters 3 1999-now The gist: Who's not gonna be in your ghostly threequel? Bill Murray!

Dan Aykroyd has been hawking his *Ghostbusters* threequel round Hollywood since the '90s, with his main stumbling block being that Bill Murray is unwilling to reprise his role as Peter Venkman – although he did say he'd agree to return if he was killed off within the first 30 minutes. Aykroyd now reckons the movie will start shooting, minus Murray, next summer. Sure.

X-Men Origins: Magneto 2009 The gist: Loads of levitating cars!

This X-Men spin-off/prequel had David S Goyer (writer of the new Superman film) in the director's chair, and Sir Ian McKellen reprising his role as Magneto, whose origin would be told through flashbacks to the Second World War, when the future villain was imprisoned by the Nazis. But a Hollywood writers' strike delayed the movie and the storyline was absorbed into X-Men: First Class.

George A Romero's Resident Evil 2001
The gist: The original zombie bloke takes on a gaming classic!

Although we did get a *Resident Evil* movie (plus four sequels), the job of writing and directing the survival horror adaptation originally fell to George A Romero, the man who basically invented zombie movies with 1968's *Night Of The Living Dead*. Unusually, Capcom rejected Romero's script for sticking too closely to the plot of the game. "They wanted something closer to a war movie," said Romero.

The gist: Morgan Freeman takes on more sicko psychos!

Ace thriller Se7en didn't exactly cry out for a sequel: one character is dead, one is retired, one is insane and one's head is in a box. But an unrelated script about a clairvoyant cop was rejigged by the guy who wrote Ocean's Eleven so it was about Morgan Freeman's Detective Somerset, who's now magic. Ei8ht never happened but the script it would have been based on hits screens next year as Solace.

The Works 1986 The gist: Overly cute robot Wall-E comes to the big screen, approximately 25 years too early! Beating Pixar's Toy Story by more than a decade, The Works would have been the first entirely CGI movie made - a wacky sci-fi comedy set in the distant future about a malfunctioning computer, The Works, that triggers a massive war, but then, realising what it's done, sets out to repopulate a devastated earth with robots. Production began in 1979, but seven years later, following seemingly endless delays, financial problems and technological meltdowns, just ten minutes of the proposed 90 minutes of footage had been produced, and the whole disastrous shebang was finally abandoned. The Works did speed CGI's evolution along, however, and many of those involved went on to join Pixar. Jurassic Park IV The gist: Attack of the superfearsome manosaurus rex! A fourth Jurassic Park is scheduled to be with us some time next year, but it'll be a completely different prehistoric beast from the one we almost got in 2006. Written by Oscar winner William 'The Departed" Monahan, the "lost" Jurassic Park IV focused on human-dinosaur hybrids that looked like the xenomorphs from the Alien movies, except even more terrifying. Unsurprisingly, studio executives decided that permanently traumatising loads of pre-teen cinema-goers probably wasn't the way to go. Spider-Man 4 Unknown
The gist: Anne
Hathaway as a rubbercatsuited thief - again! Even though director Sam Raimi himself didn't like Spider-Man 3 much, it did make a ton of cash, and so studio execs signed him up for a fourth outing, with Tobey Maguire battling the Vulture (played by John Malkovich) and the Black Cat (Anne Hathaway, who went on to play the remarkably similar Catwoman in The Dark Knight Rises). Raimi couldn't pull his story together in time, however, and eventually advised the studio to hire another director to do a reboot instead. His advice was, of course, finally taken, with The Amazing Spider-Man coming out last year and a follow-up due in 2014.

Gump & Co 2002 The gist: Run, Forrest, run... this time in the '80s and '90s!

Gump & Co would have shown us what annoying man-child Forrest Gump got up to during the '80s and '90s – the plot had him meeting Princess Di, tearing down the Berlin Wall, and fighting in the Gulf War. The script was completed the day before 9/11. Following the attack on the Twin Towers, Tom Hanks decided audiences probably weren't in the mood for life being like a box of chocolates, and it was dropped.

Gladiator 2 2005
The gist: Maximus
Meridius goes
time-travelling!


Although Maximus died at the end of *Gladiator*, that didn't deter Russell Crowe and director Ridley Scott from hiring Aussie musician Nick Cave to write a sequel. Cave's crazy script has Maximus timetravelling through key conflicts in history – the Battle of Hastings, Vietnam etc – climaxing with landing a job at the Pentagon. The studio said no. Actually, it was probably more like, "Noooooo!"

Neon Genesis
Evangelion 2010
The gist: Super ultrarobo team assemble!


The giant-fighting-robot show to end all giant-fighting-robot shows, animated TV series *Neon Genesis Evangelion* is huge in Japan. In the wake of *Transformers'* success, an English-language, live-action movie was set into motion. Steven Spielberg expressed an interest in getting involved, but the Japanese studio went bust trying to fund the project. After all, giant robots don't come cheap.

Alice 2006
The gist: Malice in Lewis
Carroll's Wonderland –
although not the 2009
film of the same name!

Based on the 2000 horror game American McGee's Alice – a nightmarish take on Alice In Wonderland – Alice was to be directed by Wes Craven and star Sarah Michelle Gellar as the heroine, but insane legal tanglings held up filming, with the rights to Alice bouncing between three different studios. In the meantime, Tim Burton's Alice In Wonderland came out – yes, it was terrible, but it was there first.

Thanks for the chinwag, Karl! Finally, what's the best thing about being British?



"No, I think when people criticise you it's almost revealing their respect. It's like with the fans – I'm disappointed if I turn up at a ground and I'm not being shouted at and called rude names. That wouldn't worry me at all, it would please me and motivate me and tell me he has a lot of things on his mind and I'm one of them. I've been called a lot worse than Nigel!"




6 You know one of your strikers is enjoying the nightlife a bit too much, but he's still producing the goods. Do you intervene or just let it continue?

"If he's not bringing the club into disrepute and he's playing well, he can do what he wants! You can advise people on how to look after themselves, you can't tell them."

And I'll never understand why anyone would want to know I've had egg and bacon for my breakfast."

"I'd take him aside and have a word about what being a professional footballer is about and what people will think when they see that. A lot of people won't see what he did the next morning. Lots of lads do charity work which goes unnoticed. The tabloids always prefer bad publicity. I wouldn't fine him, but I'd try to get him to be responsible."



A player has been out of form for weeks, then news breaks he's run up debts on a gambling site who are to be the club's next shirt sponsors. What do you do?

"I'd get some help for the lad. I've had problems with players who've run up gambling debts. It's an illness. These lads have a lot of money and time on their hands. We can't take our foot off the gas educating them about gambling – with all this 'bet in play' stuff, it's almost non-stop. The PFA need to keep a grip on it, and big gambling firms need to help too."

"Oh God! I'd fire them, personally. It's absolutely disgusting – that's the lowest of the low, the equivalent of someone spitting at you on the pitch. It's the worst thing you can do. against the Republic of Ireland summed up in one word – disappointment. It wasn't a disastrous disappointment, but they just didn't try to play. 


