



# Topless Aston Vanquish!

Aston's flagship grand tourer gets its lid removed and desirability upgraded...

- You may have noticed that we've gone a bit Aston bonkers of late. But the Brit supercar maker is celebrating its 100th birthday in lavish style, with the unique CC100 Speedster, the 205mph V12 Vantage S and now this, its flagship Vanquish GT, now a Vanquish Volante (convertible).
- And the lab-coated engineers have been busy. Lashings of carbon fibre (this is the first all fibre-skinned Volante in Aston's history) and a stiffer structure mean, with its sister motor's 6.0-litre V12 engine inside, the Volante registers the same 0-62mph and top speed (4.1 seconds, 183mph). Unheard of in a convertible.

- The lightweight, triple-skinned fabric roof may also be a factor. And it's quick, too, exposing your bonce to the sun in 14 seconds. And up again, when it rains.
- And even though the roof tucks straight into the boot, there's no space-saving compromise. The boot's the same volume as the Vanquish coupé, is 50 per cent larger than the previous DBS Volante's and still holds that all-important golf bag.
- And actually, it looks stunning, borrowing the iconic side strakes from the One-77 hypercar alongside its frowny LED rear light blades, while the line of the long roof decklid to one-piece spoiler looks very Porsche Carrera GT.
- Inside, of course, is your usual Aston opulence of full grain, exquisitely-stitched Luxmil leather and a glass-filled centre stack, again "borrowed" from the One-77, with glass gear selector buttons, new infotainment system and haptic feedback.
- An almost-perfect 51:49 weight distribution should mean sweet handling with little chassis flex. In fact, it's 14 per cent torsionally stiffer than the DBS Volante.
- Aston will give you a crisp fiver's change from £200k for this car. But you'll be handed the keys to one of the most handsome cars in the world.


**Chef prepares 70kg monster fish!**

ello Jason! So this new flick, *Hummingbird*, is a bit different from your usual butt-kicking stuff, isn't it?

Yes. I thought it was a great story.

Something I haven't done anything close to before. It was very different for me. Steven Knight is a world-class screenwriter, and I loved the other films he has made, like *Eastern Promises* and *Dirty Pretty Things*. The crux of the story, where a homeless bloke falls in love with a nun, appealed to me. It's something quite unique, I think.

It sounds it! What's so different about the character you play, then?

Joey Jones is a man escaping his demons, living hand-to-mouth on the street because he committed an atrocity as a soldier and is running away from a court martial. He's struggling to live with that, but at the same time, he's not looking for forgiveness, he's just surviving and dealing with the guilt in his own way.

Do you think the story of a returning soldier struggling to fit in is one that gets overlooked these days?

Yes, because they're the real heroes. You feel for those people. The stress and suffering they go through, and then the way they feel they can't fit back into normal society when they come home. You have to remember that they spend all that time learning skills like shooting guns and killing people, then those skills are suddenly redundant. They learn all this stuff that you're not allowed to do in the real world. They spend their lives learning to be good at something, then come back and have to learn to be good at something else. For me, to have the chance to portray one of these characters is a privilege.

It sounds pretty intense. How do you psych yourself up for a darker role such as this?

Steven Knight and I visited some places I would never normally even think of visiting. We spoke to lots of ex-servicemen and women and listened to the stories they told us about their friends and the things they've been through. It's such an interesting world,

but dangerous, too. There are a lot of people taking advantage of the weak.

So you spent a bit of time on the streets?

I met with the homeless charity Connection at St Martin-in-the-Fields, in London, and met a lot of people there who had a profound effect on me. Every story you hear is unique, captivating and interesting. But they're also sad, and tough to hear. They helped me shape the character. As an actor, you work to the script, that's your main priority. But you have to be aware, and look around for things that help you bring that little bit extra, that touch of realism that ramps the point home.

What did you learn from making a movie like *Hummingbird*?

I had an insight into an ex-soldier's world, and also a homeless person's world. These are people who are invisible at times. They walk around and people don't give them any attention. They try to reach out and talk to people sometimes, but people just ignore them. If you spend a little time actually talking to these people, you get an insight into something that not many other people ever get to know about.

There are still a few trademark Statham bust-ups in the movie. Did you enjoy having to crack out the martial arts?

I've always done martial arts and trained in a lot of different disciplines over the years. I do judo, kick-boxing, Thai boxing, jujitsu... It certainly helps with my film roles, though I don't use a particular style. Just like the real world, it becomes a case of what's effective for

that particular situation. I enjoy making action films, and having a background in that world is absolutely priceless.

Once again you're in a film set against the gritty backdrop of London. What's your favourite thing about shooting there?

London can be a character in itself, if used properly. It's not just a backdrop or a setting, it's more than that. To a lot of people, London is everything. It's a place where good things are happening and where bad things are happening, day and night. It never sleeps. It is, without doubt, one of the greatest cities in the world.

It feels like the whole film is set at night. Is that really the case?

From a practical point of view, it's easier to make a movie at 4 or 5am in the heart of the city, purely because there are fewer people around at that time. That's one of the hardest things about making films – you have to fit in with someone else's vision and do whatever the situation calls for. It takes two or three weeks before you start to adjust.

Thanks for the chat! Finally, does all the training you've done for action movies over the years mean you could save us if some bad guys burst in right now?

Ha-ha! I don't know about that. I'd probably just throw a table at them and run!

# LEON MCKENZIE

The ex-footballer talks about his new life as a boxer!





**LEON MCKENZIE** first found fame as a Premier League striker for Norwich.

He scored over 100 goals in league football but his career was cut short by his battle with mental illness. Since then, he has tirelessly campaigned for a better understanding of mental health problems. And now he has taken up boxing. *Nuts* asked him what has inspired him to make such a dramatic late career change...

**Hello Leon. In your book, *My Fight With Life*, you describe how depression drove you to the edge, even putting you in prison for a driving offence. How did it happen?**

They were my choices – bad choices – and I accept them. But I didn't care about my life because I was depressed. To my mind, I had no future. Those decisions weren't representative of who I was – I didn't care for the consequences of my actions.

**Why have you now decided to swap your footy boots for a pair of boxing gloves?**

Even if I'd finished my career as a multi-millionaire I'd still be getting in the ring. I want to be there. My boxing career won't make me loads of money – I've never said I'll win a world title. This is about me being the best boxer for me. I think people will say, "You know, he's actually pretty good!"

**Has what you've been through played a big part in you wanting to fight? Has it changed your outlook?**

So much has happened in my life now that I just want to fight. This isn't about channelling anger – you can't have anger in a boxing ring or you make mistakes. I've always wanted to box. Punters see a 35-year-old about to get in the ring for the first time. I get that. But I'll prove them wrong.

**But how does that drive and ambition to get in the ring differ from playing football?**

They're so different. Here, you're on your own. You have another ten players in football. If you're struggling on the pitch, you can hide. In a boxing ring, there's no hiding place. I gave my all to football then my body said I couldn't do that any more. In boxing, you're constantly battling with your mind and your body. You're getting up at 5am to go for a run. There are places that you go to in boxing where you really find out about yourself. I can't wait to bring all the hard work out in the ring.

**Can you remember the moment you decided this was the right thing to do?**

I'm good friends with Spencer Oliver [former European super-bantamweight champion.] I started going to his gym and he took me for a session on the pads and he was blown away. He stopped me

and said, "You have to fight. You're that good." I just thought, "Nah, I'm 34," but he wouldn't accept it. He kept bugging me and I realised I loved the idea.

**You're also from a boxing dynasty – your father Clinton was a British champ who fought Sugar Ray Leonard at Olympic level, and your uncle Duke was a three-time world champ. What do they think about your new path?**

They had their doubts. A boxing ring doesn't seem like the best place for someone who has had depression, does it? But they also knew I was set on this. They know as much about me as I do. They know about my weaknesses. They would never let me near a boxing ring if they didn't think I could hack it.

**How hard was it to pick football over boxing?**

It was a decision I was made to take. I was about to get my YTS at Crystal Palace and my coaches pulled me aside and said you have to pick one or the other. I became a pro at 17 so it wasn't a bad choice. I made an 18-year career out of it.

**Is it true that you've been sparring with Olympic champ James DeGale?**

I did four rounds with him, which helped massively. He's extremely fast, even stronger than I thought, and caught me with some really good shots. Afterwards he said, "Wow, you're good." It shocked him, I think. It meant a lot.

**Thanks, Leon! Finally then, you're fighting at York Hall in London, the same venue your dad began his own career. How special is that?** York Hall's a proper boxing venue. I feel really honoured to fight there and amazed it's actually going to

happen. It's a beautiful feeling for me to have that pedigree behind me. My family are a huge help, but they can't fight for me. This is only about me. ✕

NOVAK DJOKOVIC • WORLD RANKING: 1



He can achieve such shapes with his body that he's often like a gymnast, but on top of that he can wring power from his body while seeming to be extremely off balance and on the back foot. It's very difficult to figure out what the best way is to attack him, which is why he's been world number one for the last two years. And as a rule, you should never bet against the world number one. This year, however, I might just change all that."



**ROGER FEDERER** • WORLD RANKING: 3

"It's hilarious that there are still people who think that Roger can't win Wimbledon any more. Just plain wrong. He's the defending champion, and it's likely that when this generation of players has gone, we'll view him as the best player in the best generation of players ever. I think people should just sit back and enjoy watching him play without pressure – and when he's won 17 Grand Slam titles, he can play to enjoy himself, because there can't be that many years left in him. On a grass court, he's going to be right in the mix again. Ever since I first saw him as a teenager, I've always wanted to play like him. It hasn't happened yet. Gutted!"



**DAVID FERRER** • WORLD RANKING: 4

"What is David Ferrer? He's an absolute workman. Every day he picks up the tools and he puts in that work. In the USA, they'd call him a 'blue collar' kind of guy. He should play with a hammer and an anvil – he grinds people down on the court, then clocks off at five and goes home for his tea. When he was a teenager, he did a week on a building site to work on his fitness – in the end, I think he thought, 'The hell with that, I'd rather be on the court!' There's even a story that when he failed to practise properly, his coach locked him in a cage. Whether that's true or not, Ferrer has maximised what he has, and I respect that enormously."

I can't imagine him losing early this year, and there are many examples of players who flourish late in their career after time out injured, like Lleyton Hewitt or Tommy Haas. There's a lot to be said for keeping enthusiastic about playing. It's the old argument of fitness vs freshness."

But I'm going with Murray. They say you can tell the winner of a horse race in the paddock beforehand. If Queen's Club was the pre-race paddock, Murray looked pretty good."

- The Swamp Soccer World Cup begins on Saturday 29 June in Edinburgh.



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
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
