The Pacific Rim star on big robots, wearing Lacoste clobber and playing James Bond

Hello Idris! So, talk us through the story of your new movie

Pacific Rim. It does sound a bit silly... The story behind it is that there are these aliens that

are actually connected by DNA to dinosaurs. Facing extinction, they went to the Pacific perimeter where they became stronger, bigger, faster, until they decided, "Hey, it's time to go back!" And when they get there, they say, "Oh my God! All these homo sapiens! Where did they come from?" And so they decide, "We'll get rid of them!" So the homo sapiens build these beautiful machines these robots that look like them and are manned by them, but are super powerful. And so we experience the war between these two factions.

That's as clear as mud! But it's a proper blockbuster, right?

Let's not mess around, this film is a piece of art. The scale of the movie! Understand you're looking at robots that are 40 storeys high and Kaiju [monsters] that are probably 60 storeys high. You really wanna soak that up on a big IMAX screen so when vou leave the cinema vou have to make sure there are no Kaiju coming because vou feel like vou're still in that world.

What drew you to the movie, and your silly-named character **Stacker Pentecost?** The script was good and

pretty different. I hadn't done anything like that before. Obviously, [director] Guillermo del Toro is a good film-maker. That was the main reason - I just saw an opportunity to work with him. Pentecost is a pretty interesting character and I felt like I could bring something to life with him.

Did you and the other cast members train together to bond, or anything like that?

There was a little bit of training, but not so much for me. My character is sort of isolated from the rest of the gang. But we did see each other on the set and it's a very big, eclectic cast. Everyone was really good and fun. We'd also get very serious in Guillermo's presence and about what he wants. It was quite a serious, gritty work environment. But yeah, everyone was really cool and really colourful.

We heard that filming the scenes in the cockpits of the fighting machines was hard. Did you suffer for your art?

It was just really tough and very uncomfortable, and I was doing things I've never done in my life. It looks fantastic on screen, but from a performer's point of view, just being strapped into a harness and pulled about left and right was really tough work.

The Wire set me up at a time when my career was going nowhere. It's probably one of the greatest TV shows ever. It's epic, honest and it was different from anything else.

You've become a bit of a style icon. Did your mum dress you as a nipper?

Killer Mexican track ninja!

Drool over the Vuhl 05. It's a 695kg, 152mph, £60k, impossibly cool track weapon!

- Meet Mexico's new supercar, the Vuhl 05. It's the work of two Mexican brothers with the backing of the Mexican Government.
- The main ingredients are a race car-style honeycomb aluminium monocoque chassis, with front and rear suspension bolted onto tube steel subframes. There's a

deformable crash box in the front nose to save your legs in a shunt.

The amigos at Vuhl claim that it has three-times more torsional rigidity than a Lotus Elise. Which means a) it will have more comfortable on-road suspension, and b) it will be an all-conquering corner destroyer on circuits.





- On top of the chassis sit body panels made out of reinforced plastic for lightness. Optional carbon fibre panels would shave another 25kg off an already skinny 695kg. That makes it lighter than KTM's X-bow, but a smidge heavier than the Ariel Atom.
- From the squashed VW Scirocco front end to the

frowning Koenigsegg rear, the Vuhl's lines really work. There are no doors, no roof and not a lot of in-car entertainment, aside from that turbocharged 2.0-litre motor behind your seat.

 Borrowed from the Ford Focus ST, the Ecoboost engine's power has been raised to 285bhp and it uses the same Ford six-speed manual gearbox. No paddleshift nonsense. And no ABS, no traction control and no power steering either.

 The Vuhl is hairy-palmed analogue driving, with nothing but you, a carbon fibre bucket chair, four wheels and a turbo-sniffing motor to chase the road with. It'll do 152mph – which should feel like Mach 2 with such a shallow windscreen – and gets to 62mph in 3.7.

 Best of all, its suspension and steering are being developed on UK roads so this could give Caterham, Ariel and Lotus nightmares. It's as basic as a festival toilet, but it'll cost around £60k. Count us in.

BEING A MOBSTER WAS A LIFE OF EXCITEMENT... BUT I SAW THINGS THAT TURNED MY STOMACH'

AS THE MAN WHO RAN A NOTORIOUS GAMBLING DEN, SAL POLISI WITNESSED THE RISE AND FALL OF THE MAFIA IN NEW YORK. HERE, HE TELLS *NUTS* HOW HE LIVED TO TELL THE STORY...



ello Sal. Can you tell us how you became involved with the Mafia? Sure. I had an uncle involved

in the Mob. I thought back then that it was a golden, glamorous age and I wanted to be a part of it. My grandfather was involved with New York's Colombo crime family and by the late '60s, I was running an illegal gambling operation. Of course, by 1972, *The Godfather* came along and that gave the lifestyle even more glamour. For a 27-year-old guy like me, it was impossible to resist.

Tell us about your gambling den, The Sinatra Club.

I decided to open up a club to make some money, and went into business with a hitman called Dominic from the Cataldo family. Ours was the only joint in town where the Five Families could mix with each other – although the rule was no guns. This was at the time of the war, remember. The bathrooms had black lights and in the rear there was an exit, just in case the cops came in through the front.

Is it true some of *GoodFellas* is modelled on your club?

Well, I knew Henry Hill [played by Ray Liotta in the film] and the guys he worked with very well. In fact, I was in prison with him... There were parallels with that film. Look at Dominic Cataldo, he was one of the worst. He'd been whacking business partners for years and he became more and more paranoid and bloodthirsty. Dom used to do hits on guys right in the back of his restaurant, put them in the trunk of his car and drive them up to Boot Hill.

Are all mobsters rich? Or is that just a myth?

Are you kidding me? We had all sorts of gambling in that club – which none of the mob families could resist – and I went through millions of dollars. I was making £50,000 a week. And you've gotta remember, we weren't paying taxes on it. We had all the best girls, too – just like the ones in your magazine. Ha-ha!

Er, thank you! What did you spend the money on? I didn't do drugs, so I spent it all on women, 11 sports cars, a racetrack, Rolexes and the high life. I also gave my kids all that they wanted.

Notorious mobster John Gotti used to hang out at your club – what can you tell us about him? We were good friends, John Gotti and me. When he first came into The Sinatra Club, he never had any money and we would lend him 50 bucks to play cards. However, what he did have in spades was



charisma. Everyone knew him – he knew everyone and he upheld the old-style principles of honour and respect. By 1980, he'd taken a leap up through the ranks and before you know it, he'd become Boss of Bosses.

Did you ever witness anything that really terrified you? Sure. In the '70s and '80s, the mob changed because of drugs,



- year that Mafia "capo" (boss) Gregory Scarpa Sr struck a deal with the FBI that saw 26 charges of murder dropped.
- The five Mafia families who currently operate in New York are the Lucchese, Bonanno, Gambino, Genovese and Colombo.

mob changed because of drugs, and the ideas of family and respect were lost. I was involved in a lot of brutal assignments, I beat up witnesses and did a lot of things that make me wince. I witnessed vicious beatings and was involved in almost every possible crime but murder and child abuse.

Do any incidents stand out?

One particular job turned my stomach more than anything. It wasn't to whack a guy but to "participate" in a murder. For my initiation into the Colombo family, I was ordered to dig a grave. I drove to the Hamptons and found a spot on a quiet part of the beach. It took me most of the night to dig a hole six feet long and six feet deep. It was as close as I wanted to be to that world of death and violence.

MAFIA MONEY MAN

You've been involved in many heists – what was the most audacious one?

When it came to robbing, I had an addiction. I loved nothing more than ripping off banks and trucks. The most audacious was when we ripped-off an airport and dropped a million dollars of luxury watches - I can't imagine how much it would be worth today. How did I do it? Well, it was an "acting" job. I drove into the high value cargo area in a truck with switched plates, talked my way in and just loaded it up. The key was to lock up afterwards - it bought time for us to make our escape.

How did you feel about your life of crime?

I was never terrified of danger, in fact I was always running to it. Mine was a life of excitement, but you always knew that the guys you were running with would kill you in a second and drop your body off in the next area code. I eventually realised that it was all changing, getting darker, and guys started doing unsanctioned hits over drugs and money. left and right. And you know what? After a time, even gold doesn't shine as much when vou get up close.

Finally, then, you wound up in witness protection after turning your back on the mob. How scary was that?

Witness protection was a challenge, I was a New Yorker in Texas and I stuck out like a sore thumb! I had two names, two social security numbers, and it was a pain in the ass. However, there was a hit out on me because I'd testified against John Gotti... Thankfully, no one really came looking for me. I started using my real name after Gotti died and nowadays, the young guys couldn't care about an old guy like me.

Ha! When I was 26, I was a bit nuts. I was just wide-eyed at everything. Modelling... live TV... moving to Hollywood... I think I was probably too young for all of it. But now I feel like there's nothing that can phase me. Not in an arrogant way, just that the older you get the more you know yourself, the more comfortable in yourself you become, and the more attractive you become.

How do you keep looking so darn incredible?

Well, I work with Reebok so I keep myself in shape with them. I do pilates too. I'm never sitting still for very long. But with food, I never deprive myself, whatever it is. I've never done a faddy diet. It's not sustainable. I'm lucky to have a fantastic chef who cooks healthy meals for me and stocks up my fridge, so I have good things to eat rather than ordering a takeaway!

Really? So you never just fancy ordering a Domino's or getting stuck into a doner kebab in front of the telly?

Ha-ha! No. I'd never eat a kebab. That's like eating a rubbish bin in my mind and that'll make you feel rubbish afterwards.

Good point! How are you settling into life as Keith Lemon's sexy sidekick on *Celebrity Juice*?

It's been so much fun, actually – we all had a fun time doing that. But the thing with filming – it's never how it seems! I really love Holly Willoughby.

All you need to know about Chris Froome!

10 facts about the fella out to smash the Tour de France!

BRITS USED to dream of producing just one Tour de France winner. This year, we might get our second in a row, as Chris Froome tries to match Sir Bradley Wiggins' 2012 win. But who is he? *Nuts* tells all!

 The Tour de France is on ITV4 until 21 July.



Chris acted as Bradley Wiggins' "domestique" during his 2012 Tour de France victory. A domestique (it means "servant" in French) serves the team leader, namely Wiggins, by providing him with food and water from team cars, shielding him from opponents and the wind, and even giving up his bicycle to him in the event of the leader damaging his own.



Technically, in 2012 Froome was what is known as a "superdomestique", meaning that he would attempt to stay with his team leader (in this case, Brad Wiggins) for as long as possible. As a result, Froome not only won an individual stage of the race himself, he also ended up finishing the whole race in second position!



Wiggins seemed to be a little bit less pleased with Froome's 2012 stage seven win than Froome himself. "I told Chris to save a bit with 1.5km left," he said later. "I was shouting at him. He's got his stage win now and that's good, since he's going to be working for me in the next two weeks." Sir, yes, sir!

Although Mark Cavendish won the sprint competition (green jersey) in 2011, Froome and Wiggo were the first Brits to finish in the the podium places in the overall competition (yellow jersey) in the 109-year history of the Tour de France.
