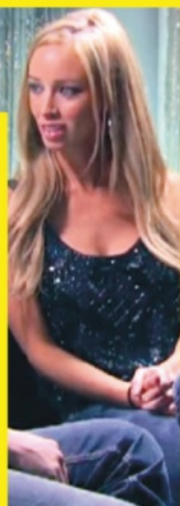

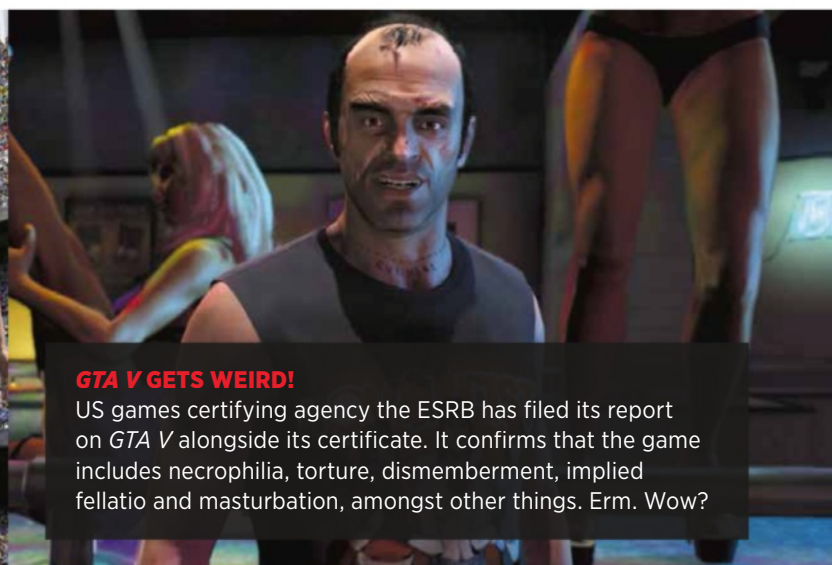
PS4 RELEASE DATE REVEALED!

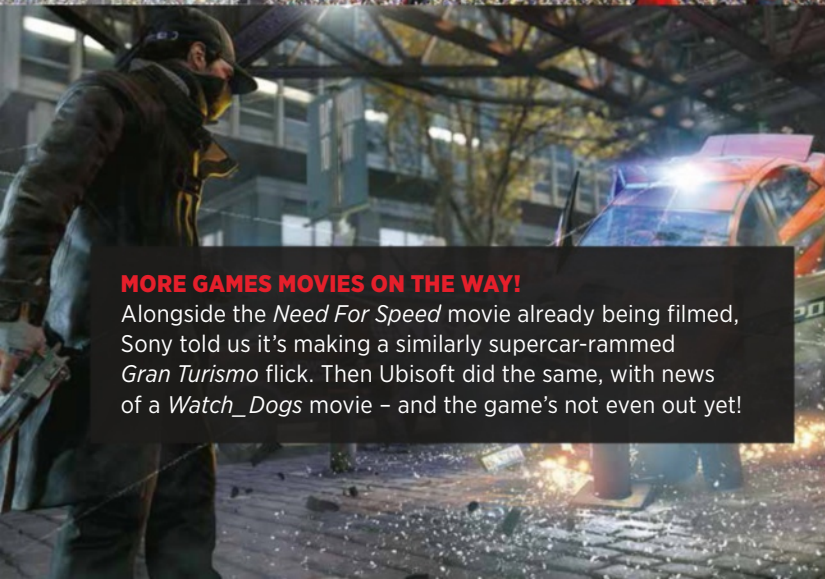
FIFA GOES RETRO

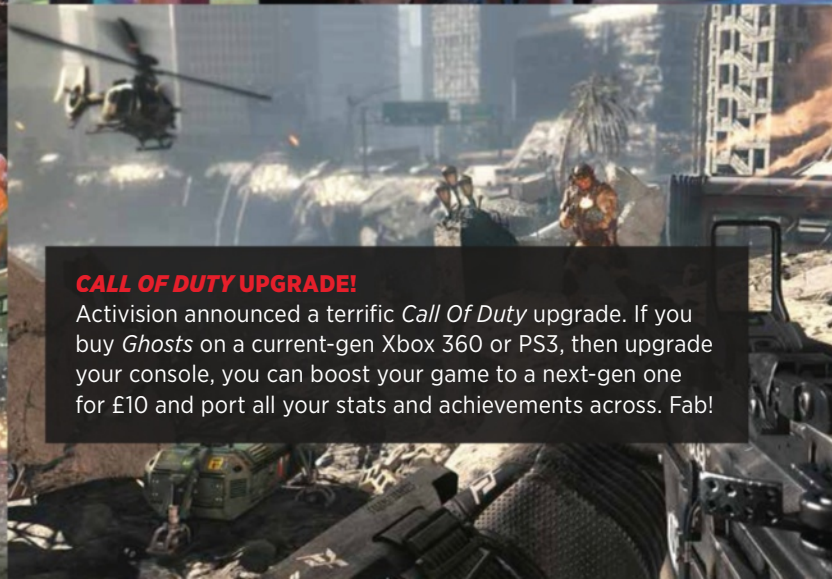
GTA V GETS WEIRD!

Building facts

- The 800ft² mansion was built on top of the 26-storey building over a six-year period after owner Zhang Lin originally bought an attic on the 26th floor.
- Owner Lin responded to other residents' complaints with indifference and loud parties, with the work mostly being carried out under the cover of darkness.
- When it looked as if the building might collapse on to the floor below, Lin just added metal supports to the side of the building to hold it all up.
- Authorities have given Zhang 15 days to tear the property down. But Lin argued with claims he'd built an enormous villa, contending that it was, "Just an ornamental garden."

1,024bhp Ford GT homage!

Galpin Auto plugs a classic GT40-sized hole in our supercar lives with the GTR1!

- The GT was the blue oval's retro remake of the classic GT40, which in the '60s, was Ford's sledgehammer to race legends like Ferrari. The GT40 scored all three podium positions in the 1966 Le Mans 24-hour, changing our view of Fords forever.
- The GT was made from 2004 to 2006. With its mid-

mounted supercharged V8, rear-wheel drive, manly gearbox, aluminium chassis, bucket seats with holes in and doors you could shut your hair in it won the hearts of Ford and supercar fans alike.

- But it still looked as if it was from the '60s. Galpin, the garage guys behind *Pimp My Ride*, then stepped in

with its GTR1. Boss Beau Boeckmann said the GTR1 is a "Vision of what a Ford GT may have looked and performed like today."

- To realise his vision, Beau and his team transformed the GT. So the GTR1 is now 5in wider, with all-new extended bodywork made from aluminium and carbon-fibre

by bespoke concept car experts Metalcrafters. In total, the new body took 12,000 man-hours to perfect.

- Metalcrafters also came up with the one-off glass, jewelled LED headlights, tail-lights and forged 20in race wheels held on by three-spoked knock-off centres – just like its GT40 grandpa.

- Galpin saved the 5.4-litre V8, but binned the supercharger for a pair of 61mm turbochargers. In doing so, the horsepower is now nearly twice the GT's original 550bhp, with Galpin claiming an eye-watering 1,024bhp and 739lb-ft of twist.
- So that's more horsepower than a Bugatti Veyron and

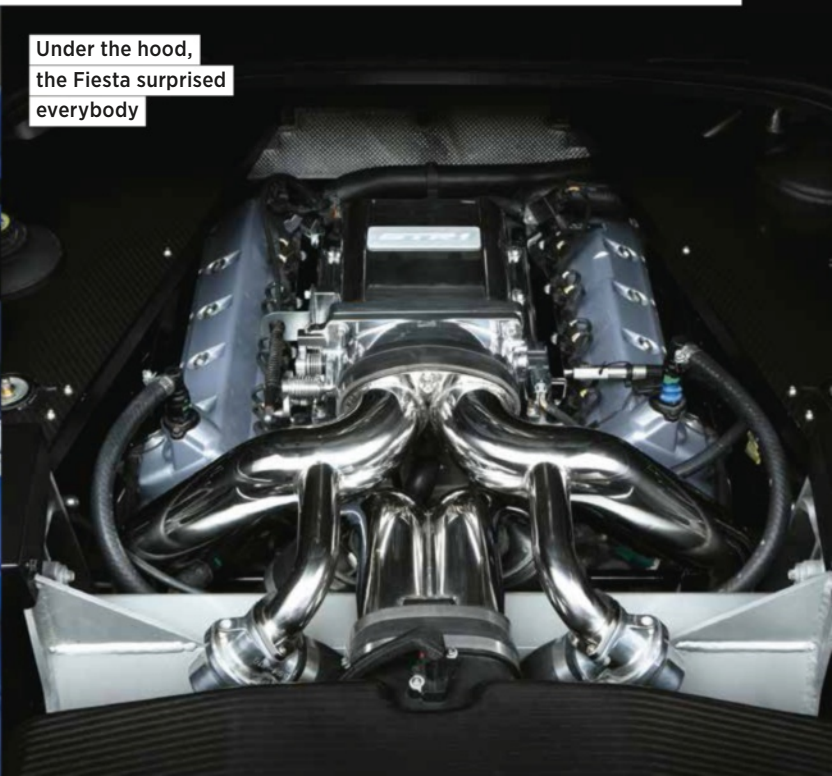
nearly twice the torque of Lamborghini's Gallardo. And that's running on weak 91 RON unleaded petrol.

- The fuel is still good to take the twin turbo V8 from 0-100mph in 6.0 seconds and the GTR1's top speed will exceed 225mph.
- Just six GTR1 Galpins are planned, priced from £666k.

Inside The Mind Of Mark Wahlberg

The movie star tells *Nuts* about his new role as a notorious gym boss in *Pain & Gain*, and what makes him tick!

20% loves bodybuilding!

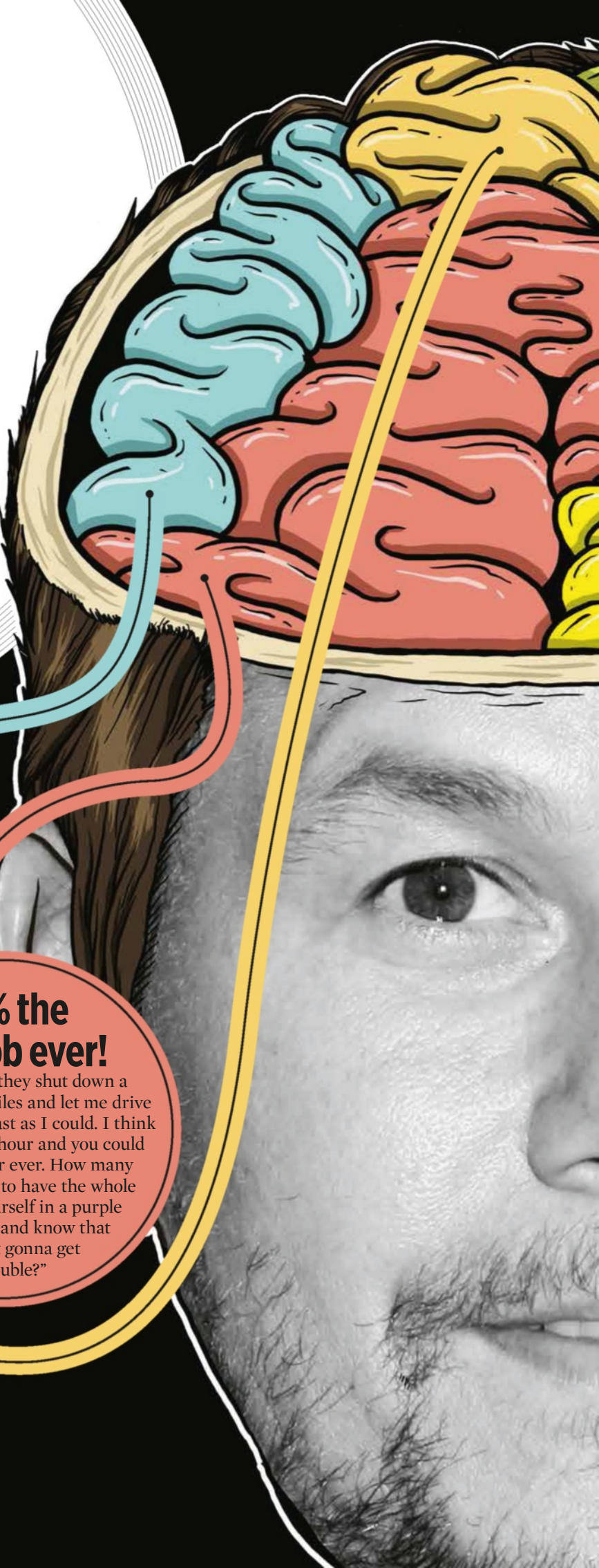
"I love the world of bodybuilding. I came out to live in LA when I was 20 and the first place I went to was Gold's Gym on Venice Beach. It's the Mecca for bodybuilders so I got to see guys like Lou Ferrigno [the original Hulk on telly] and see how relentless they can be. I was fascinated by the true-life tale of bodybuilders who turn kidnappers and the chance to play a character as outrageous as Danny Lugo [in *Pain & Gain*], who I heard about in *Rolling Stone*."

13% fitness regime!

"You've got to get up early, hit the heavy weights, eat 12 meals a day and stuff your face until you can't eat any more! I did four movies in 12 months last year. I got down to 165 pounds for *Broken City* and then up to 212 pounds for *Pain & Gain*. But afterwards I'll change the diet and instead of lifting weights I'll play basketball."

40% the best job ever!

"In *Pain & Gain* they shut down a highway for five miles and let me drive a Lamborghini as fast as I could. I think I hit 180 miles an hour and you could see open road for ever. How many times do you get to have the whole highway to yourself in a purple Lamborghini and know that you're not gonna get in trouble?"



2% on getting old!

"While we were making *Pain & Gain*, Dwayne Johnson got hurt when he went back to wrestling. I told him he shouldn't be doing that sh*t any more! But I'm in my 40s and I'm not a kid now so I deal with a lot of soreness. I don't bounce back the way I used to, so bench-pressing 350 pounds takes its toll."

7% rap alter-ego Marky Mark!

"It was fun but it'd have to be the right time to revisit it. I was asked if I'd perform at a concert for the marathon victims in Boston so in that scenario, absolutely. Then I hear the Funky Bunch are rehearsing. I'm like, 'Guys, I'm making *Transformers 4*!'"

10% on playing a loopy killer in *Pain & Gain*!

"With this Danny Lugo guy, there's something about certain men – it seems to be a common thing in bodybuilding and sports – if they could just have a little bit more. He's on Death Row now, so I decided not to meet him, but I'm interested to know what he thinks of me playing him. We made the film in Miami where the real events took place in the '90s so I met a lot of people who knew him. Everybody had different takes – some thought he was cool and others were intimidated by him."

1% ex-jailbird!

"When I went to jail, that was a wake-up call. Over my lifetime I've known a lot of unsavoury characters. I made a lot of mistakes in my own life, too, but thankfully I was able to learn from them. That was quite some time ago. Certainly now that I have a beautiful family, I've got all the more reason to stay on the right path."

2% anti Hollywood!

"I get annoyed sometimes. Even though I appreciate celebrities who use their celebrity to bring attention to stuff, sometimes it's just as much about getting attention for themselves. There's sh*t going on in their own backyard but they're worrying about the environment while flying around in a jet!"

5% on future projects!

"I'm usually looking for the opposite of the movie I've just finished, so after *Transformers 4* I'm making an independent drama then I'm shooting *Ted 2*. After that, I'll be working on a script from Bill Monahan who wrote *The Departed*, based on the book *American Desperado*. 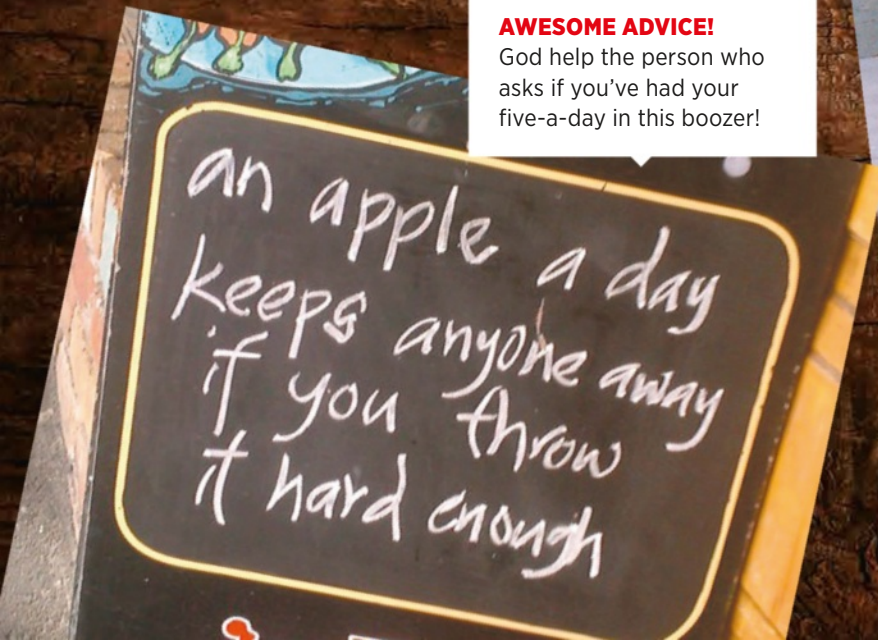

PUT YOURSELF in the shoes of 22-year-old Swede Vugar Huseynzade. One rainy Saturday, you've spent the afternoon in your bedroom eating cereal and trawling the markets on *Football Manager*. Your finest online achievement so far? You've dragged non-league Tamworth to the Champions League final. Then your phone rings and you're told about an opportunity that will change your life forever. You're asked to run the show at Azerbaijan giants FC Baku. Sound mental? Huseynzade tells *Nuts* how he swapped the desktop for the dugout...

Hello Vugar! Tell us about yourself and how you became known to the football world?

Hello! Well, I was born in Azerbaijan but moved to Sweden when I was young. When I was about 16-years-old I decided to travel from Sweden to Lithuania to see FC Baku play a European qualification game there. Azerbaijan is a fairly small place, so when the club president Hafiz Mammadov heard that there was an Azerbaijani student studying business in Sweden, he asked to meet me. We had a short chat which went really well.

But since then, your only experience had been playing *Football Manager*? I'd always wanted to work in football and have played *Football Manager* since 2002. I realised that you can do 30 to 40 per cent of a real manager's job playing it. It's a joke to say I got the job just because of *Football Manager*, but it did help.

So when did the leap come from you being an ace on screen to getting the call? It was always in my mind that the FC Baku president had said, "Maybe you can be a manager when you've finished your education" when I went to visit him all those years

ago. I thought he was just being polite. But I finished my education in 2011 and then got a call saying he wanted to meet. So I decided to fly down to FC Baku to try to speak to him again.

What was in your mind? Did you have any idea that you would be offered a job?

I didn't know what was in the president's mind at the time, but what I know now is

our meeting must have been positive. Mammadov gave me a job on the business side to begin with, because he liked the fact that I showed passion. In November, he sacked the manager and three days later he came to see me. He said, "We have a very young team – you're a young guy and you've a big future with big potential and this club is the same. So why not mix those two things

together?" And he offered me the job of director of football and I accepted. His idea is that if I can develop, the club can develop, too.

How has playing the game helped in a practical way?

It meant that I knew how to negotiate contracts, how the bonus system works and how you do scout reports.

Can you give us any examples?

The game does give you a 70 per cent picture of what a player's about. I was offered Marius Pena, a striker from Romania, so I looked at his stats online. He didn't have good speed, but he was very good at everything else. You have to weigh it up. If Pena had speed, he wouldn't have come to Azerbaijan, but he can do a job here. We signed him and he scored five goals in his first six games.

What's been the most daunting part of the transformation from gamer to gaffer?

Obviously, it's different in real life. You're suddenly sat in a dressing room with

30 real footballers. As for agents, they all come with different personalities and agendas. It will not come as a shock to say that there are agents out there who are trying to fool you. That happens – you need to be careful with everything you say, every move and every step you take. You have to constantly remember what you want from each deal.

How does being a young manager benefit you over the older gaffers?

Well, my biggest achievement was getting the squad unified. We had big cliques – Spanish players only hanging out together by themselves and Brazilians do the same. I'd take them out for dinners, cups of coffee, or maybe to a movie. I'd always – even in a silly way – try to make club life more interesting than it was. For most of them Baku is part of a new culture, so I'd take them out to nice restaurants and show them the city. If you like a place, you feel more attached to the team and want it to do well.

How do you think it's all going?

The coach, Božidar Bandović, has been brilliant with me and he has been a bit unlucky at times, but that happens – even to José Mourinho. We finished fifth and people say it was a very good first season, but I wanted us to do better. I was expecting us to play in the Europa League, but we missed out. We made it to the semi-final of the cup. We won the first game against Khazar Lankaran, former Wales manager John Toshack's team, 1-0, but we finally lost 2-1 on aggregate. We had a better team and three times as many chances but they made theirs count. A high point was the quarter-final cup win against rivals Inter Baku, when Shahriyar Aliyev did an amazing backheel. Videos of that even went viral!

I knew that the football was faster here, with less time on the ball and lots of physical confrontations. And yeah, I've already seen this is true! But I think my own style complements this. I won't hide from the physical side, that's for sure.


What did fellow countryman David Luiz have to say about life in the Premier League?

He said it was a challenge but a greatly exciting one. This is a football country, for sure. The fans and the atmosphere in every game – against big teams and small ones – were like nothing he'd ever seen. I can't wait to experience this for myself on a regular basis.

Looking forward to the derbies against Arsenal?

I'm used to fierce rivalries between local clubs. This is not something that will intimidate me, exactly the opposite in fact. Knowing the club and the supporters are desperate for a result – that's a very powerful thing.

Pep vs José!

As the pair's rivalry is rekindled, we ask: who is the master?

➔ **THEY MAY** have both left Spain, one in glory, one under a cloud, but nothing can keep José Mourinho and Pep Guardiola apart for long, as Chelsea and Bayern contest the UEFA Super Cup. *Nuts* asked top sports psychologist Dr Paul McCarthy to unravel the mind games...

DR PAUL MCCARTHY!

Dr Paul has worked with football and tennis aces and he now works at St Andrews golf course.



SPECIAL IN HIS OWN MIND

"José Mourinho built up the title of 'Special One' for himself, and since he coined it he's been constantly battling to protect this image. In his time at Madrid the image was flipped on its head, as the world saw Pep Guardiola and Barcelona as the best force in world football. Guardiola hijacked José's perception – everyone in the world wanted to be Barcelona, not José Mourinho – and that hurts José."



REJECTED BY SPAIN

"Mourinho has said that he doesn't want to be where he is not loved and Spain, the dominant nation in world football, doesn't show the same love as other countries. The Spanish press called him 'The Translator' and not in a jovial way. His ego is all about approval – he wants to feel appreciated and regards anything that withholds that approval as derogatory. But Guardiola is a Spanish hero."

THE MOMENT PEP FLIPPED

"Pep is a manager who will accept his failures, the opposite of Mourinho who always finds someone else to blame. He'd rather criticise the referee than his team, using interviews to make his excuses. But this is José putting on a show, which is against Pep's beliefs. This showmanship made Pep lose it and call Mourinho 'the f**king boss of the press conference' – his first real show of pressure."





PEP TURNING DOWN CHELSEA

"If it was a new club to José, the fact that Chelsea went to Guardiola before him could have hurt. But it didn't, as he is where he feels most loved. José is resilient, but lacks the credentials his opponent has in his background as a footballer. Pep didn't turn down Chelsea because Mourinho wanted the job, he joined a side who were more successful, offering a better chance of continuing his fantastic legacy."



PEP'S QUIET BUGGING

"Pep doesn't really have to do anything to get under José's skin. First, Barcelona themselves rejected Mourinho when Pep got the job. Pep was the best because not only was he winning, but also he did it in what was seen as a superior way to Mourinho's. Guardiola performed at a level of expertise beyond what José could offer, and it's this that hurts the self-branded 'Special One' more than anything."

Pep vs José: The Verdict

"Both managers share many of the same traits. Each is confident, motivated, committed, defiant, loyal and respectful. But they differ in the roles they take as managers. Pep takes a less assuming role, whereas José has to be 'the man'. Pep has been there and played the game, so he's comfortable to let his team do the talking. José feels that to be loved he has to be on everyone's mind. For me, **GUARDIOLA** wins the mind battle – he never has to say or do much in response to José. He's passive, yet exerts his influence through his team's performances. He feels he doesn't have to enter into the mind games that seem to distract José so much, almost to the extent they hinder him from doing his real job."

The war in numbers

WHO EARNS MORE?

GUARDIOLA, whose £14.5m outstrips José's piffling £8.5m salary by a mile.

WHO IS THE MORE SUCCESSFUL MANAGER?

MOURINHO – they've both won the Champions League twice, but José has seven titles in four countries, compared with Pep's three Spanish ones.

WHO HAS THE RICHEST OWNER?

Various companies own shares in Bayern that total about £1bn. **MOURINHO** is the winner here – his boss, Roman Abramovich, has a fortune of £9.35bn.

WHO INHERITED THE MORE SUCCESSFUL CLUB?

Chelsea won the Europa League and got third place in the Premier League. But **GUARDIOLA** has the toughest act to follow – Bayern won the league, cup and Champions League treble – and the German Super Cup!

WHOSE SQUAD IS MORE EXPENSIVE?

Bayern boast seven players who cost £20m or more and Chelsea only six, but they have a certain Mr F Torres, who cost £50m. We'll call this one a **DRAW**.

WHO WAS THE BETTER PLAYER?

GUARDIOLA, with his six league titles, one European Cup win and 47 caps. José didn't play to any high level.

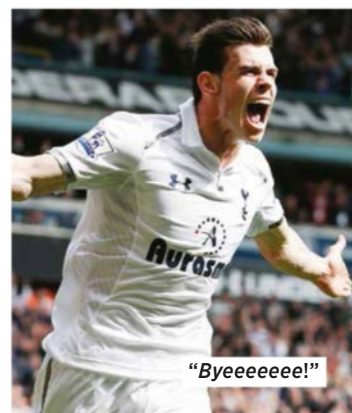
Moyes shouldn't just go for 'tried and tested!'

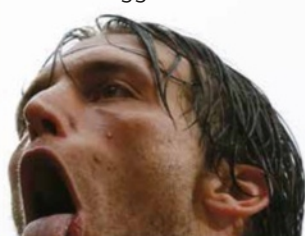

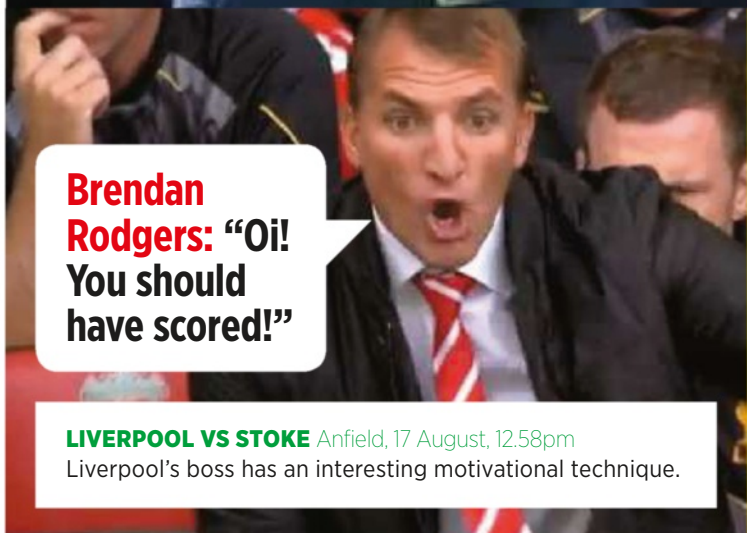

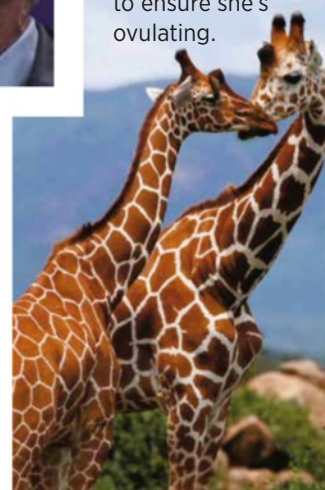
