Transfer Deadline Day has become one of the biggest events in the football calendar, so there's a real buzz around Sky Sports' new five-storey building in West London as we enter. On arrival, we see Tubes from *Soccer AM* (real name Peter) who's filming the whole thing for the Saturday morning show. It's going to be a big night, and we're there to witness the whole spectacle.

5.15PM MEETING THE MAN BEHIND IT ALL!

Our first stop is the office of Sky Sports executive editor Andy Cairns. "Deadline day's perfect for Sky Sports," he says. "We'd always covered it, but in 2008, it went crazy when Robinho signed for Manchester City. Now, people take the day off to watch it. We've already got off to a great start today with the transfer of **Gareth Bale** from Spurs to Real Madrid." "Sorry lads, do you mind? I'm trying to do a show!"

5.45PM ÖZIL GOING TO ARSENAL!

News is filtering through that Real Madrid are looking to off-load German ace Mesut Özil to Arsenal. Of course, that's not the only deal that's going on – Sky Sports reporters are at every Premier League club, plus a few Championship clubs. Co-producer David Stokes says, "I write the scripts for the presenter's autocue, which is then read out on air." So that's how they look so calm!



6.20PM DOWN INTO THE "ENGINE ROOM"!

Nuts is taken to the "gallery" in the basement – a rabbit warren full of screens and busy-looking producers, directors and vision mixers pressing buttons and typing furiously. As we arrive, reporter Peter Stevenson's report from Liverpool's training ground is taken off due to some fans making rude signs in front of the camera. This is loads better than a normal gallery!

Demba Ba could go from Chelsea to Arsenal? Exciting!

Hi James! How did your new BBC2 comedy-thriller *The*

Wrong Mans come about? It depends how far you want to go back. On 22 August 1978, a young man was born who had an idea...

Er... not that far back! Ha-ha! It was that time that everyone started watching those TV box sets like 24 with high production values. We thought, "I wonder why no one's tried to do that in a half-hour BBC comedy?" We wanted to write a sitcom that still had those cliff-hangers you get at the end of *Breaking Bad* and 24 which make you go, "I have to watch the next one right now."

Shouldn't it be The Wrong Men, not The Wrong Mans? Our reason for calling it The Wrong Mans is to let you know it's a comedy show. If it was a drama, it'd be called The Wrong Man. Mat Baynton's [aka Deano from Gavin And Stacev character witnesses a car crash, finds a phone ringing at the side of the road, answers it, and someone says, "If you're not here by five o'clock, we'll kill her." And that's the start of the show.

Sounds interesting... We thought, "What if something that massive happened, but to two ordinary guys?" It would be funny because they'd be going, "What are we going to do?" "I don't know!" So we just called it that because we thought *The Wrong Mans* was a funny title.

How did you manage to find humour in what is such a gruesome story?

In 24 or the *Bourne* films, there are moments when they go, "We have to go to Paris" and the next shot is Jason Bourne coming out of the Paris Metro. In our show, we'd go, "We've got to go to Paris," and the next scene would be us trying to book Eurostar tickets online, saying, "Can we go after half ten 'cos it's cheaper?" even though someone's life is at stake.

Your character has a bit of a man-crush on Mat Baynton's, but he's in love with his ex. It all sounds a bit like the Smithy/ Gavin/Stacey love triangle! If you could say where the heart of the show is, then it's a love story. But it's not a ménage à trois! If that's what you're after, it's literally a mouse click away. You're not going to find it on BBC2 after The Great British Bake Off!

How did you get so many famous people to cameo? We were humbled that so many people said yes. What all actors really want, rather than be in ten scenes and have lots of lines, is to have moments when they have a chance to shine. So we thought, "Let's make every part a thing that an actor would go, 'I would hate it if someone else did this.'" We wrote some parts with specific people in mind, like Dawn French and Nick Moran.

How did you get Homeland star David Harewood involved? We actually started shooting *The Wrong Mans* in 2010, and the David Harewood bit was shot before Homeland. We'd worked on this show called *Fat Friends* together and I said, "Would you just come and do us a favour?" He went, "I'm not doing anything, sure." Everyone's going to think, "Look at these guys. They're just showing off!"

The Wrong Mans is showing in America on hulu.com. Should we all throw our TVs in the bin? Is the internet the way forward?

I'm thrilled hulu can afford so much money to promote us in America, but I just wonder if they've really thought it through. It's not like I'm Kevin Spacey in

House Of Cards. There are going to be posters of us all around America, apparently. People are going to be thinking, "Who on earth are these two?"

Thanks for the chat, James! Finally, is it true you offered a part to Adele to make up for famously cutting her off at the Brit Awards in 2012? Ha-ha! No. You've just made that one up!

- There are those who still think that Volvos are driven by retired colonels who love to tug caravans. This should help shove that prejudice aside, because this "Concept Coupé" is what Volvo are telling us is the future of their design and engineering. Looks a bit sharp, doesn't it?
- The Concept Coupé was partly inspired by Volvo's P1800 from the '60s – probably the sexiest model to emerge from the Swede firm's factory. It borrows the P1800's razor-sharp creases that run along the rear wing tops and a suitably retro front grille. But that's about where the old-school stops.







- Fresh design features that we'll see on future Volvo models include horizontal, T-shaped LED front running lights, C and D-shaped rear lights, as well as the "floating" effect of the radiator grille slats.
- One thing the Swedish have always got bang-on is interior design. This is no exception.

First, there's a portrait tablettype touchscreen interface which replaces many centre console buttons.

 Then there's a hand-cut crystal gear lever, the aluminium details and wood inserts. And because, in 1959, Volvo was the first company to invent and fit three-point seat belts, the

Coupé wears special belt buckles to celebrate this.

 Volvo won't say how fast it'll go, but the car's front wheels are powered by a 2.0-litre four-cylinder engine that feeds on both turbo and supercharging magic powers. The top speed should be around 155mph, with a 0-62 of 4.7 seconds.

ello Vin! Great to see you back in our cinemas as Riddick, but the last Riddick film, Chronicles

Of Riddick, came out in 2004. Why have you made us wait so long for a new one?

Oh, it was a fight. It was a struggle. It was a campaign! And ultimately, a huge victory for all of the Riddick fans around the world that we actually got it done. How did I succeed? Not the Hollywood way, ironically. Fast & Furious 4 had come out. It had broken records - it took over £72million on the opening weekend. We went into Universal and said, "We want to make this new Riddick movie." They basically kicked us out of the city and said never come back here again. But we just didn't quit. We just kept at it, finding a way to get it done. which included going to Germany and getting foreign money and making a couple more billion dollars for Universal. Then they were ready to help us.

Why do you think people love **Riddick so much?**

He's a character who's been given up on, or ruled out, or blacklisted. It's very close to home. We all know that I've been blacklisted in a small way every time I said no to a picture. The wrath of Hollywood has tried to bury me. I think what resonates with people is this kind of loner. No matter how sociable we are, we can always identify in some way with a loner. I love anti-heroes!

I was the bouncer who stopped the other bouncers. If a guy was already on the floor and five bouncers were jumping on his head. I'd be the one going, "Hey, man, that's enough!" But when I started, it was all fighting. I was a bouncer for nine years at this bar called Mars in New York. To do that job, vou have to be able to read people, and you have to be

ready to fight - every night. I must have been in hundreds of fights, and they weren't pretty. But you try to avoid violence as much as you can.

Is it true that your name came from your days on the door?

Yeah. When you're getting into fights in New York you don't want everyone to know who you are, and where vou live. So all bouncers in New York in the '80s had a nickname. People said I was full of energy. They would say, "There's Vin Diesel!" It just stuck.

Who is Canelo Álvarez?

A quick guide to the man out to mash Mayweather!

- Álvarez's full name is Santos Saúl Álvarez Barragán. He earned his nickname "El Canelo" ("The Cinnamon") on account of his red hair.
- El Canelo fought and defeated – Ricky Hatton's brother Matthew in California in March 2011. "I don't think Ricky Hatton's brother is on the level of Floyd Mayweather," was Mayweather's assessment of that win.
- He defended the WBC light middleweight title he won against Hatton, against another Brit, Sheffield's Ryan Rhodes.
- He holds the WBC, WBA and The Ring magazine world light middleweight titles.
- His current record is 42 wins, one draw, no defeats, with 30 of those wins by knockout or technical knockout.
- In 2008, Canelo and all six of his brothers fought on the same card. Canelo is the youngest of the six.

Fans want to fight me, train me, be trained by me and anything else you can think of. Mad stuff, but my Twitter and Instagram have brought me closer to my fans and I love that I can talk to them and hear from them.

What's the best piece of advice you've ever been given?

The one that sticks with me the most is: "With hard work, anything is possible." I work harder and train harder than any other fighter, and that's why I'm the best at what I do. I know this for a fact. That's why I tell all the fighters in my gym that hard work and dedication are the key.

Thanks, Floyd! Finally, there's a 24-carat solid gold WBC belt for you if win. Will you wear it in public? I don't fight for the belts.

I fight for my legacy, to keep my undefeated record and be known as the greatest to ever lace up a pair of gloves. That gold belt will be just another belt alongside my many others in my case at home. It's already damn crowded in there!

The men who risk their lives doing bonkers dives!

TOM DALEY, you don't know you're born! This chap is one of the loons competing in the Red Bull Cliff Diving World Series, which comes to the UK this week. *Nuts* speaks to Brit hopefuls Blake Aldridge and Mat Cowen about this most scary of sports...

A rib-shattering rush!

British cliff divers Blake Aldridge and Mat Cowen explain just how dangerous their sport can get!



dangerous as throw yourself off a cliff? Mat: I've always been a bit crazy so it seemed like a natural step after trying Olympic-style diving. Blake: It's dangerous, but we're all professionals. So it's more of a calculated risk for us, rather than absolute danger, although if it goes wrong, you're going to smash yourself to bits! I've got lost in the air but stuck with it and managed to figure the dive out.

What does "getting lost in the air" mean?

BA: Basically, losing your awareness of the dive. We're meant to know exactly where we are during the dive, but the fact that you're 30 metres up means that there's not always a point of focus. A normal diver only jumps from ten metres. When you're out in the wilderness there's nothing for you to see. MC: Your brain takes over. Your body knows that vou can do the dive. it's a lot more mental being able to execute the dive. You have a split second where your brain kicks in and says, "Do this! Do that! Land on your feet!"

What happens if you *don't* land on your feet?

BA: If you hit the water on your side, you're looking at broken ribs, torn spleen, punctured lungs. torn retinas... We have to land feet-first because the impact on the water is so much greater than springboard diving. We're three times the height! MC: I've seen a few divers get pretty badly hurt. One of my good friends got knocked out twice. We all have a mutual respect because it's so dangerous.

Is it an adrenaline rush?

BA: You push your body and your mind to their absolute limits. I've done Olympic diving - same board, same height, day in, day out. We don't have the time or physical capacity to train like that, and the impact on the water is too great, if you practised a lot, you'd get injured pretty quickly. You have to lie to yourself and convince your brain that you've been up there and done it before.

Finally then, how do women react when you tell them what you do? MC: I'll be honest – I don't bring it up unless I'm directly asked as they tend not to believe me!
