# A quick word with Simon Cowell and Harry Hill!

### The unlikely duo on their X Factor musical!



Hi Harry and Simon! What made you decide to make an X Factor musical?

Harry: A few years ago, I was watching the end of *The X* Factor – I think Eoghan Quigg had just got through to the semi-finals. TV Burp was finishing so I was in a celebratory mood - I'd had a few drinks. I had the idea to write a musical, so I phoned up [ITV Director of Television] Peter Fincham. I thought, I'll have to get to Simon somehow – he's not in the phone book. Peter said, "I'm in the bath!" I said, "I need to talk to Simon Cowell." He said, "I'll just hand you over." Simon came on the line and said, "Harry, why don't you and your wife join me on my yacht?" I said, "Well, you're not going to get me like that." Anyway, we went, and that child starts school tomorrow. I wouldn't mind but we hadn't even left Southampton - he conceives all his children in international waters for tax reasons. [To Simon] Do you actually drive that yacht, Simon? Do they let you drive it around? Simon: No. They won't let me

into the cockpit. **Harry:** He was in the cockpit in another way that night!

#### How can you have a musical of a show that's already a musical?

Harry: You're right, some people do think, "What are you talking about? The X

Factor: The Musical? How can it be a musical?" But it can be. Simon: I thought that. Harry: Did you? Simon: I've been pitched musicals before but I've always said no because they've taken themselves so seriously. But I always thought you were funny. Then I was told, "Harry's going to come in and pitch you a musical." I thought, "God. no!"

Harry: I was a bit nervous at the first sing-through. Someone said, "Simon's coming today. If he doesn't like it, it's over." So I positioned myself where I couldn't see him. Simon: I told my PA to find me a seat close to an exit. I said, "If the songs are crap, I'm out!" But I loved it. There's a singing dog that falls in love with me. There's a hunchback that does an Eminem-type song. I thought, "I'm in!"

#### Was anything off limits, like Dannii Minogue, high trousers or nappies?

Simon: Dannii who? Also, my trousers aren't that high any more. They used to be. I tried not to be too involved. I wanted Harry to feel he had a free rein to do what he'd like. When you're in the public eye, there are days you open up a newspaper and think, "Christ almighty!" I knew I was going to get a lot of stick, but it's done affectionately. I get it full on throughout the whole

show. It totally takes the p\*ss out of me.

Harry: He did ask, "Please could there be a part for Sinitta?" But you've got to draw the line somewhere.

#### Simon, Nigel Harman, aka bad boy Dennis Rickman from EastEnders, is playing you on stage. What advice do you have for him?

**Simon:** Just be a d\*ck every night. It was always going to happen. They showed me a couple of people, but I'm very happy with the choice of actor.

#### You've said before that you hate musicals.

Harry: That's the thing we all agreed on – we all hated musicals! Simon: I've sat in some musicals and walked out after ten minutes. But then there are others I've seen more than once. If I had to imagine what I wanted a musical to be like, it's this. It's fun, it's a p\*ss-take, it's larger than life. # Awesome AeroSeven concept!

After 40 years of cooking up the same race car cuisine, Caterham serves up tech for tea!

- Caterham cars are based on a Lotus design from 1957, so when they talk about radical changes, that usually means heating, or doors made of something other than vinyl and poppers.
- But this time, the boys aren't crying wolf, launching the AeroSeven concept, and it's the first peek at what they promise to be an all-new road car out next year. It features such witchcraft as ABS and traction control. And it will

hardly share any similar parts with the faithful '50s Lotus, but instead a newer recipe cooked up with its F1 racing arm and partners Renault.

 Because while the AeroSeven will go on sale next year, in 2016 a deal between Alpine (Renault's sports car department) and Caterham comes into play, where we'll see Renault Alpine-badged road-legal race weapons. Which will continue to carry Caterham's DNA of being







CATERHAM

#### stupidly light, stupidly fun and groomed for naughty power-to-weight ratios.

- The AeroSeven now uses Formula One aerodynamics to dictate its looks and create downforce, with the bodyshell made from carbonfibre. Your bum still sits over the back wheels, but the suspension's independent at the back and both ends feature F1-style inboard pushrods, with bespoke springs and dampers.
- Caterham have then thrown in all sorts of fun F1 stuff, like launch control and a Lewis Hamilton-spec steering wheel that will have buttons to adjust throttle maps (which defaults to "Race" mode) and a "Pit lane speed limiter".
- The right-hand pedal talks to a 2.0-litre Duratec Ford engine that revs to a ringwincing 8,500rpm and spits out 237bhp. The gearbox is currently a six-speed manual,

transferring power to the rear wheels through soft, sticky Avon CR500 tyres. So the 62 sprint is served up in 4.0 seconds, with the max arriving at 150mph.

 It's not often we can say the words Caterham and radical in the same sentence, but after 40 years of drooling over the same two-seater Lotus drawings, they're taking their bare-bones game to another level. And it'll only cost £45k.

Welsh, whose book *Trainspotting* was turned into a successful film. On average, how often do people compare the two? Ha-ha! You f\*\*king had to, didn't you? *Trainspotting*? Is that some Lithuanian film that no one's ever seen?

Er, fair enough! Well, *Filth*'s a legendary book about a bent cop. Had you read it before filming?

No, I hadn't. Irvine and the director suggested I didn't read it, largely because they're very different. They're similar in terms of their tone, darkness, comedy and depravity, but they're very different in terms of the narrative. But since I've finished, it's become must-have bedtime reading. Ha!

#### You mentioned the darkness and depravity of it all. Did you have to leave any bits out for the big screen?

There's a scene in the film where we're in an underpass and this student has just been killed. In the book, they get finished off with a high heel shoe to the head. If we'd left that in, it would have been very hard to sympathise with the character.

I enjoy a fair old drink in a spike, like a binge, every now and again, but I don't do it every night. So I tried to drink every night, to the point of being really drunk, just so I'd wake up the next day and feel the way he'd feel. I'm not a method actor but it was quite nice to be able to go to work and go, "Bah, I f\*\*king hate everything. I hate myself, I hate my breakfast, I hate my shoes, I hate my pants, I hate everything ... "

That must've led to a few colourful moments on set! There were tons. Can I remember any of them? Nope. It was probably the dog scene. Also, weirdly, I had to sexually harass this female character who happened to be played by my sister. She's called Joy McAvoy, and she's brilliant. The scene is very horrible and intense and all that, but because it was my sister, we were just p\*ssing ourselves laughing the entire time. I basically ask her to suck my balls. At no time when we were seven years old, arguing about whose turn it was to play Super Mario Brothers on the NES, did I think I'd be acting with my sister in and asking her to get her tulips around my bulbs.

Does this "semi method acting" mean you were a bit of a nightmare even after you stopped filming? My sense of humour did become way more filthy, and it's already filthy. My wife did start to get a bit like, "This is getting a bit too much, mate." I went home very tired, because it took a lot of energy.

In the cold light of morning, UQCC that third bottle of tequila didn't seem so clever Weirdly, this character came a lot more naturally for me than a lot of parts I've played, probably because even though the film is so surreal, he's still someone I believed wholeheartedly in.

You're famously playing Macbeth - one of Shakespeare's maddest characters. What is it with you and the nutjobs? The whole year has been leading up to Macbeth, really. I started off playing a grumpy guy in Welcome To The Punch, then I played someone who's a bit mental, angry and violent in Trance. then I did Filth, which absolutely took it to a new level. Weirdly, I feel that my character in Filth and Macbeth are very similar. They've both been hugely traumatised and are tenuously holding onto reality, so those two parts have bled into the same thing for me.

#### Any chance of doing some more frothy romantic nonsense, just to keep our mums happy?

I think so. I like romantic stuff and I haven't done much in a while. When I read a script, I don't think, "Is this film funny and touching or dark and less loving?" The important criteria is, is it good? If something romantic comes in that's interesting, why not?

Thanks, James. Finally, there's a scene in *Filth* where you photocopy your private parts. Be honest, have you ever done that in real life? No. I took a picture of it when I was 16, but that was it!
