As an actual, professional cake maker, how would you do on the *Great British Bake Off*?



Flats don't stop road construction!



WHEN **CHINESE** authorities started building an eightlane motorway in Xi'an, Shaanxi province in Western China, they presumed they'd simply steamroller the blocks of flats in its way and have it up in a week or so.

So when the block's residents - who'd only moved in a few months before, after being rehoused to build a park - refused to budge, they just thinned the road down to half the lanes and squeezed it through regardless. Compromise - alive and well in China!





The 200mph, 640bhp retro muscle car!

A beautiful Frankenstein's monster of classic Yank motors... it's the Equus Bass 770!

- Some believe there's no finer four-wheeled transport than a classic American muscle car. We don't have a time machine, but luckily, Equus has saved us the trouble because the Yank marque has created a modern, luxurious - yet retro-looking - homage to that golden era of V8 street-lethal heroes. It's called the Bass 770.
- Based in the homeland of the American car - Detroit, Michigan - Equus is a small
- outfit that has plucked the DNA from a 1967 Ford Mustang fastback a '68 and a 2013 Chevy Camaro, plus a sprinkling of 1970 Plymouth Roadrunner for the 770.
- You only need to look at the price tag (£156,700 gets you on the waiting list) to get the unsubtle hint that this is not an off-the-shelf car. The Bass 770 body shape mimics more '60s Mustang than anything, but with a "binocular" hoop front





bumper reminiscent of a '70 Plymouth Roadrunner, lights/grille inspired by a '70 Plymouth Barracuda and a touch of Eleanor Mustang thrown in for good measure.

- Its bodyshell has been formed from aluminium and features carbon fibre structural parts, with a tubular roll cage skeleton. Underneath is also very aluminium, keeping chassis weight down and performance figures up

 the latter of which is vital
- in the bench-pressing world of muscle motors.
- By using an aluminium 6.2-litre V8 (apparently from a new Camaro) complete with supercharger and pleasingly old-school manual gearbox, the big numbers are 640bhp, 605lb/ft, a 0-60 in only 3.4 and 200mph tops. Those are closer to supercar stats than anything American with old-school looks. Easy now to see why this mutant

muscle car comes wearing carbon ceramic Brembo brakes in each corner.

- Unlike the lairy '60s icons that inspired it, the Equus doesn't shy away from technology to help you stay away from ditches. Standard features on the Bass 770 include magnetic selective ride control (as used in Ferraris and the Audi R8), performance traction management, active handling system and variable-ratio
- sports power steering. So it'll whip a Lambo Gallardo to 60 and even likes corners.
- The Bass 770 serves up another shock with an interior far from the old days of bare-bones sticky black vinyl and crap dash plastic. It takes the muscle car brief and positively drenches it in luxury.
- Shame about that naff faux Ferrari horse motif. And that ridiculous name. We suggest you order yours debadged.





"I'm back!" exclaimed Sophie on the cover of *Nuts* when she made a triumphant return to boob-mongering earlier this year after a two-year hiatus. Oh how we missed her!







ello gents! First off, tell us about your new flick Escape Plan. It sounds awesome!
Sly: It is! I play a guy whose job it is to break out of prisons and test their weaknesses, but he winds up imprisoned for real in the ultimate maximum security prison. Arnold plays the leader of the inmates and together we figure out something pretty extraordinary. That's where the intrigue of our escape plan begins!

This is the first time you two have shared top billing. What made this movie ripe for pairing up?

Sly: After I read the script I knew *Escape* Plan was the one. The most important thing when planning a movie - who are the players? Who's gonna be your competition and your antagonist and eventually your buddy in this thing? Arnold, of course! When he complied, it was green-lit immediately. There was no one else considered, he was the guy. **Arnie:** For me it was all about the chance to work with Sly. We were trying for decades to make a movie together and finally we found the right story. Yes, we did Expendables but this was starring alongside each other throughout the whole movie.


So what kind of weird films were you two offered that didn't make the grade?

Sly: They'd bring us things where we'd dress up as girls and there were bickering neighbours and we'd have arguing pets. I go, "This is not working," so I said, "Why don't we be two creepy inmates when we're 20 years past our prime? There's a good idea!" And that's where we are. But it turned out great. It's fantastic. We found a new prime!

When you work together, is there some sort of "ultimate bromance" thing going on? What's your relationship like?

Sly: We're very competitive and everything we've accomplished in our lives has been through struggle and overcoming the odds because we're just not willing to settle for second best. Rarely do you get two personalities like this working together... We're just a couple of old warhorses and more than a little alpha territorial!

Who edges it in the competitive stakes? Arnie: In the '80s when the Action genre really got going, I ran into Sly one time and said, "In *Commando* I killed more people than you did in *Rambo*!" And Sly



says, "Absolutely not! I killed 97 and you killed 93!" But I was defiant telling him "next movie, I'm gonna kill more than you" but he told me he'd be killing more than a hundred so I'd never catch up! This is how it went... Who has more muscles? Who has the biggest guns? Who can kill the most people...

Surely the only way to settle this is Rambo versus Commando?

Sly: You mean together? Me and him? Do you think he would do it? Hmm... Commando and Rambo. Why not? They're almost the same guy!

There's loads of funny moments in Escape Plan. Who's better at playing for laughs?

Sly: I have to defer to Arnold on this one because he really developed action comedy and the use of humour in very dramatic situations... My characters? Rambo is not exactly a ball of laughs, is he? But humour defuses the violence and lets the audience know not to take it too seriously and that it's not intended to be mean spirited – it's just escapism. **Arnie:** Yeah, there's one very intense moment where I'm getting busy with a big gun wiping out all the bad guy's guards on the top of the prison but I've got my smirk on my face and the deadpan line to deliver. And the buddy thing kicks in because Sly is coming up from the water and I'm handing him a gun and killing more people. **Sly:** He's being modest. He invented the one-liner. "I'll be back!" That's one of his major contributions. They didn't have those before.

We must ask you about *The Expendables* 3. How awesome is it to be working with the likes of Harrison Ford?

Sly: It's fantastic! I've told the director [Patrick Hughes] not to approach this as a continuation but as an original. With

the young Expendables in this film we've taken a bit of a gamble. Only one of them has acted before but the rest are world-class athletes, world champions... But they have something you can't manufacture – whether you go to acting school or just walk around with a bunch of bluff and bravado – they have fire in their gut. Plus we got Mel Gibson, Nic Cage, Wesley Snipes and Jackie Chan!

Just a few stars, then! Arnie, how's it going getting back into it all?

Arnie: In this film there's a great combination of new talent and a great sense of humour. For

instance I've just done a scene with Jet Li where he disarms this guy and pulls his guns out shooting five people so fast I couldn't see the moves. I'm trying to follow how he does it but this must be the fastest guy around! To have that kind of martial arts talent and use it with weapons and then leap down steps to take guys out - it's so quick! Bringing this many action stars together with competing styles is awesome.

Besides kicking butt on screen, have you got much in common when the camera's off? Do you watch box-sets together?

Sly: We're both Austrian. We've both been Mr Olympia seven times. And he's wearing my suit.







What's the best thing about being a bona fide *Nuts* babe?



But anyone who has taken a nation as their home, and feels part of that nation, should be considered for the national team.




