- One bullfighter, Juan José Padilla, was gored in the face by a bull in Zaragoza in September 2001, losing his left eye, the use of his right ear and facial paralysis. He returned to the ring five months later with an eye patch, several titanium plates in his skull, and the nickname "The Pirate".

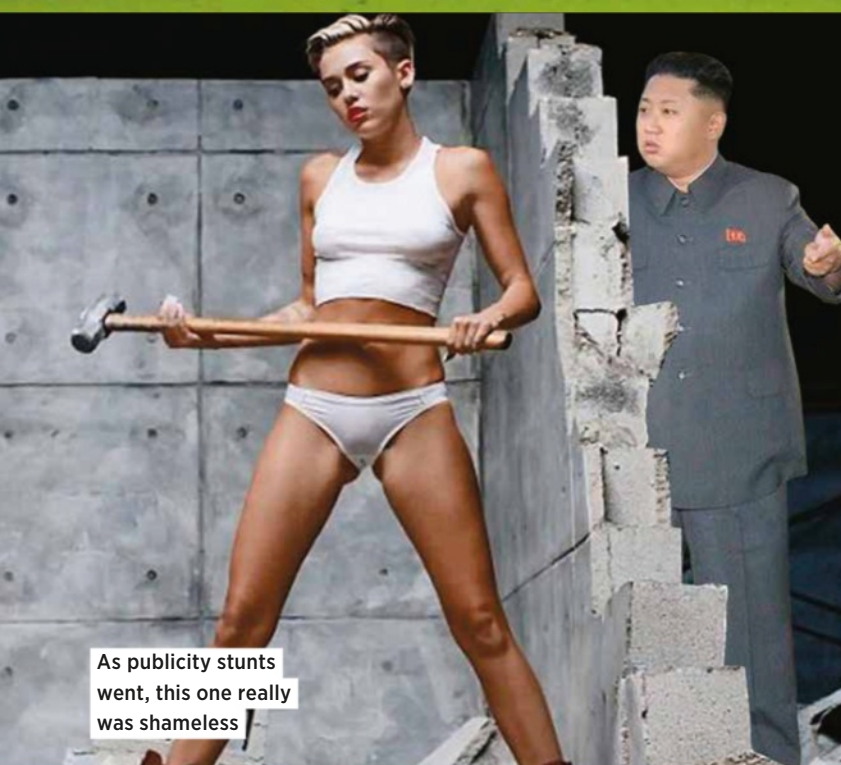

# A quick word with Johnny Knoxville!

**The *Jackass* star on fake willies, perfect pranks, his worst ever injury and violent lady fans!**

➔ **Hi Johnny! Tell us about your new flick, *Bad Grandpa*...**

After five hours of make-up I'm transformed into 86-year-old Irving Zisman [Bad Grandpa from *Jackass*] and take my grandson Billy on a road trip, pranking the public as we go. It's far out!

**How far do you go?**

Everyone who likes *Jackass* is gonna love *Bad Grandpa*. Getting my Jim Dog [Johnny's preferred name for his winkle] stuck in a Coke machine and swinging my fake balls in a strip club makes this one R-rated. In America, nudity's bad. I wish the kind of nudity you have in *Nuts* was good there.

**You're accident prone to say the least! What's the worst injury you suffered this time?**

I was shooting a promo dressed up as Irving at a frat house. I sat with the students watching the movie and everyone was hammered. After a while, I realised my heart was racing and it dawned on me, "F\*\*k! Someone's dosed me with ecstasy!" I thought, "This could be fun!" Then I snapped a tendon in my hand which needed an operation and 26 stitches. I think I did it hanging from a basketball hoop or maybe it was crashing through a table. It was fun, but I would have been bummed if they'd spiked me with acid.



**What does your doctor think?**

Which one? I've got 20 doctors' numbers in my phone! Recently, I fractured my elbow and right now I have a torn shoulder. My left side's my impact side so it's all f\*\*ked. And my back's blown out but I don't know what else to do besides move forward. It's what I do and a big part of it, so I don't really think about it. And I have asthma! But I don't give a sh\*t – I'm fine with it.

**Which was your worst injury?**

When I go in for a physical I have to list all my injuries. I have a piece of paper to hand them. The worst was when Travis Pastrana [from extreme sports stunt crew Nitro Circus] talked me into doing a dirt bike stunt. I screwed up the backflip and the handlebars smashed into my crotch. I tore my urethra and because of my busted penis I had to p\*ss through a tube for three years!

**When you plan a prank, do you worry people will react badly?**

I don't give a sh\*t about being punched, but I don't want someone to hit me wrong and then their knuckle hurts, so they sue us. In America there are lots of lawsuits, so when I'm trying to get someone angry I'll bring 'em back down. Then I'll get 'em angry again and bring 'em down.

**Sounds dangerous!**

I have to gauge what I can get away with and when I'm out with [pretend grandson] Jackson I've got to be careful because I don't want someone swinging around him. We always have a plain clothes person within ten feet of the prank. And with a mouth like

Jackson's... sometimes if he doesn't get the desired reaction from someone, he'll yell an insult as they walk off.

**What was your favourite prank in the film?**

We had a great scene in the diner where Irving "sharts" on a wall but we needed an entrance, so we built a giant penguin to leave out front for me to crash into. So this guy who had no affiliation to the restaurant came out and started going nuts on me for 40 minutes. I was having so much fun. I yelled at him and he got angry and when people get irrational I know I've got 'em hooked. He wanted to hit me, but when it was over, he was great.

**Did you ever get spotted as Johnny Knoxville in an old man costume?**

I was pranking this one guy and he said, "I see you with your fake hair, fake eyebrows and fake moustache!" When he said that I was like, "Well, sh\*t!" And I just got up and left because I thought he'd rumbled me. But I later learned he didn't know it was me and just thought it was some old guy with fake hair.

**Who was the inspiration for Bad Grandpa?**

I love old Vaudeville comics and my father was a prankster. He'd spike his employees' drinks with laxatives and send them letters with bad news from the VD clinic.

**What's the strangest thing a fan has ever said or done?**

I'll get guys trying to fight me, and girls get weird. I've had one say, "Hey Johnny, I love your stuff!" And then punch me! Or there are girls who put their cigarette out on my arm.

**Finally, are you looking forward to old age?**

Sure. People think you're harmless, which helps when you're playing a dirty, old man. My make-up guy said when they do old age make-up on women, they cry. But with me I'm like, "Hell, I'll be a handsome old devil!"

# 217mph tuned Ferrari F12 Berlinetta!

German spanner monkeys Novitec Rosso spruce up Ferrari's flagship!

- The Italians are pretty protective about their creations, and rightly so when they're as handsome and hardcore as the 730bhp, 211mph F12. It isn't a quick Ferrari, it's a 1.6-tonne firework wearing Pirellis. So how did a bloke called Wolfgang Hagedorn and his Novitec team from Stetten, Germany, massaged multiple improvements into an already *Bake Off*-beatingly successful recipe?
- Well, they made it faster, more powerful and a bit more, well stocky. Let's talk girth first. Called the N-Largo, it's a wide-bodied conversion of the F12, which has been achieved with new flared front wings and rear quarter panels, which also feature slitty gill vents to allow hot air to escape from each brake disc and direct air to the rear wing.
- The width increase of 4.2in was achieved using carbon fibre components, and

Novitec say that each panel was designed with aerodynamics and cooling in mind. By using a wind tunnel, the N-Largo's front bumper and central front blade have, for example, been remodelled to glue the front end (reducing lift) at high speeds.

- At the rear, there's a carbon wing and new detailed five-piece diffuser panel which generates more downforce. Also, in order not to look too

under-wheeled with its newfound broadness, the original Ferrari 20in rims have been discarded in favour of wider-track forged three-piece rims – 21in at the front and 22in at the rear.

- **Suspension-wise, there's a front-end lift function, so as not to hit your beautiful bodywork on kerbs and inconsiderately placed speed humps. We love the two angled intake beaks that sit at the back of the**

**bonnet, and which serve to force cool air into the engine bay, to be eagerly snorted up by the 48-valve 6,262cc V12.**

- Developing peak power at 8,250rpm, the Ferrari's glorious 12-cylinder has had its bhp boosted from 730 to an impressive 781 thanks to an ECU remap and a freer breathing exhaust system. Don't forget this thing doesn't have any help from turbos or superchargers.
- **The extra power means the 1,630kg supercar's top speed swells from a not-particularly-slow 211mph to 217mph. Yes, this is a rather rapid car. And 62mph will fly past in just 3.1 seconds.**
- And it's an expensive car, obviously. A standard vanilla F12 from Ferrari will uppercut your wallet for a hefty £239,352. The Bond-villain sounding N-Largo could set you back a fee approaching £150,000 more.

**1** In 2011, British censors banned *The Human Centipede 2* because it was too graphic. It finally got an 18 certificate after the film's makers agreed to make 32 cuts, losing two minutes and 37 seconds of the most extreme footage.

**2** The 2013 remake of the *Evil Dead* used 70,000 gallons of fake blood – 50,000 gallons in the final scene alone. The 1981 original used just 300 gallons.

**3** Anthony Anderson appears in *Scream 4* as Deputy Perkins. He also featured in *Scream* spoofs *Scary Movie 3* and *Scary Movie 4*.

**4** The CGI team who made Freddy's face in the 2010 *Nightmare On Elm Street* also created Harvey 'Two-Face' Dent in *The Dark Knight*.

**5** In *The Conjuring*, the witch Bathsheba Sherman is hanged for killing her children as a sacrifice to the Devil. Based on true events, the real-life Bathsheba was found innocent of the crime and died of natural causes in 1885.

**6** Screenwriter Simon Barrett penned 2013 slasher *You're Next*. He also appears in the film as the Tiger Mask Killer.

**7** The budget was so low for 2007 blockbuster *Paranormal Activity* that the stars Katie Featherston (Katie) and Micah Sloat (Micah) were paid less than £500 each.

**8** In *The Texas Chain Saw Massacre* (1974), Gunnar Hansen, who played Leatherface, wore three-inch heels to look taller.



**9** Legendary spooky movie bloke M. Night Shyamalan – the man behind *The Sixth Sense* and *Unbreakable* – has made cameo appearances in all but two of the films he's directed.

**10** To promote *The Ring Two* in 2005, copies of the "cursed tape" from the movie were left in public places. They showed five minutes of the film and a web link.

**11** In *Drag Me To Hell*, Justin Long's character can be seen using various Apple devices – a nod to the fact he famously starred in a series of "I'm a Mac" adverts for the company.

**12** When Specs and Tucker enter Elise's house in *Insidious: Chapter 2*, there is an African tribal painting hanging on the wall. The same painting makes an appearance in both *Paranormal Activity 2* and *3*.

**13** Four of the actors who appeared in *Texas Chainsaw 3D* (2013) also featured in previous films in the franchise, breaking the record of the three who returned in 1994 for *Texas Chainsaw Massacre: The Next Generation*.

**14** Before remaking *Halloween* in 2007, a crossover film with Pinhead from *Hellraiser* was mooted, but dropped after fans rubbished the idea in an online poll.

**15** *Don't Be Afraid Of The Dark* writer Guillermo del Toro makes a brief cameo as a passenger on the plane, sitting behind the lead character Sally.

**16** All the songs featured in 1981 wolfy classic *An American Werewolf In London* feature the word "moon". ▶



**17** In the 2012 version of *The Woman In Black*, Daniel Radcliffe plays the Arthur character. In the 1989 TV version, Arthur was played by Adrian Rawlins, who was also Radcliffe's father in the Harry Potter films.

**18** Citizens of Burkittsville – the town where *The Blair Witch Project* was filmed – claim that the legacy of the movie has ruined their community and, in 2010, voted to sell the “Welcome to Historic Burkittsville” signs that the studio donated to them, for £3,000.

**19** In *House On Haunted Hill* (1999) the lead is called Steven Price, in tribute to the star of the 1959 version, Vincent Price.

**20** The ending of apocalyptic zombie flick *28 Days Later* is notoriously vague, but a pilot can be heard saying “Lähetätkö helikopterin?” That’s Finnish for “Send helicopters”, suggesting everything’s OK...

**21** During one of the torture scenes in *Hostel Part II*, Roger Bart (Stuart) screams “I’m f\*\*king Hercules!” Ten years earlier Bart provided the voice for Hercules in the Disney cartoon about the mythical hero.

**22** One of the squaddies in *Dog Soldiers* is called Bruce Campbell, a tribute to the star of the original *Evil Dead* film, who went by the very same name.

**23** *Paranormal Activity 4* star Stephen Dunham died of a heart attack just one month before the film was released in the States in 2012.

**24** Based on a true story, the house in *The Haunting In Connecticut* is burnt down at the film’s end. In real life, there was no fire and the house is still standing.



**25** In the director’s cut of the 2009 version of *Halloween II*, mental killer Michael Myers removes his mask and screams, “Die!” before stabbing Doctor Loomis – the first time in the entire series the killer speaks.

**26** In *Splinter*, Farrell gives Seth a safety deposit box key. The address on it is 1060 W. Addison St – home to the Chicago Cubs baseball park, Wrigley Field.

**27** Johnny Depp and Jackie Earle Haley both auditioned for *A Nightmare On Elm Street*. Depp got the role of Glen Lantz and Haley missed out – only to get the part of Freddy Krueger in the 2010 remake.

**28** The creator of the *Hatchet* slasher trilogy, Adam Green, is a member of a paranormal investigation group called Hollywood Ghost Hunters.

**29** The Michael Myers mask used in the original *Halloween* movie was actually a mask of *Star Trek*’s Captain Kirk turned inside out.

**30** *Psycho* director Alfred Hitchcock bought all copies of the book it was based on to keep the ending secret.

**31** The woman who bathes in virgins’ blood in *Hostel Part II* is based on Elizabeth Bathory – a real life Hungarian countess who was said to have killed hundreds of young girls.

**32** In the original 1974 *Texas Chain Saw Massacre* film, a real human skeleton from India was used in one scene because, apparently, its cost was actually less than using a false one.



**33** Stanley Kubrick convinced the American Motion Picture Association that the river of blood emerging from the lift in *The Shining* was really rusty water to get a trailer approved.

**34** Harvey Stephens, who played Damien in *The Omen*, plays a tabloid reporter in the 2006 remake.

**35** Ryan Gosling was the initial choice to play apocalyptic survivor Jim in *28 Days Later*. The part eventually went to Cillian Murphy.

**36** Simon Pegg and Edgar Wright appear in George A Romero's *Land Of The Dead* (2005), as zombies tied up in a bar for punters to fire paintball guns at.

**37** The werewolf transformation skin effects in *An American Werewolf In London* were achieved by pulling hair through fake skin, and then reversing the footage.

**38** Eli Roth was given an official pardon by the President Of Iceland after he depicted an Icelandic character in *Hostel* as a sadistic drunken sex maniac.

**39** The language of the vampires in *30 Days Of Night* was created for the movie by a linguistics professor.

**40** In the 1985 zombie flick *Day Of The Dead*, Joe Pilato improvised the words, "Choke on 'em! Choke on 'em!" as the living dead tuck into his innards.

**41** Only one person is killed by a chainsaw in the original version of *The Texas Chain Saw Massacre*.



**42** A crew member on Eli Roth's *Cabin Fever* was arrested by police when he drove home from the completed shoot with a decapitated corpse prop he'd decided to take home as a souvenir.

**43** The address of *The Exorcist* director William Friedkin's production office was 666 Fifth Avenue.



**44** In this year's remake of *The Evil Dead*, the first letters of each of the main character's names (David, Eric, Mia, Olivia, Natalie) deliberately spell "DEMON" when put together.

**45** Production on *The Omen* was famously cursed. Actor Gregory Peck and writer David Seltzer's planes were both struck by lightning.

**46** Another oldie supposedly steeped in curse was *Poltergeist*. In the six years between the release of the first and third films, four cast members died in separate, pretty horrible circumstances.



**47** In *Paranormal Activity*, Micah uses *The Picture Book of Devils, Demons and Witchcraft* to investigate. It's a real book, on Amazon for a fiver.

**48** The supposedly haunted Linda Vista Community Hospital is featured in *Insidious 2* but has also been used as a filming location in over 20 horror movies, dozens of TV shows and a Foo Fighters music video.

**49** Demonologist Lorraine Warren, whose exploits *The Conjuring* (2013) are based on – makes a cameo in the film.



**50** 2012's daft take on the genre *The Cabin In The Woods* featured 80 different types of monster. It took 60 artists six weeks to create the bone-chilling beasts.

Ha-ha! Actually, there are pictures of girls in there too. My crazy life doesn't deny the existence of girls!

**Your gag – “I’ve just been on a once-in-a-lifetime holiday. I’ll tell you what, never again.” – was voted joke of the festival at Edinburgh a few years ago. Where do you go from that?**

It wasn't really the best joke, was it? Thing is, you have to meet certain rules to even be entered for the best joke, so long jokes that are absolutely hilarious won't make it because they don't fit into a newspaper column. So that brings it down to people who do one-liners.

**Did you have all this in mind when you were telling your jokes then? “Keep them short, win an award” sort of thing?**

No, I can only write short jokes anyway, so it suited me. I've tried writing long jokes but they don't normally work, to be honest. I was telling a gag about a shepherd's pie-dog once and the audience just sat there and stared at me for about five minutes.

**Do you see gag potential in everything you encounter, like some sort of joke Terminator?**

Some days I write loads and other times I'll just think of them when I'm out and about. It depends if I've got a tour coming up. I've never made a joke at a funeral or anything.

**What would happen if you and your brother, BBC radio presenter Jeremy, had to swap jobs for a week? So he'd have to do comedy and stand-up, and you'd need to tackle the serious issues of the day...**

Jeremy could probably get away with doing my job for a little while but I'm not sure if he's got enough jokes in the locker to do it for a week. He has actually written a few jokes for me. I don't think I could do his job because I get lost very quickly when I'm hearing him talk to a politician. I'd probably end up trying to chat about crazy golf instead of the economy.

**You were also best man at your brother's wedding – did you feel added pressure to make it the funniest speech in history because you're Tim Vine?**

Ha-ha, the funniest speech in history?

Well I didn't succeed in that, did I! I had a strong opening gag though, which was “Me and Jeremy, we go way back”, which was quite amusing at the time.

**What advice would you give to a reader who might have to give a funny speech?**

If you want some advice for a wedding speech I'd always get everyone to give you a round of applause and then say, “My, what a reception!” I did that gag as well and it got a good response.

**When was the last time that you heard a joke that really made you groan?**

I don't ever groan at jokes! To me, if you groan at a joke that means you're not joining in with the silliness of it. I imagine people who groan at jokes aren't much fun at parties.

**What are you like when you meet people for the first time – do you go straight in with a joke?**

No, I normally make conversation first. I went to a fancy dress party once dressed as sodium chloride and this bloke threw sulphuric acid on my head... I didn't know how to react! Write that down, it's a joke. You can have that.

**You've done a spot of acting too, but could you ever turn serious, and have a part in something like *Top Boy*?**

Ha-ha! Yeah, actually I'd like some sort of serious role as the head of a spaceship or something. Maybe a character that has a lot of serious looks and lots of close-ups. I've not been offered such a role yet, though.

**Maybe people don't realise you'd like a serious role. As soon as they read this the offers will come flooding in...**

Yeah, hopefully some Hollywood producer will be reading *Nuts* and they're looking for someone that appears to have little acting


experience but just expresses a slight interest in having one serious scene! I could be their man for that. My favourite film is *Unforgiven* and apparently they're working on a sequel called *I Said I Was Sorry*! I'll tell you who is a rubbish actor though... Dustbin Hoffman.

**Ha-ha! Which UK institutions would benefit from an in-house punmaster?**

The last time I had a job in an office was in Croydon – or as I call it, “Stonehenge with windows” – I used to always muck about and stuff. My Dad said, in all seriousness, that it's the people like that who should be paid more. Those in the office that are happy to have a laugh and a joke and keep morale up are more important than people who just sit inputting data. That's what offices need to improve productivity – someone

there making people happy. So to answer your question, I think every office in the land should have someone that goes desk to desk, making people laugh.

**Thanks, Tim. Finally, have you ever had a gag go disastrously wrong on stage?**

Don't use props. I remember very early on in my career, I went on stage with a big envelope on my head and some more on my hands and I said to the crowd, “Well, you lot are weird... where are your envelopes?” and it got a bit of a laugh but not the best one to start with. Although, I then said, “You're probably wondering why I've got an envelope on my head... it's because someone sent me!” I love that joke. Maybe I'll bring it back,  actually!
