THE KINGS of Call Of Duty this year decided to reboot the popular shooty game, chucking out the Modern Warfare and Black Ops brands for a shiny, new CoD: Ghosts, The simple story of two brothers and their dog fighting against an entire angry continent of bad guys is out this week on Xbox 360 and PS3. We played it to the end. Here's what we reckon...

#### "Here, fishy fishy!"

If you're tired of being canon fodder for online ninjas, Squads is your friend. You create a group of ten soldiers and fight offline against game-created bots. You learn the maps and experiment with weapons before going online.

#### WEAPONS

Ready for your trigger finger is a sweet remote sniper rifle, a mission where you're dealing death from a helicopter and a fun, thudding underwater machine gun. And don't panic, the A10 gunship drone makes an appearance.

#### SIGHTSEEING

The venues you'll be staring at down your iron sights add lashings of fun. Highlights include a shark-infested underwater mission, a jungle section in Mexico and an epic zero-G battle in lower Earth orbit near the end.

#### MULTIPLAY

Alongside your death matches are new modes Cranked (kill within 30 seconds or you explode). Infected (a zombie game where a kill infects other players) and Extinction (a four-player co-op game fighting off aliens).

#### Verdict!

With 18 great missions that'll take about eight hours on normal difficulty, there's campaign aplenty to fill your boots, but it's the multiplay that's your year's time sink. And with Squads and new modes - in particular the awesome Extinction, which sees you fighting off armour-plated aliens in an alternative world better than ever. It's a classic CoD! \*\*\*\*\*

#### Advice for noobs!

Executive producer Mark Rubin with tips for the CoD novice

'If you're a first-time player concerned about your skills, use Squads. Set it on easy, work your way up, and really level up your haracter. You're not wasting time

"In Squads, you can get familiar with every weapon. So try every weapon. I might not be good at sniper rifles, but if I don't try them I won't know."

"If everything in the game doesn't feel natural, switch your loadouts and your perks around."

"If you go out and you're just getting demolished, you'll think your set-up is wrong. But that doesn't necessarily mean that's true. Keep trying."

"Never reload after you've just killed someone as their mate is likely to follow them around the corner. Engage, engage, engage, fall back a little bit, reload."

"I see on kill cam all the time that I'm shot while my team-mate is running up trying to get the knife kill. Don't go for the glory kill, just shoot someone!

"Use your mini map and find out where you can run and where you'll get into a choke point. Even good players are uncomfortable on a map they've not played before."

"The game gives you sound cues. If you hear a Predator missile coming, run indoors. Learn those cues and learn what to do when you hear them

# The 200mph **Ferrari Quad** Lazareth V8F!

You don't need a skid lid to ride a guad bike legally, but you might for the Lazareth Wazuma We live in a world where downsizing has become the norm. Formula One engines are shrinking and, thanks to technology (and the need for more miles per gallon), big motors are trading places for smaller-cc engines armed with turbos or superchargers. But not everyone plays by such rules because not everyone thinks guads should be the preserve of farmers and chavvy helmet dodgers.

 Say hello to a French-built four-wheeler called - deep breath - the Lazareth Wazuma V8F Matt Edition. Calling it a guad would be like calling Buck Palace a quaint little bolt-hole. For a start, this guad's

heartbeat is that of a redblooded Italian Ferrari 3.0-litre V8 engine – taken from a 308 model. It can do 250bhp, thanks to fuel injection devised from two Yamaha R1 superbikes.

The injection is a tuneable Sybelle system that can be remapped from a laptop.

- The guad is far lighter than a car, so although the engine "only" produces 250 horses, it tips the scales at 650kg, which equates to 385bhp per tonne.
- It has a max speed of 200mph, if you have the balls or stupidity for it. That's a gnat's pube faster than a Ferrari 458 Italia.

 Changing gear doesn't involve any Italian car parts or Japanese bike bits. In fact. it's a six-speed sequential transmission borrowed from a BMW M3, so cogs can be shifted via buttons on the 'bars. A shedload of hardcore engineering, then.

It does looks like a threewheeler, but the pair of special Momo 18in rear rims are actually positioned close together. Each hoop wears a monstrous 315/30/18 section tyre, while the front end sports 285/30s. Brakes are vital when you hack about with your legs clenched

#### around Ferrari firepower, hence the fitment of Brembo calipers and 324mm disc brakes in each wheel.

 Nothing on earth looks guite like this Wazuma V8F. It's spectacularly low-slung, with Ferrari motor on full show. side pods inspired by an F1 car, leg-singeing side exit exhausts and not even a tiny windscreen to shield you from wasps while doing 200mph. The whole thing's custom, including a suspension system with racecar-style horizontal

shock absorbers. Apart from the obvious lunacy and showboatiness of the Laz Waz, it is ironic that a) guads were invented for off-road use and this would probably get stuck if it parked next to a puddle. And b) it is not road legal in France, where it was created. The chances are, this calibre of . auirkiness will be sold to someone who can afford the £154,800 price tag and who won't be using it to check over the sheep on a muddy hillside.

#### **Prepare for** grim gigs... When you start out, you're

going to play some tiny venues. You end up in these horrendous dressing rooms, sat on crates. There's no glamour. Often, you have to stand in a kitchen where they'll be making curly fries and chicken in a basket and when you go on, you think, "I actually smell of chicken. I smell of chips." I played a tiny 40-seater in Edinburgh. One night, there was a kid in the front row. He only looked about 12 so I thought I'd better not swear. I said, "Hey mate, what's that under your chair?" He pulled out a copy of Harry Potter and said, "It's a book in case you're sh\*t."

#### Handle your hecklers...

Just be guick and harsh. My contract is, "I'm here to tell you jokes and not be mean to you." When they break that contract, all rules are gone. I was 17 when I started doing stand-up, all fresh-faced, and someone shouted, "Where's your pubic hair?" I said, "In your wife's teeth." He didn't laugh, but it's you versus him. And you can't let the heckler win. Then again, if the heckle gets a big laugh from the audience, just laugh and take it. You look churlish if you start going, "Yeah, but, your mum...'

#### Don't turn into a diva...

I used to play these rooms above pubs where people were on fruit machines and playing pool while you're in the corner of the room trying to tell jokes. Sometimes there wasn't even a microphone. At least now, everyone's facing the right way. I've got a really good tour manager. If I ask a question too far, like, "Can you put filtered water in the kettle

before you make my brew?" he'll just tell me to f\*\*k off. My only demand is that there's fruit backstage. You don't eat all day since you're nervous, and afterwards you're starving, and there's no late-night salad bar. Otherwise, you're there at midnight at the Colonel's...

#### Get new material off your mates... I find myself with random

pieces of paper that say things like, "Why does no one ever believe you when you say you've sat on the remote?" I always think, "I'll write something about that one day," but I never do. I always listen to people. Even in the most inane conversations, you'll find something funny. especially when you're just hanging out with your mates. Stuff like, "I'll get all these pints in, lads, this is tax deductible." I go back to the smaller clubs and turn up unannounced sometimes. For the first three minutes. the audience is like. "Brilliant. what a lovely surprise, it's someone we've actually heard of." That's all you're getting though, three minutes of grace. After that, it's, "You'd better be funny..."

> "Five a day? You must be joking!"

#### Read the papers... You have to do as much

preparation as you can for a panel show. You don't know what the questions are going to be, but you know the themes, especially with the topical ones. You think, "I'll just watch the news all week and read every newspaper, and I'll be able to crowbar stuff in." It's all about the crow-barring. These shows take two-and-a-half hours to record. You have to have the confidence to go, "What about this?" Of course, I think that everything I start to say is going to be hilarious. It's only when you get to the end...

#### Don't tweet your best gags...

Often, I'll put an observation out there. I don't know if something is a general observation until people have confirmed it. I could say, "Have you ever noticed when this happens?" and you might be thinking, "I've literally never seen that in my life." If people go, "Yeah, it happens to me all the time," I'm on to something. Social media is so good for

Anyone who's dared to get up on stage deserves respect. So many Nuts readers will be funny blokes and their mates will go. "You should do standup." On the outside there's bravado but inside they think, "I would cry if I went on stage and no one laughed." Getting heckled is horrible. Everyone staring at you is horrible. No one laughing at your jokes is horrible. But it's not as bad as the feeling in 50 years' time when you're on your deathbed thinking, "I wonder if I could have done that?" Stand-up is

Deal with negative press...

I've had all sorts of mad things written about me. I got a review once with five stars and thought, "God, I've never had five stars". As I was reading it, I realised the jokes they were describing weren't mine. I just took the five stars and put it on my poster. I don't mind interviews. The classic worst question is, "Tell us a joke, then." No one asks anyone else to do their job for free. "What do you do for a living?" "Oh, I'm a plumber." "Could you have a quick look down my toilet?" For some reason,

#### What's the weirdest thing a fan has said to you?

You know, sometimes people think I look like me but they don't think it's really me. They usually say things like, "You're like a skinny version of Kelly Brook!" Someone once sent me an apple press. That was weird.

#### Er, who wouldn't need an apple press? You're always in the papers – what's the oddest thing you've read about yourself? Someone once wrote that I was going to a hypnotist to try and reduce the amount of time I spent getting ready before going out. Not true, obviously!

#### What's the worst job you've ever done?

Probably a paper round I did when I was very young. I'm not good at early mornings, so that didn't last long.

You did a few on-stage nudey scenes in Calendar Girls a while back, then played Keith Lemon's love interest... which was the most daunting? Calendar Girls wasn't at all daunting. "This is fantastic! At first I thought it was a piece of old equipment from the Eastern Bloc but upon closer inspection, I realised that it's actually a gas bottle with some fins stuck on the side and wheels to enable portability. Again, the charge is provided by a car battery.

"God knows why these mortar rounds are getting a bright-red makeover. They're not something you'd usually worry about visually, unless you painted them in drab colours to prevent them from being seen. Maybe this guy just took a shine to them and wants them as ornaments in his house?"

"This is crazy - it reminds me of something you might find in a Chinese military

museum. It's an improvised device for a small hand grenade, which is probably

launched via the use of a shotgun shell. It's not very safe at the firing end and

WORKSHOP! "Here's another example of a mortar tube. In this case, it's being welded together and the welder will be fixing a plate on to the base. He'll need to be extremely skilled, as if this isn't done properly, it'll blow the base off, meaning that the firer could either be killed or seriously injured."

#### "This mortar is being used in conjunction with a widely available app which

provides angle degrees or compass directions - see how one of the guys in this photo is adjusting the stand. It's a good use of modern technology so long as they can convert the data it provides effectively - which I suspect they can."

#### EXPLOSIVES!

"These could be captured or unexploded artillery shell heads, and they're not designed to be fired. Instead, they can be buried or concealed in a wall to cause damage to personnel or to vehicles, and they're battery-operated via a command wire. The destruction they cause is very nasty."



"This is a home-made twin mortar tube that's designed to be a portable weapon. Judging by the accompanying heavy-duty battery, I'd say that the rounds are ignited via a crude but effective firing system, which probably comprises a couple of spark plugs."

#### RENADE CATAPULT

This will be used to lob grenades at targets nearby. It could be effective, but a grenade will go off soon after the pin has been pulled. If it slipped off the sling, the firers would have to hit the floor to avoid the worst of the blast. I wouldn't like to be the one at the front."
