Hi Aaron! We guess the obvious question is: can Arsenal win the title?

Well, we believe we can, and why shouldn't we? What we've done so far has maybe surprised a few people. The last few seasons, we've been slow starters and then kicked on after Christmas. Playing catch-up hasn't helped us in the past, so we're improving. This season, we've started well, so I reckon we can do something special this time around.

Is this the most open Premier League season ever?

There are definitely five or six teams who can win the League this season, which is obviously a novelty. It's exciting to be right at the heart of the title challenge. Obviously, I'm quite keen that it's us at the end of the day. It sounds like you all really fancy your chances...

No one is taking anything for granted – no way – but I love the fact that we're in the mix already and are performing as we know we can. We're a confident group.

The addition of Mesut Özil has been a real positive influence.

He's one of the best players of his kind in the world. He's settled in brilliantly and given us extra quality and experience. His talent is there for all to see and he's also a really good guy. Sometimes it takes a while for new players to find their feet but he's done amazingly – a lot because of his ability but also his personality. As a team, overall, I think we're moving forward
