














# Lambo's new Huracán!

Meet the next Gallardo! The Huracán LP610-4 is a 610bhp, 202mph thing of silliness!

- New V10 Lambos only come round once every ten years or so, so this is a biggie for the chaps at Sant'Agata Bolognese, Italy. And this, the Huracán LP610-4 has got some act to follow.
- The Gallardo was Lambo's most successful car of all time. With 14,022 bespoke cars rolled out of the factory.
- We'll go over the raw numbers first. The LP610-4 in the name, as with all Lambos, describes the powertrain: a 610bhp, 4WD V10 monster. A 5.2-litre powerplant, it'll guff out 610hp at 8,250rpm, with max torques of 560Nm at 6,500rpm. The Stig is going to like this. A lot.





- This power is channelled through a seven-speed dualclutch transmission much like the one that sits inches from the ground in Audi's R8. So? 0 to 62mph in 3.2 seconds and a top speed of over 202mph.
- Keeping this ruffian on the track is actually a pretty conventional carbon and aluminium hybrid chassis,
- which you'll able to tweak with three set ups available on the steering wheel – Strada (silly), Sport (crazy) and Corsa (full Stig).
- And the look, while very Lambo, is still fresh, angular and exacting, with one defining line running from nose to tail, and a very Astonlike lift to the rear spoiler.
- While the Huracán will be officially unveiled at the Geneva Motor Show in March, it's being introduced to potential owners over 130 private preview events in 60 countries worldwide, when the price will be announced. But don't expect much change from £140k. Not got your invite? Us neither.

Meet the Morpheus Lander, son of the Shuttle!

SPACE TRAVEL, it turns out, is pricier than running a Premier League football team (a smidge). Indeed, money was one of the reasons why NASA had to mothball their Shuttle fleet. But this is their new plan. Called the Morpheus Lander, it's a cheaper, greener, cooler method of space travel, that will autonomously land a robot probe on big rocks like asteroids but, firstly, the moon. From blast-off to landing, the whole crazy shebang will be terrifyingly automated, much like a Bayern Munich goal.



# Morpheus facts

- The Morpheus vessel, which is only about the size of a car, can hold a 500kg payload in its cargo bays.
- It essentially consists of four silver spherical propellant tanks topped by avionics boxes and a massive web of wires.
- It uses a liquid oxygen and methane fuel composite formulated to be safer, greener, less expensive, and less explosive than standard lander propulsion fuels.
- It will be used to deliver cargo and fuel to asteroids and other extraterrestrial surfaces, as well as being used to refuel deep-space probes.







No. I've interviewed him many times and he's a lovely man. He called up and said, "Can you play my producer in my video?" which I thought sounded like fun.


You present a show called Quiz In My Pants on the internet. Where do you buy your pants?

# Darren Anderton: 'AVB can be forgotten!'

The Spurs and England legend says, "Yes, Spurs really can beat the Gooners!"



#### Hi Darren! You obviously join us at the start of a new era for Spurs. Are they a bit all over the place right now?

I think Spurs will have had their next man in mind when they sacked Andre Villas-Boas, although obviously a 5-0 home defeat has a habit of hastening such decisions. I know the hierarchy have thought very highly of Tim Sherwood and Les Ferdinand for a while, so the fact they were there perhaps made the decision

a bit more comfortable. I think most people in and around the club are impressed with Tim's coaching so they figured why not? He reads the game very well, was always willing to put his point across, and was a good captain and a good man.

# Do managerial changes often have a galvanising effect in big games like these?

Actually, that's exactly what it usually does. A footballer wants to play, so you make sure that when you train, you train hard, and when you play, you play to stay in the team. So you get that extra graft, those better performances. A few good results in games like the Arsenal game and I'm afraid Villas-Boas will be quickly forgotten. That's the way football is. All the players who were out of favour under AVB now have a clean slate and a way into the team.

#### Neither side's going to put out a traditional early-round weakened side, are they?

They both have top-class squads anyway, so they can make changes, but there's no way either team's going to give up this game – they're going to put out teams to win. It's a North London derby in the Cup – form, league positions, all that's out the window.

# What are the main Arsenal weaknesses Spurs can exploit?

Well, we all know how great they are in midfield, and how they've improved at the back. The bottom line is, if you're going to beat Arsenal you have to test them defensively, and I don't think that anybody has done that this season – apart from Manchester City. But what they did is show what can happen if you get at them.

#### There are some who say that, in terms of quality in depth, Spurs are second only to Man City.

Yeah, they have a great squad. My only problem with it is that it's very samey-samey in a lot of positions – central midfield, on the wing, in the hole. But we need cover at centre-back and a couple more strikers.

# Ah, yes. Strikers. What exactly is going wrong for them when it comes to goals?

They've just been too negative. The general consensus when it comes to AVB is, "Good position in the league, pretty damn dull to watch." Spurs teams always try to entertain and win games, create chances and be good to watch, but this season, they just haven't been good to watch, because they don't have a Modric or a Bale to unlock defences. But they have good enough players.

#### Who would be your automatic starters for the Arsenal game and how would you play it?

Paulinho has done very well. I like Sandro and Dembele in the middle of the park. They're really missing Kaboul at the back. I'd like to see two wingers, so that might mean Sandro and Townsend or Lennon. I'd stick with Soldado and maybe play Defoe with him. Then I'd just get at them. Yes, you can be defensive to a point, but you have to get at them and close them down in midfield. You have to have a couple of players in the middle who'll do that, but you have to have a goal threat. In the league earlier in the season, Spurs did OK but we didn't threaten their goal and they wore us down.


# Football's in good health... hopefully!




