

# Lexus' M4 beater!

#### It's aggressive, it's beautiful and it pumps out 450bhp - watch out BMW, it's the Lexus RC F!

- There's nothing we enjoy more than a good old car manufacturer ding-dong. And the seconds are out for a proper toe-to-toe - BMW's M4 vs this, Lexus's RC F.
- Lexus isn't exactly known for madcap styling, but in the RC F's case, things get impressively masculine. The new coupé bodyshell sees bloated wheel arches, forged 19in wheels, deeply sculpted bumpers, larger air intakes and a gigantic
- grille/slanty headlight combo that has hints of their £300k LFA hypercar.
- Neither this or BMW's M4 are on sale yet but the Lexus is already making its rival look average, with those shark gill slashes cut into the front wing inlets that flow straight into the flared side skirts.
- The two cars are almost the same size, produce nigh-on the same power, both are rear-wheel drive and both have four rasping exhausts.
- BMW has reverted to a 3.0litre straight-six for the M4 but a turbo helps it achieve 431bhp and 406lb-ft.
- Meanwhile, the RC F keeps it old-school, being built around a dirty big naturally aspirated 5.0-litre V8 that brings 450bhp and 383lb-ft to the fight. 2-0 to Lexus.
- The RC F won't be available as a manual, instead coming equipped with a SPDS (Sports Direct Shift) paddleshift eight-speed automatic.
- This is Lexus' most powerful V8 offering ever, and it's the first to use a torque-
- Whether the RC F can beat the M4's 0-62 blast in 4.1 secs remains to be seen. So far, Lexus is simply saying "under 4.5 seconds".
- One thing you guarantee for your £60k is that a Lexus RC F will always be a rarer sighting than an M4. Which makes it a very special beast from the east.





# TO FIGHT ALONE!"







**Meet Marcus** inspired Hollywood's latest action thriller...

T'S 2005 in Afghanistan. A crack team of US Navy SEALs are given the green light to assassinate Al-Qaeda kingpin Ahmad Shah - a commander in the Anti-Coalition Militia. Today, the only surviving member of the team who took on that deadly mission is Texan-born Marcus Luttrell, who tells us the real story behind new Hollywood blockbuster Lone Survivor that was inspired by his mission...

"Shah was a serious Taliban force - a mountain man known to have been directly responsible for several lethal attacks on US Marines," recalls Luttrell. Operation Red Wings was launched with the intention of taking out Shah and his men. But within an hour of Luttrell and SEAL Team 10 (consisting of him, Michael P Murphy, Danny Dietz and Matthew Axelson) landing in the Hindu Kush mountains, Shah had launched an ambush. The team were attacked with AK-47s and Rocket Propelled Grenades (RPGs), and soon became cut off in the mountain range. Luttrell recounts the horror...

### AMBUSH!

"I shouldered my rifle and rolled over. There was a huge tree 20 metres above me, and that's where I saw 40 to 50 Taliban militia above. I said to Mike, 'It's go time." Luttrell and his comrades

came under intense fire. "It was steel rain, if you can imagine such a thing. There was nothing we could do, so we started fighting an intense gunfight. For three to five minutes we sat in the grove of trees shooting. But every time I'd shoot someone, another fighter would take his spot. It was hard to tell where they were coming from as they were manoeuvring to get a better vantage on us, but we couldn't move. Normally,



### **HUNTED!**

'Hey man, I just took a hit!

We need to get out of here.'

We tried to fall back."

Tragically, Murphy, Dietz and Axelson were killed on the mountain that day, alongside the crew of a Chinook helicopter which the SEAL team had called in that was taken down by an RPG. Luttrell was alone.

"I grabbed my rifle to try to move but, when I stood up, the ground gave way and I started to tumble. I was paralysed from the waist down and found out afterwards that I'd broken my back and my pelvis, and I'd been shot – 11 through and through bullet wounds with shrapnel sticking out of both legs."

"I rolled over and started belly-crawling, although I couldn't pick my legs up, so I was effectively dragging the shrapnel into me."

"I wedged myself into the side of the mountain and covered myself with rocks. All my med gear was destroyed, so I stuffed mud it into my legs to stop the bleeding as I began blacking out. I lay there all day. I didn't move one inch as they knew how many of us there were, and they were looking for me. I went from being hunter to hunted."

Eventually, a Pashtun villager named Gulab discovered Luttrell. Living by an ancient Islamic code to protect those - even enemies - in need, Gulab defied the Taliban and hid the soldier until he was located by American forces.

It's perhaps at this point that Mark Wahlberg's big-

screen retelling of the tale, Lone Survivor, takes on some artistic license. The final scenes feature Gulab's village coming under attack as they harboured the "lone survivor". In reality, Shah's fighters held off.

Luttrell explains, "They wanted me, but they would never kill a hundred Afghan people in order to get me," The fighters needed the villagers on side.

Marcus now runs the Lone Survivor Foundation to help wounded former service personnel recover from their ordeals. He says of his experience: "It was a tale of

brotherhood, and about no matter how bad it gets or what happens, you fight just to protect the guy next to you until you die. It went from hunting this guy down to protecting each other until the end."





#### What was your best night out in Vegas?



#### How exciting is it to play in a team that plays such freeflowing football?



And don't forget, this run of form he's on is great news for England in the run-up to the World Cup!








# The title race isn't over yet!
